Vittmi tal-Gwerra

Fil-bidu tal-gwerra, fil-Belt Valletta kien hemm popolazzjoni ta' madwar 24,000 persuna. Matul il-gwerra, 93 persuna pajżana: 57 raġel u 36 mara li minnhom kien hemm tmint itfal, mietu bl-attakki tal-ġħadu fl-istess belt. B'kolloġġ mill-bidu sal-ahħar jum tal-gwerra kienu saru 3,340 attakk mill-ajru fuq Malta u l-ħbit totali mill-ajrulplani tal-ġħadu kien jammonta għal 2,357 siegħa. L-attakki kienu mqassma hekk:

- 1940: 211 attakk
- 1941: 963 attakk
- 1942: 2,031 attakk
- 1943: 127 attakk
- 1944: 8 attakki

War casualties

At the start of the war, the population of Valletta was 24,000. During the war 93 civilians, 57 males and 36 females, died from enemy action in the city; 8 were children. There were a total of 3,340 air attacks on Malta lasting a total of 2,357 hours. The attacks were divided as follows:

- 1940: 211 attacks
- 1941: 963 attacks
- 1942: 2,031 attacks
- 1943: 127 attacks
- 1944: 8 attacks
