My name is Rafael Leitão and I've participated with all of you in the 2002 Odin week, some will remember me for shore.

Well, now I'm a co-director of a dance company in Portugal, and I move the research department on dance and theatre, also, organize an international festival, that aims to present different contexts and supports of working the subject: Body.

The festival presents not only movement performances, but also theatre piece, music, performances, and many other artistic projects, inside or outside. The preference goes to new supports of working.

In the last editions many artists from Europe and US came upon, this years under my work we had the world premiere of the new Susanne Linke piece, and other important performative works. The festival have a big impact in the media.

The new artistic development of the company aims to improve the research subjects. And that includes a reformulation of exchanges program within different company's. The new support wants to move further on this exchanges, and look for new contexts abroad.
