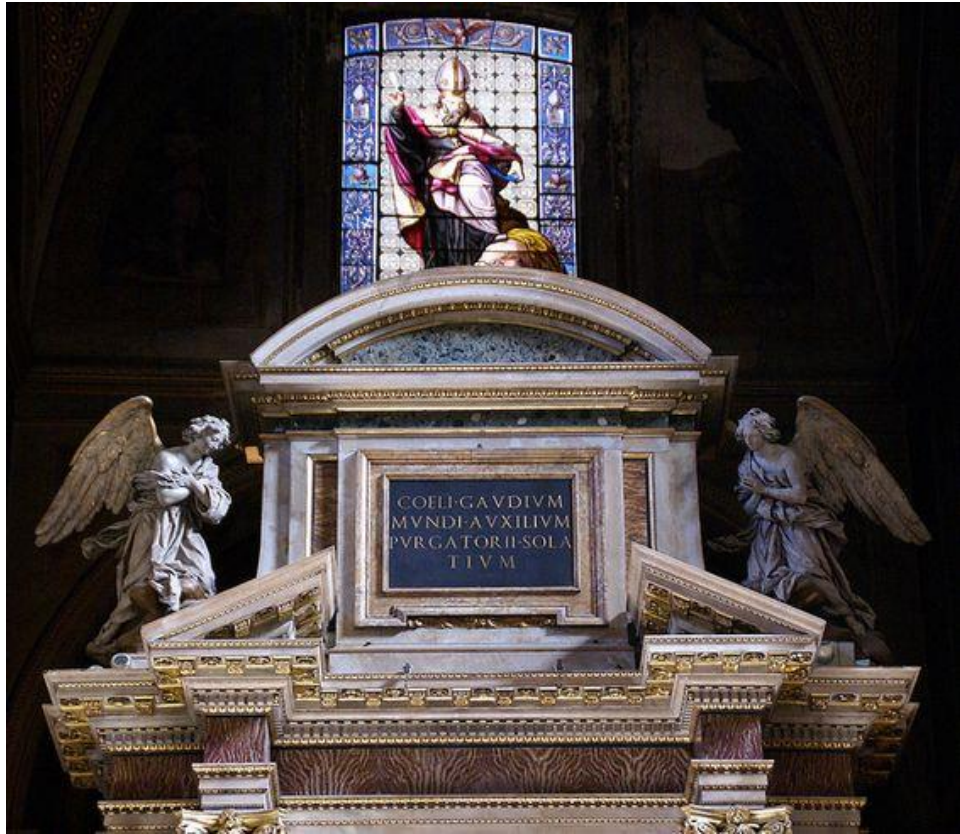


Plate 1: Gian Lorenzo Bernini, High altar of S. Agostino, Church of S. Agostino, Rome. Detail.

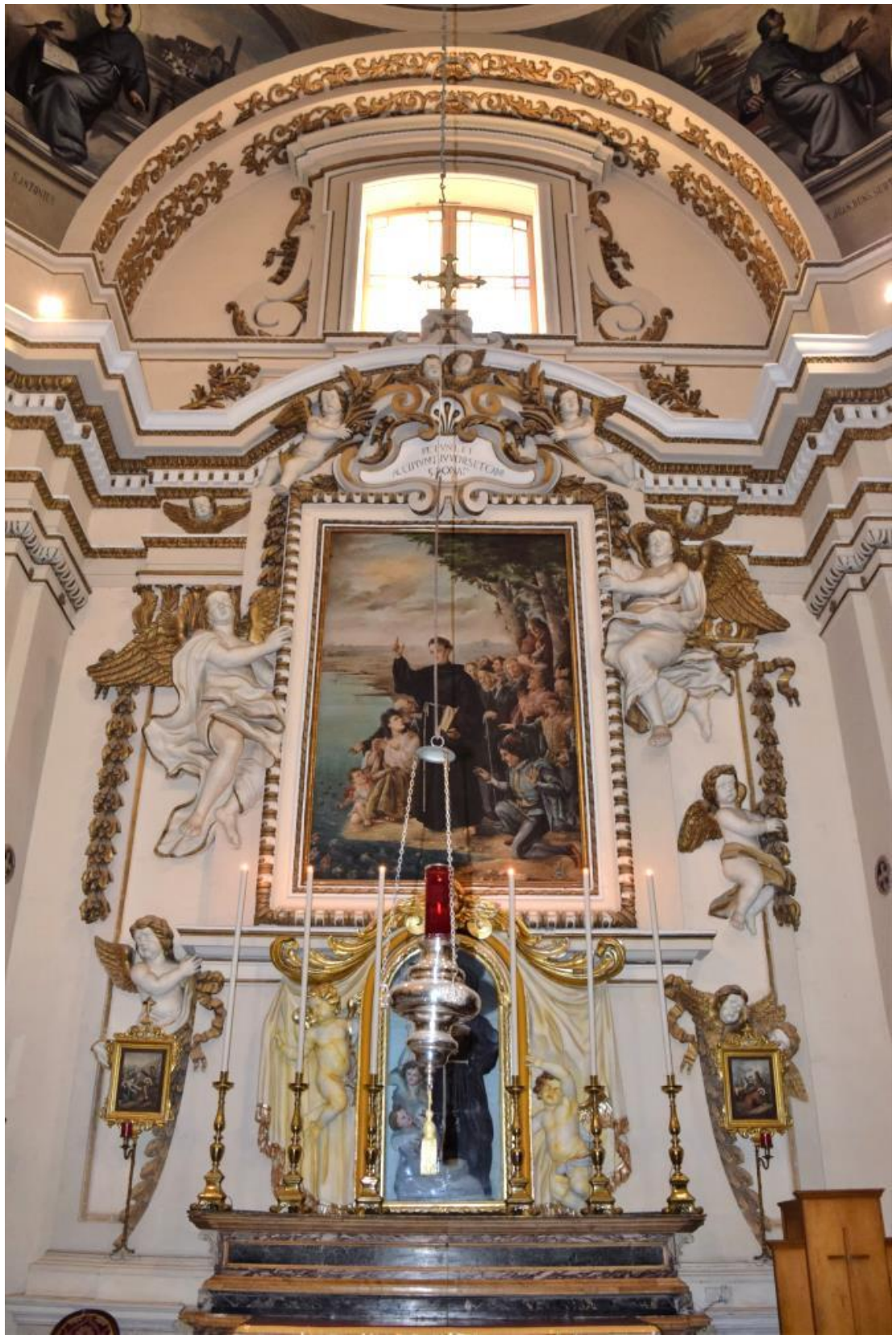

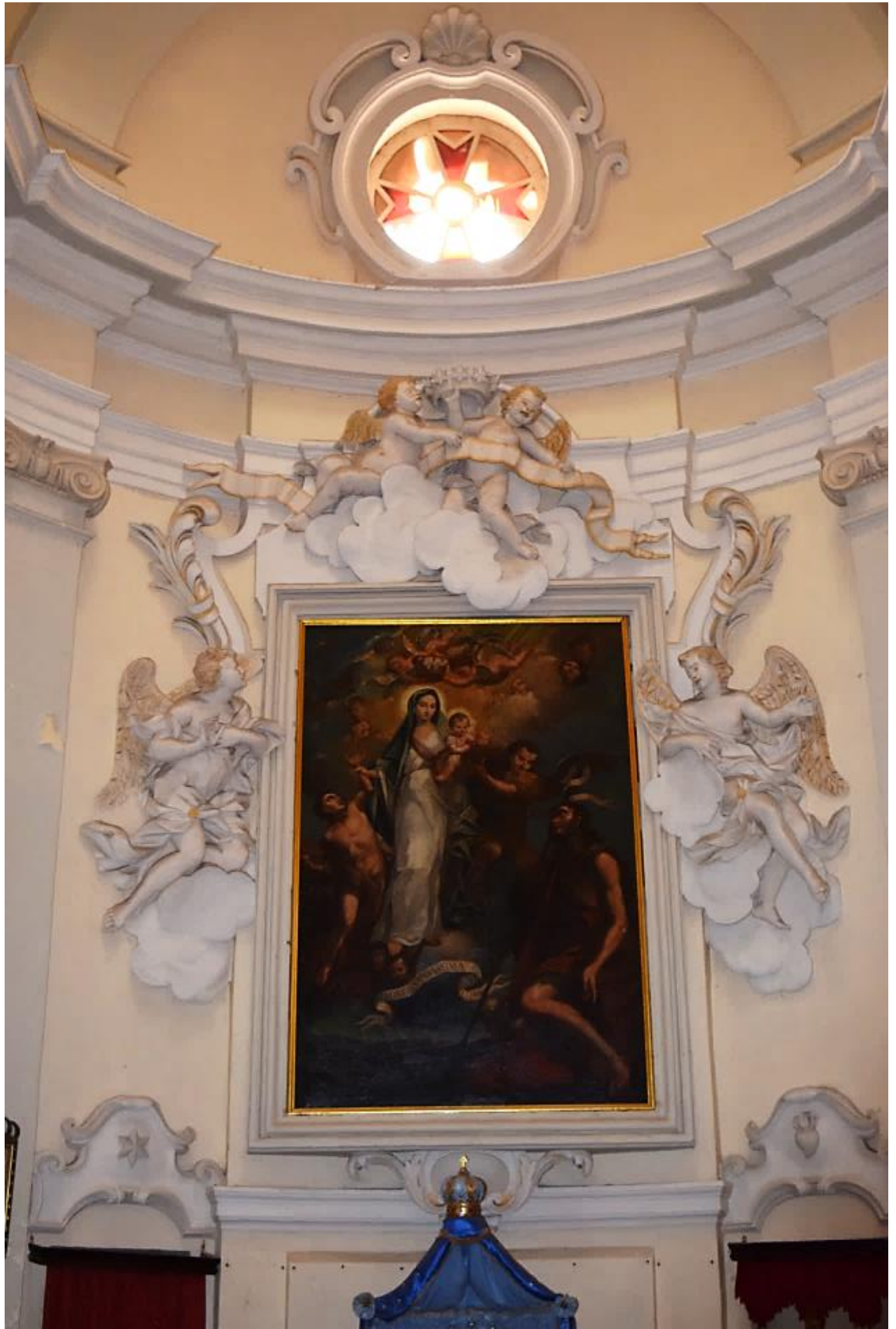

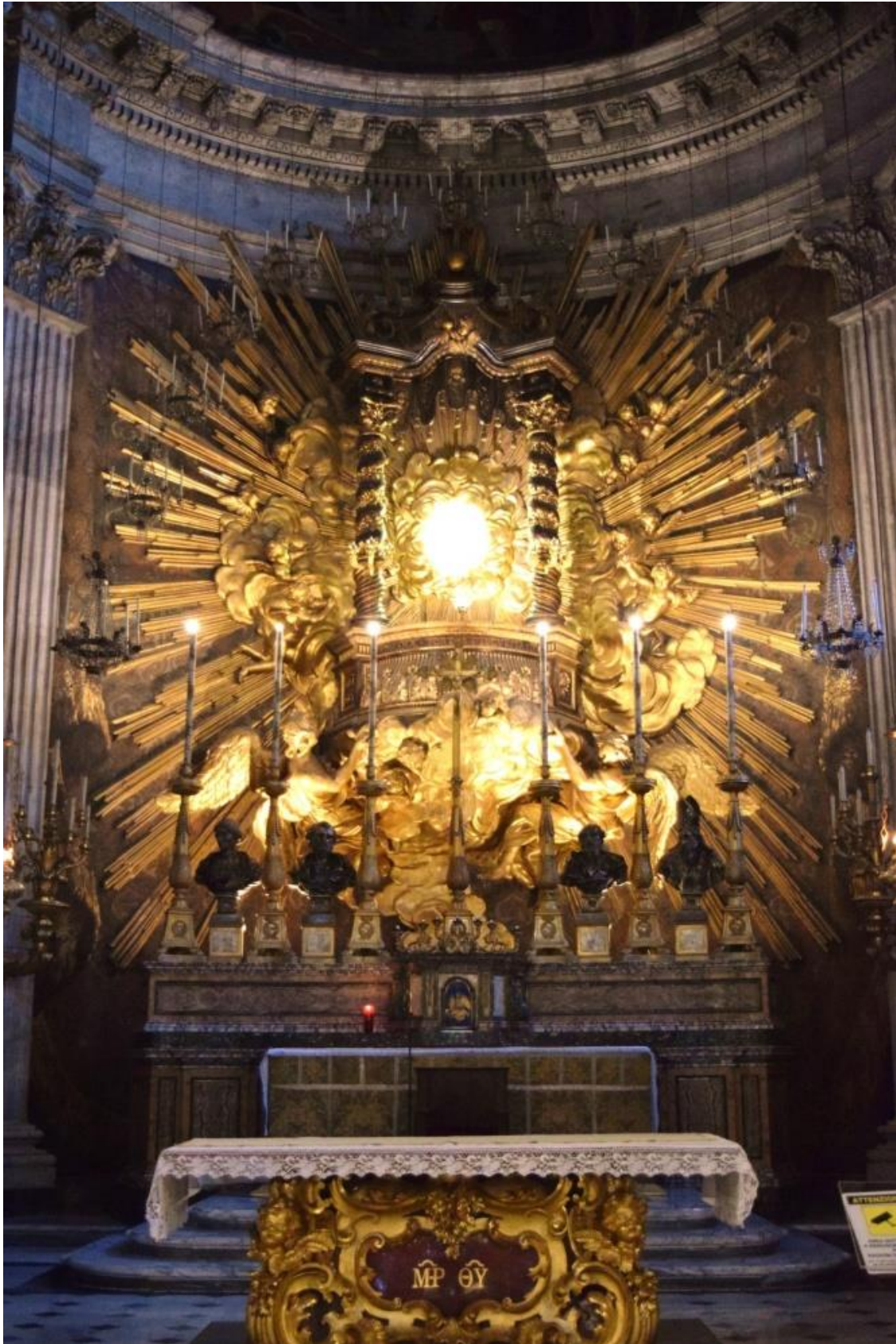

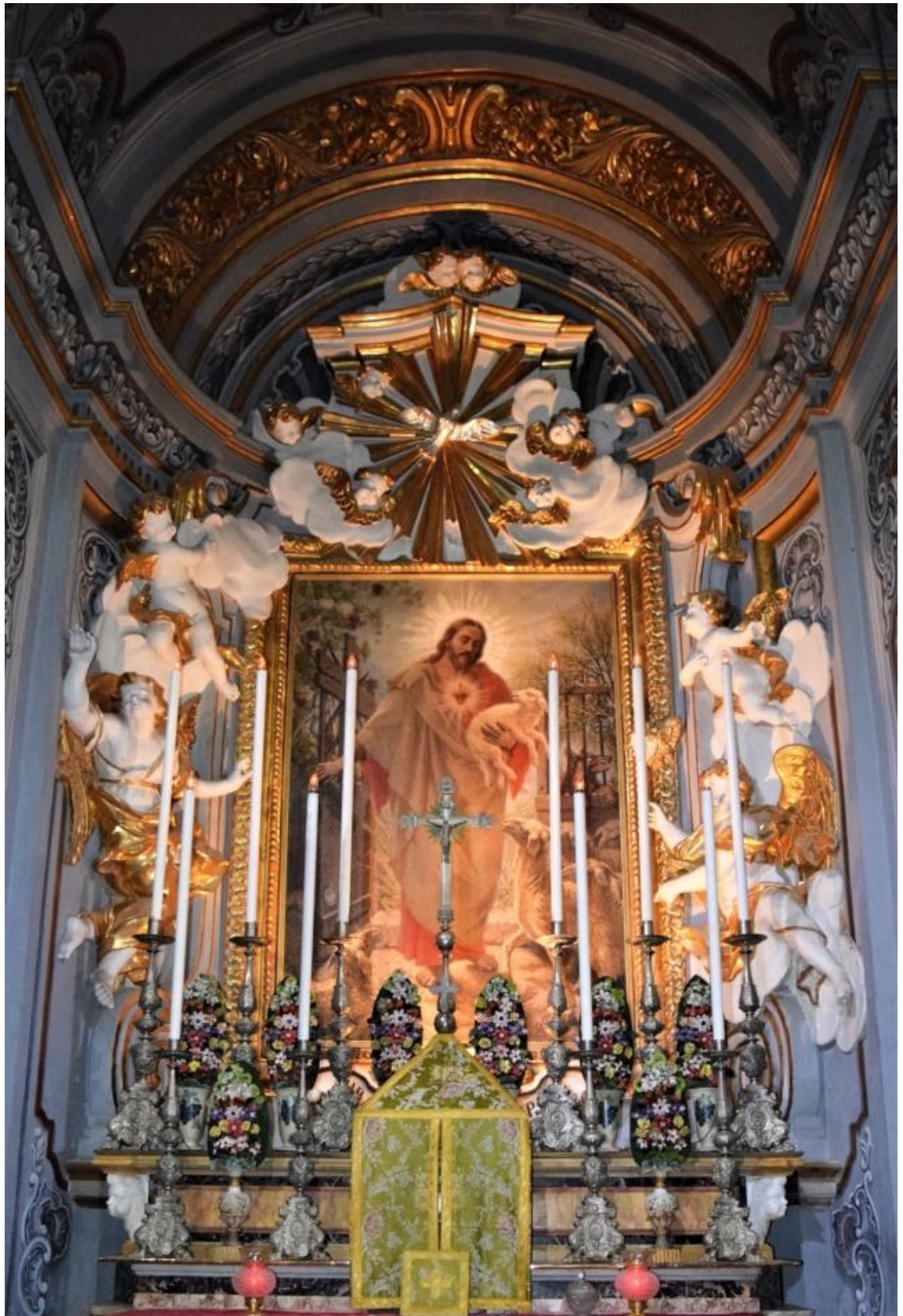

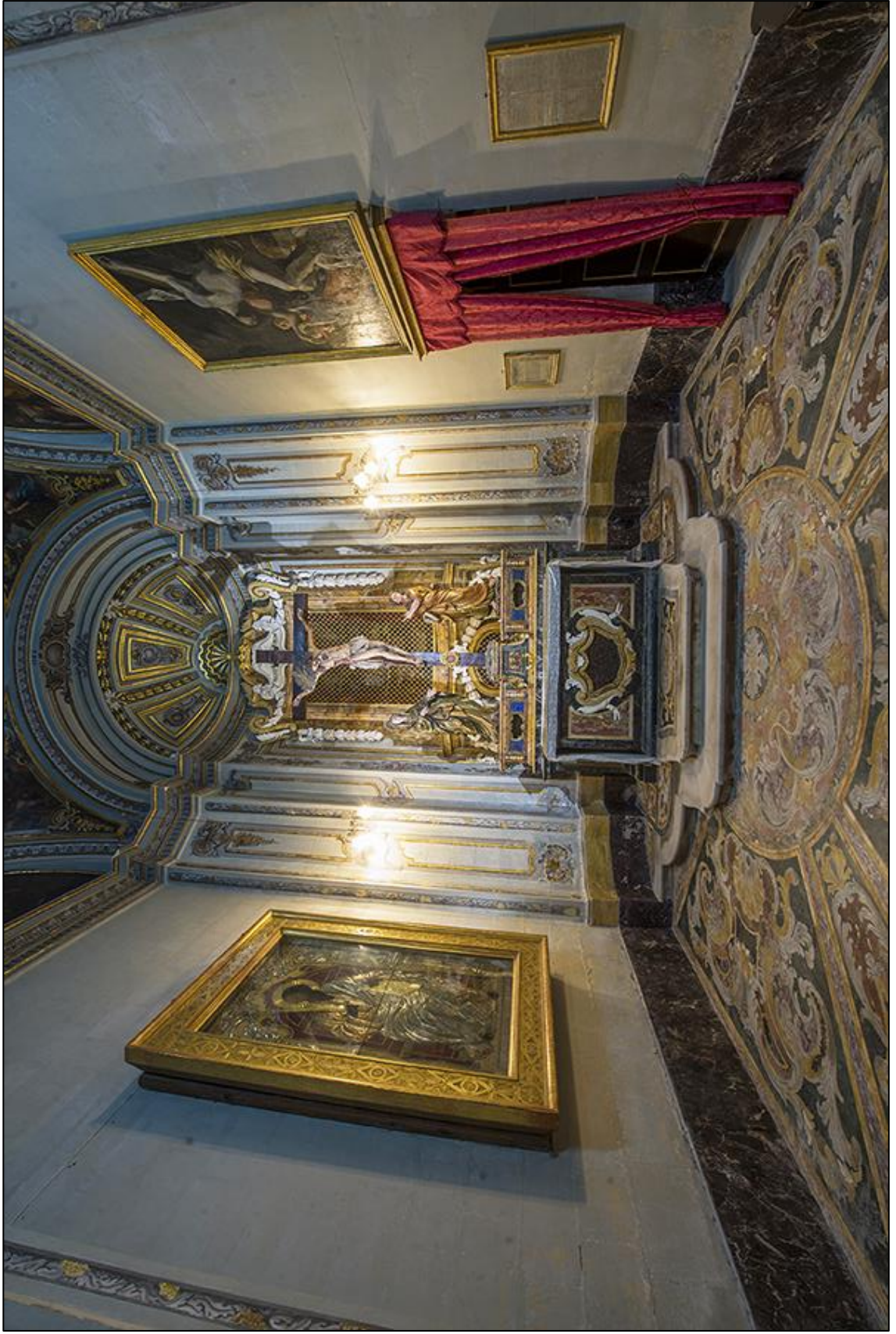


Plate 38: Francesco Zahra and Durante family, Chapel of the Crucifix, Cathedral of St Paul, Mdina.

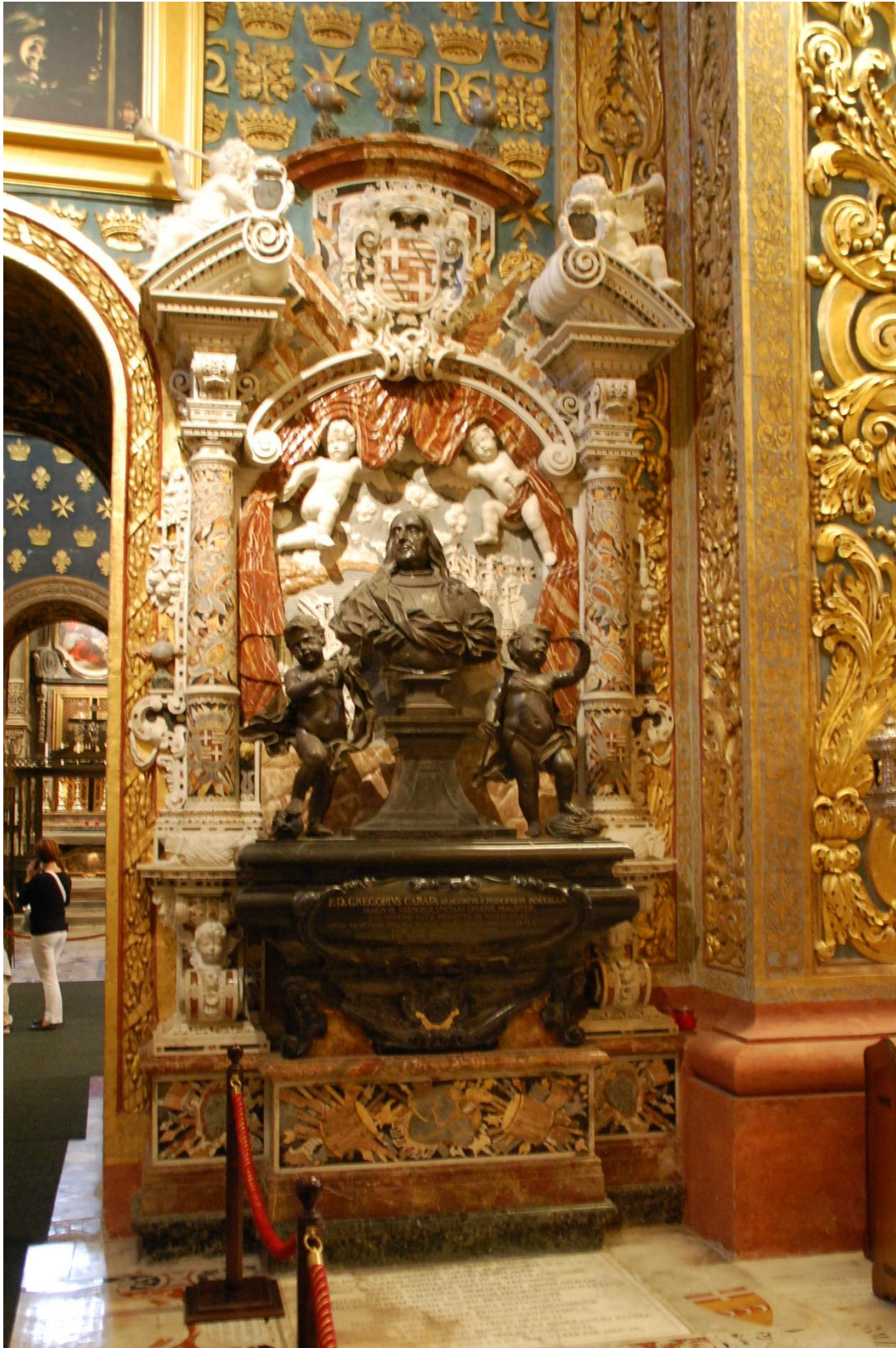

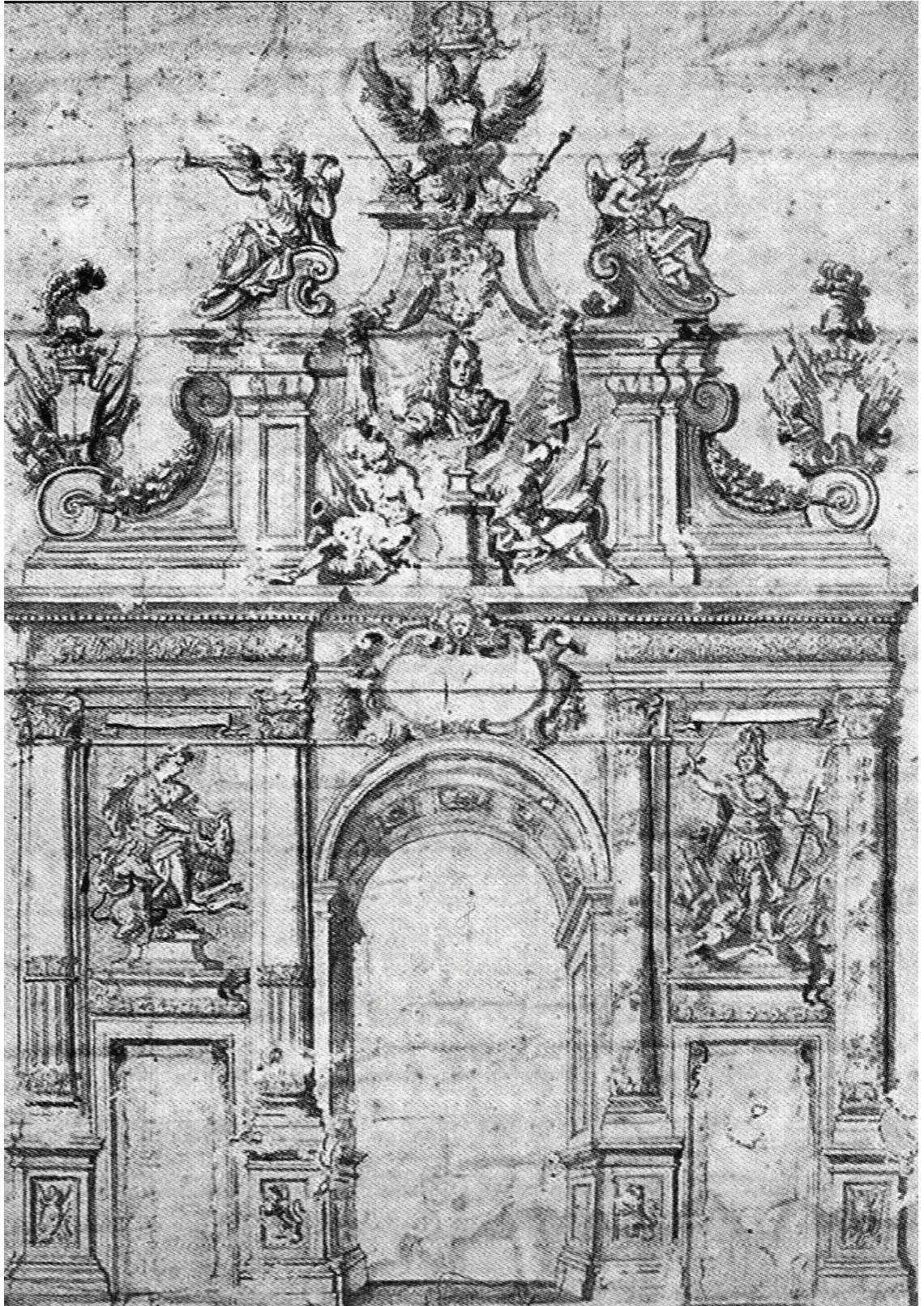


Plate 42: Pietro Paolo Troisi, Design for the Triumphal Arch of Gran Master Vilhena.

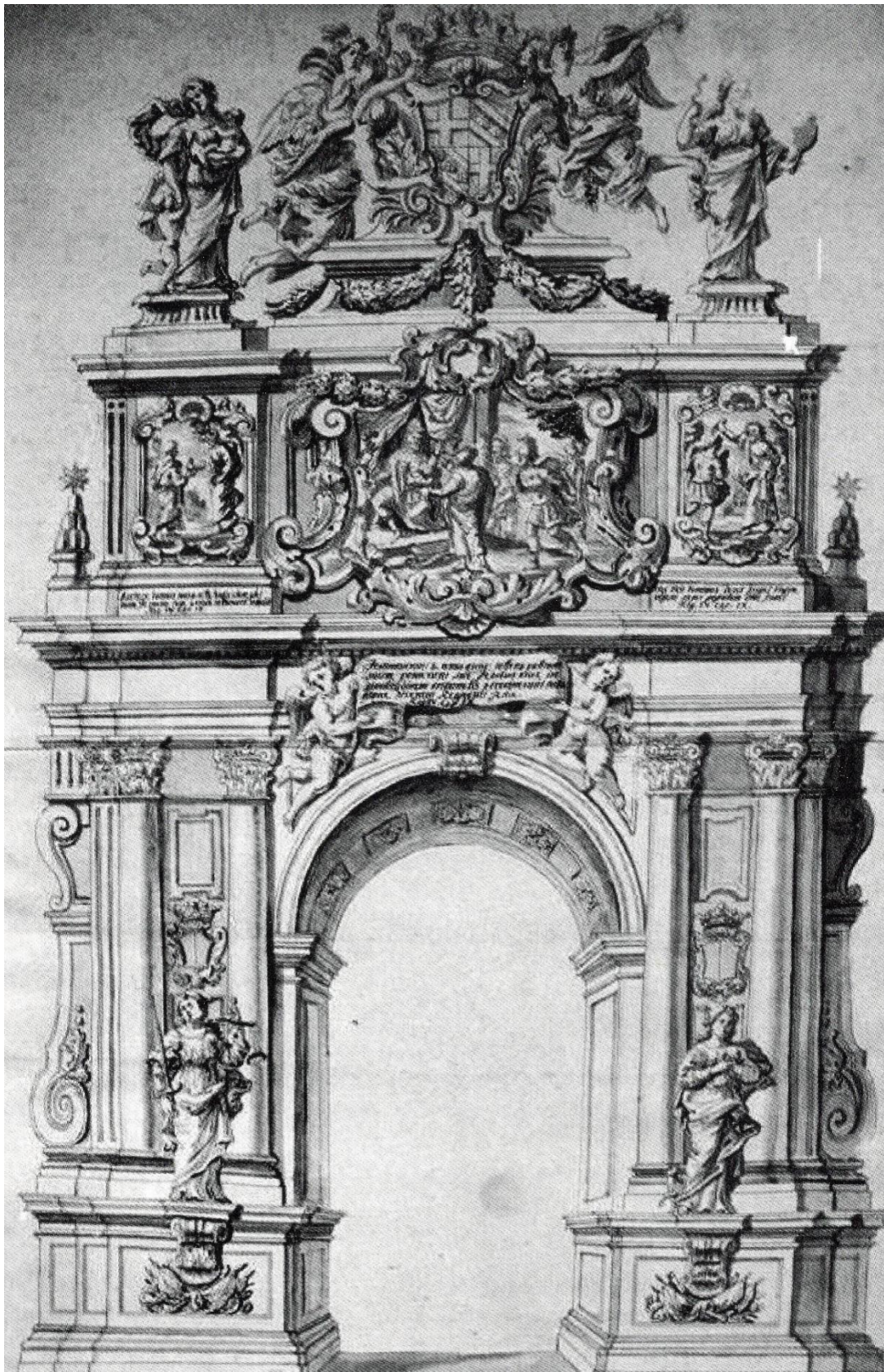


Plate 43: Pietro Paolo Troisi, Design for the Triumphal Arch of Gran Master Zondadari.

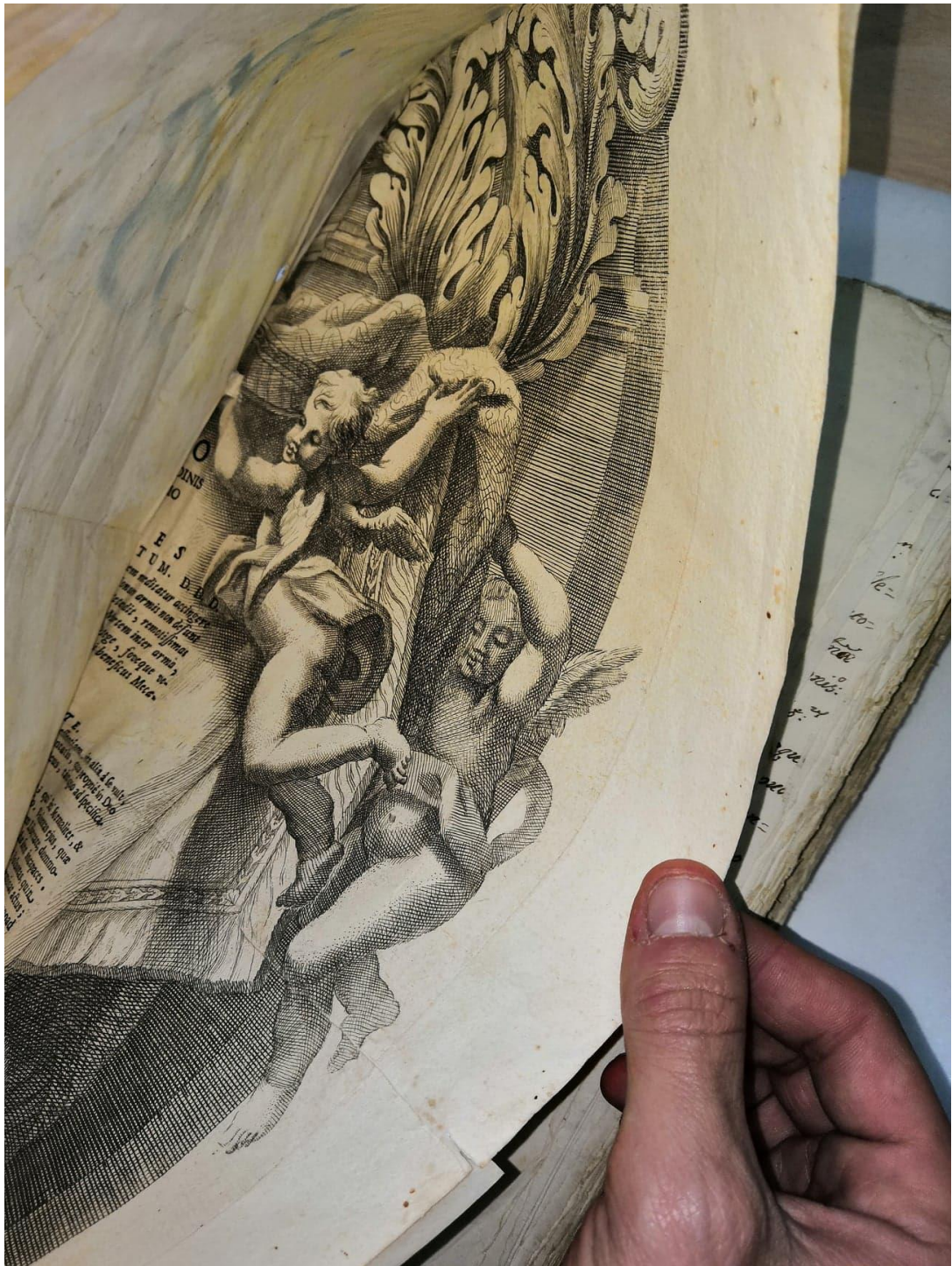

APPENDIX A

QUANTIFICATION OF BERNINESQUE ALTAR REREDOSES IN MALTA DATABASE

Appendix A: Quantification of Berninesque Altar Reredoses in Malta Database

This database represents the majority of churches in Malta which were built either in the late seventeenth to the late eighteenth century or churches which were built earlier than this period but majorly altered in the eighteenth century. The database determines the total number of altars in a church and the style which their altar reredoses adopt. Altars have been categorised into the following sections: Berninesque or Roman Baroque impacted altar reredoses which include figures (such as angels, saints, *putti*); Berninesque or Roman Baroque impacted altar reredoses which do not include figures but include other architectural decoration (such as *gloria* rays, cherub heads, acanthus leaves); altar reredoses which display Barocchetto characteristic elements (that is, sculpture which has moved away from the Late Baroque style but still cannot be categorised as Rococo); altar reredoses which display the style prevalent in seventeenth-century Malta whether actually executed in the seventeenth century or later in a retardataire style (the placing and type of decoration is often determined by the architectural members of the altar reredos); and other styles.

Appendix B: Archival Database

The aim of this archival database is to categorise and organise archival research undertaken mainly at the Notarial Archives, at other archives such as the Mdina Cathedral Archives and the Archiepiscopal Archives at the Curia, Floriana as well as onsite research in churches in Malta and Gozo.

An Excel file entitled '**Archival Database**' is the main repository of information resulting from research at the Notarial Archives (see screenshots on following pages). In addition to the archival reference and the elements of the contract, an analysis of the work of art which is mentioned in the contract is also included. The catalogue number refers to another folder (CAT_NO_1) which includes several files including photos of the archival documentation, the work of art, and photos of other works or prints with which any comparisons may be drawn. Occasionally, a text file is also included to add any other information needed to be divulged. What follows is a sample of the extensive database.

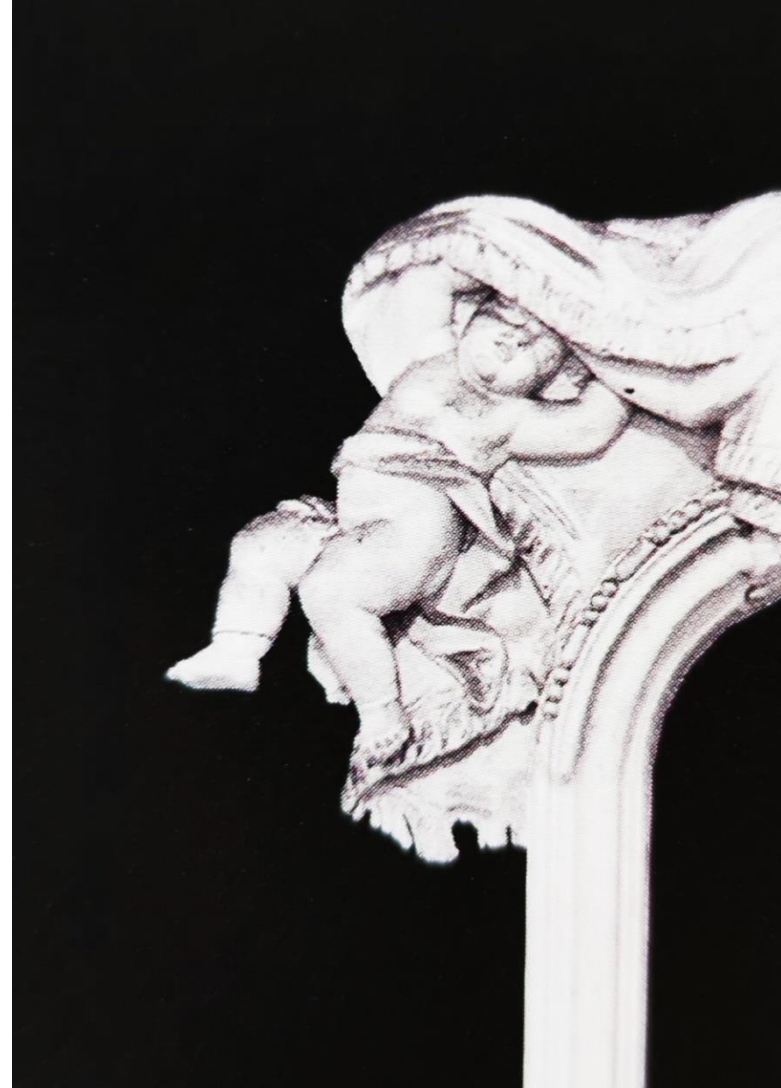

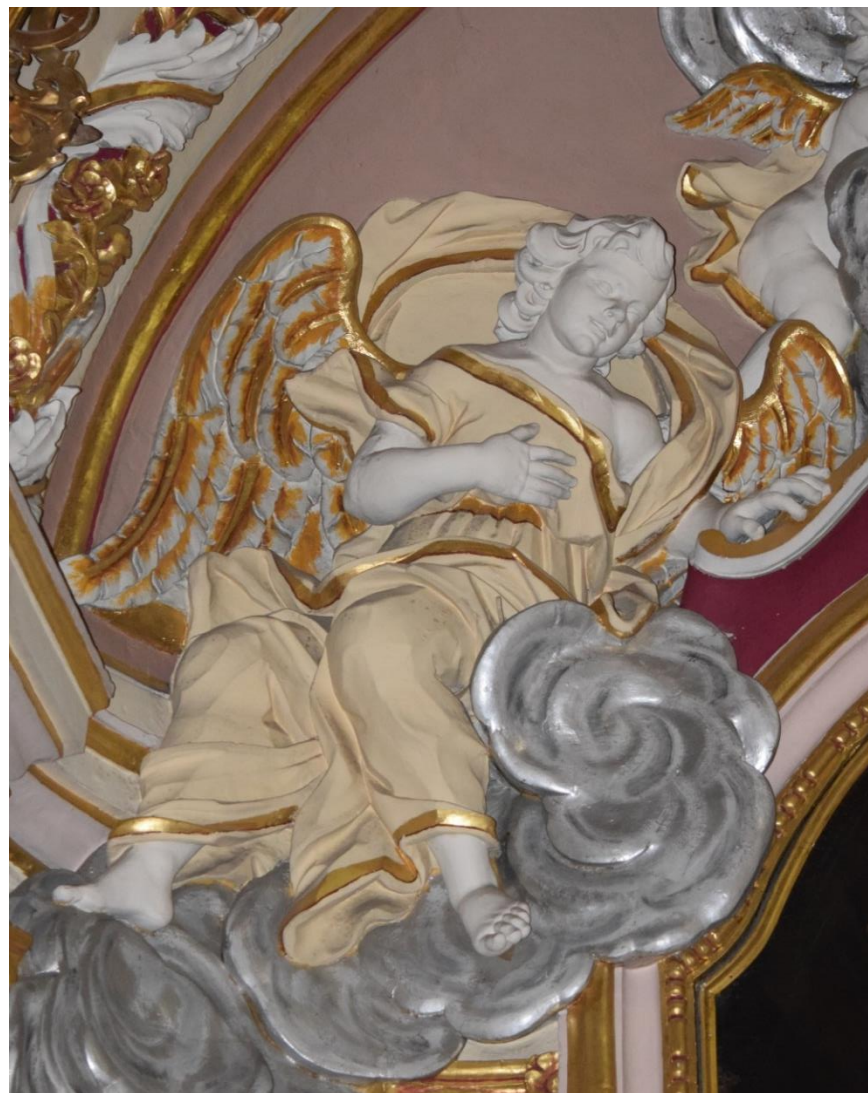


Fig. C.14 Parish church of St Philip of Agira, Żebbuġ. Detail. (right)

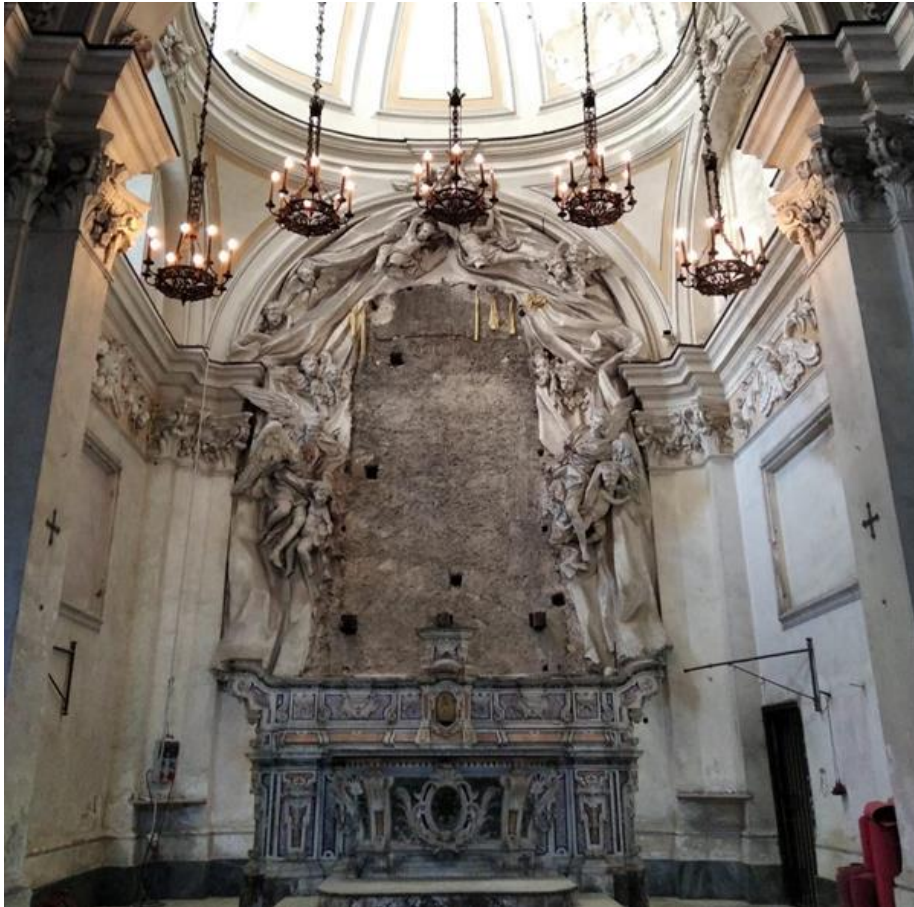


Fig. C.15 Chiesa della Compagnia della Disciplina della Santa Croce, Naples. Detail. (left)

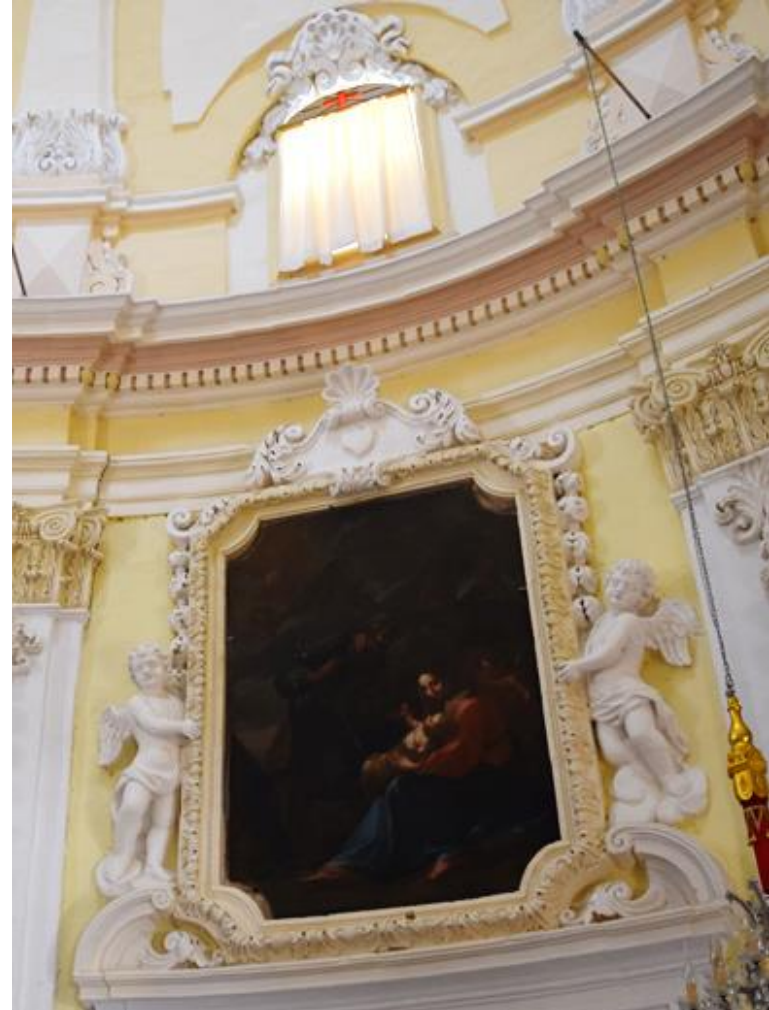


Fig. C.48 Church of the Virgin of Providence, Siggiewi. Detail. (right)

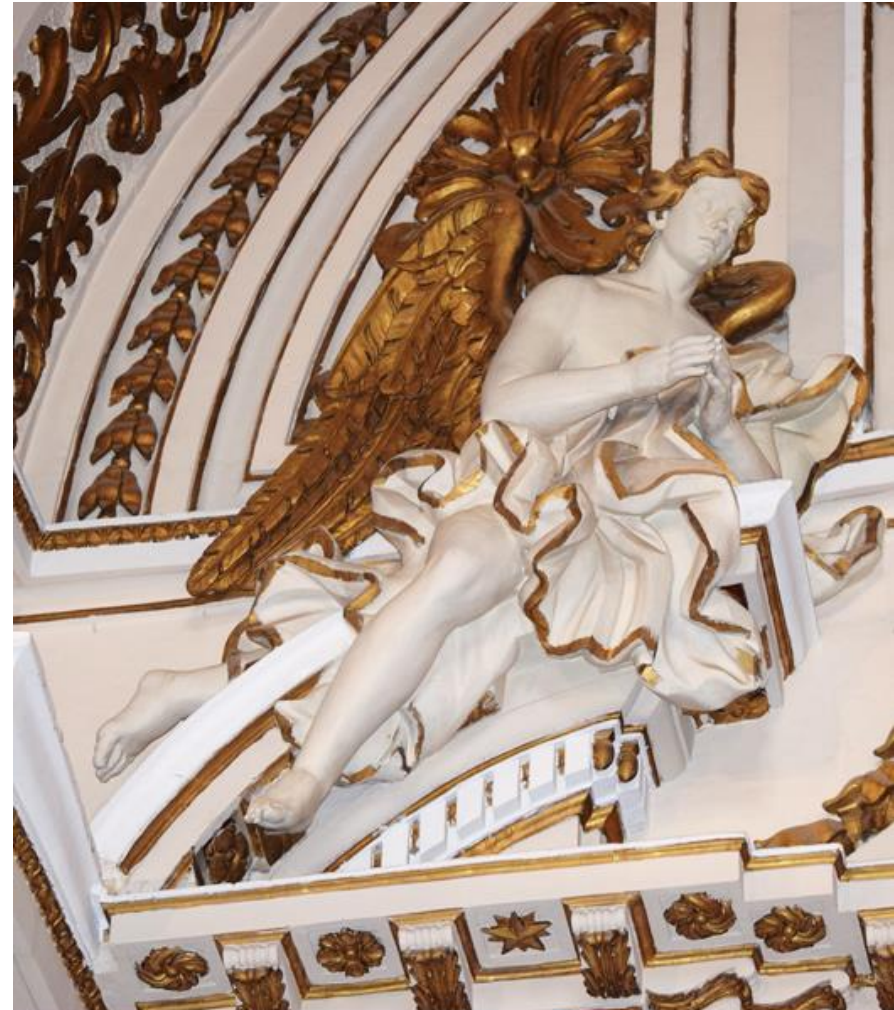


Fig. C.52 Church of St Francis, Rabat. Detail. (right)

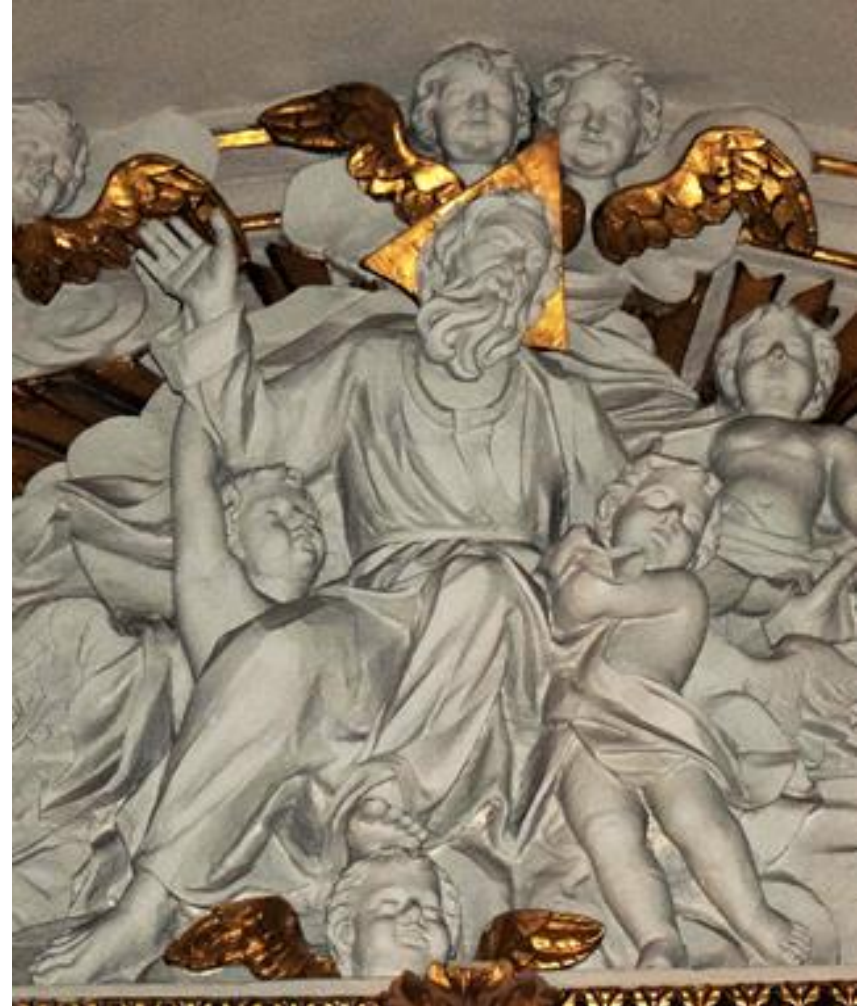


Fig. C.60 Parish church of St Helen, Birkirkara. Detail. (right)

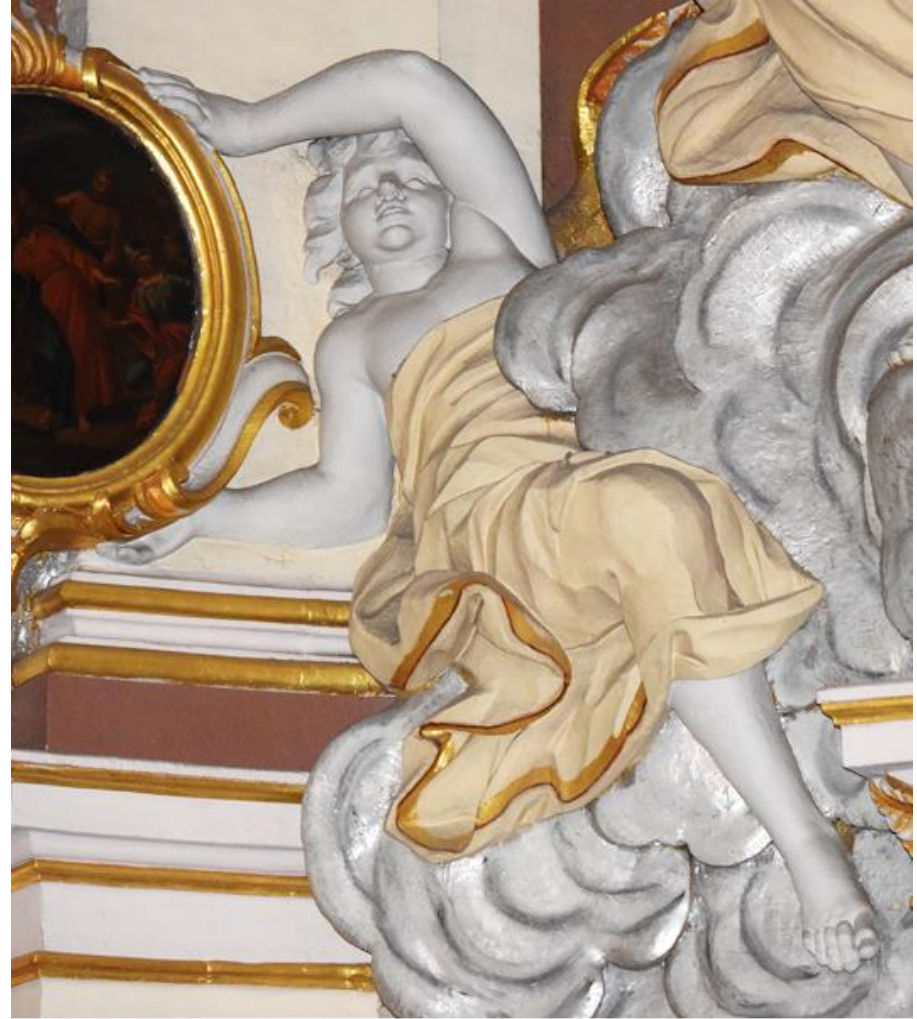


Fig. C.64 Parish church of St Philip of Agira, Żebbuġ. Detail. (right)

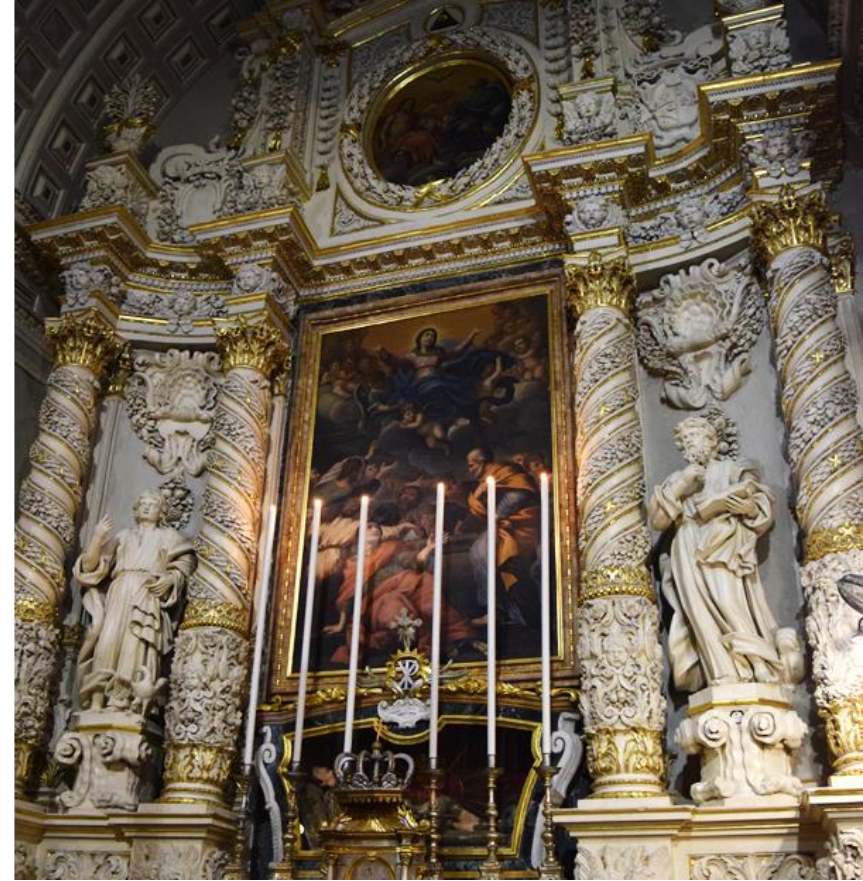


Fig. D.22 Parish church of the Assumption of the Virgin, Attard. Detail. (right)

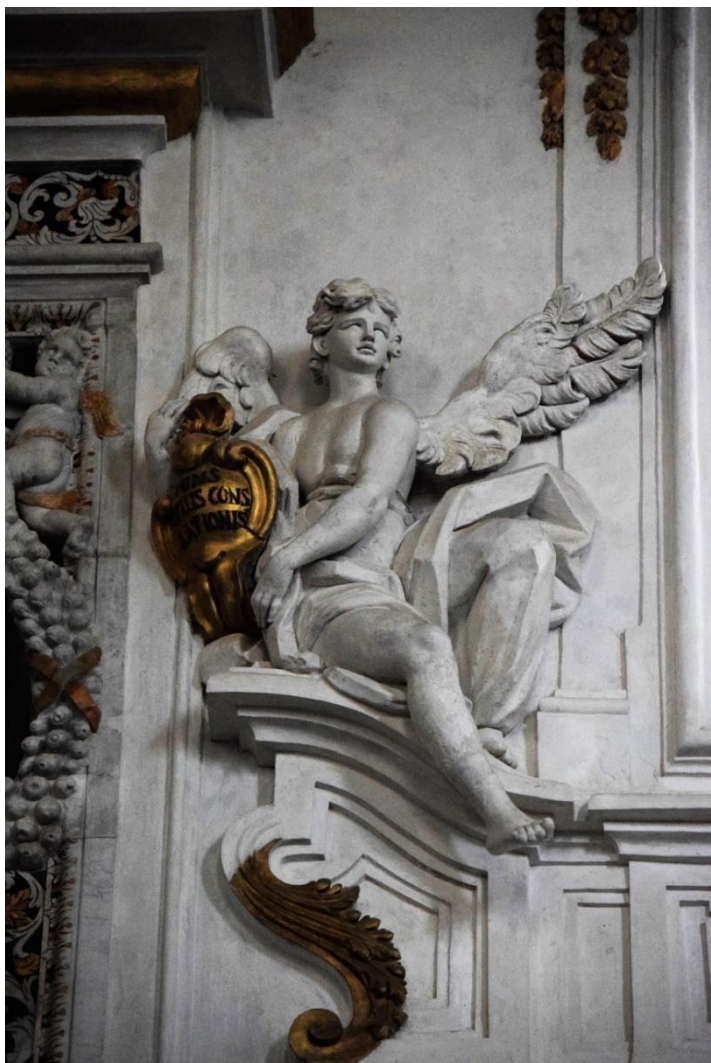


Fig. E.9 Chiesa del Gesù, Palermo. Detail. (left)

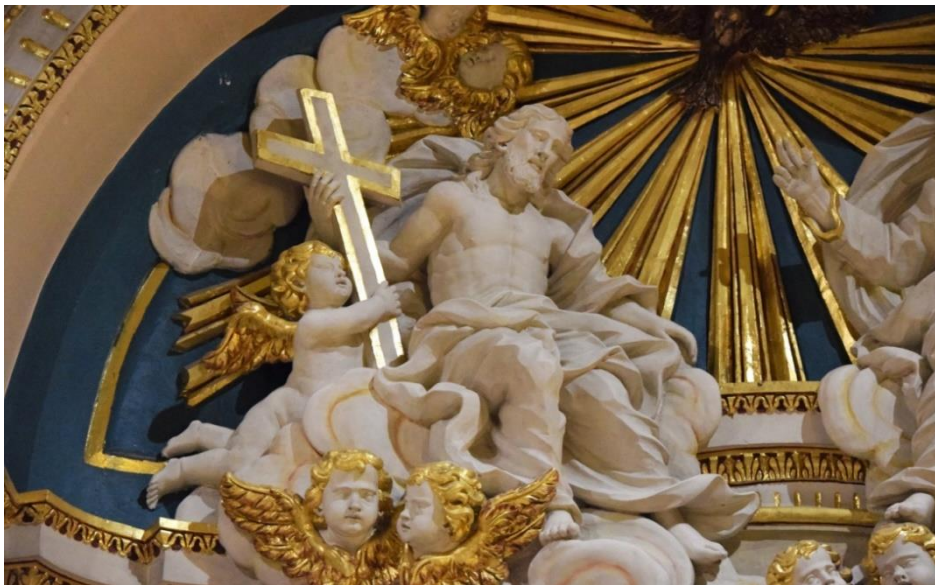


Fig. E.41 Parish church of the Assumption, Qrendi. Detail.

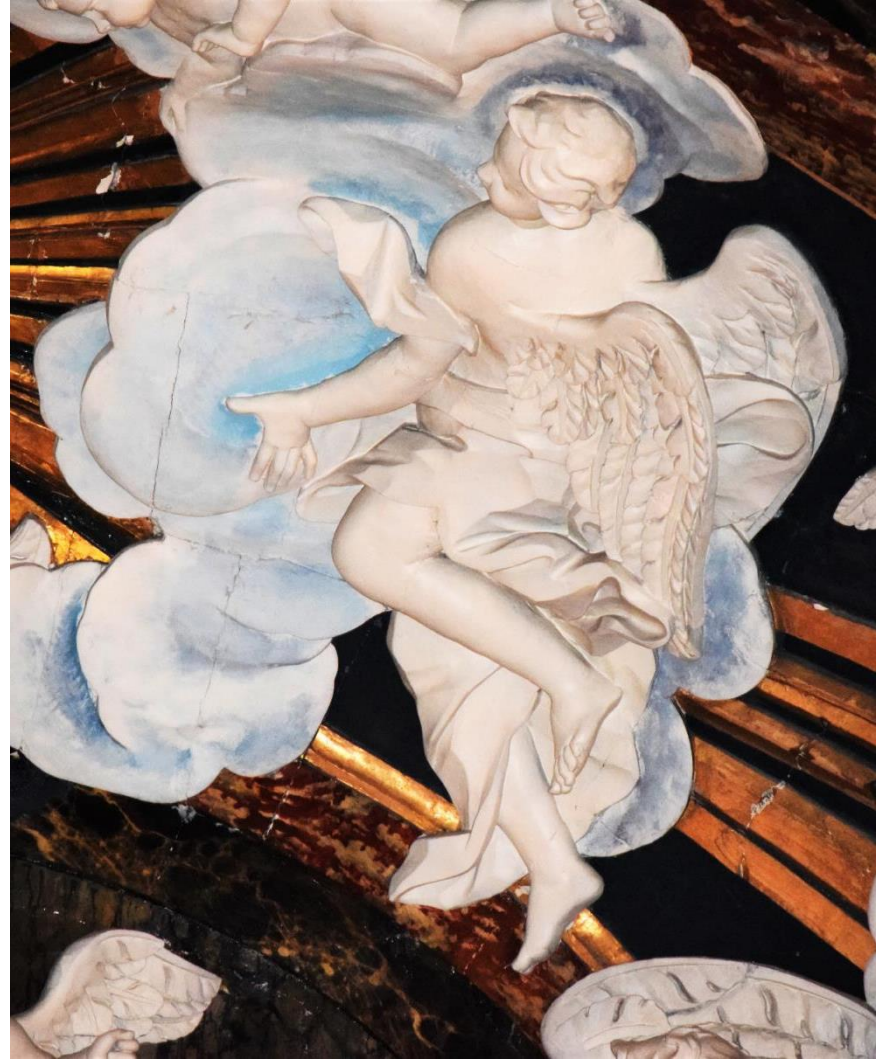


Fig. E.63 Church of St Philip Neri, Senglea. Detail. (right)

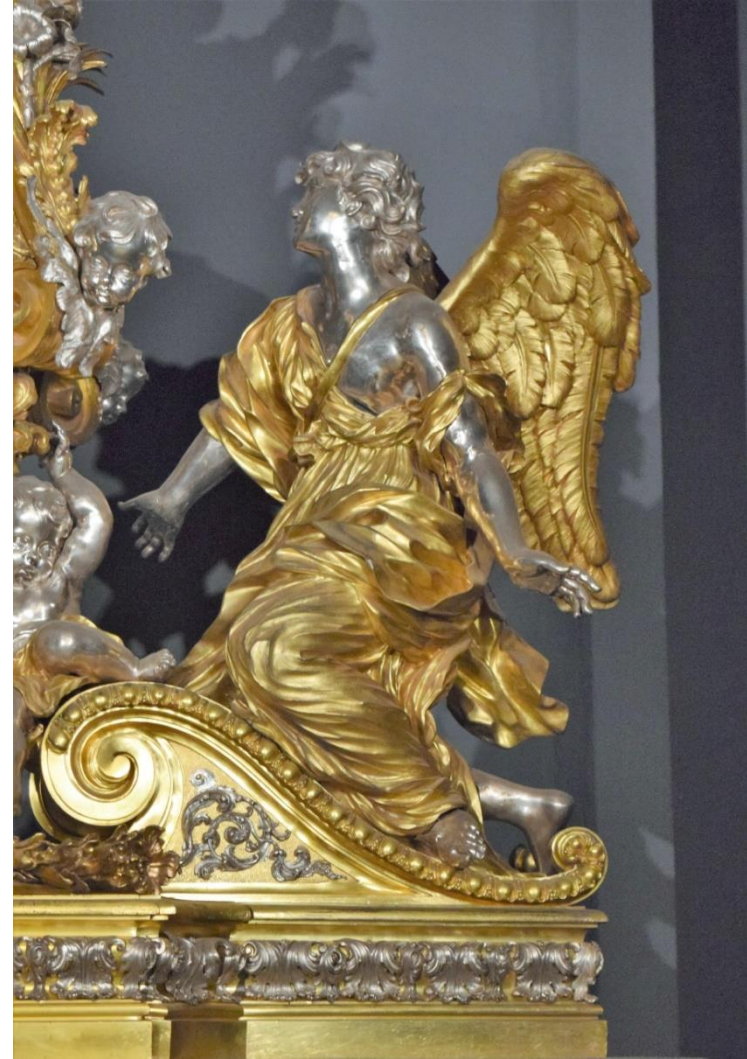


Fig. E.82 Reliquary for the Right Hand of St John the Baptist, St John's Co-Cathedral, Valletta. Detail. (right)

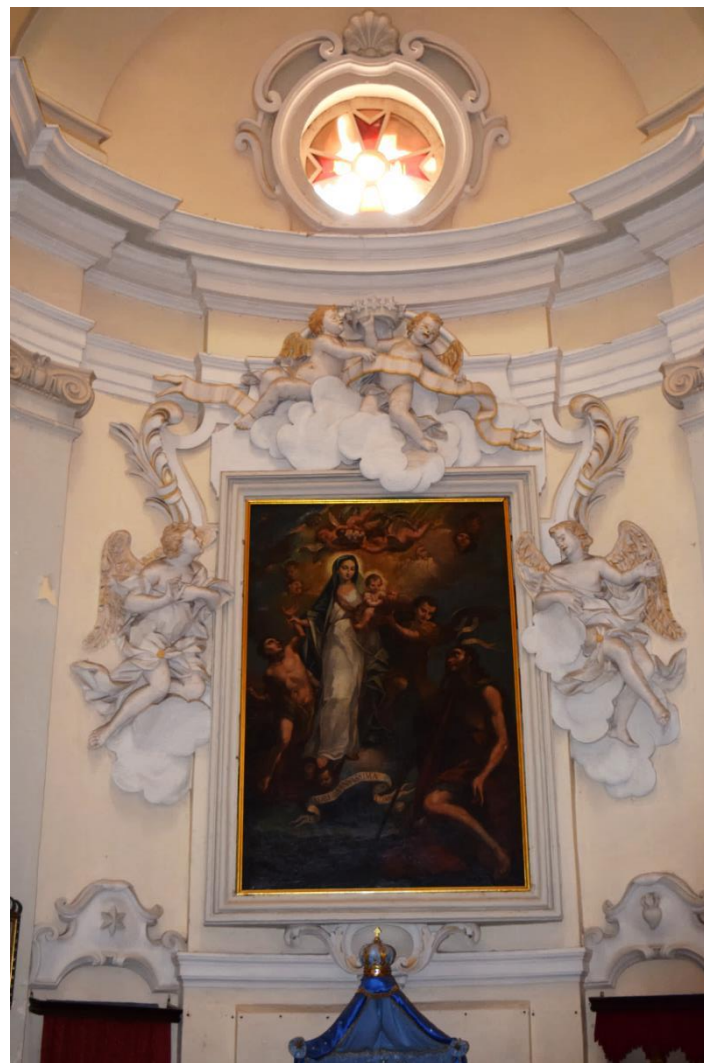


Fig. E.86 Church of St James, Žurrieq. (right)

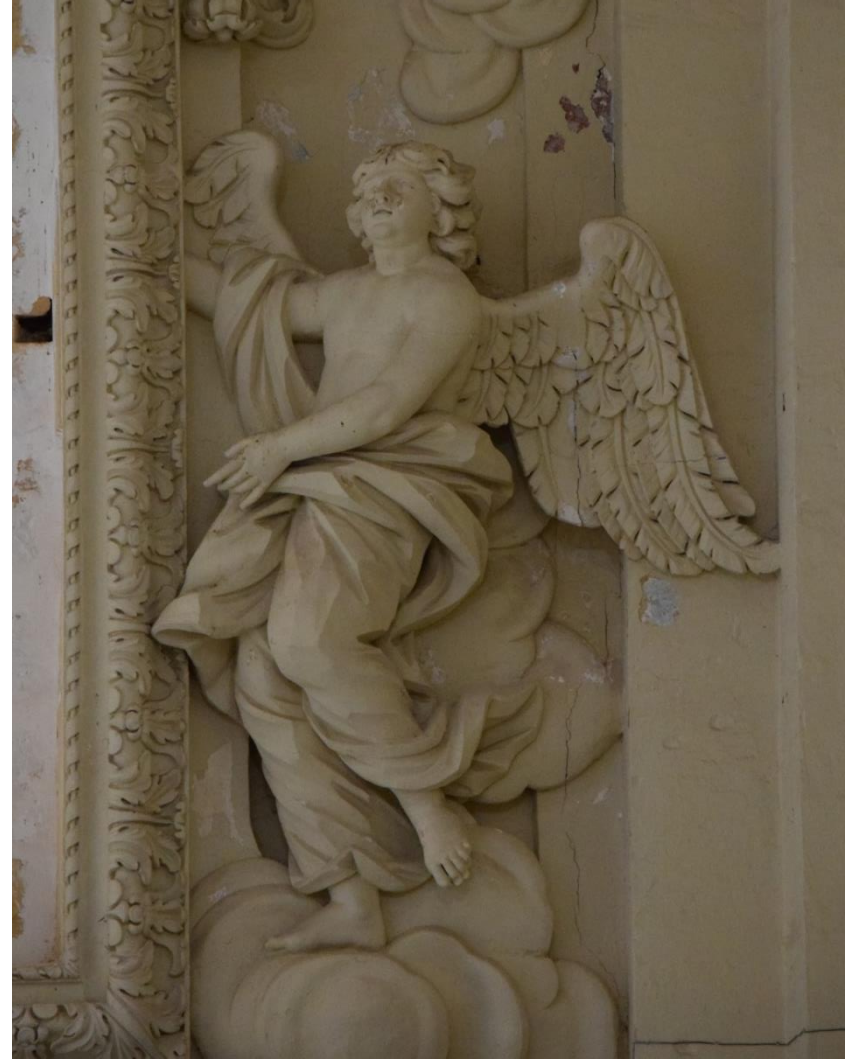


Fig. E.88 Church of the Virgin of Mercy, Qrendi. Detail. (right)

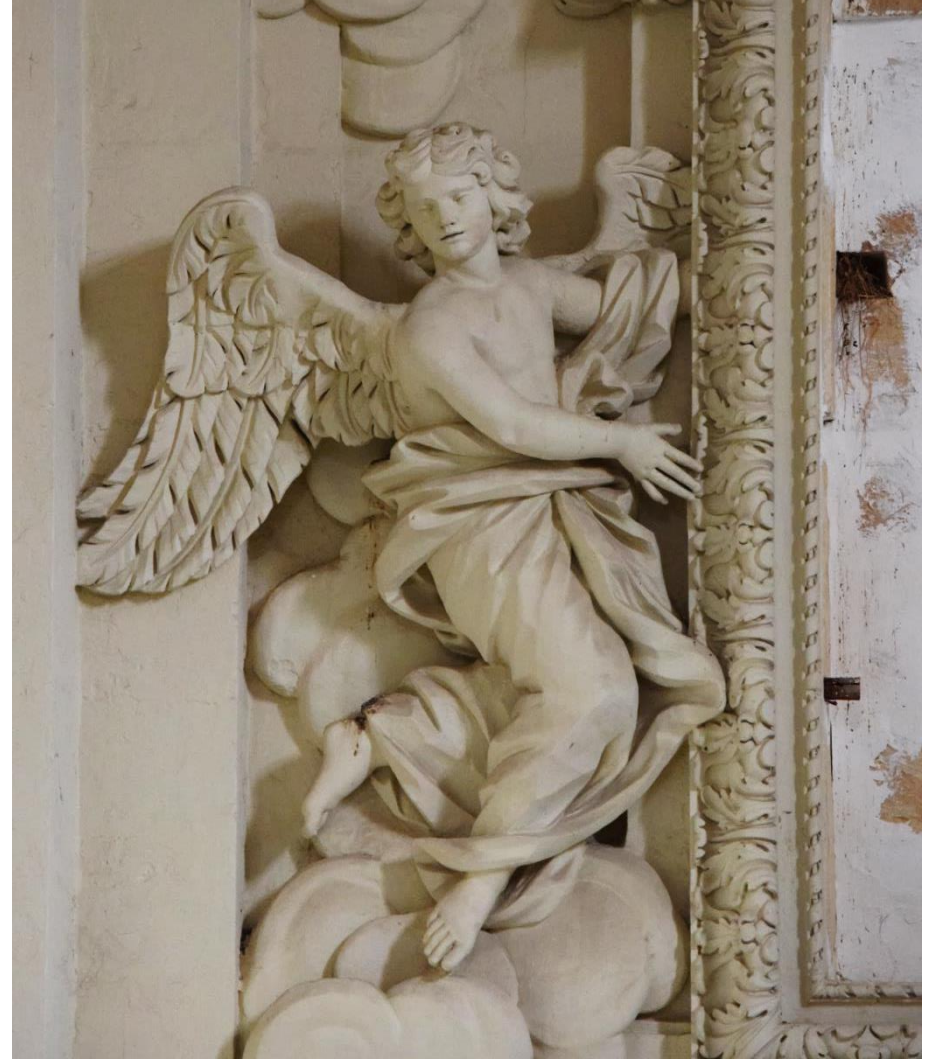


Fig. E.90 Church of the Virgin of Mercy, Qrendi. Detail. (right)

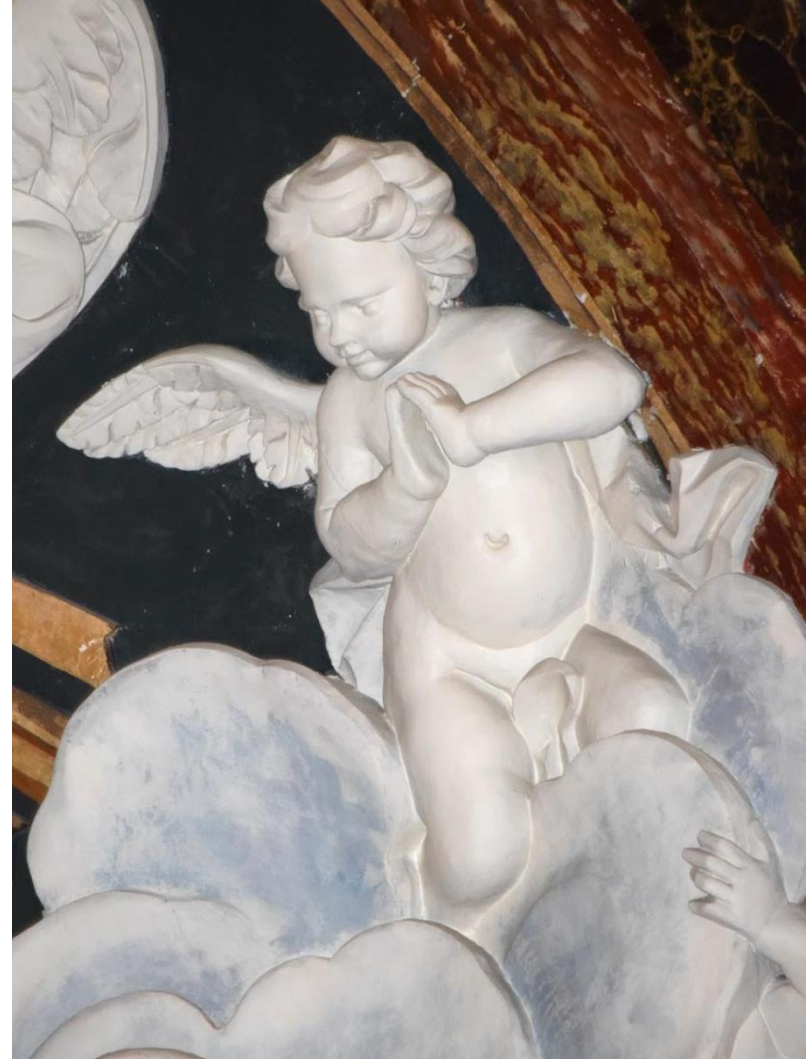


Fig. E.92 Church of St Philip Neri, Senglea. Detail. (right)

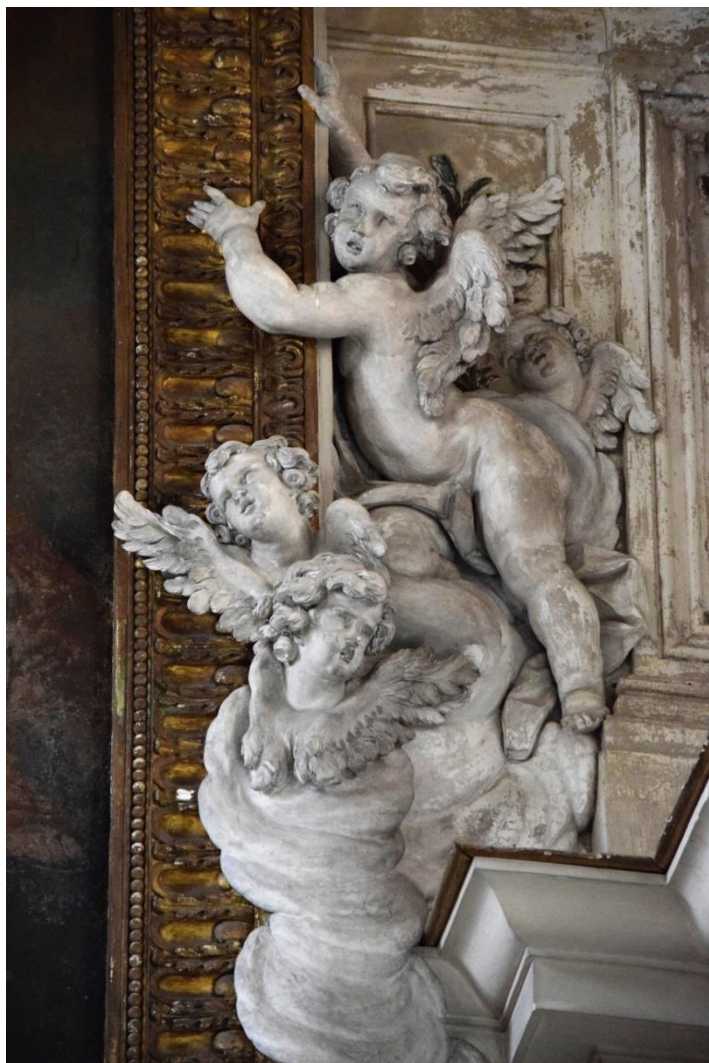


Fig. E.93 Chiesa di Santa Ninfa dei Crocieferi, Palermo. Detail. (left)

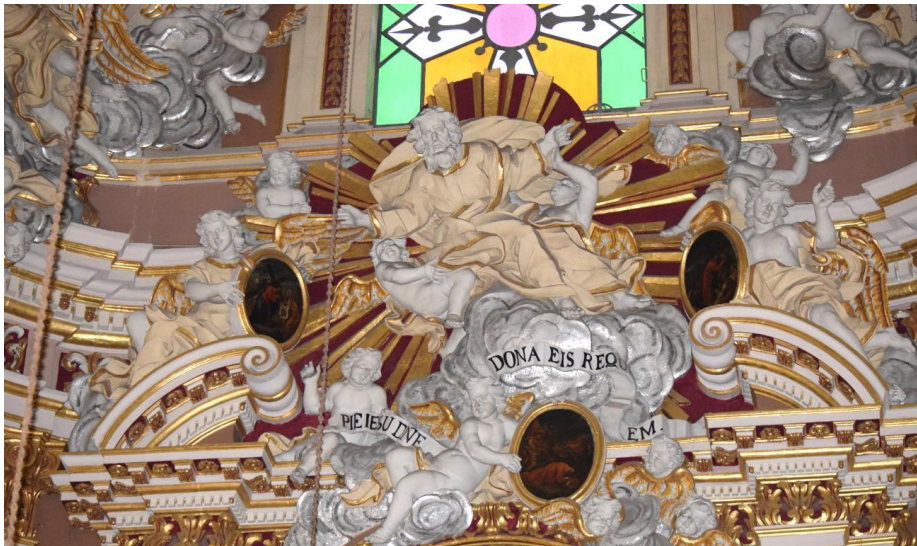


Fig. E.108 Parish church of St Philip of Agira,

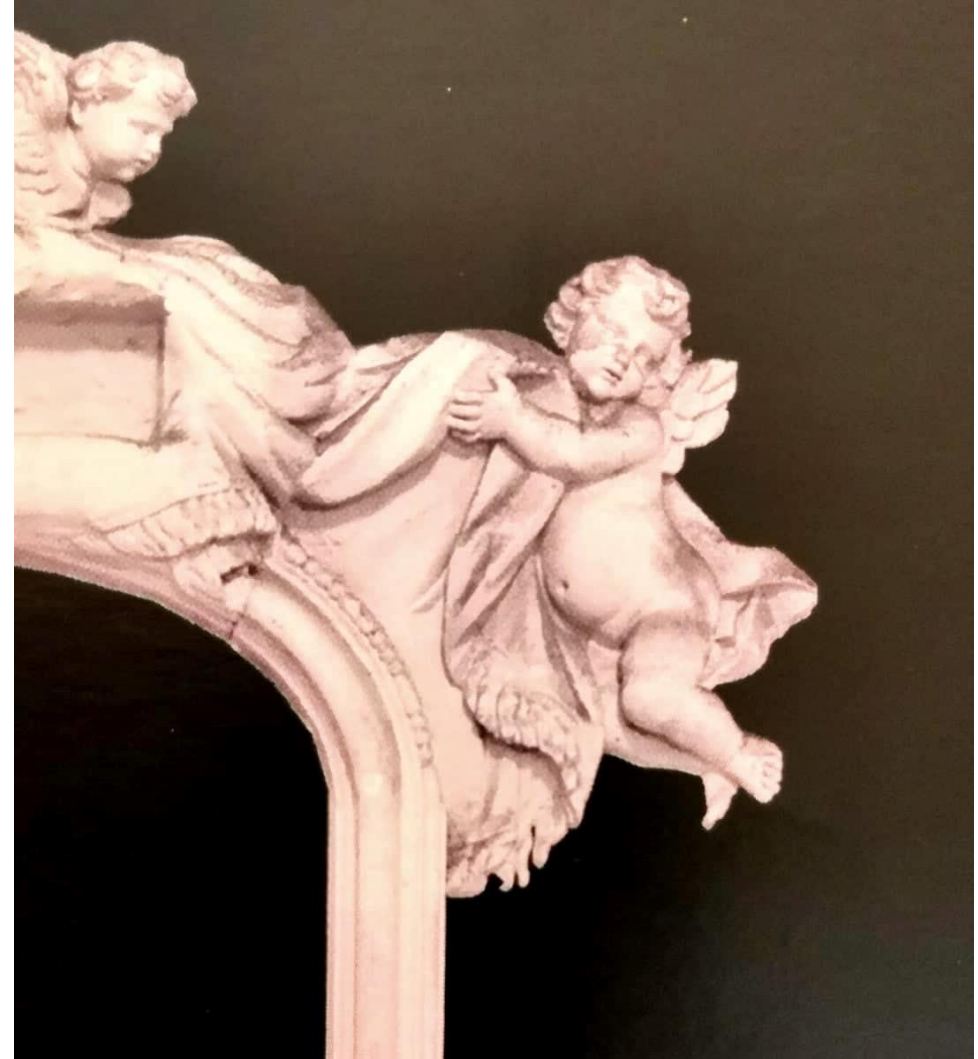


Fig. E.110 Church of St Mary Magdalene, Valletta. Detail. (right)

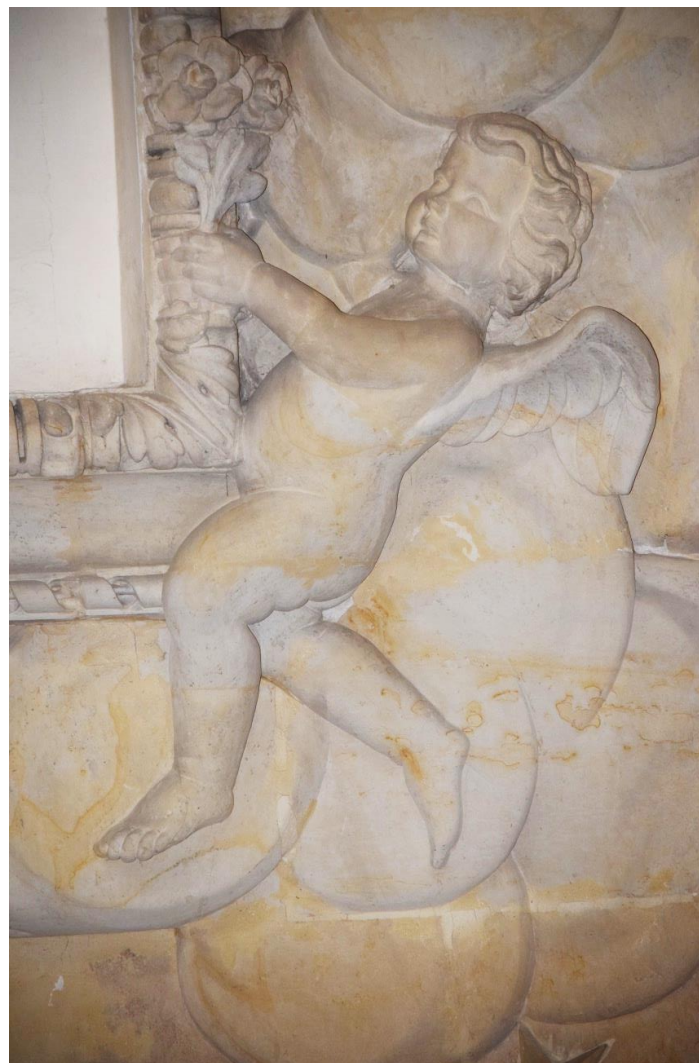


Fig. E.121 Old Parish church of St Mary, Birkirkara. Detail. (right)

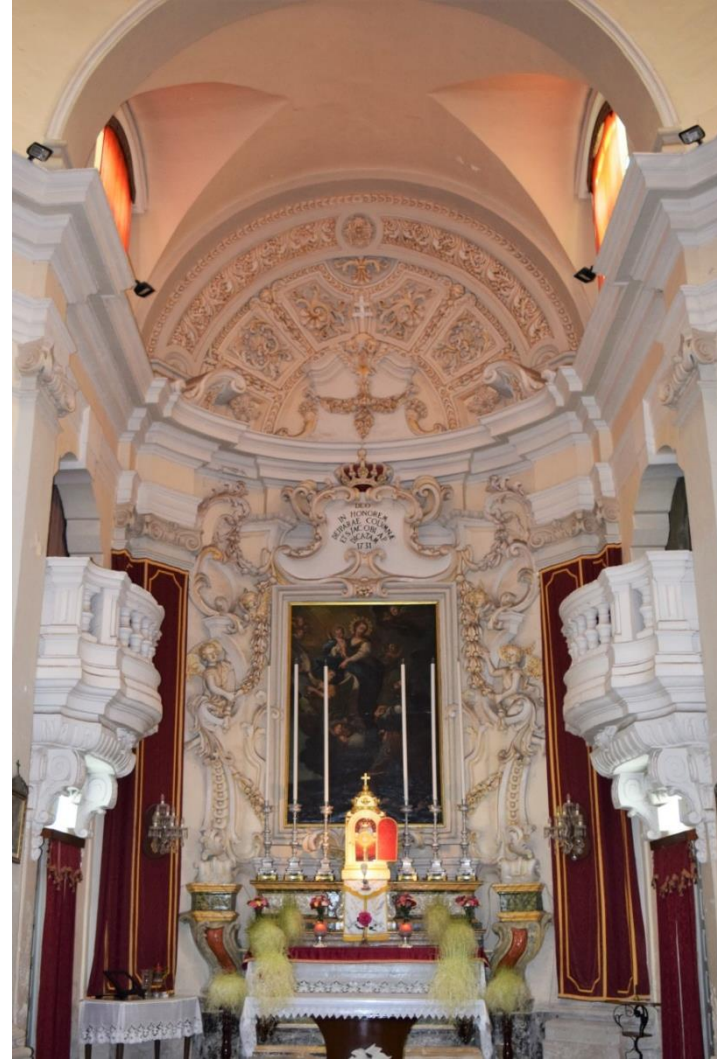


Fig. E.123 Church of St James, Żurrieq. (right)

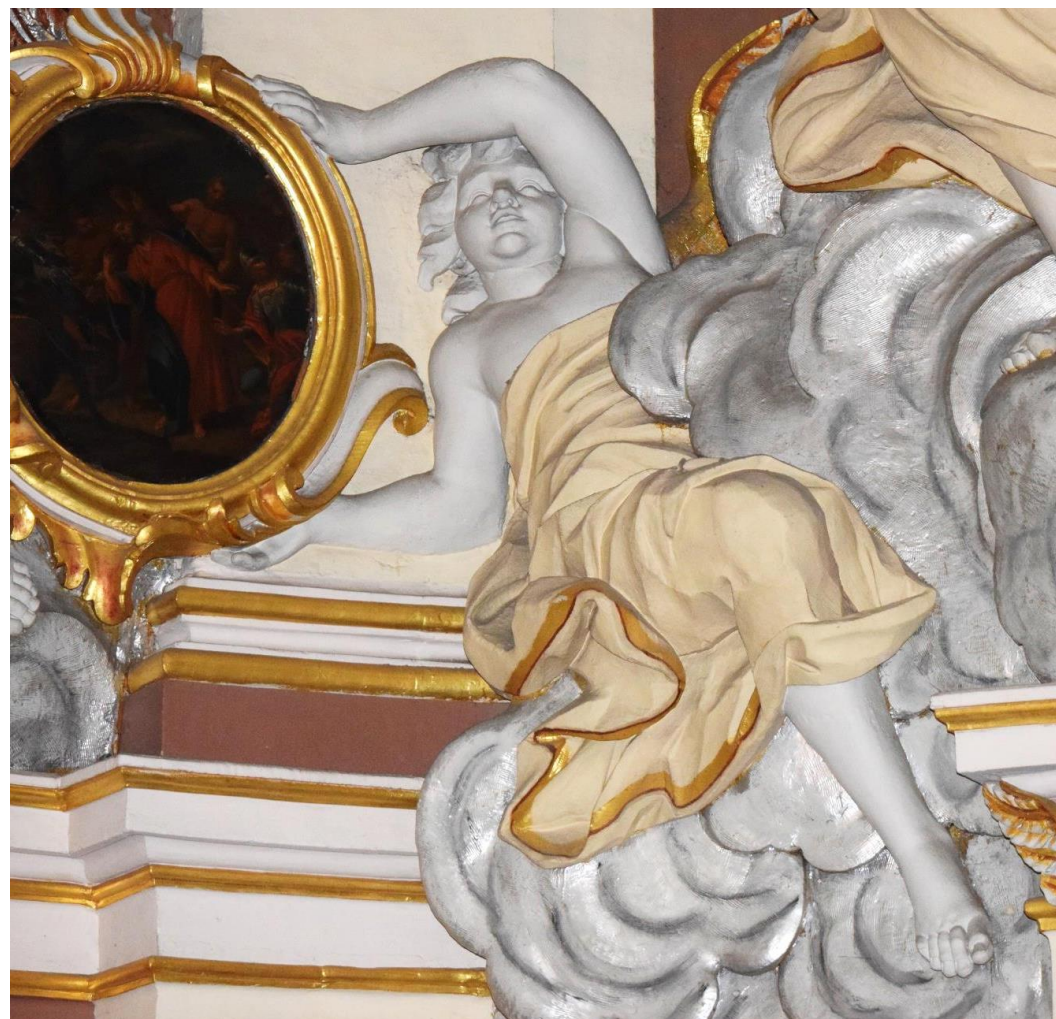


Fig. E.127 Parish church of St Philip of Agira, Żebbuġ. Detail. (right)

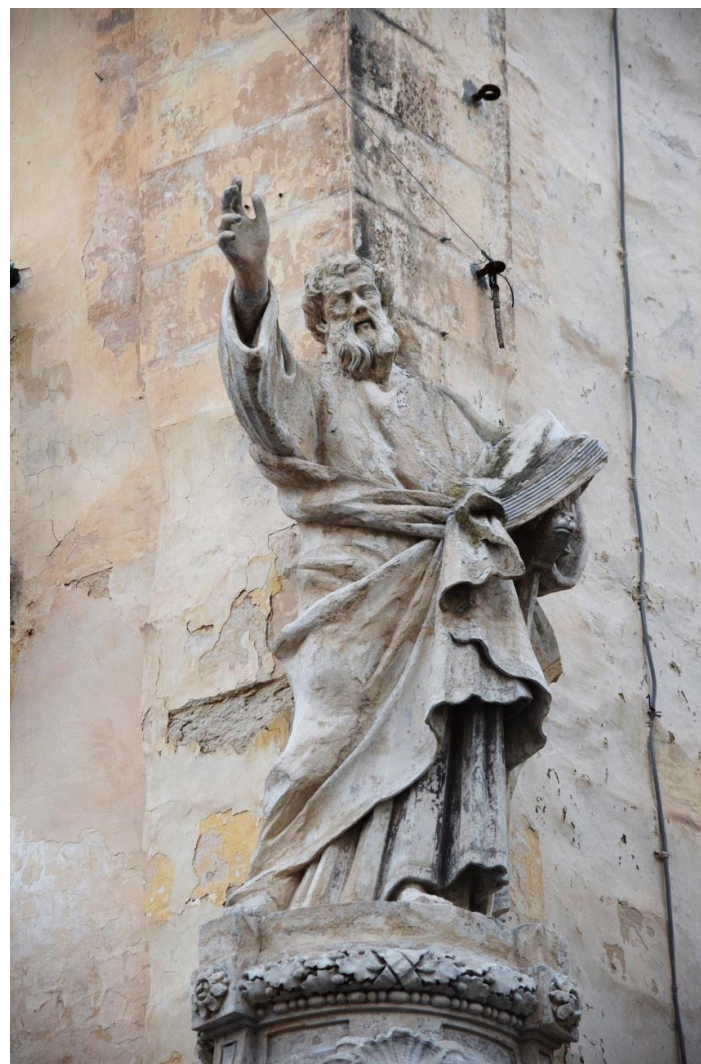

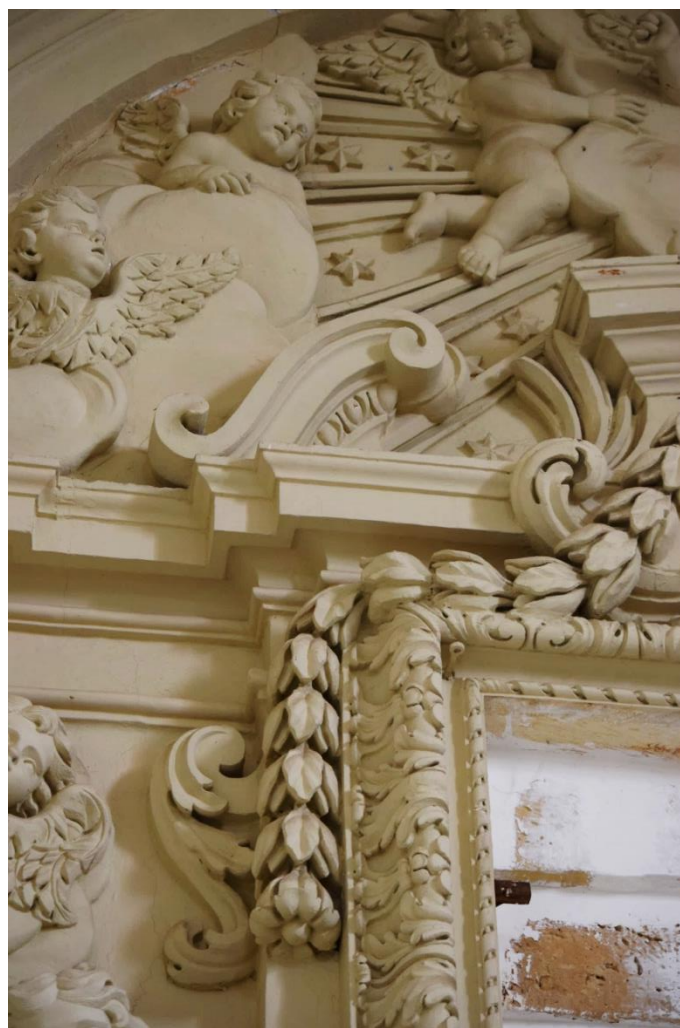


Fig. E.173 Church of Virgin of Mercy, Qrendi. Detail. (right)

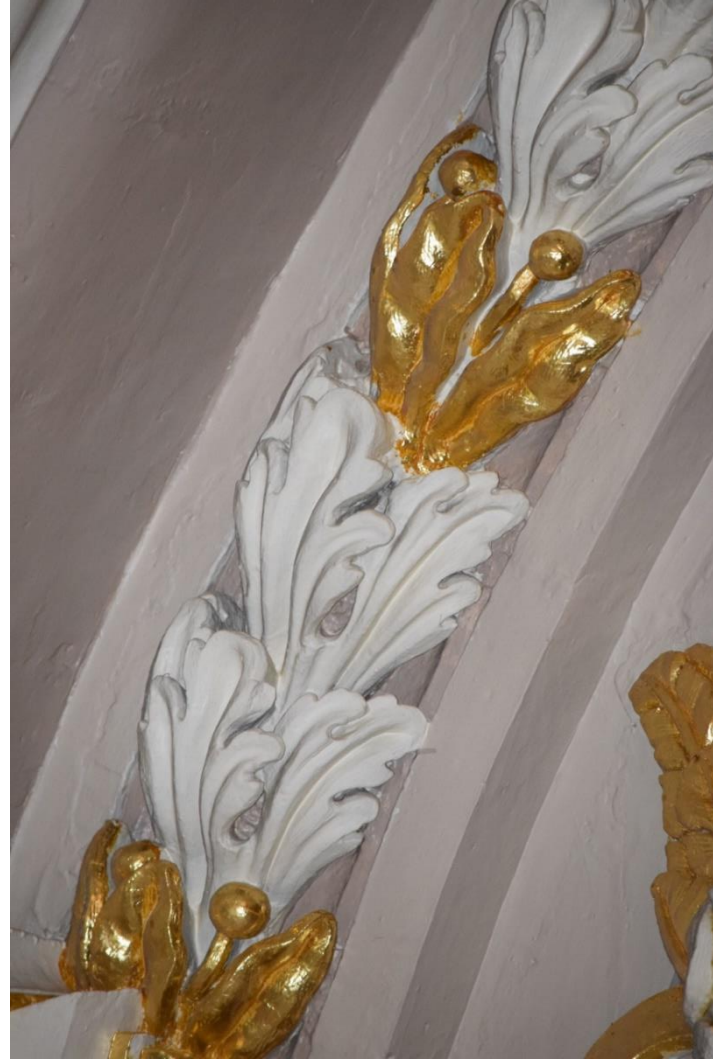


Fig. E.179 Church of St Mark, Rabat. Detail. (right)

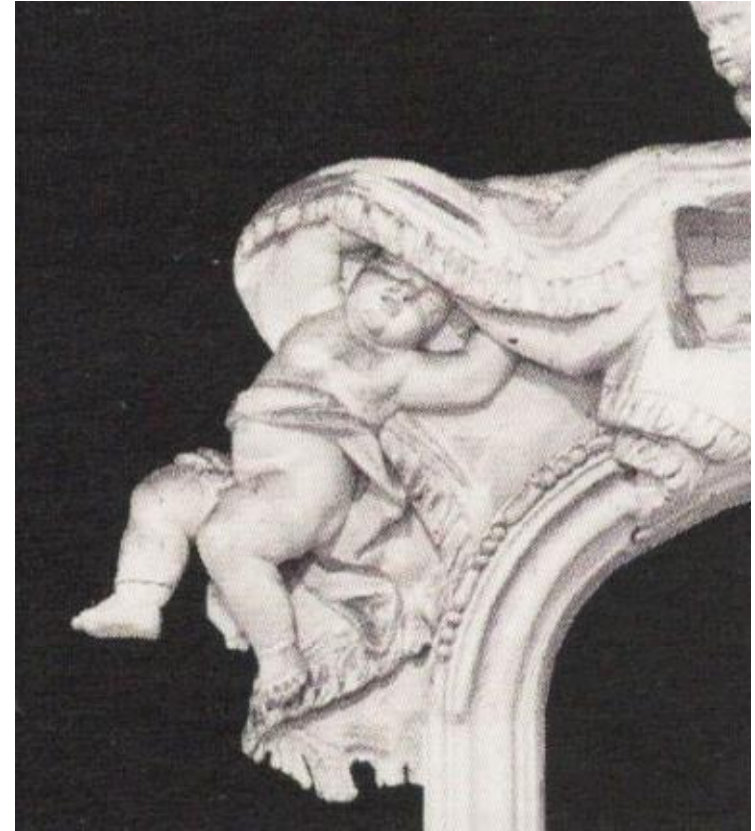


Fig. E.183 Church of St Mary Magdalene, Valletta. Detail. (right)

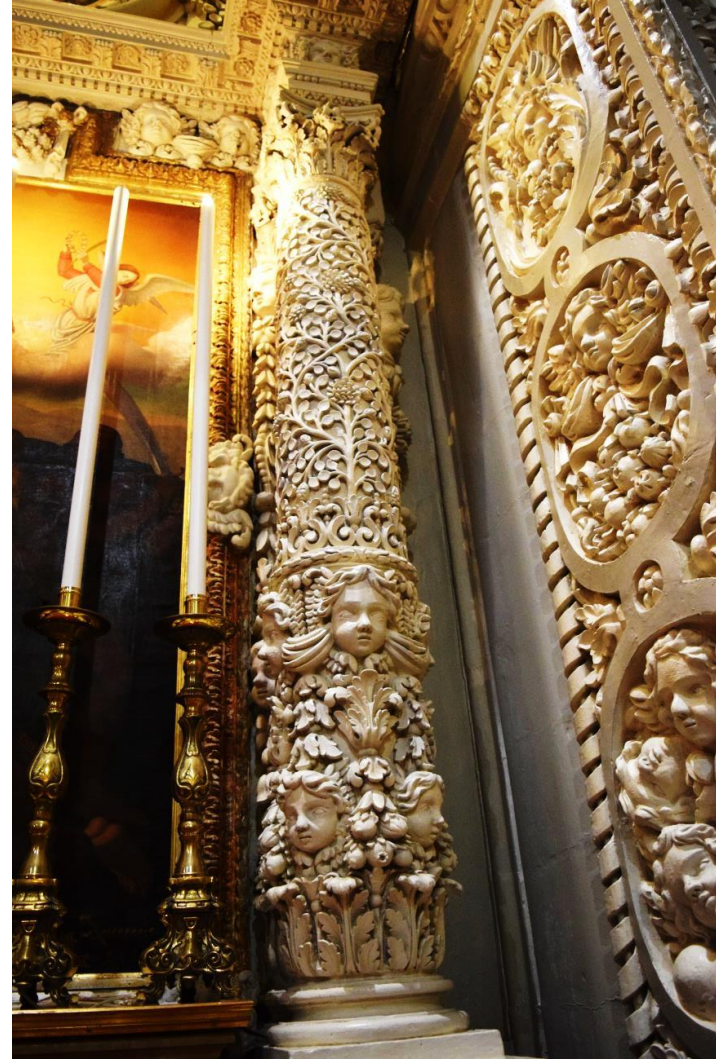


Fig. F.4 Parish church of the Assumption, Attard. Detail. (right)

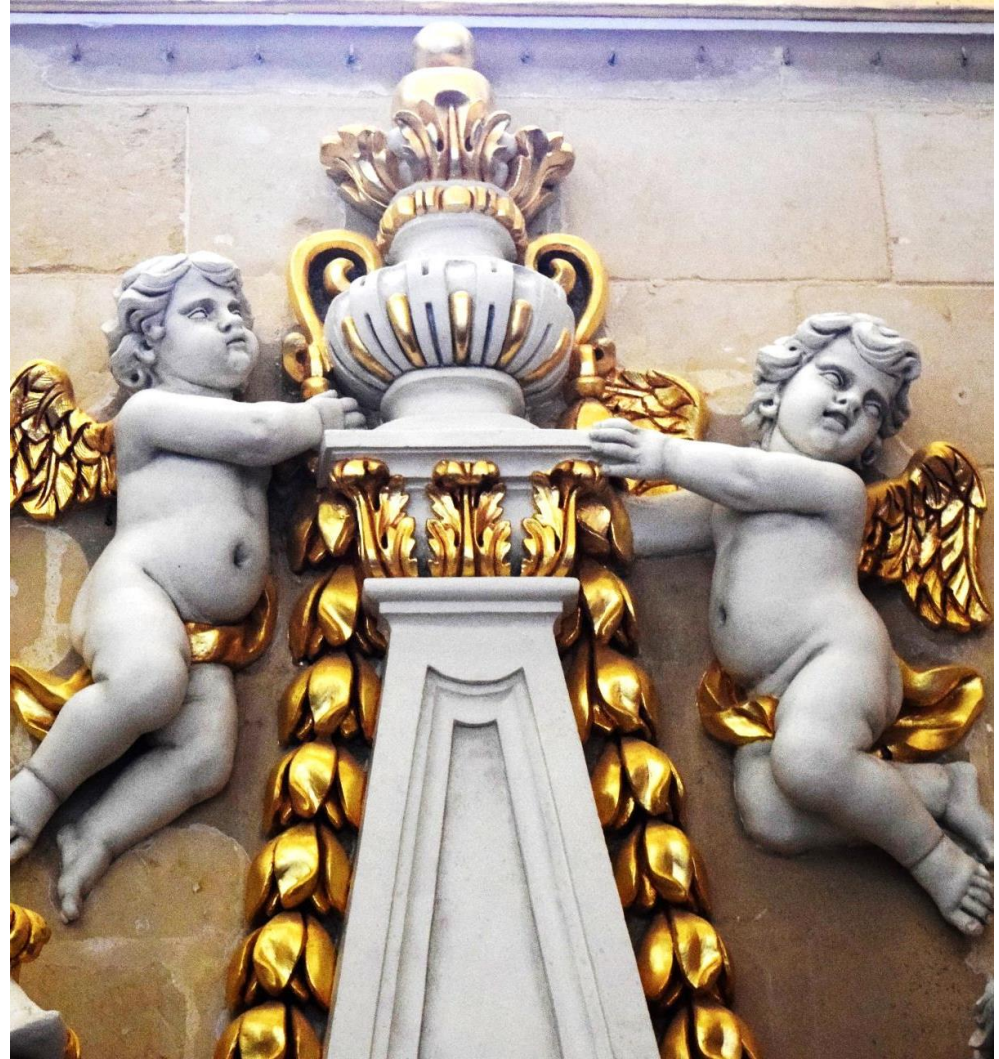


Fig. F.18 Ferdinand Castelletti tomb, Gozo Matrice. Detail. (right)

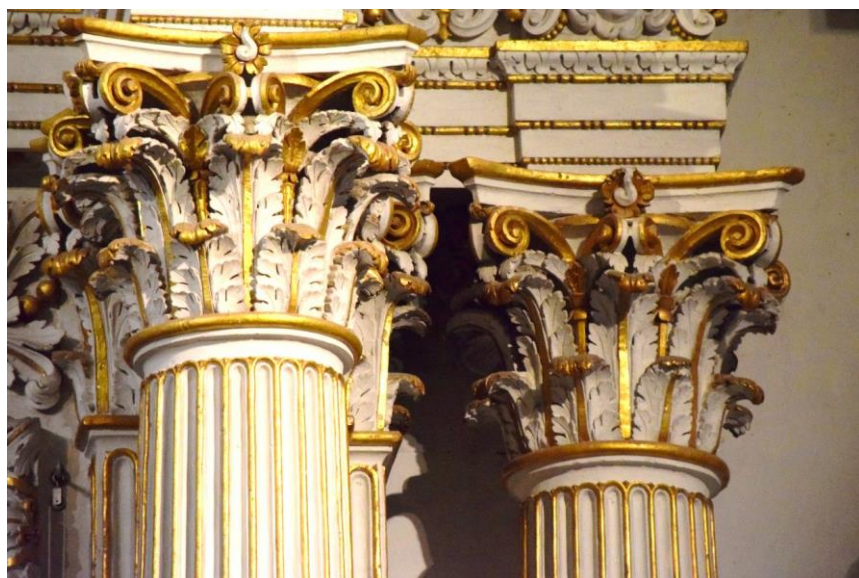


Fig. F.19 Cathedral of Siracusa. Detail. (left)

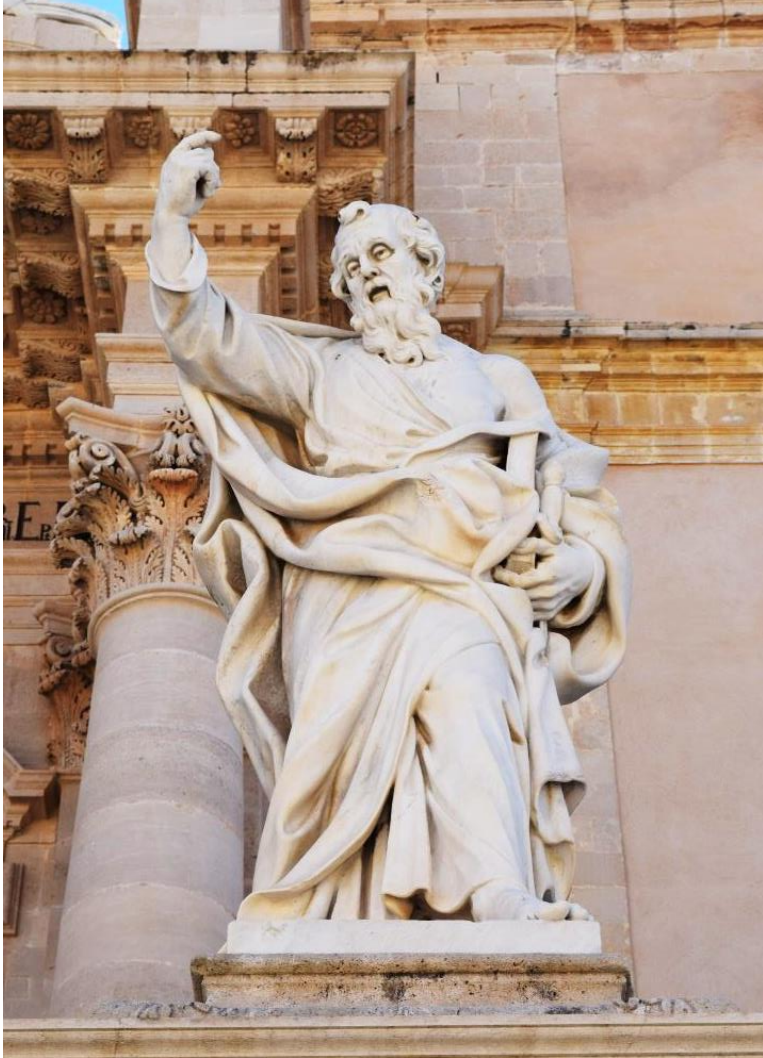


Fig. F.23 Exterior, Cathedral of Siracusa. Detail. (left)

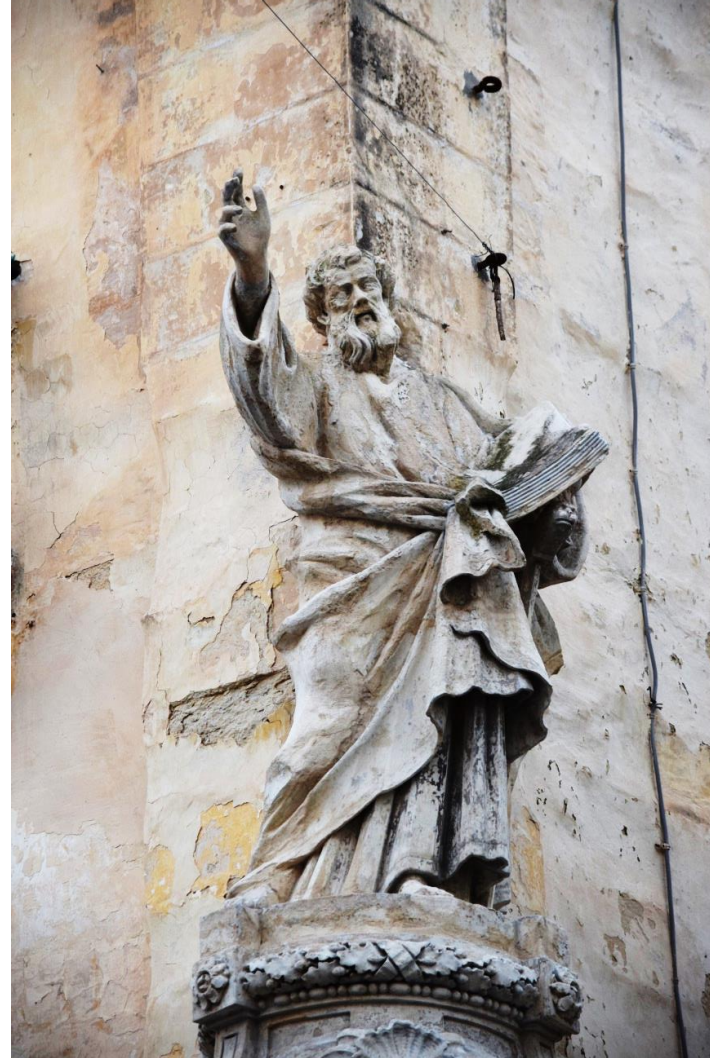

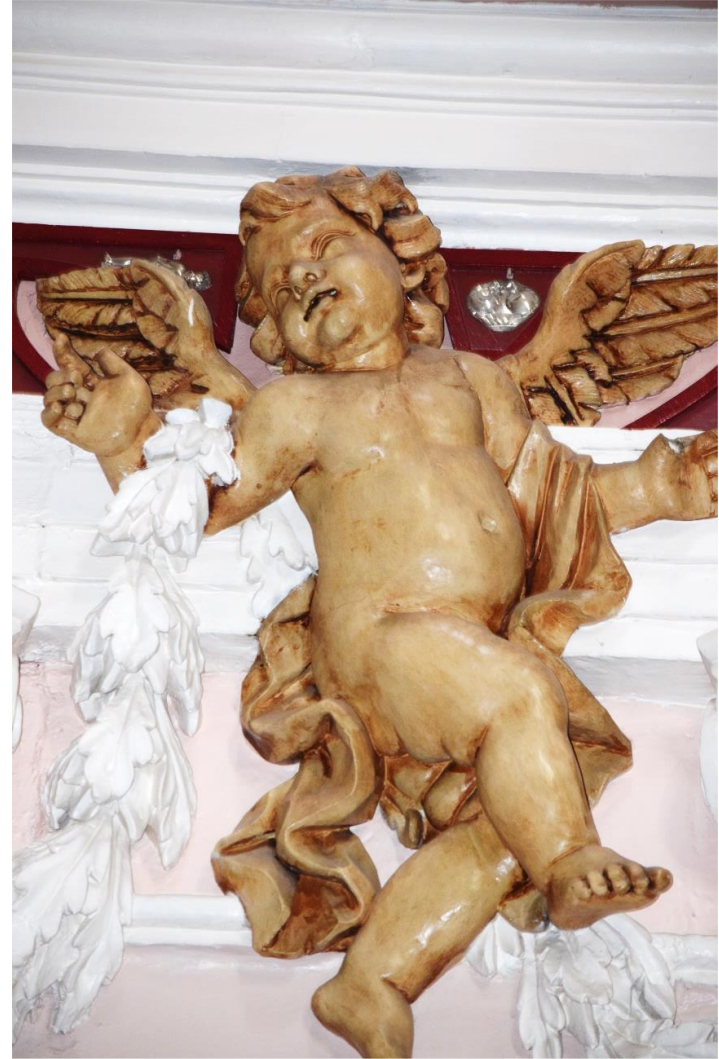


Fig. F.30 Oratory of the Holy Crucifix, Senglea. Detail. (right)

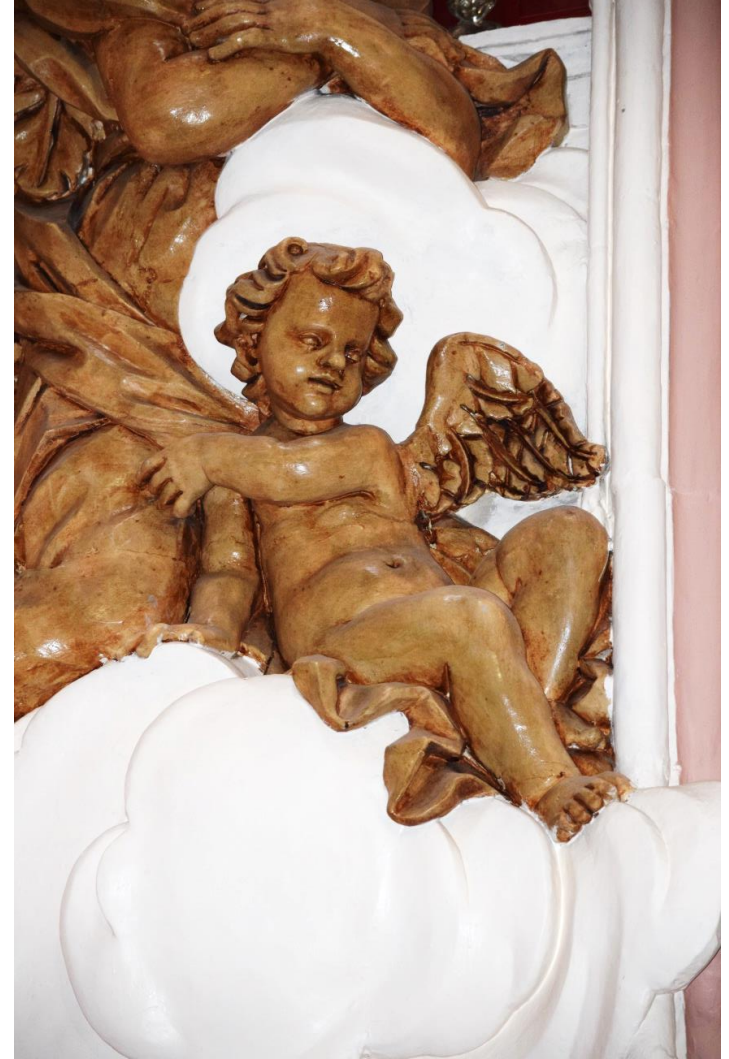


Fig. F.32 Oratory of the Holy Crucifix, Senglea. Detail. (right)

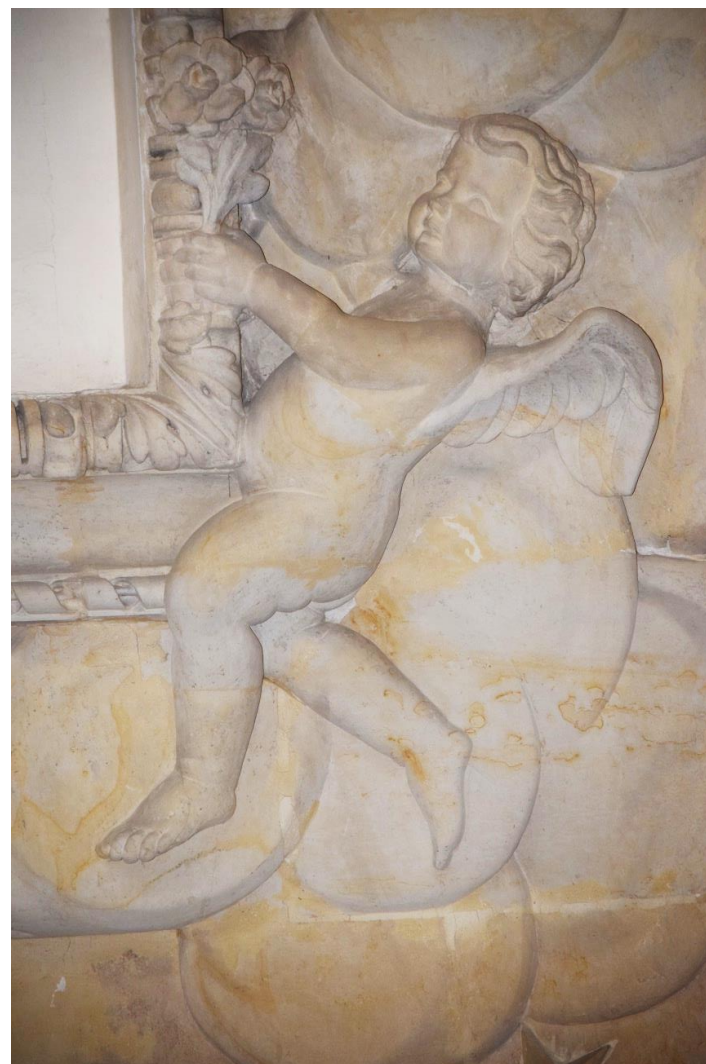


Fig. F.50 Old parish church of St Mary, Birkirkara. Detail. (right)

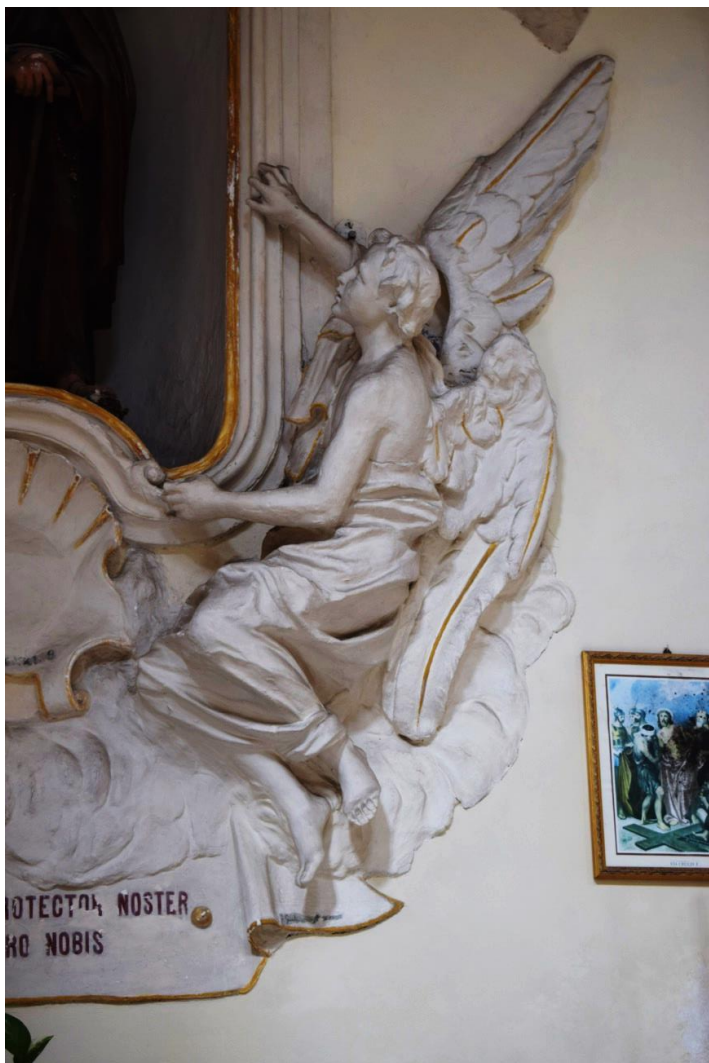


Fig. F.53 Chiesa di San Carlo al Corso, Noto. Detail. (left)

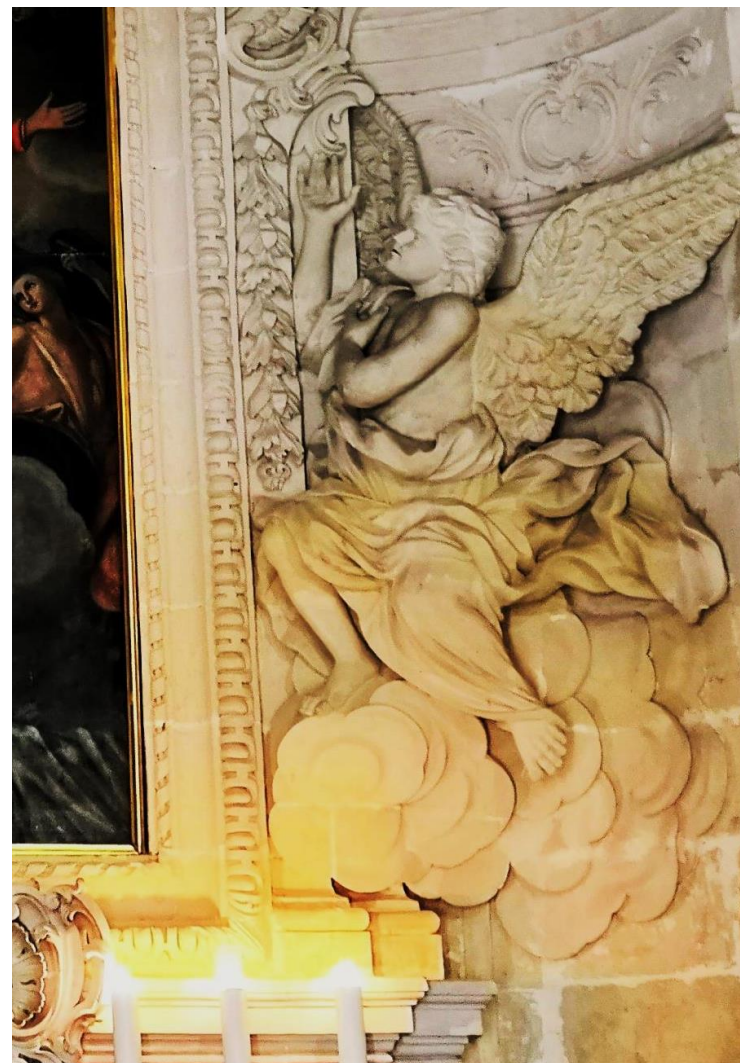


Fig. F.54 Church of the Assumption, Safi. Detail. (right)

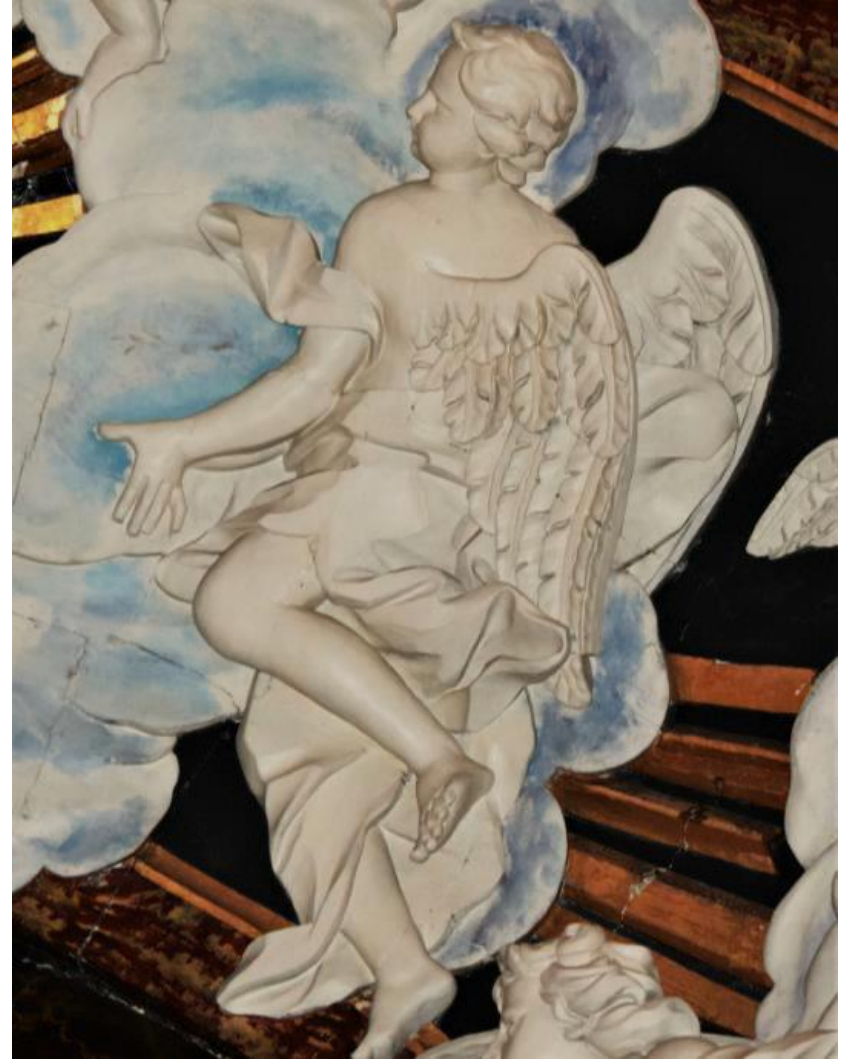


Fig. F.58 Church of St Philip Neri, Senglea. Detail. (right)

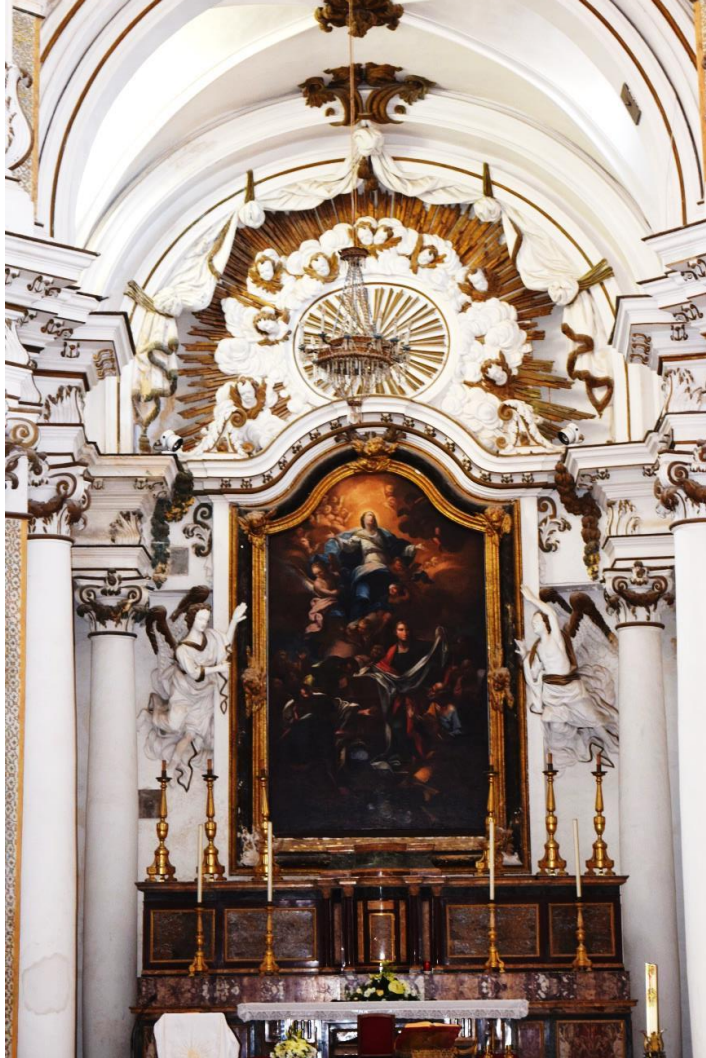


Fig. F.61 Chiesa di Santa Chiara, Noto. (left)

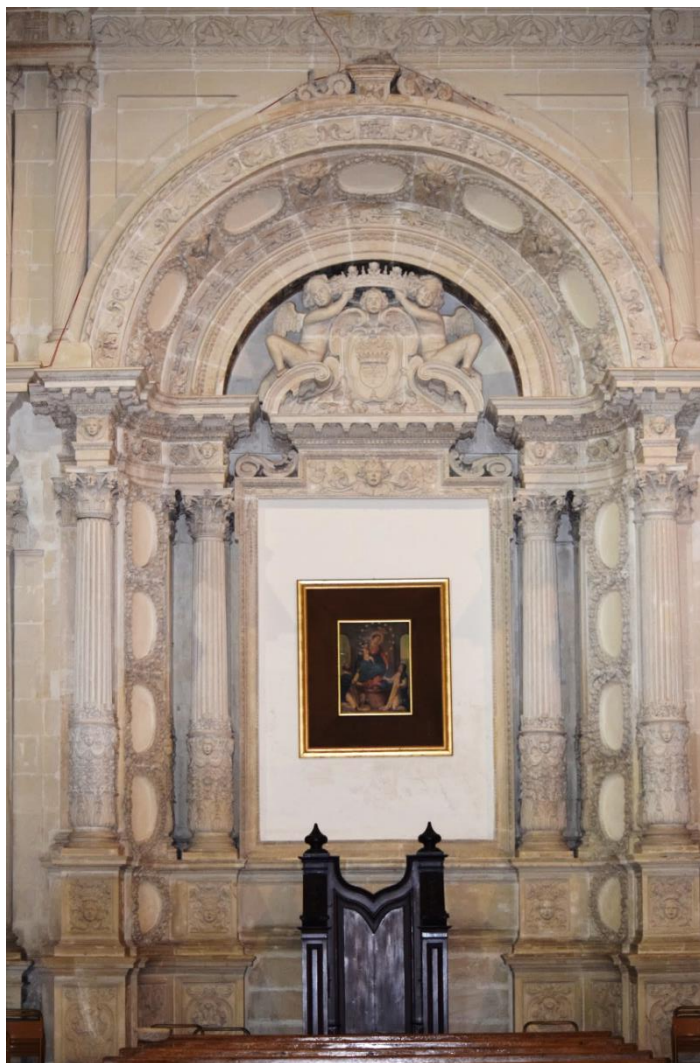


Fig. F.78 Old parish church of St Mary, Birkirkara. (right)

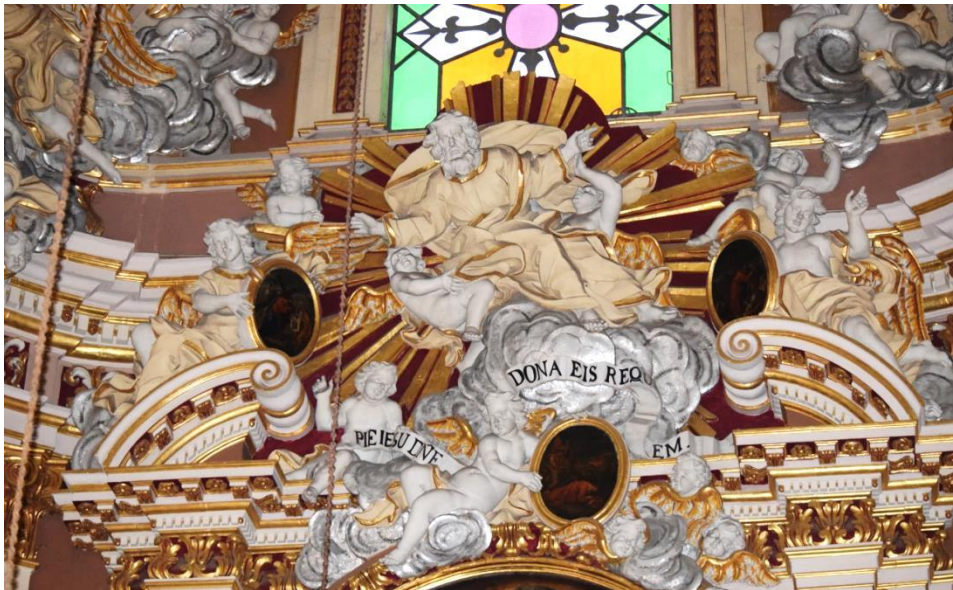


Fig. F.84 Parish church of St Philip of Agira, Żebbuġ. Detail. (bottom)

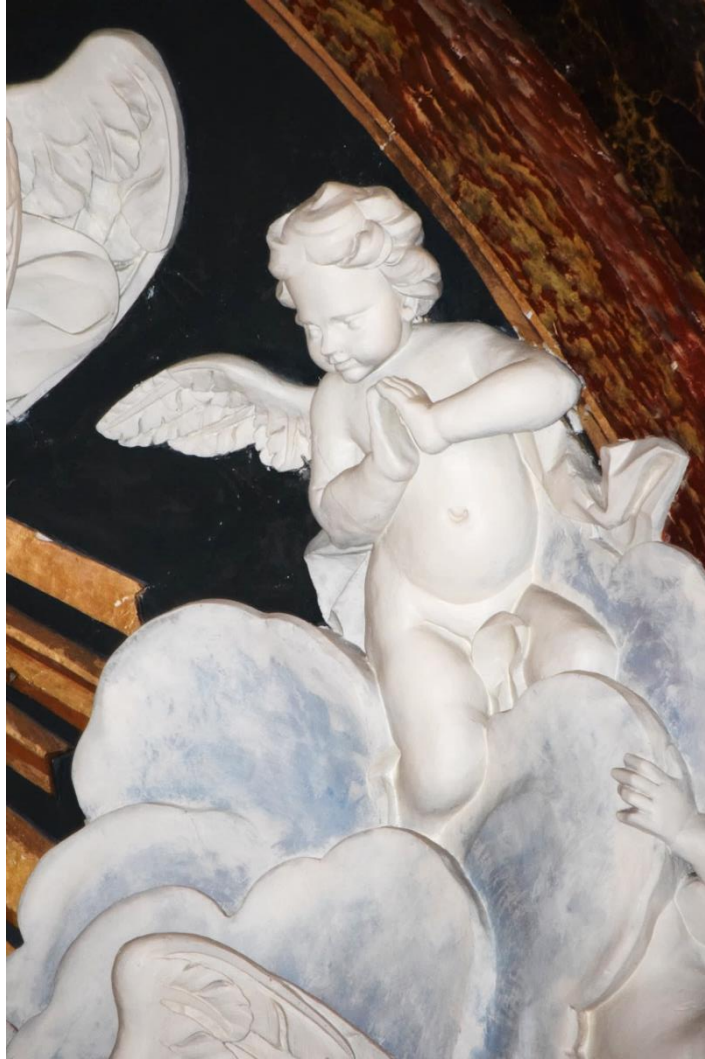


Fig. F.102 Parish church of St Philip Neri, Senglea. Detail. (right)

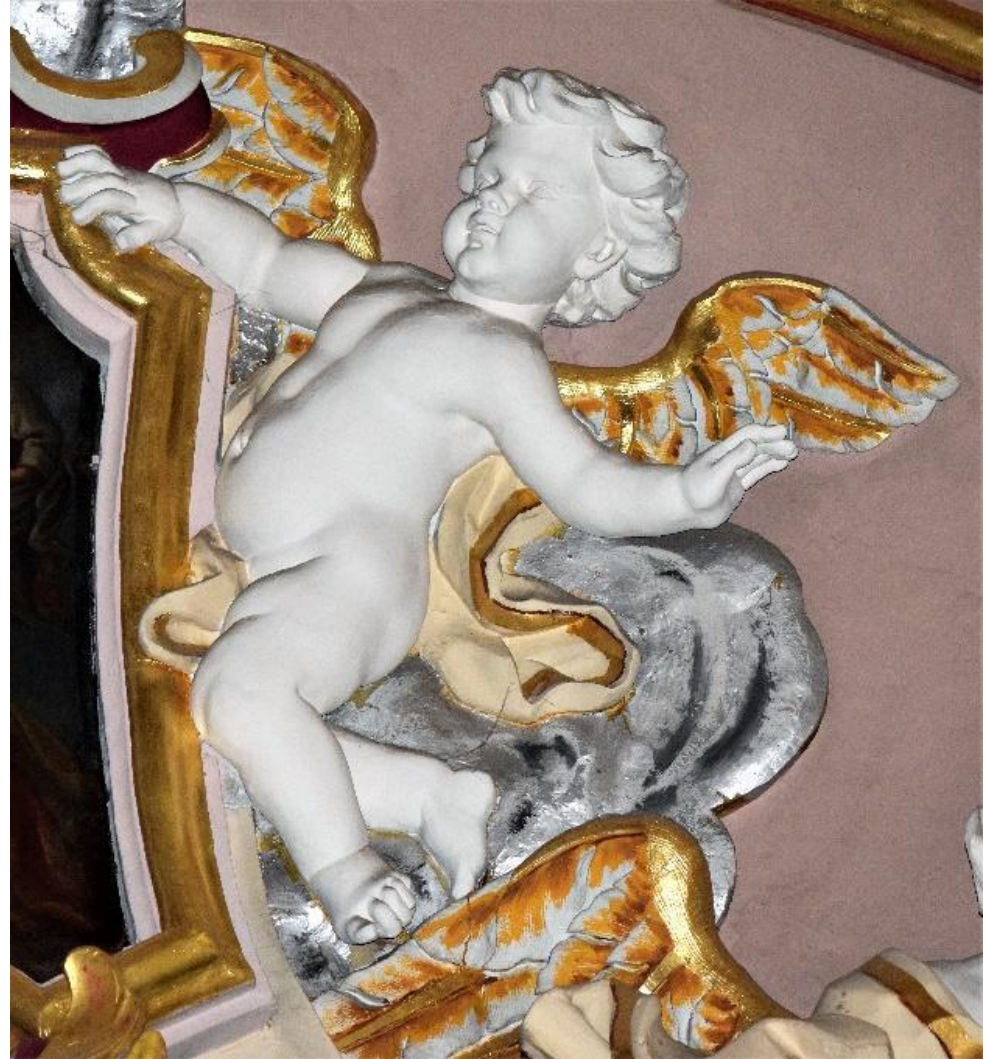


Fig. F.104 Parish church of St Philip of Agira, Żebbuġ. Detail. (right)

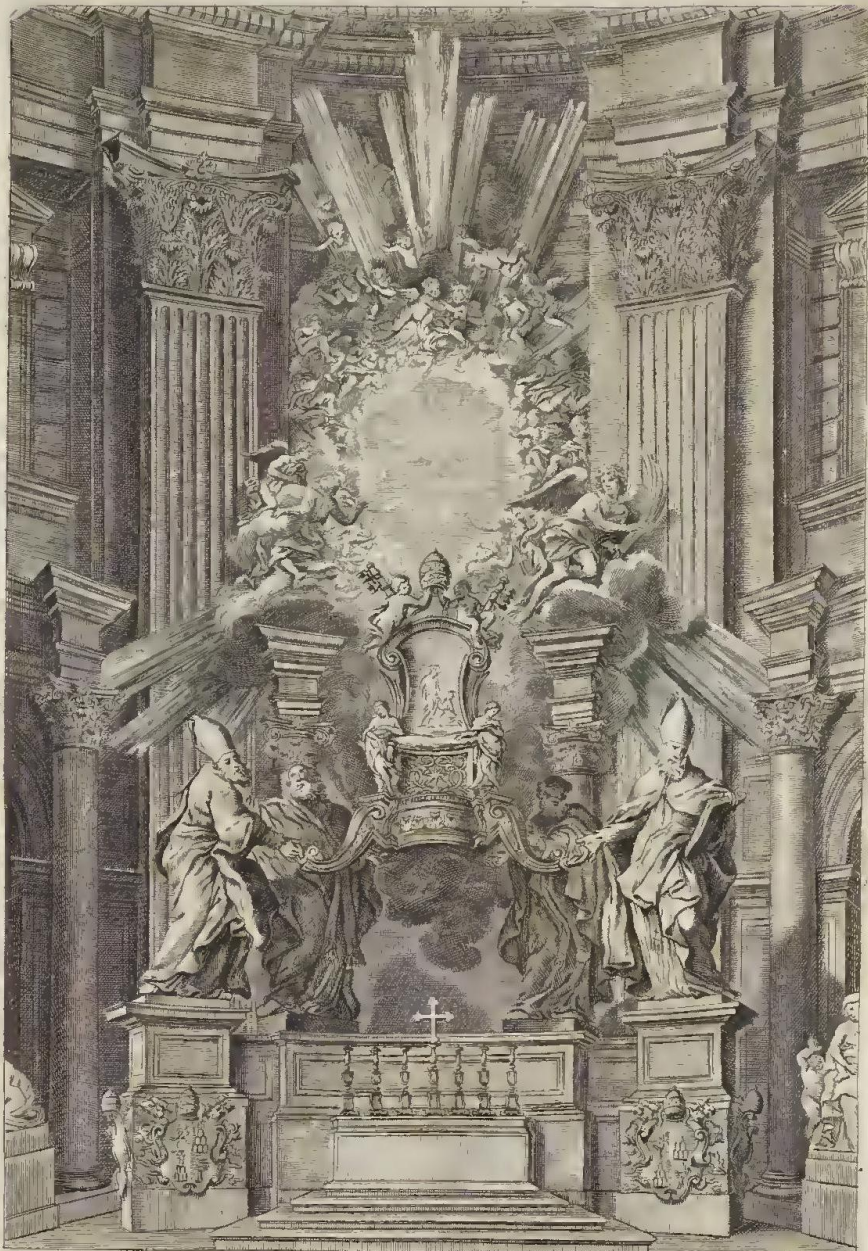


Fig. F.111 Chiesa di San Giovanni Evangelista, Modica. Detail. (left)

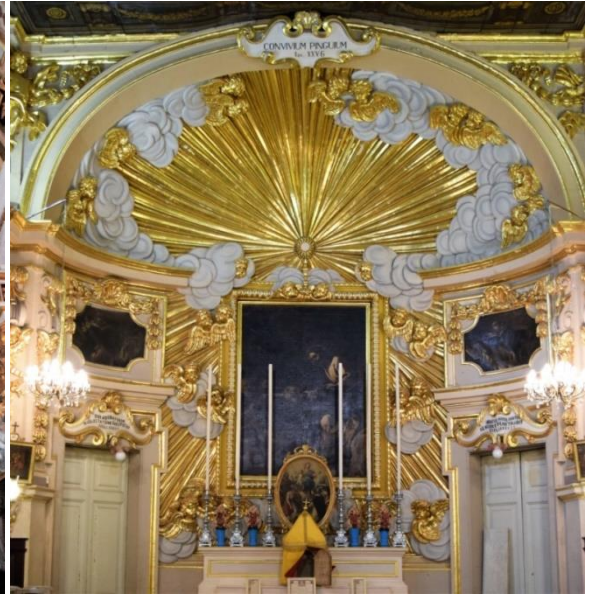

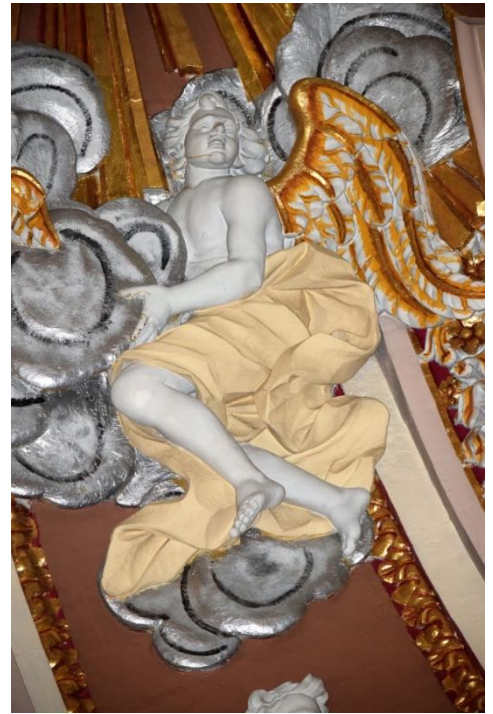

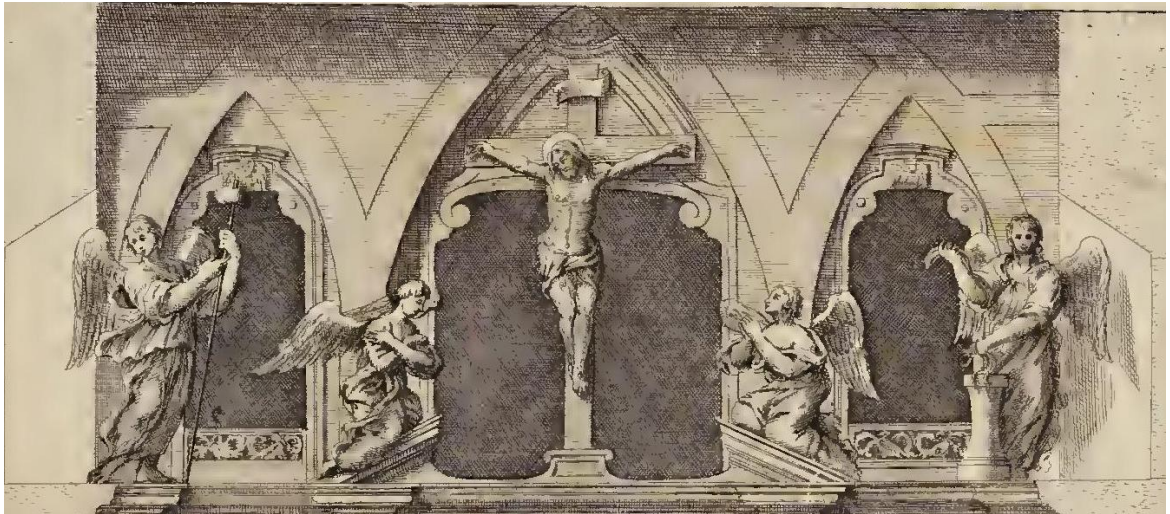

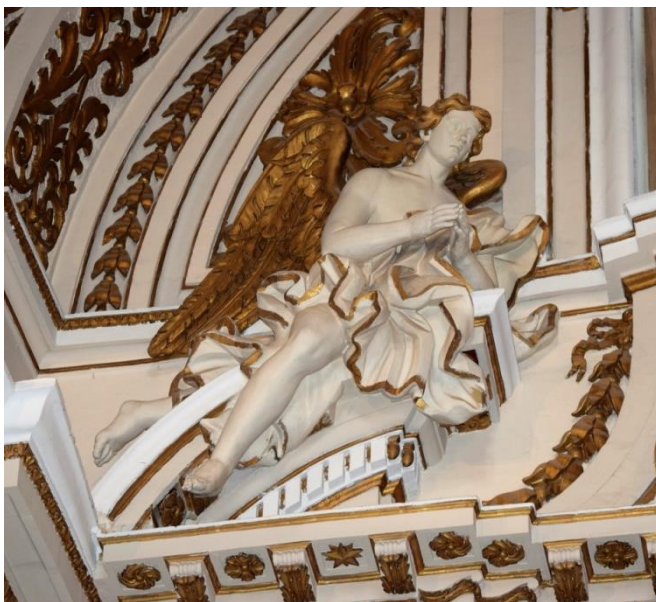

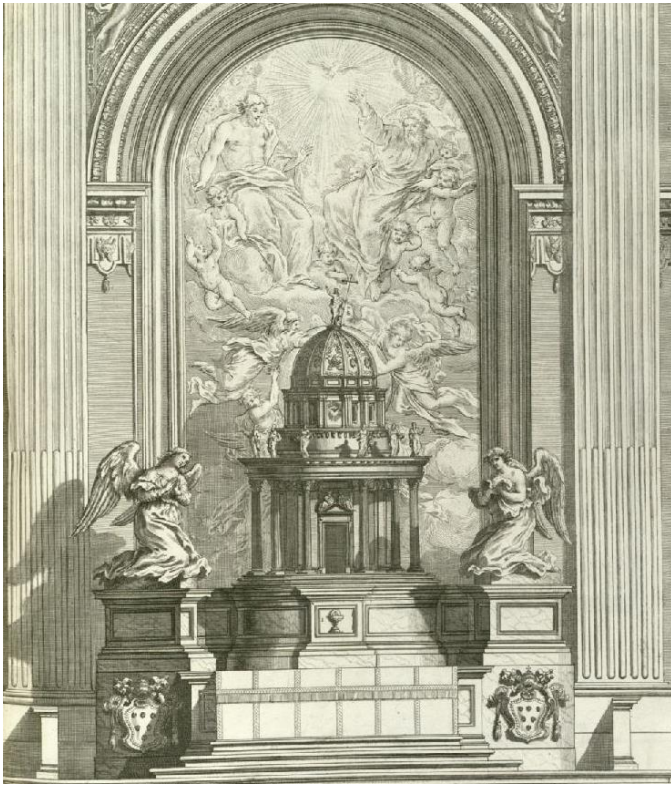

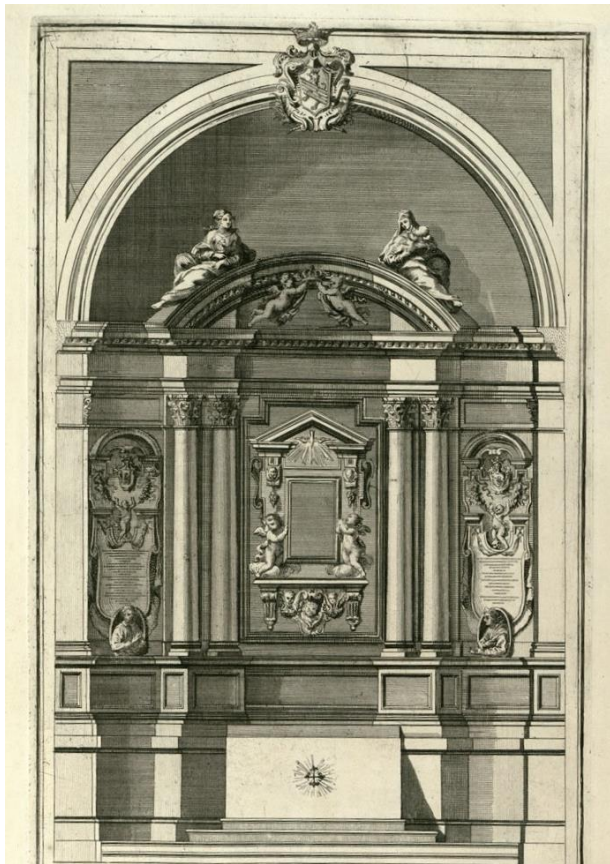

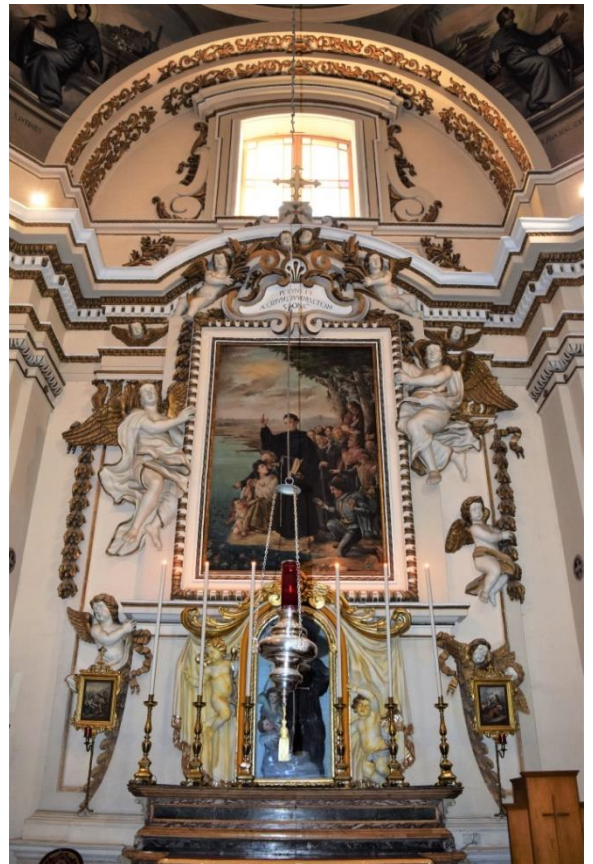


Fig. G.34 Pietro Paolo Zahra, Altar of St Anthony of Padova, Church of St Francis, Rabat, post-1712.

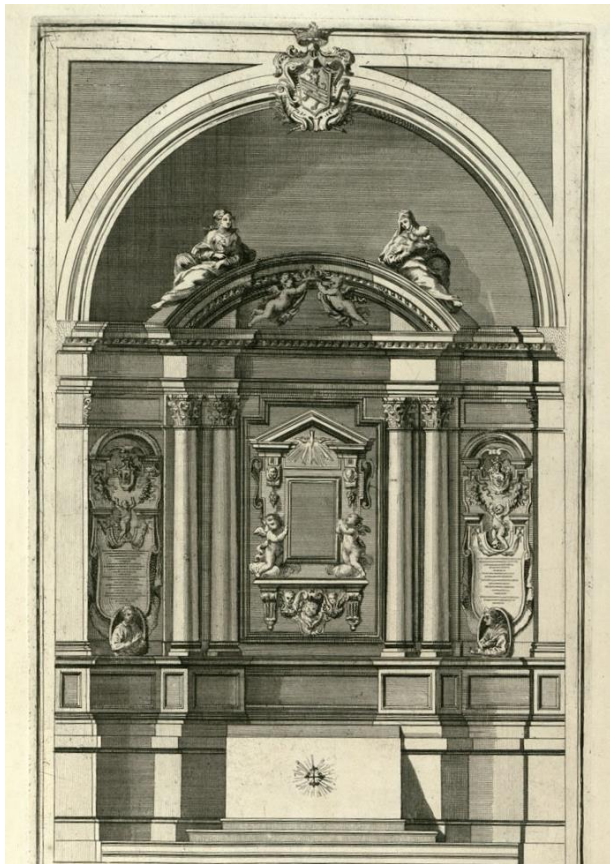

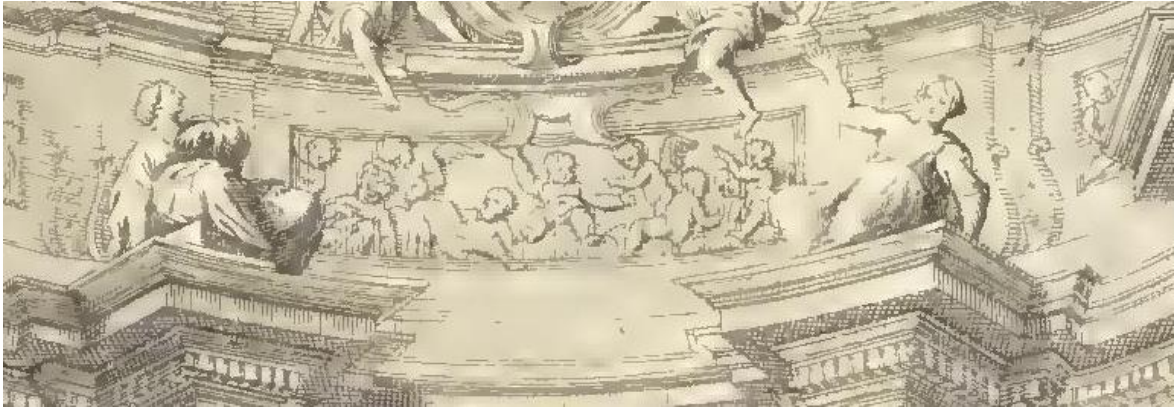


Fig. G.40 Andrea Pozzo, *Perspectiva pictorum et architectorum*, II, fig. 72, 1700. Detail.

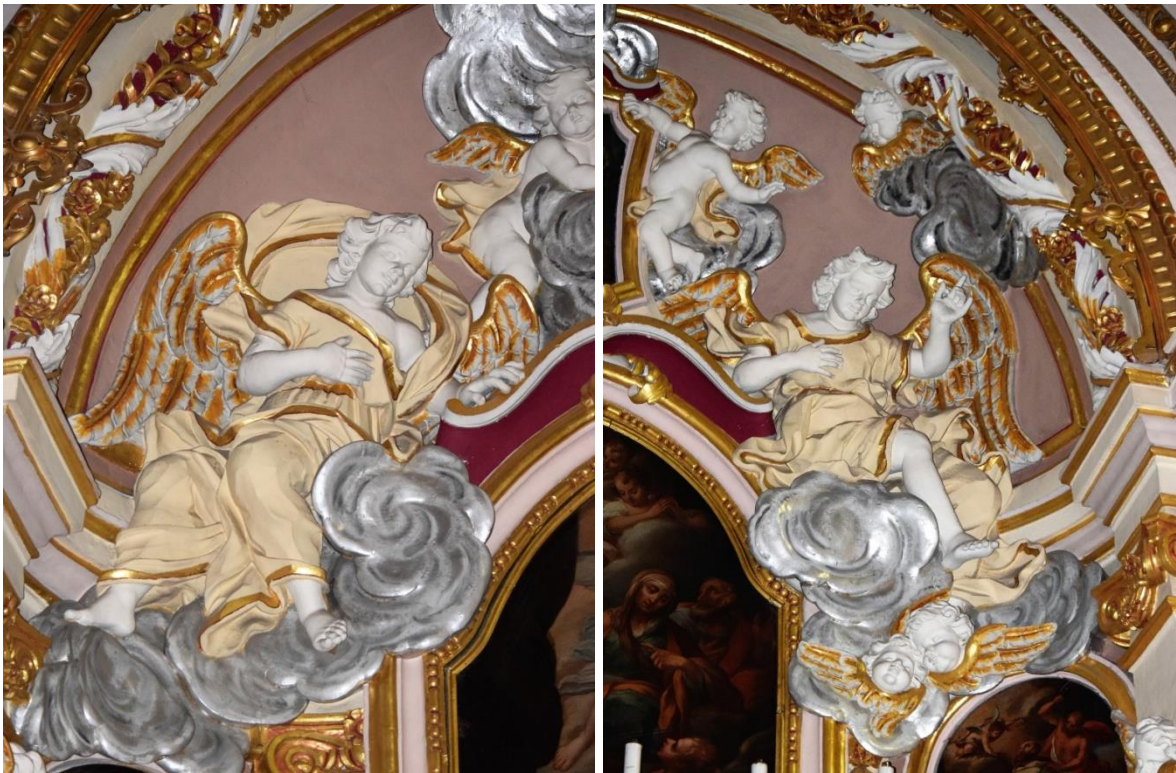

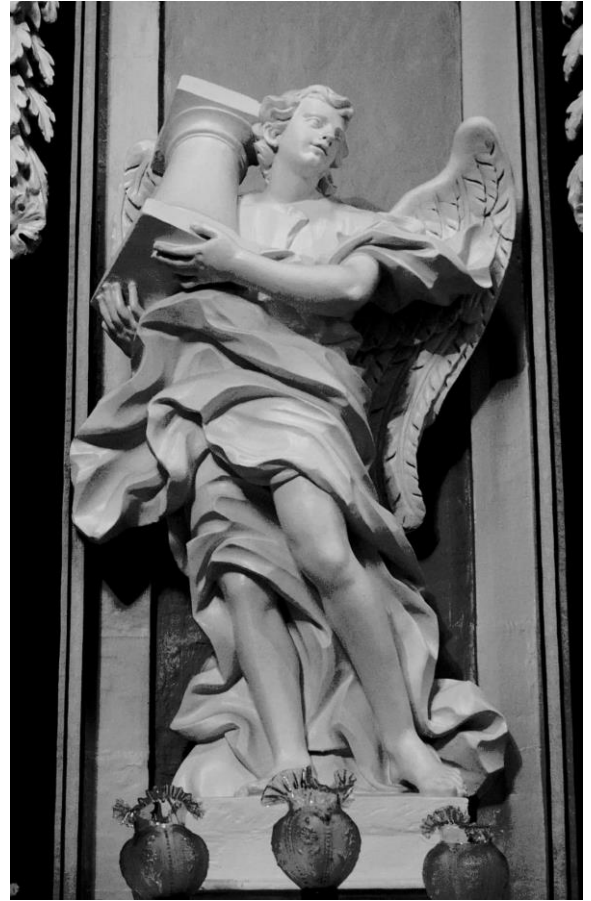


Fig. G.44 Pietro Paolo Zahra, Angel with the Column, Oratory of the Holy Crucifix, Senglea, 1731.

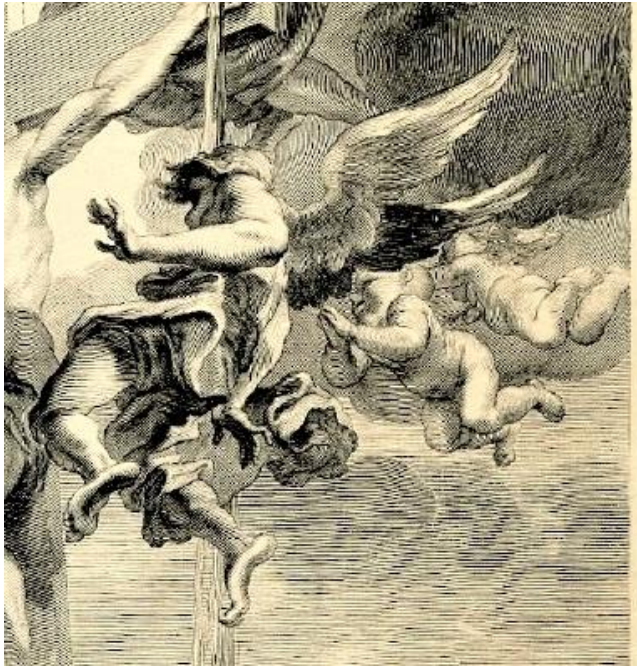


Fig. G.55 After Gian Lorenzo Bernini, *Sanguis Christi*, c. 1670. Detail.

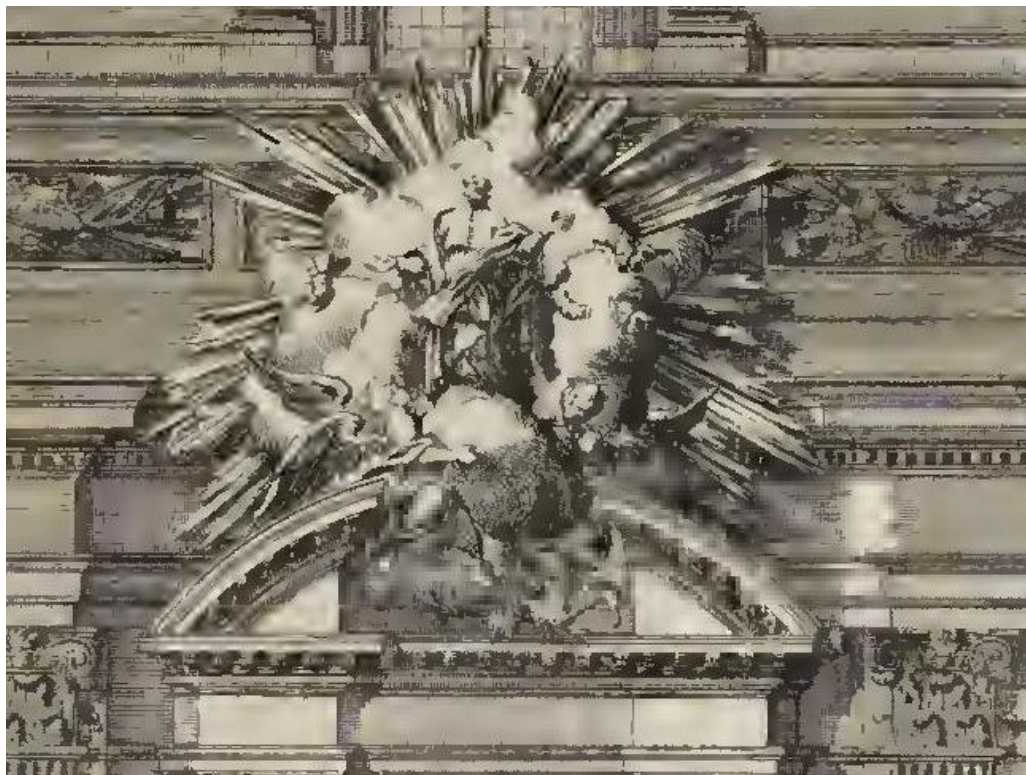

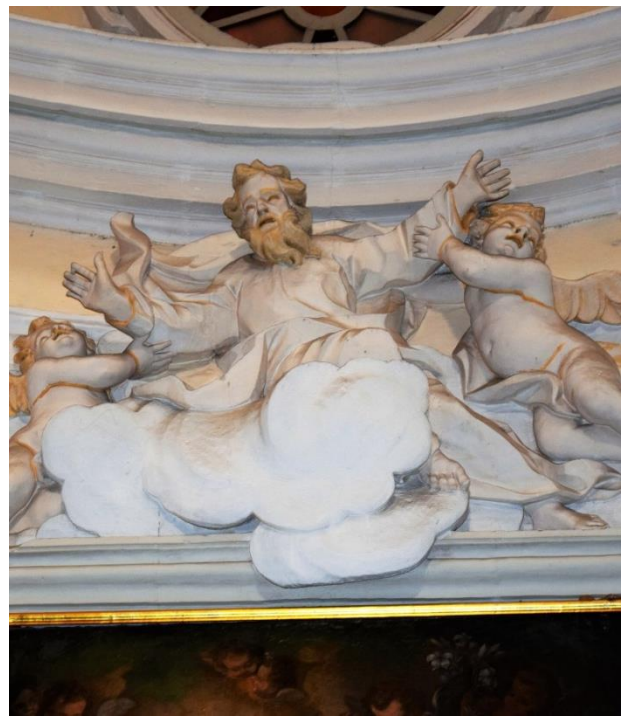

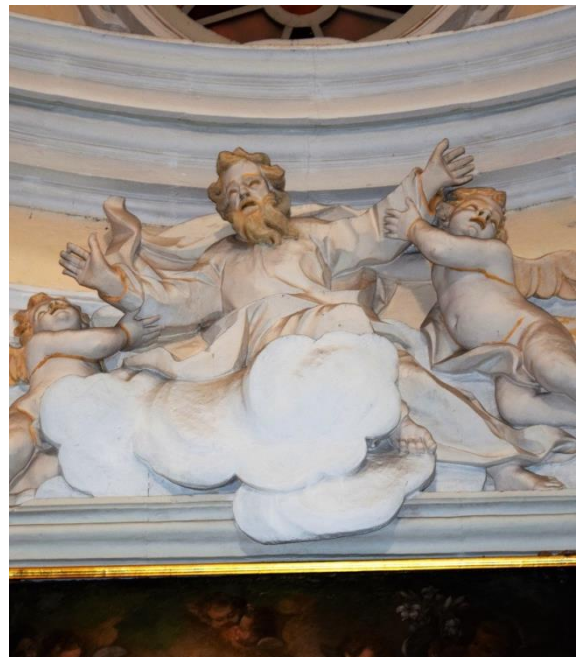

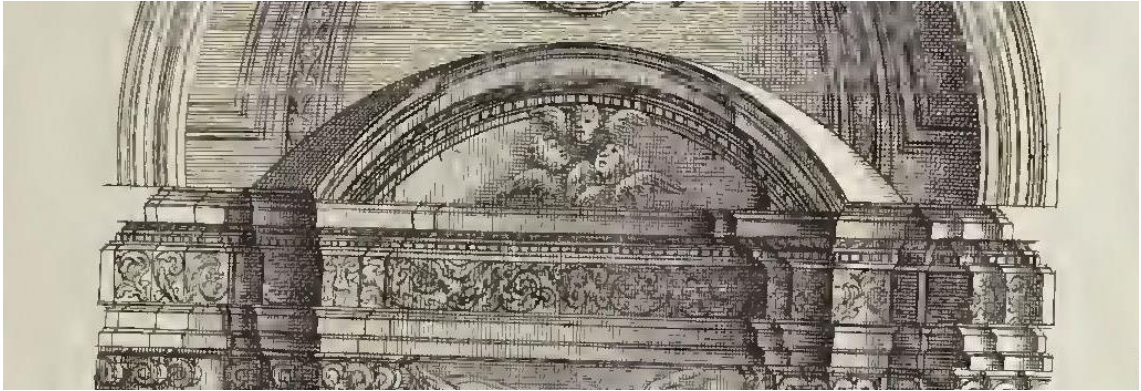

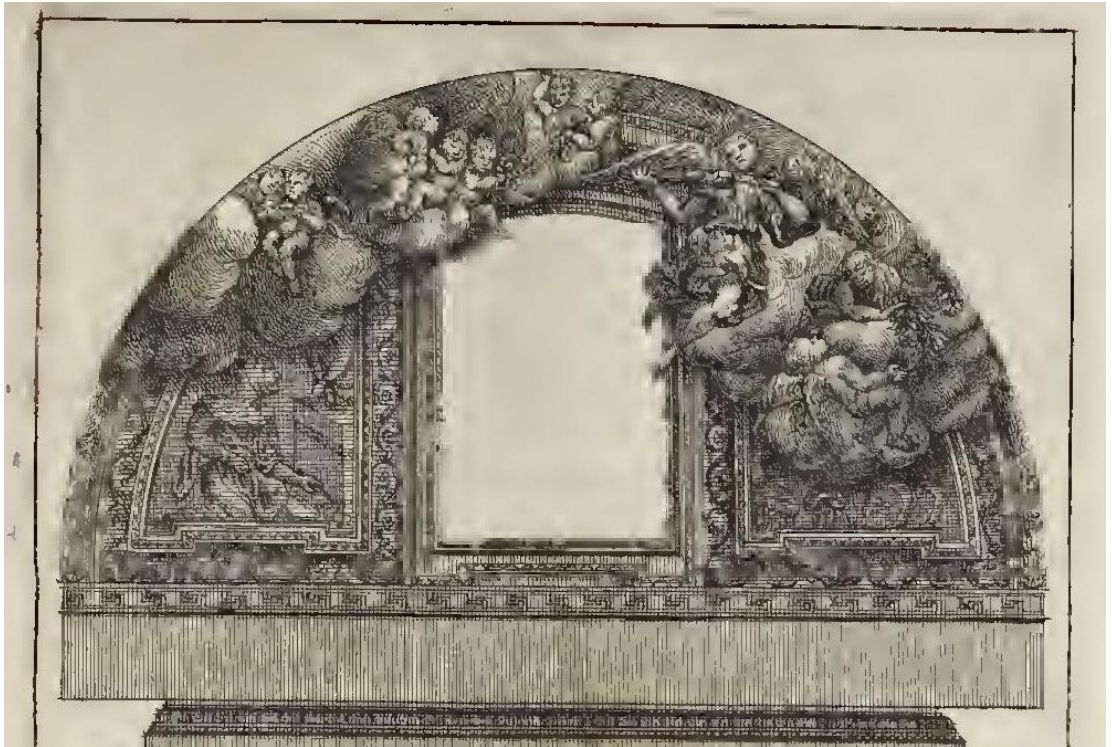

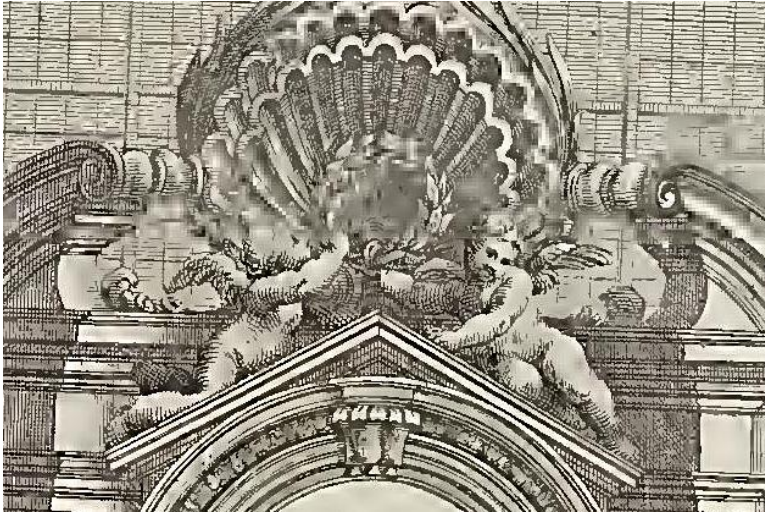

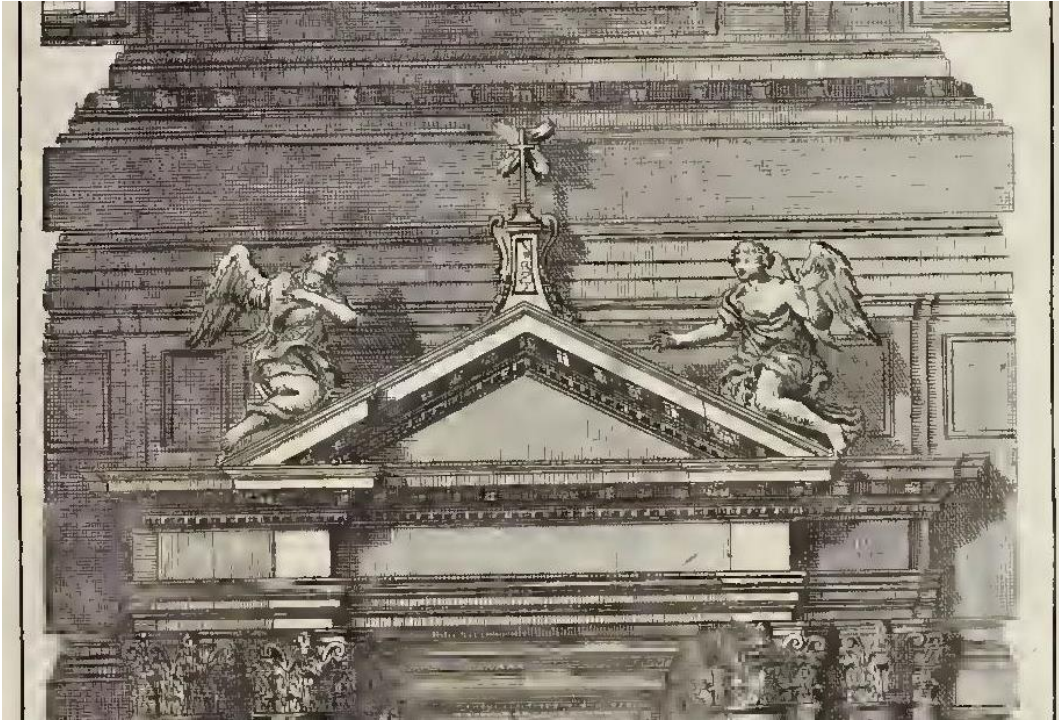

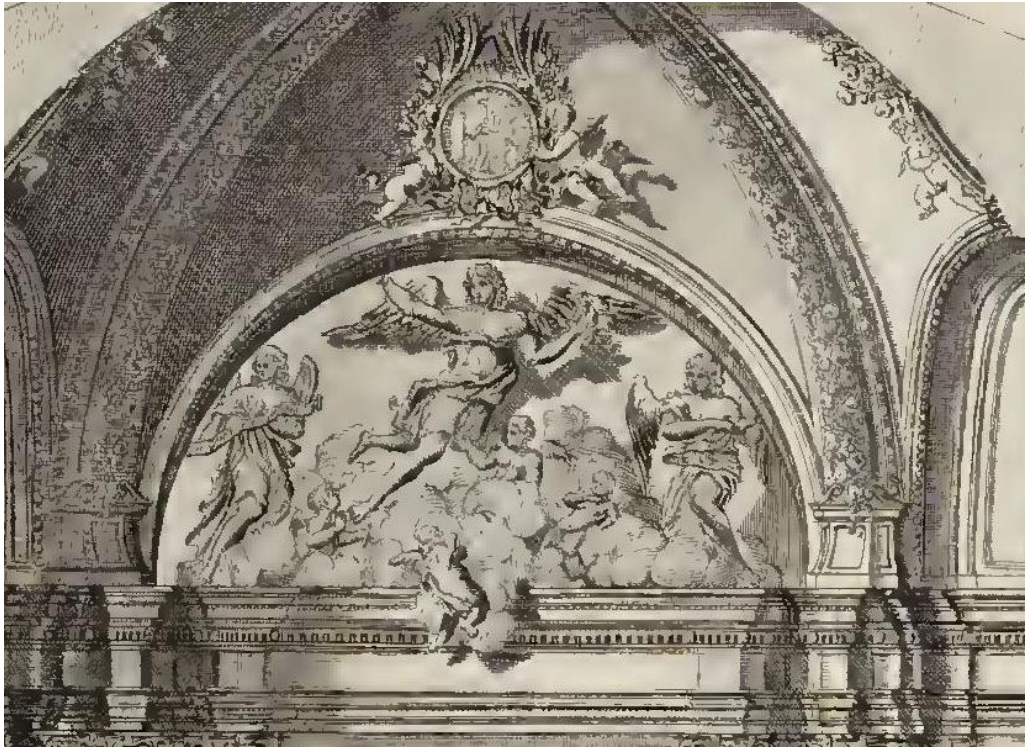

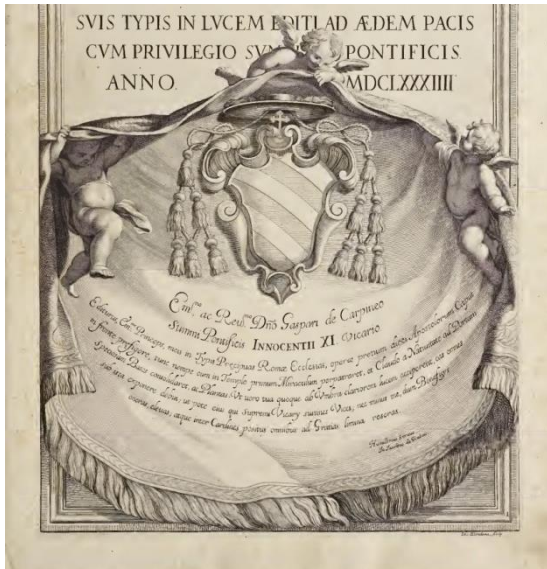


Fig. G.99 Giovanni Giacomo de' Rossi, *Insignium Romae templorum*, front folio, detail, 1684.

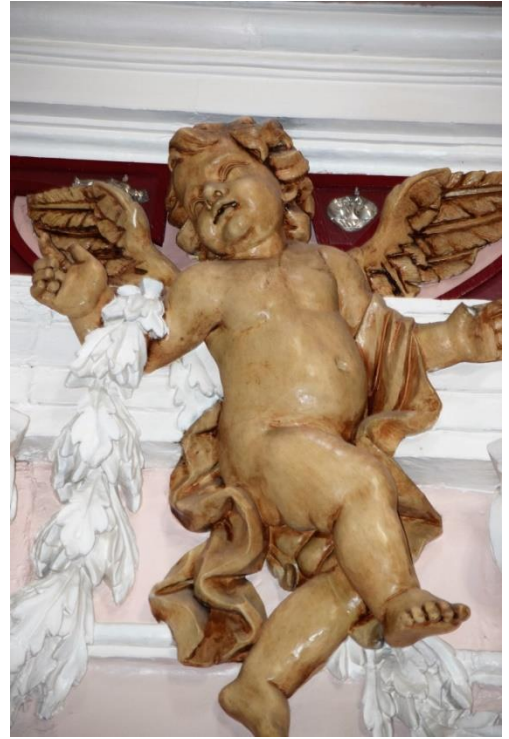
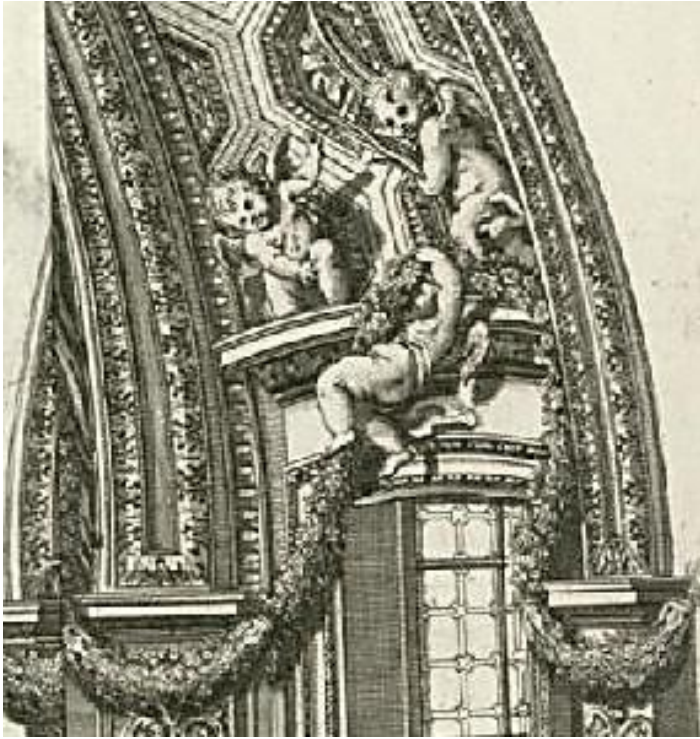

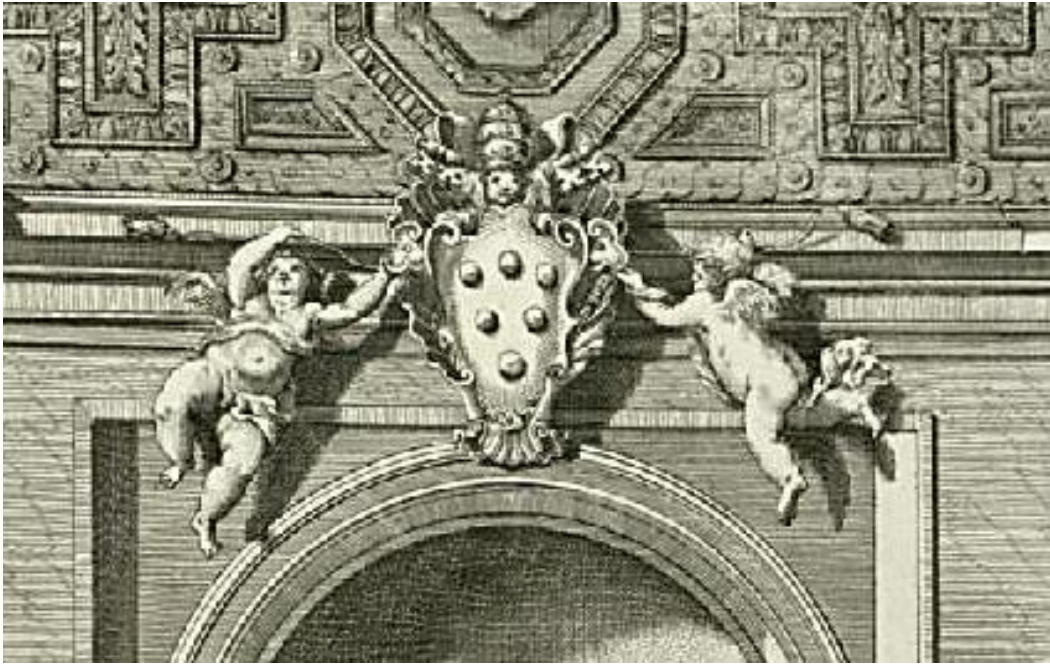

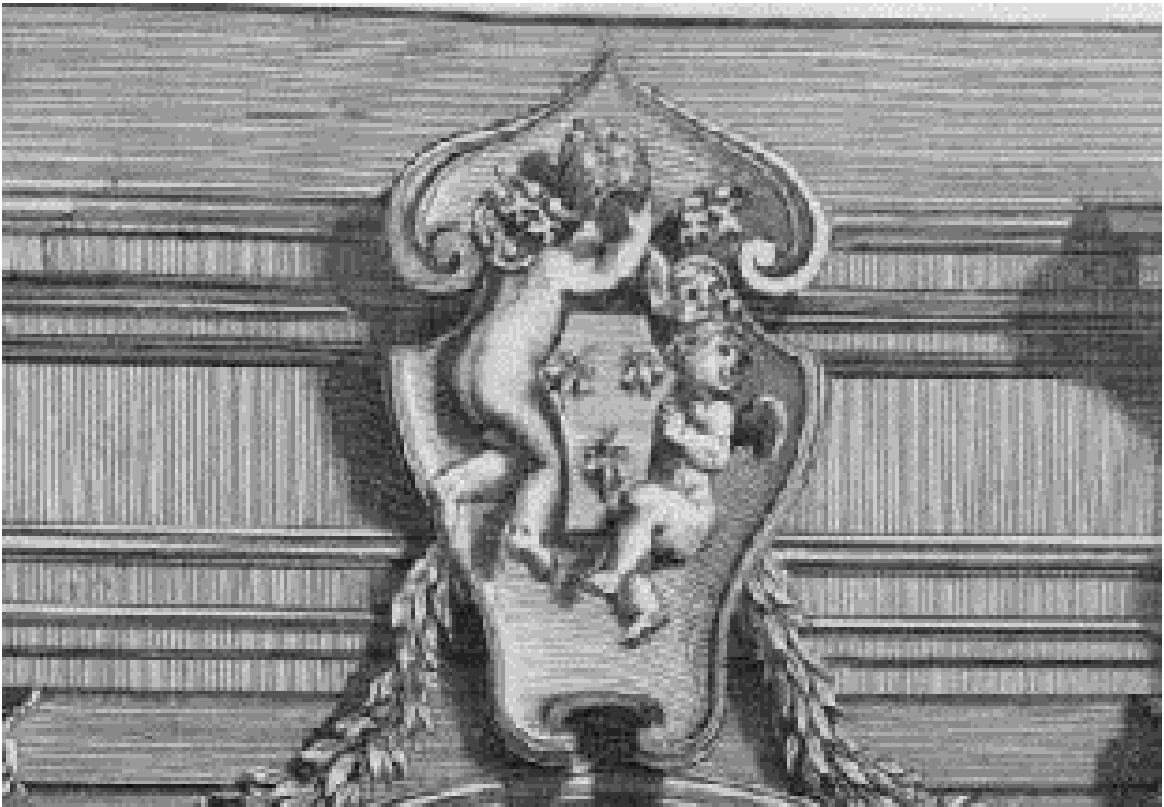

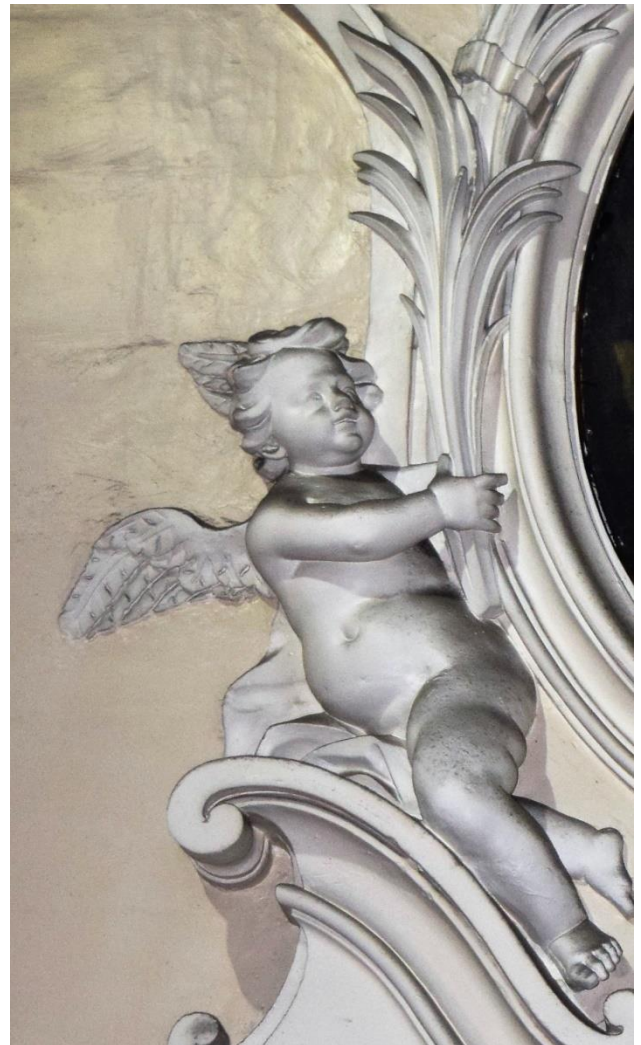

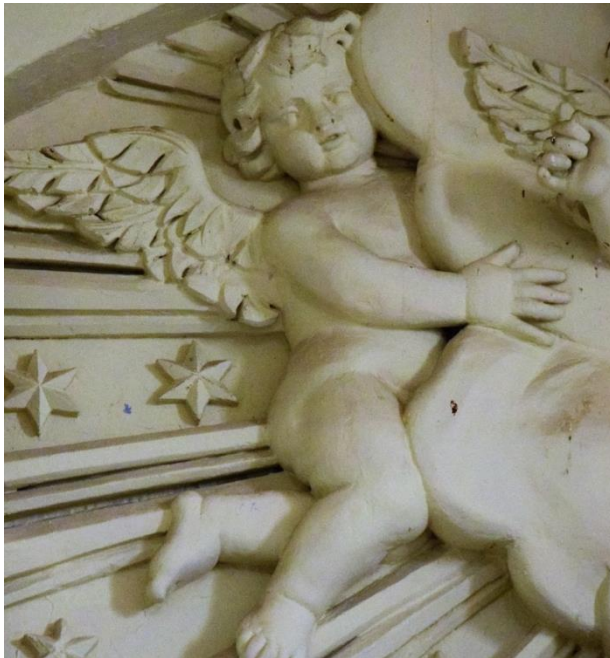

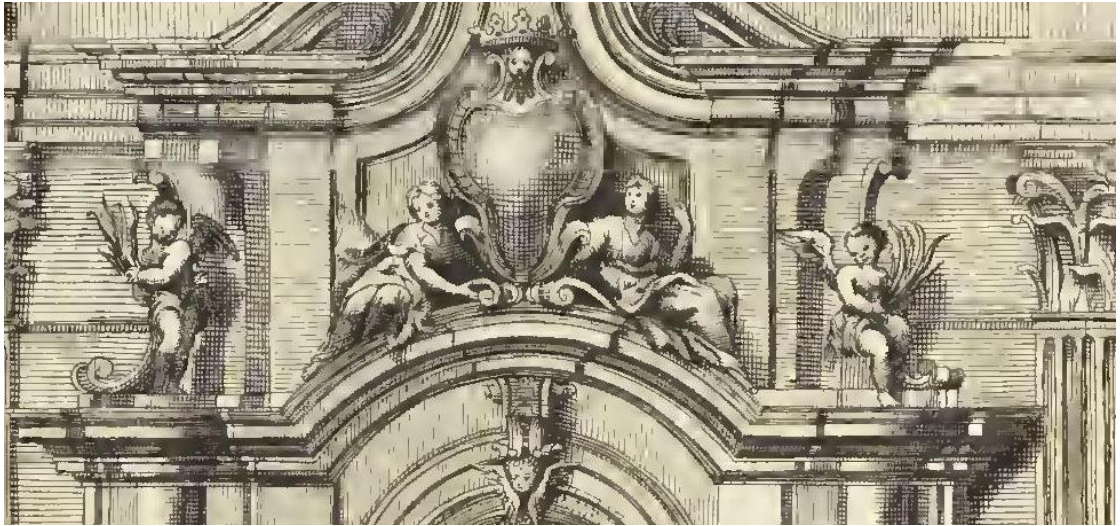


Fig. G.130 Andrea Pozzo, *Perspectiva pictorum et architectorum*, II, fig. 64, 1700. Detail.

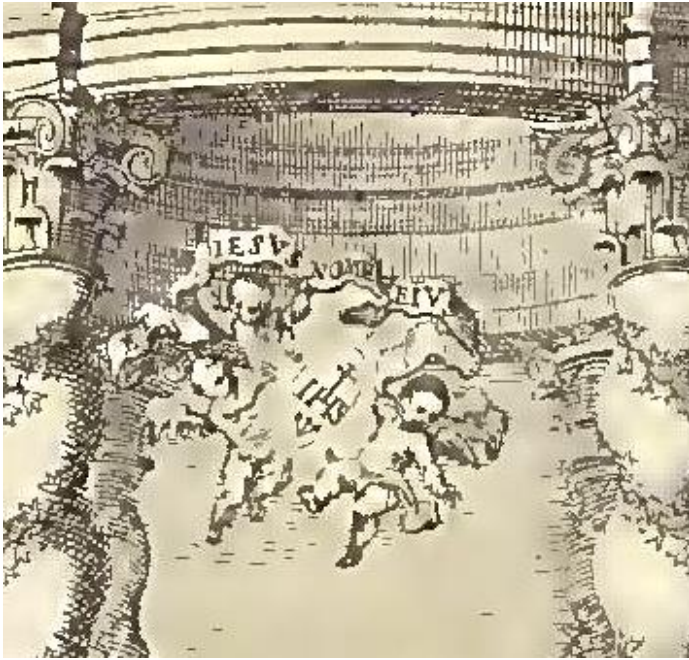


Fig. G.133 Andrea Pozzo, *Perspectiva pictorum et architectorum*, II, fig. 69, 1700. Detail.

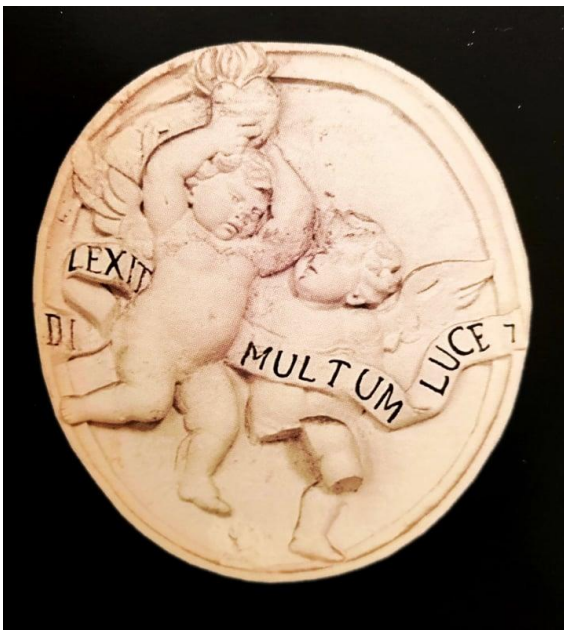

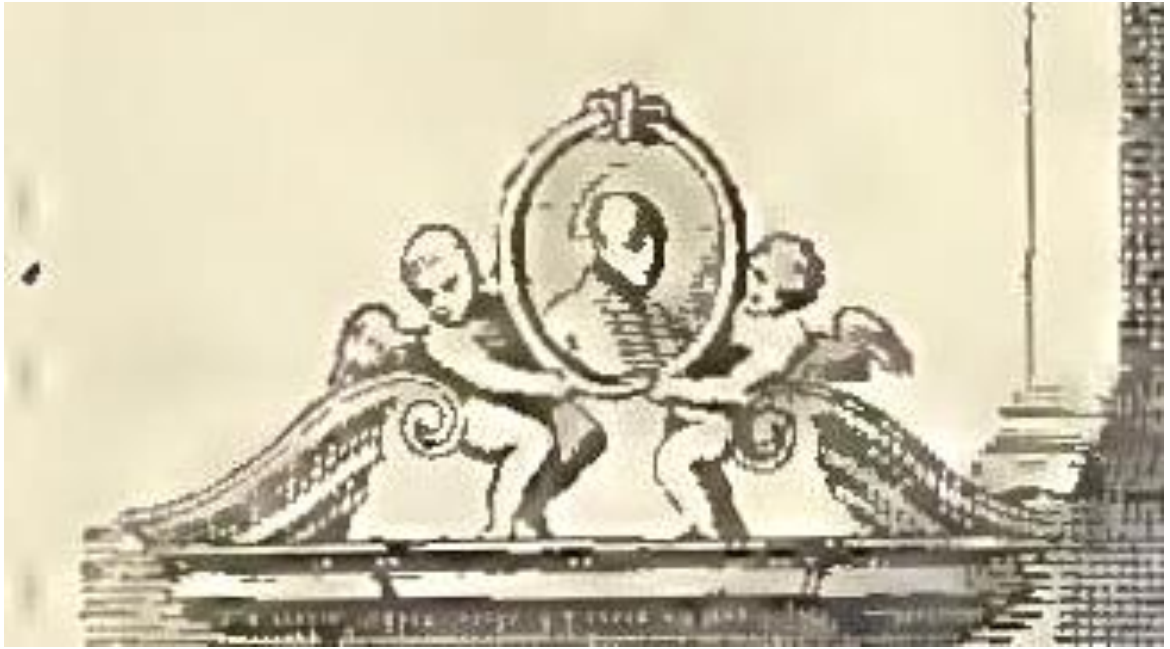


Fig. G.138 Andrea Pozzo, *Perspectiva pictorum et architectorum*, II, fig. 77, 1700. Detail.

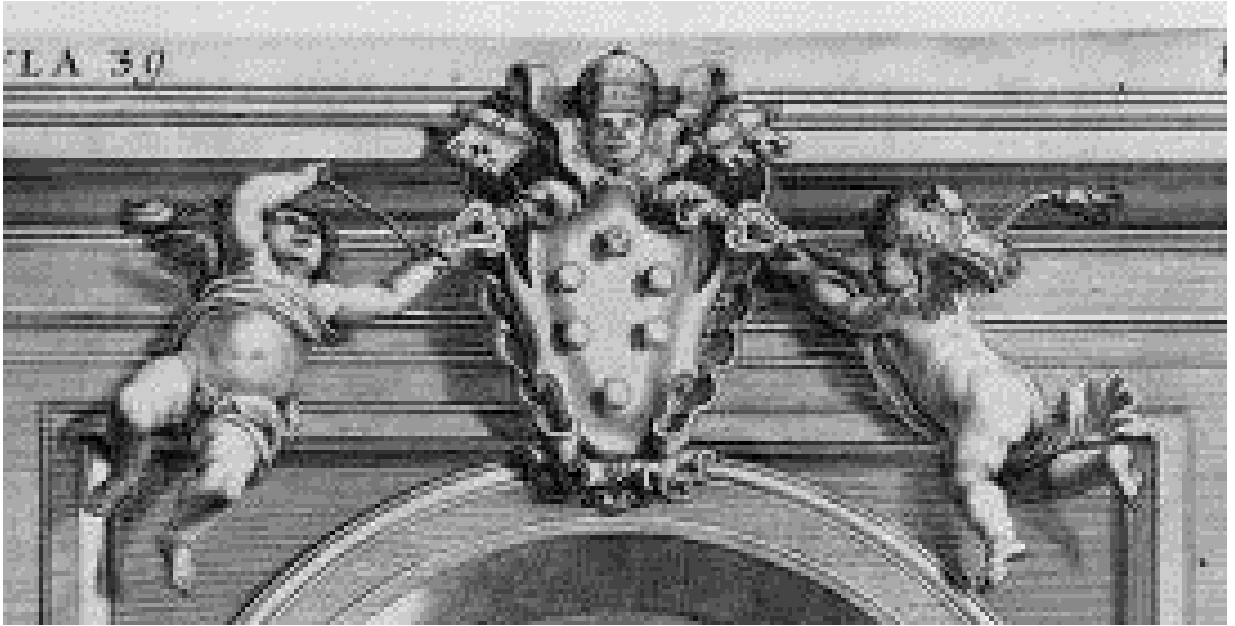

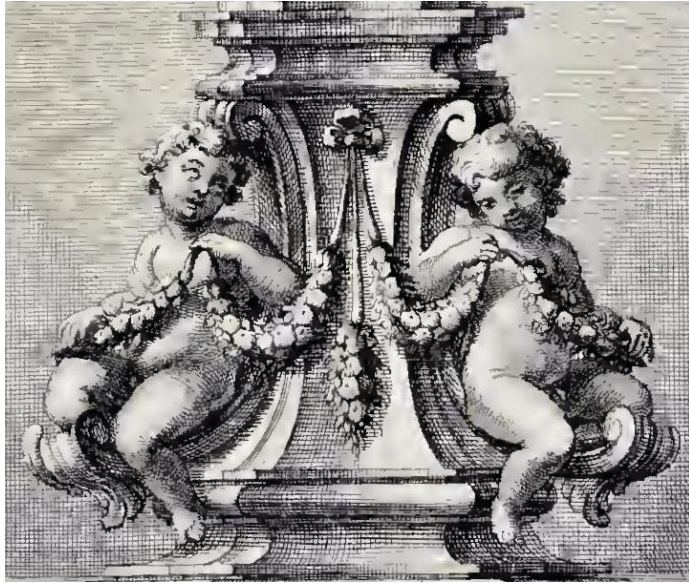


Fig. G.148 Giovanni Giardini, *Disegni diversi inventati e delineati da Giovanni Giardini*, pl. 32, 1714. Detail.

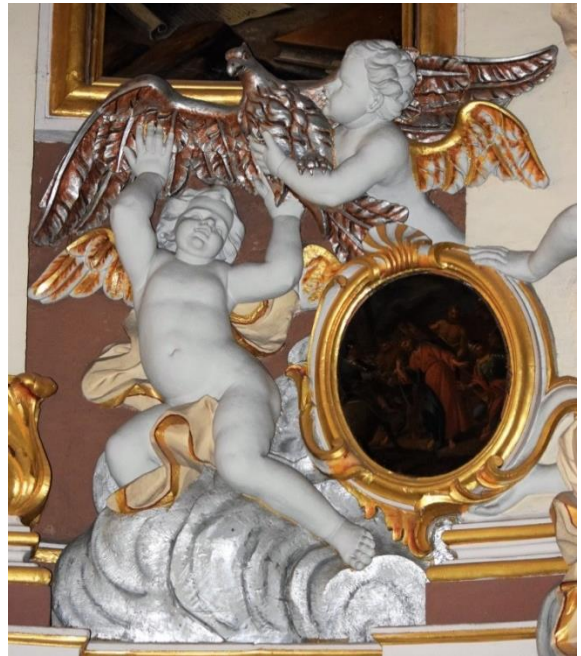

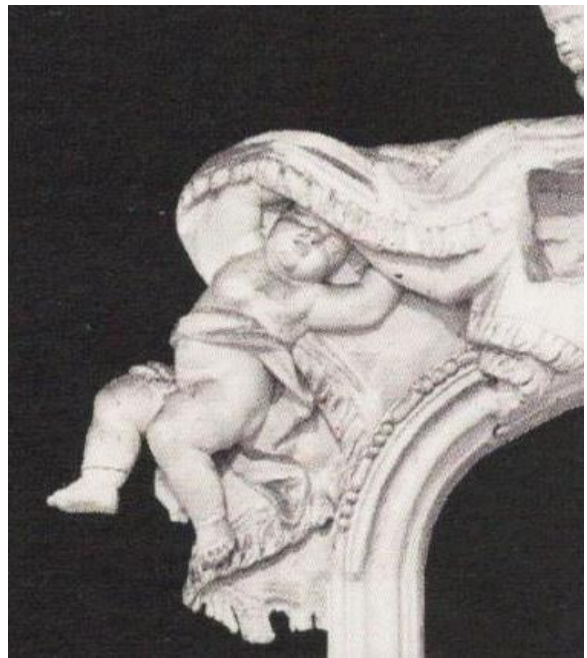

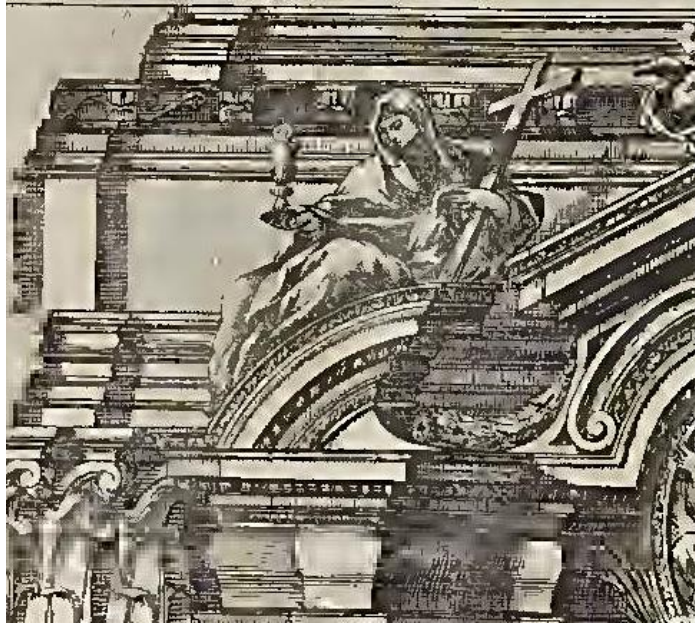

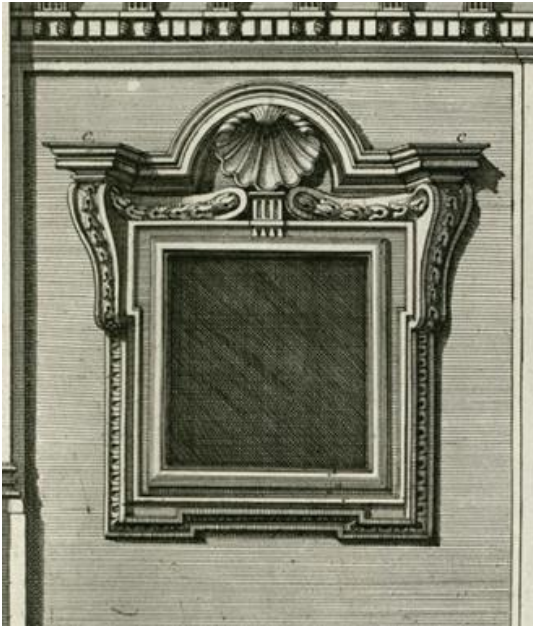

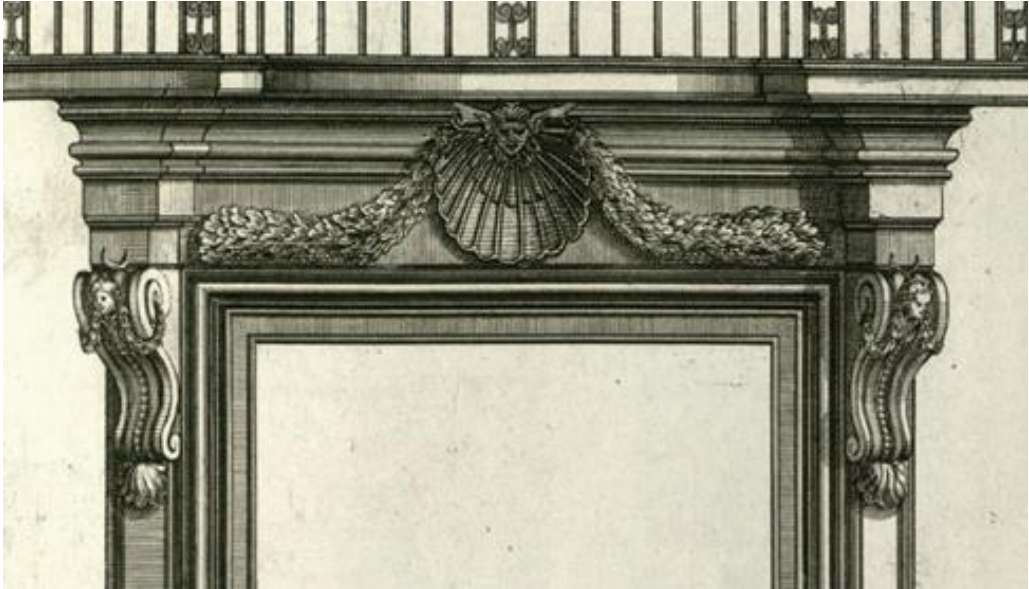

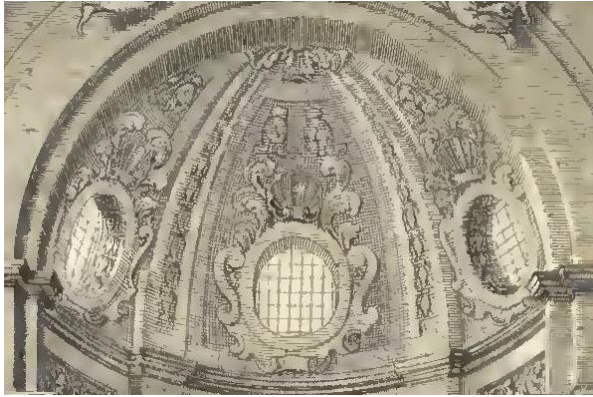


Fig. G.181 Andrea Pozzo, *Perspectiva pictorum et architectorum*, II, fig. 15, 1700. Detail.

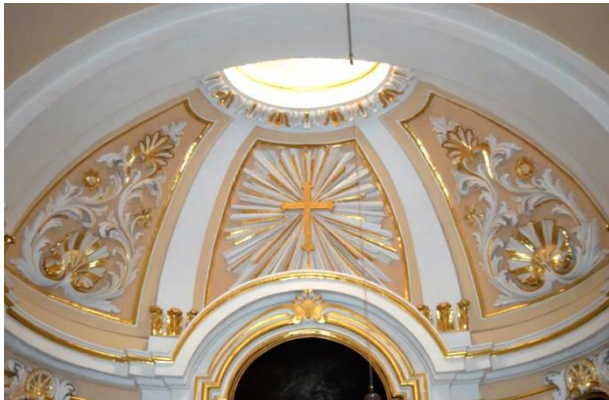


Fig. G.183 (?), Titular altar, Church of St Margaret, Cospicua. Detail.

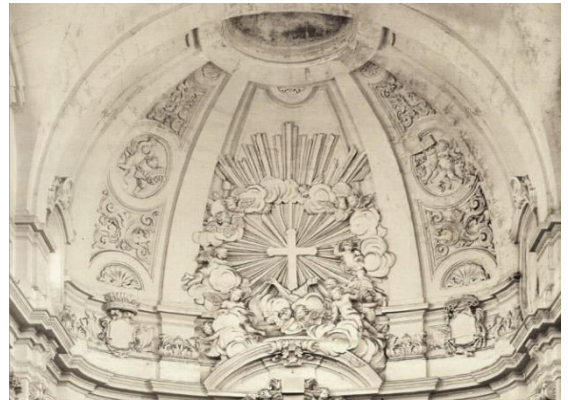


Fig. G.184 Pietro Paolo Zahra, Titular altar, Church of St Mary Magdalene, Valletta, 1726. Detail.

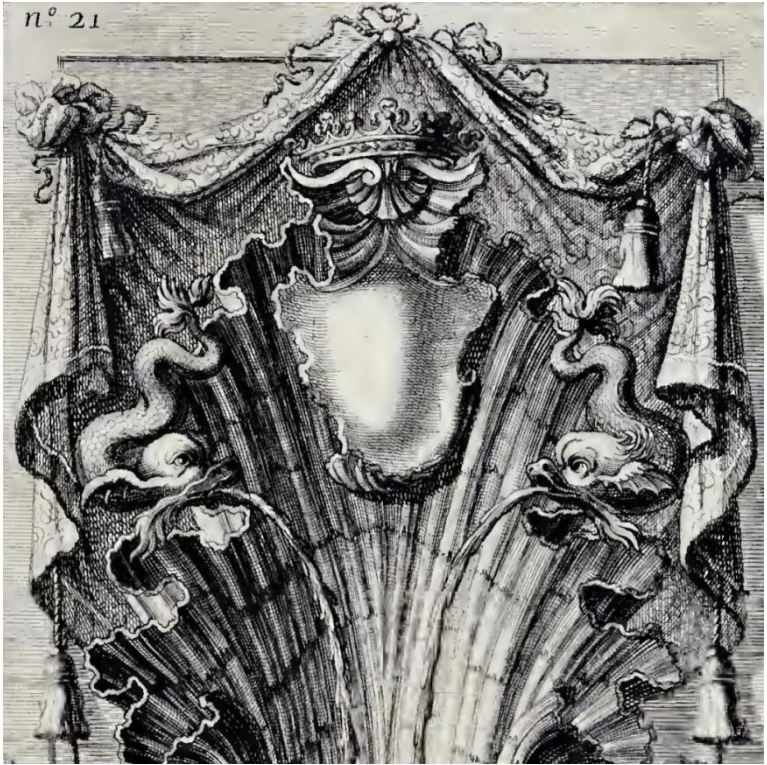


Fig. G.198 Giovanni Giardini, *Disegni diversi inventati e delineati da Giovanni Giardini*, pl. 21, 1714.
