Sabiex dan ikun possibbli, l-ewwel haġa li għamilna kien li sseparajna t-telefonata ta' emerġenza li nirċievu fuq in-numru 191, mit-telefonati l-oħra li jidħlu fuq in-numri 224001 sa 7. Dan għamilni ħalli i ntroduċejna r-Reception

Area fl-entratura tal-Kwartier Generali, fejn membri tal-Korp se jilqgħu in-nies li jirrikorru għal xi servizz, u jirċievu dawk it-telefonati kkollha li ma jkunux t-emerġenza. għaldaqstant, il-membri tal-Korp fil-Command and control room ser ikunu jistgħu jikkonċentraw aktar fuq kull telefonata ta' emerġenza li tidħol fuq in-numru 191.

Barra minn dawn l-inizjattivi, sabiex ikunu f'pożizzjoni li nistgħu nwieġbu għat-telefonati ta' emerġenza fl-iqsar żmein possibbli, il-Korp investa fis-sistema tal-automated Vehicle Location system. Din is-sistema tippermettilna, li meta jinqala' l-każ ta' emerġenza, permezz ta' mapep digitali nkunu nafu eż-żgħad fejn ikunu qiegħdin il-vetturi tal-Korp, u

għadaqstant inkunu nistgħu nibgħatu fuq il-post ta' l-incident, dik il-vettura li tkun l-aktar fil-viċin tal-lokalitā.


Sabiex l-iskop ta' dan iċ-Charter jirnexxi huwa meħtieġ li nsibu l-kooperazzjoni tal-pubbliku. Minn numru kbir ta' telefonati li nirċievu fuq in-numru 191 jirriżulta li 80% ma jirrigwardawx kažijiet ta' emerġenza. Għaldaqstant, nieħu din l-okkażjoni sabiex nappella l-membri tal-pubbliku ġalli jekk ma jkollux everġenza, iżda jkollu bżonn is-servizz tal-pulizija, iċċemper il-Kwartieri Generali tal-Pulizija fuq 224001-7 jew l-Għassaq tal-lokal tiegħu. B'hekk ma ntelfux lil xi hadd li veru jikollu każ ta' emerġenza u kun qed jipprova jaqbad magħna fuq in-numru 191.



Police educate the young




Sergeant Charles Zammit, who was responsible for traffic education, told the Malta Independent that his team taught the five to nine-year-olds how to cross roads, where and how to ride bicycles, using a safety helmet and wearing seat belts, even at the back of the car.

Inspector Norbert Ciappara gave a talk to parents on substance abuse and how parents need to remain close to their children so they notice if there is a problem. Inspector Ciappara told the Malta Independent he believed that the drugs problem in Malta was under control.

Fis-27 ta' Marzu ta' 1-1997, għal ġabta tal-11.30 ta' filgħodu, l-iskwadra kontra d-Drogi kienet nfurmati mill-pulizija ta' I-Għassa ta' Birżebuga li persuna kienet marret tirrapporta każ ta' suspectt ta' sejba ta' droga.

Il-persuna rrappurtat li 'Villa Ferretti' li tinsab fi Triq Salvatore Cachia fil-Qajjenza, limiti ta' Birżebuga, kienet ġiet żgassata. Fil-fatt instabu diversi kmamar f'din I-istess villa żgassati wkoll. Numru ta'siġar f'din il-villa, eżattament fil-bitħa tagħha, kienet ġew maqlugħha u minflokom tqoġġew pjanti żgħar li kienet jixbhu lill-pjanti tal-Cannabis.

L-ewwel li waslu fuq il-post kienet I-pulizija tad-distrett minn I-Għassa ta' Birżebuga u wara kienet infurmata wkoll l-Iskwadra kontra d-Drogi. Dak il-ħin il-membri ta' l-Iskwadra taħbi it-tmexxija ta' l-Assistent Kummissarju Michael Cassar u l-Ispettur Nicholas Ciappara marru fuq il-post u kkonfermaw li l-pjanti li kienet jidhru miżrughha fil-ħamrija, fil-bitħa ta' din il-villa kienet fil-fatt tat-tip Cannabis.

Hemmhekk kienet osservati numru konsidervoli ta' qsari li wkoll kien fihom pjanti żgħar hafna, iż-ġħar minn dawk li kien hemm miżrughha fil-ħamrija, li kienet jidhru li aktarx kienet tal-

Cannabis ukoll.

Fil-kmamar tal-villa, partikolarment f'kamra minnhom kienet osservata xi żerriegħha tal-pjanta Cannabis li dehru kienet qed ikunu kultivati biex jibdew jikbru.

Bil-każ kien infurmat il-Maġistrat ta' I-Għassa, Dr. Apap Bologna li għamel inkjesta u nnomina bhala esperti biex jassistuh lis-Sur Philip Zammit, lil Dr. Anthony Abela Medici, kif ukoll Uffiċċiali oħra tal-Pulizija bhala Uffiċċiali tax-Xena tad-Delitt, tal-Fotografija, u mit-Taqsima tal-Forensika.

Minn investigazzjonijiet li bdew immedjatamente, irriżulta li din il-villa kien qed jieħu ħsiebha l-persuna stess li rrapporta l-każ. Is-sidien tal-villa, li huma persuni ta'nazzjonialita Maltija, jidher li kienet ilhom ix-xhur ma jersqu 'l-hemm u allura pjuttost kienet tidher li hi villa abbandunata.

Sar magħruf ukoll li l-persuna li kienet qed tieħu ħsieb dik il-villa fissem is-sidien, dakħinhar tas-sejba kien mar hemmhekk, mingħalihi li sejjjer jaqta' xi ftit lumi mis-sigar li kien hemm ftit tax-xhur qabel. Minflok, hekk kif fetah il-bieb, irrealizza li l-bieb kien ġie żgassat. Dahal ġewwa, u osserva wkoll li d-diversi kmamar li kien hemm imsakkra l-ahħar darba li kien daħħal hu, kienet lkoll żgassati.

Barra li kienet żgassata, il-

villa kienet tidher li qed tkun okkupata wkoll. Dan kien jidher ċar mill-mod ta' kif kienet miżmura l-kmamar, kif ukoll id-dehra ġenerali ta' l-istess residenza.

Irriżulta li, hekk kif il-persuna in kwistjoni kompla dieħel 'il-ġewwa u resaq lejn il-bitħa, osserva li s-siġar li kellu miżrughha kienet nqalghu biex minflokom inżerġu diversi pjanti li kienet telgħi u li għal persuna in kwistjoni dehru li kienet suspectu.

Il-bitħa fejn instabu dawn il-pjanti kienet madwar 70 pied b'45 pied iż-żda din ma kinitx kollha ħamrija. Iż-żoni bil-ħamrija kienet żewġ qatħat b'daqs ta' madwar 20 pied bi 15-il pied wis-a' rispettivament.

Anke minħabba li l-persuna kien diġi ntebah li l-bieb kien żgassat, żidiedlu s-suspett li wasslu biex mar I-Għassa tal-Pulizija fejn għamel ir-rapport. L-imsemmi inidividwu qabel ħalla l-post osserva li l-bieb tal-garaxx, kienet bidlulu l-ikatnazz ukoll.

Wara li saret l-inkjesta u l-Esperti elevaw l-esibiti, jiġifieri l-pjanti kollha li kien hemm, il-pulizija żammew il-villa taħbi osservazzjoni kontinwa għal diversi jiem, pero jirriżulta li qatt ħadd ma resaq lejn din il-villa f'dan iż-żmien.

Dan il-każ madanakollu ma setax jinżamm mistur biex l-investigazzjonijiet setgħu eventwalment jagħtu l-frott

mixtieq peress li l-ahbar tas-sejba ta' din il-mixtla kienet ħarġet pubblika minn xi mezzi tax-xandir fi żmien mhux addattat u għalhekk, min kien responsabbli minn dawn il-pjanti, induna x'qed jiġi fil-konfront tas-sejba minn l-istess mezzi tax-xandir.

Taqlib fil-post ma nstab xejn, jekk wieħed jirreferi għal taqlib bhala tgerfix, anzi, jista' jingħad li meta l-pulizija u ufficjali oħra marru fuq il-post, dan kien jidher miżmum nadif ħafna.

B'kollox il-pulizija elevat 149 xitla tal-Cannabis ta' diversi qisien, ghaliex dawk li kien hemm fuq in-naha ta' barra kien akbar mill-qsari li kien jidħru li għadhom kif bdew jinbtu. Minn hemmhekk ukoll ġew elevati affarrijiet oħra relatati mat-tkabbir tal-pjanti Cannabis. Ma kien jindika xejn li hemm ġew kien qed isir xi abbuż, inkella xi preparamenti għal traffikar ta' droga, naturalment ħlief għal pjanta nnifisha.

Kemm fil-fatt huma stmati li jqumu dawn il-pjanti fis-suq lokali mhux magħruf. Aktar minn hekk il-pjanti kien għadhom żgħar, fil-bidu tagħhom u fil-fatt l-akbar li kien hemm ma kinux ta' tul aktar minn tlett piedi.

Ġie osservat ukoll li ma kienx hemm pjanti maqlughin u dan hu ovju ghaliex pjanta li tkun daqshekk żgħira, wieħed ma tantx ikollu x'jieħu minna.

Provi u indikazzjonijiet li l-villa kienet intużat riċentament kien il-bini ntern innifsu ghaliex kif kien miżmum, l-ambjent

kien wieħed nadif ħafna waqt li l-post fejn tinsab il-villa hu wieħed li normalment jinħakem faċilment minn ħafna trubien u elementi oħra bħal raxx tal-baħar. Dan appart i-fatt li l-pjanta tal-Cannabis tinhtieg kura u attenzjoni kbira biex tikber u allura ma tistax tkun abbandunata għal aktar minn ffit jiem.

Jidher li wara din is-sejba, il-pulizija partikolarment l-Iskwadra Kontra d-Drogi kienet waslet għal numru ta' arresti mill-viċinanzi tal-villa. Kien interrogat ukoll min kien qed jieħu ħsieb il-villa sabiex il-pulizija setgħet stabilixxiet certi fatti.

Mill-investigazzjonijiet pero ma rriżultax li xi ħadd jew uħud minn dawn il-persuni setgħu b'xi mod kien involuti b'konnessjoni ma' din il-mixtla u għalhekk ħadd ma ttella' l-Qorti.

Kummenti ġeneralii li daħlu dwar il-każ

Inghatat informazzjoni tajba dwar numru ta' zgħażaq li ġieli ffrekwentaw ir-residenza msemija fil-każ. Ingħataw dettalji dwar persuni li setgħu kien nvoluti, flimkien ma' indirizzi u vetturi wżati minnhom. Diversi persuni wrew ix-xewqa li jsir programm fejn it-telespettaturi jkunu murija d-diversi tipi ta' droga li jeżistu. Numru minn dawk li ċemplu, daħlu fil-qasam investigattiv tal-każ u taw diversi spunti dwar x-setgħu għamlu l-Pulizija u l-Forensika biex faċilment waslu biex jinqabdu dawk il-persuni wara l-każ tal-mixtla ta' Birżeppu.

Kif jidher hawn fuq, kien hemm numru ta' persuni li ngiebu quddiem l-attenzjoni tal-pulizija bhala suspettati minn fost dawk li ċemplu. Il-pubbliku kkopera ħafna u ta d-dettalji kollha possibbli biex dawn in-nies jinqabdu immedjatament u jkunu nterrogati. Overview

The U.S. Market for cocaine may still be substantial, but the narcotraffickers of Latin America have made great progress in diversifying their client base. Recent U.S. drug abuse statistics provide insights into the motivation for diversification.

The peak years for cocaine abuse in the United States were in the late 1980s and early 1990s. Since then, cocaine abuse has been slowly but steadily declining. In 1985, there were 5.7 million cocaine users in the United States. The current number is estimated at under two million. (By the standards of the Office of National Drug Control Policy in Washington, a cocaine "user" is anyone who has taken the drug at least once in the past month.) The most precipitous drop, according to the National Household Survey on Drug Abuse, has been among users of crack, the cheap, smokable and highly addictive "rock" form of cocaine.


One reason for the decline is bitter experience with cocaine addiction. U.S. society has been dealing with the cocaine epidemic for more than 15 years. In that time frame, many of the original users of cocaine have died from their addiction, been incarcerated for drug-related crimes or sought treatment to stop using cocaine. Meanwhile, younger members of society have witnessed the wreckage experienced by the first group of abusers, and those grim

lessons have deterred many youngsters from ever experimenting with cocaine.

Today, the U.S. market accounts for only 280 tons of the 700 tons of cocaine produced in Latin America every year. While demand in the United States had declined, coca production in

replaced the mediocrities. Despite their small size, these groups have proven quite effective, not least of all because of their willingness and ability to cooperate with one another and with organized crime gangs in other corners of the globe.

One of the most successful new groups was the Millennium cartel, overseen - until his arrest last October - by Alejandro Bernal Madrigal of Bogota. Bernal's syndicate was reportedly moving 30 tons of cocaine out of Colombia every month. Much of the cocaine was concealed in cargoes of frozen fruit.

Changing Latin American Trafficking Patterns.

The cocaine trade is no longer controlled by five or six mediocrities in Latin America. By the mid-1990s, Colombian authorities, with U.S. assistance, had crushed the Medellin and Cali cartels. And Mexican syndicates began fragmenting after the 1997 death of drug kingpin Amado Carrillo Fuentes, as members of his Juarez cartel fought with one another over his succession, while continuing their turf wars with the rival Tijuana cartel.

Numerous small syndicates have

was its development of circuitous shipping routes. Bernal's syndicate shipped its U.S.-bound cocaine through Ecuador, Chile and Guatemala in order to bypass the stricter inspection Colombian imports receive at U.S. entry points. The circuitous shipping technique presupposed cooperation with criminal elements in all of the way station. In addition, Bernal cultivated close ties with Mexican traffickers. Donnie Marshall of the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), credited Bernal with taking "his organization into a new realm where ... business was transacted in numerous nations."

In response to the U.S. crackdown on air smuggling from Colombia, Latin American traffickers, in general, have developed numerous new smuggling routes. In recent years, significant in



general, have developed numerous new smuggling routes. In recent years, significant amounts of cocaine have been shipped out of the seaports of Ecuador, Peru and Venezuela. Argentina and Paraguay have also emerged as major way stations for the cocaine produced in Colombia, Bolivia and Peru. Traffickers rely on the virtual lack of radar surveillance for the thousands of airstrips in northern Argentina. In Paraguay, cocaine shippers benefit from that country's central location, its network of rivers and its well established tradition of smuggling, coupled with official corruption.

The demise of the large Colombian cartels created growth opportunities for Brazilian traffickers, most of whom once worked for smuggling operations overseen from Cali and Medellin. Instead of competing with their former bosses, the Brazilian gangs are effectively cooperating with Colombian counterparts.

The cooperation benefits the Colombian in several ways. First, the Brazilian groups provide expanded access to Atlantic ports - a particularly attractive benefit as cocaine markets open up in Europe.

Second, the Brazilian gangs are well positioned to develop a Brazilian market for Colombian cocaine. The Brazilian traffickers more readily elude police detection, because they blend in with local society.

One small Brazilian drug syndicate is reportedly run by a rancher, Leonardo Dias. Dias allegedly controls 24 planes ferrying cocaine from Colombia to Suriname. His 17 companies, including construction firms and

an air-taxi service, may launder the drug profits.

The Brazilian gangs are also developing their own processing facilities. Last June, police in Para discovered a laboratory in the final stages of construction. The underground laboratory would have been able to process up to 10 tons of cocaine a month.



Cocaine Abuse on the rise in Latin America

Then years ago, drug abuse was not a major problem in most Latin American countries. That is no longer the case. And Cocaine is a big reason why. Drug testing of people arrested for all kinds of crime (not just drug-related) is one indicator measuring the extent of the abuse problem. In parts of Latin America, more than 10 percent of arrested suspects test positive for cocaine.

Buenos Aires, which has become a major transit point for cocaine headed for Europe, reports serious problems with cocaine abuse, especially among young people. The Argentine capital now has an abuse rate of 4.1 percent in a population of 12 million residents in Buenos Aires. And cocaine is a major contributor to that statistic. Cheap prices, half

what they were in the 1980s, are a factor. At US\$5 to US\$20 per gram, cocaine in Buenos Aires sells for less than a quarter the price in major U.S. cities. Drug rehabilitation centres, focusing on middle-class cocaine abusers, represent a growth industry in Argentina today.

Brasilia, another drug transit city, has similarly developed and addiction to cocaine. The drug is ingested in various forms: inhaled as a powder, smoked as a paste (often mixed with other drugs) and smoked as crack, the "rock" form of the drug.

In Chile, a 1998 survey showed a clear rise in drug use in the preceding two years, with cocaine fuelling the increase. More than 5 percent of the population between the ages of 12 and 62 had used marijuana, coca paste or cocaine in the preceding year.

That figure compares with just over 4 percent in 1996. The drug abuse rate is even higher in the capital, Santiago.

From 1988 to 1998, the number of people using illegal drugs in Mexico jumped from 1.5 million to 2.5 million. In that period, the market for low-grade cocaine has juana. Cocaine abuse is a significant problem in Guadalajara, Juarez, Mexico city and Tijuana.

According to a 1998 survey, 3.2 percent of Peruvians had used cocaine in the preceding year. That figure compares with 1.3 percent in 1988. Bazuco, a smokable derivative of coca paste, plagues the streets of Lima, where the drug can be purchased for the equivalent of 10 cents a hit. Although Peruvian authorities have succeeded in reducing the local coca crop, Peru remains a significant coca producer. As with



many drug production countries, some of the coca "leaks" onto the domestic market. One Western diplomat in Lima recently summed up the phenomenon: "Suddenly, you had all this product in everybody's back yard and nobody to buy it. It was sort of like having grass clippings, but these clippings had a high worth. So they just turned around and found another market - here."

West European Trafficking Patterns

With coca production up in Colombia and cocaine consumption down in the United States, Latin American traffickers have turned to Western Europe more and more in recent years. General Rosso Jose Serrano Cadena, Colombia's National Police director, agrees: "What we are seeing is a heavy push of cocaine into Europe."

According to U.S. officials up to 130 tons of cocaine produced in Latin America every year now goes to the European market. About 57 percent of that amount enters Europe via the Iberian Peninsula, where traffickers exploit cultural ties linking Spain and Portugal with former colonies in the New World. Other significant West European entry points for South American cocaine include the Netherlands (about 15 percent of cocaine imports to Europe) and Belgium (6 percent).

During his six-day tour of Western Europe last October, U.S. drug czar Barry McCaffrey underscored the menace cocaine poses for the European market. He warned his hosts that they are "now the target of a drug threat that is searching for new customers." Those customers can be found in large numbers in Western Europe, the U.S. official noted, "because the money is here!" During his visit to the European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction in Lisbon, McCaffrey counselled his European counterparts, "My caution to our European partners is to understand the enormous threat from cocaine appearing in

the workplace, in the family structure and school systems."

European counternarcotics statistics support McCaffrey's warning. In the first six months of 1999, European cocaine seizure were double the amount for the first half of 1998. The second half of the year saw no let-up.

In July of last year, Spanish authorities made the largest single cocaine seizure ever reported in Europe: 10 tons of cocaine was intercepted 1,000 kilometres southwest of the Canary Islands, on a ship that had sailed from Panama. Most of the drugs were headed for other parts of Europe, but Spanish gangs were reportedly guaranteed a 40 percent cut of the cocaine haul to provide safe transport through Spain.

Between April 1 and December 10 1999, British customs officers confiscated more than a ton of cocaine.

In late December 1999, Swedish officials reported confiscating a record level of cocaine for the year: 409 kilos. Previous annual cocaine seizures ranged between 2 and 27 kilos.

Wrong Port for Banana Boat

The 52 kilos of cocaine found in a Dublin fruit and vegetable ware house in mid-December may have been routed to Ireland by mistake. The drugs arrived via a Colombian banana boat that put into Antwerp, Belgium, before unloading cargo in Dublin. Irish security officials believe the consignment was probably intended for the continental market. "This would be too large a load for the Irish market," Speculated on police spokesman. "We reckon it was sent to the wrong country."

The cocaine busts continue into

the new millennium. In early January, following an investigation lasting several months, Spain's Civil Guard broke up a major cocaine ring operating in Madrid and Catalonia. Five members of the syndicate were arrested and more than 16 kilos of cocaine was confiscated.


During his European tour last autumn, U.S. counternarcotics official Barry McCaffrey praised Spanish authorities for their work against the cocaine trade. McCaffrey added that Dutch drug officials had also contributed to the sharp increase in overall European cocaine seizures for 1999.

Rising Cocaine Abuse in Western Europe

Unfortunately, even the best police work cannot intercept all the cocaine entering Western Europe. The European Observatory on Drugs and Drug Addiction reported that cocaine use was on the rise throughout the continent. That finding was presented at the Drug Congress 2000, held in Brussels in late October. The report noted that most of the cocaine was snorted in powdered form. Crack smoking had made some inroads, but was relatively rare in most section of Western Europe.

In England, nearly 10 percent of suspects arrested for crimes test positive for cocaine use. Britain's top drug control official, Keith Hellawell, recently appealed to pop stars to incorporate anti-drug messages in their work - in an effort to undermine the "chic" image of such drugs as cocaine. Hellawell praised the willingness of such musicians as Eric Clapton and Elton John to speak about their own experiences with the ravages of cocaine and other drugs.

Cocaine enjoys a chic image in Stockholm. According to Swedish authorities, the main distribution centres for the drug are the capital's most fashionable bars and night spots.



The East European Cocaine Connection

For several years, Russian crime gangs have been cooperating with Latin American cocaine cartels. U.S. officials estimate that 10 tons of cocaine smuggled in Europe is shipped through Russia. Some of the cocaine stays in Russia, to feed the growing drug habits of the newly affluent classes there, but most is routed west - through other members of the Commonwealth of Independent States and other East European countries. Cocaine traffickers prefer the longer eastern routes, even to supply markets in Western Europe, because customs offices in Eastern Europe often lack adequate resources, as well as experience in identifying cocaine.

Last August, Ukrainian authorities destroyed a huge haul of cocaine taken from a Russian vessel two years earlier. More than 600 kilos of cocaine had been confiscated from a ship ostensibly travelling from Colombia to Belgium.

In recent month, Georgia, Romania and Poland have reported an increase in cocaine seizures. In Poland, crime gangs often negotiate directly with Latin American counterparts, without the benefit of Russian middlemen. Polish traffickers have developed contacts with shippers in Suriname, for example. In May 1009, Polish authorities intercepted four cocaine shipments mounted from Suriname to Szczecin. The cocaine was hidden in cans of beans. Some of the cocaine was apparently intended for the Dutch market.

Polish security officials estimate that 35 percent of the illicit drugs smuggled into Western Europe from Latin America and Asia now transit Poland. Szczecin and

Gdansk are the main ports of entry for these drugs.

The Balkan routes that have long been used by Asian heroin and opium smugglers now ferry cocaine as well. German experts believe as much as 30 percent of the cocaine that ends up in West European markets may be funneled through the Balkans. Once the drugs arrive in Balkan ports, Albanian crime groups are the key shippers.

Increasingly, East Europeans are hiring out to transport cocaine for Latin American cartels. A Ukrainian captain, assisted by two Ukrainian officers and a mostly Greek crew, piloted the China Breeze, carrying nearly 4 tons of

Ukrainians and Russians manned the ship carrying 10 tons of cocaine toward Spain last July, when it was intercepted by Spanish authorities off the Canary Islands.

Cocaine's Inroads in Other Parts of the Globe

Cocaine runs do not stop at the Canary Islands. Nigeria's Drug Law Enforcement Agency reported a record cocaine bust last August. Authorities in Kano, in the northern part of the country, seized more than 67 kilos of cocaine from two Nigerian traffickers. The drugs had been brought into the country aboard a Balkan Airline plane and were transported to Kano via Nigeria Airways.


In October, a U.N. official shared with the press his belief that UNITA rebels of Angola were dealing in cocaine. "We have reason to believe that cocaine from producer nations like Colombia is being smuggled to Angola's southern border with Namibia via Brazil," said the official, who wanted to remain anonymous. He believed the rebels were bartering cocaine for weapons and stolen vehicles, smuggled in from South Africa, via Namibia. UNITA spokesmen have denied any involvement in smuggling cocaine.

Cocaine figured also in recent Ghanaian busts. Between December 13, 1999, and January 2, 2000, customs officials at Accra's Kotoka International Airport confiscated nearly 5 kilos of heroin, cocaine and marijuana from five Nigerians, three Malians and one Ghanaian.

cocaine from Panama, on an apparent mission for Greek and Colombian crime groups. The ship was intercepted in the Caribbean by the U.S. Coast Guard last May.

Crack cocaine is the source of major health and crime problems in South Africa. The drug first appeared on the local market in the mid-1990s. Abuse problems





were initially restricted to Johannesburg, but crack has spread to KwaZulu Natal, the Western Cape, Bloemfontein and more recently, the Eastern Cape. Health authorities in Johannesburg say the speed with which local crack users become addicted exceeds that of any other drug previously encountered.

Reports of cocaine smuggling and abuse are no longer rarities in the Middle East in 1999. Turkish authorities seized 13 kilos of the drug.

In Israel, a 1999 survey prepared for the authority for Combating Drugs cited cocaine as a significant problem among young abusers. According to the survey, 2.5 percent of Israeli youngsters had used cocaine in the preceding year. Ben Gurion International Airport in Jerusalem was the scene of a cocaine bust early this year. Police apprehended a courier who has swallowed packets containing more than 1.2 kilos of cocaine.

Even citizens of Saudi Arabia, a country that bans any form of intoxicant and executes drug traffickers, have been linked to the cocaine trade. Late last year, a French weekly charged that a senior Saudi official was involved in shipping 2 tons of cocaine to France. The cocaine had allegedly been aboard a Saudi aircraft reserved for top officials. The government in Riyadh denied those charges. At the same time the Interior Ministry in Riyadh requested that Paris "provide all information ... on this subject so that the proper Saudi authorities can take the appropriate measures."

Cambodia, the Philippines and Hong Kong number among the East Asian way stations for the global cocaine trade. Hong Kong is a transit point, for example, for a drugs-for-abalone operation involving other corners of Asia and South Africa. Valued for its alleged aphrodisiac properties, abalone is harvested off the coast of South Africa, dried and exported

to Hong Kong, Singapore and China. From those locations, crime syndicates ship the dried abalone to various East Asian markets and pay for the abalone in cocaine and heroin.

Last June, Hong Kong authorities cooperated with U.S. and Canadian counterparts to shut down a major cocaine and heroin smuggling operation transiting the former British colony. Cocaine from Latin America was being shipped to Vancouver via Hong Kong and Macao.

Alert customs officers at Hong Kong's international airport found 8 kilos of cocaine in an unclaimed bag last July. The officers became suspicious because of the heaviness of the bag, ostensibly containing picture frames and a transformer. On further investigation, the frames and transformer were found to be stuffed with cocaine.

These days, cocaine abuse numbers among the problems cited by health officials in such countries as Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Taiwan and Thailand, far removed from coca production areas. Crack cocaine has developed a following in China. Not satisfied with the profits derived from shipping crack into China, drug dealers from Hong Kong and Taiwan have been setting up processing centres in China itself. Those underground laboratories will reportedly be able to manufacture crack on a large scale.

Cocaine is making inroads in Australia as well. In 1998, authorities there seized a record 225 kilos of the drug. That haul was almost three times the previous record.

Sophisticated Methods for the Cocaine Trade

The new breed of Latin American cocaine trafficker is adopting many of the sophisticated methods of legitimate businesses. Nowhere is this more evident than in communications technology. A




good example is the Millennium cartel of Alejandro Bernal Madrigal. Some 100 people working for the cartel kept in touch with one another via the Internet. One method of communication was e-mail, employing encryption software that was so sophisticated that advanced U.S. computers required 24 hours to decrypt a message lasting seconds. Another Internet-facilitated method of communications involved chat-rooms protected by sophisticated firewall, so that if one operative was arrested, he would not leave a communication trail leading to other member of the cartel.

Black Cocaine Surfaces at Argentine Border

An Uruguayan man was done in by a heavy suitcase last May, during a routine border check in August, Argentina, near the border with Bolivia, customs inspectors,


Cellular telephones have also become standard among cocaine traffickers. Bernal's cartel elevated the cell phone to a new level of sophistication, by routing calls made on such phones through the Internet. In this way, individual traffickers could safely call in daily operating information - regarding sales, drug movements distribution schedules, etc. That information was fed into a central computer, located on a ship off the coast of Mexico. Once again, there was no lateral sharing of information and no traceable communications up the chain of command.

Cell phones are a standard accouterment for even low-level traffickers - for example, on the streets of Brasilia, the favelas of Rio, the barrios of Mexico City. Their popularity can be explained by the difficulty of tracing cellular calls, as opposed to calls made from stationary telephones. To make tracing even more difficult, many traffickers used "cloned" cell phones. In other words, they steal phone numbers from legitimate cellphone users. The stolen

numbers are used for only a short period of time and are thus discarded often before the legitimate user realizes his phone has been cloned.

Cocaine traffickers are also taking advantage of advanced chemistry to elude detection. Customs officials in Europe, in particular, have come across cocaine that has been chemically altered to change its colour, even its smell. Last year, more than 100 kilos of "black cocaine" was discovered in Albania, the Netherlands, Spain and other European countries. Smaller amounts were found in the United States. Black cocaine is yielded from a processing technique that employs charcoal and other chemicals. The end result looks like metal moldings. The substance not only looks very different from typical cocaine, the incorporation of charcoal effectively blocks the cocaine smell that sniffer dogs have been trained to detect.

Other chemical processes can change the appearance of cocaine. Customs agents in several countries have come across blue, red and yellow cocaine. In some cases, cocaine has been altered to look like transparent sheets of acetate.

Such chemical tinkering has a drawback. It is expensive to alter the cocaine in the first place. And before the drug can be used, it must be chemically altered one again. The added expense is cited as a major reason why colored cocaine is not being produced on a larger scale.

The cocaine cartels apparently prefer to put their capital into sophisticated transportation options. Superfast speedboats are the favourite method of transporting. Colombian cocaine in the Caribbean and the eastern Pacific. Because of modifications, these vessels are capable of carrying two-ton payloads at speeds of up to 126 kilometres per hour. In addition, they can often run for up to 1,600 kilometres without refuelling. Such features

render the specialized speedboats virtually uncatchable by U.S. Coast Guard cutters.

New Levels of Cooperation Against the Cocaine Trade

As cocaine traffickers cooperate with organized crime syndicates on a global level, counternarcotics authorities are intensifying their international cooperation. Last fall, the Western Hemisphere was the scene of two massive crackdowns against regional trafficking in cocaine and other drugs.

Operation Millennium was joined by law enforcement agencies from the United States, Mexico, Colombia and Ecuador. In mid-October, those agencies mounted 72 simultaneous drug busts, netting, among others, Alejandro Bernal Madrigal of Colombia's Millennium cartel and Fabio Ochoa Vasquez, formerly of the Medellin cocaine cartel, who allegedly helped integrate the remnants of that syndicate into a more efficient, multinational trafficking operation Colombia's police director, General Serrano Cadena, called Operation Millennium the most important blow delivered to Colombian cocaine traffickers since the Cali cartel was crushed in the mid-1990s. "This was an immense operation," Serrano added, "an operation you could call perfect." In Ecuador alone, the operation netted 3.5 tons of cocaine.

The 43 suspects arrested in Colombia in the course of Operation Millennium may well stand trial in the United States, where they face much longer prison terms than in Colombia. General Serrano said of the suspects, "All of them are extraditable, all of them."


Last August, the constitutional Court in Bogota cleared the last legal obstacle standing in the way of extraditing Colombian nationals. Extradition of Colombian nationals had been banned in 1991, lifted in 1997, but remained unemployed until after review by the Constitutional Court. In

November, Colombian authorities extradited Jaime Orlando Lara Nausa to the United States, where he faces drug trafficking charges. Lara is the first Colombian national to be handed over to U.S. authorities since 1990. His extradition was followed a few days later by the hand-over of Fernando Jose Flores Garmedia, a Venezuelan national who resided in Colombia. Flores will stand trial in a Miami court on charges of Laundering money and smuggling cocaine.

Extradition is considered an essential weapon in the fight against Colombian cocaine traffickers. It is so feared by the drug cartels that they mounted a terrorist bombing campaign in the late 1980s and early 1990s to intimidate the government in Bogota to rethink its policy. Another series of bombings in Colombia last autumn has been linked to drug traffickers protesting extradition. So far, however, Colombian officials are undeterred. U.S. State Department spokesman James Rubin views the extradition of Lara and Flores as the "harbinger of a greater ability for the United States and Colombia to work together in this battle."

Colombia and the United States were among the participants in another major counternarcotics campaign conducted last October; Operation Columbus. Law enforcement authorities from Panama, Suriname, Venezuela and 10 Caribbean island states also took part in the 12-day effort in the Caribbean Basin. DEA spokesman Michael Vigil called Operation Columbus "the largest anti-drug operation in history." It yielded nearly 1,300 arrests in 15 countries, 900 kilos of cocaine, 9 kilos of heroin, 1,100 tons of marijuana, 4,700 litres of hashish oil and 10 kilos of opium poppy seeds. The operation had an immediate economic impact on the region's cocaine trade: The price of a kilo shot up by US\$2,000 within days of the raids.

The members of South America'



common market, Mercosur, recently resolved to improve their cooperation against regional drug trafficking. Mercosur includes a key cocaine production country, Bolivia, as an associate member. The trading bloc also includes such key cocaine transit states as Argentina, Brazil and Paraguay.

Washington is seeking greater European commitment in the fight against cocaine smuggling. During his fall tour of Western Europe, General McCaffrey argued that it is in Europe's interest to increase aid for alternate economic development in the Andean coca belt.


Developments in the Treatment of Cocaine Addiction

Last year raised hopes for some new treatment options for cocaine

addiction. BP-897, a drug developed by the INSERM national research institute in Paris, was demonstrated as highly effective in reducing the cocaine cravings of lab rats trained to associate light stimuli with cocaine. The drug works on the same brain receptor as dopamine, a neurotransmitter that triggers pleasure and euphoria and has been associated with the drug addiction. Scientists believe dopamine alerts the brain that something pleasurable is about to happen - such as the euphoria induced by snorting cocaine. INSERM and the French pharmaceutical company Biojet, which owns the patent on BP-897, began human trials of the drug last fall.

Human trials have also begun on three possible cocaine therapies

at Columbia University in New York. Researchers there are examining the drugs' abilities to block or dilute a cocaine high. The drugs were developed for other purposes: desipramine to treat depression; reserpine to prevent psychotic episodes; and memantine, marketed in Europe to ease the symptoms of Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia. Herbert Kleber, medical director of the National Centre on Addiction and Substance Abuse at Columbia University, hopes these therapies could prove useful for "addicts whose underlying emotional and mental problems may have led them to cocaine abuse". He adds a cautionary note: "No one has been successful in developing a drug for cocaine (addiction)."

Unfortunately I have to open this IPA page by announcing a rather bad news. The founder of the International Police Association, ex police sergeant ARTHUR TROOP died peacefully at the Sue Hospice, Peterborough on Thursday 7th December at 4.50 p.m. at the age of 85 years, following a brave fight against cancer. His funeral was held the following Thursday 14th December at his local church in Lincolnshire. As expected, for this funeral a considerable number of National Sections were present. Although the local Section could not be present for the funeral the Secretary General sent our condolence to the family on behalf of the National committee and members. Arthur Troop has been sick for some time now, but when he attended the 50th Jubilee of the association held in May, during the World Congress in Bournemouth, he looked rather well. He had managed to attend for nearly all the congress sessions and functions, although not staying to the very end. For the Secretary General and myself, it was the last time we have met him. He was extremely happy when he met Her Highness Princess Margaret on the opening ceremony. In July he succeeded to celebrate his 60th wedding anniversary. I am positive sure that Arthur's absence from the PEB during the next international meeting will much felt, especially his traditional speech. During the international meeting Arthur was always approached by

PA - Emblem.



Officially the Inter. Police Ass. has two Emblems. These are the crest and the roundel, both protected by Inter. Copyright 1774. The roundel emblem consists of the world surrounded with a belt having the words IPA on top with the motto 'Servo per Amikeco' at the bottom. On the other hand the crest is more elaborated, having the roundel on a star and a wreath on both sides.

According to Article 7 of the International Rules - Protection of the emblem, it is stated that: The IPA emblem, which is protected by inter copyright may only be used within the framework of the Association and must not be utilised for commercial purposes. The National Sections may authorise their sub-sections and members to use the emblem only under the above mentioned express condition. Any change made to the emblem

jeopardises copyright protection and is therefore not permitted. Models of the two protected forms are kept by the International Secretary General.

Our Association apart from having the **PEB (Permanent Executive Board)** there are also a number of Commissions who conduct different works. One of these Commissions is the **Professional Commission**, which carries out surveys and other works concerning police work. A survey held last year among member Sections concerned police training, a summary of which I am presenting for your information.

POLICE TRAINING COMPARISON

Summary of questions:

1. What kind of education does the police applicant have to have?

There is no comparison in this question, as many Sections did not respond. The common thread seems to be that all applicants must have had secondary and high school education

2. What is the minimum age of a police applicant?

The lowest age of an applicant is 17 and the highest 21 years. In most Sections the applicant must be 18 to 19 years of age.

3. What is the maximum age of a police applicant?

The maximum age of a police applicant is between 30 to 40 years. Some Section have no age limit and others up to 55 years.





- have female applicants, other 4 Sections had women police prior to 1930: 6 Sections from 1930 to 1959: 10 Sections from 1960 to 1989 and two Sections since 1990.
- 5. Do you have a cadet system?**
Half of the Sections have a Cadet System. In some countries where there are State police some of the States have a Cadet system, whereas other States do not.
- 6. How long is the basic training of a police recruit?**
Training time differs from Section to Section, with the minimum training being 4 months. Over half the Section training lasts for 1 year or more. This depends on the type of training, ie for Middle & Higher ranks the training is for 2 or more years.
- 7. Does the applicant receive an official diploma on completion?**
In the majority of the Sections the applicants receive an official diploma. Only 6 Sections do not.
- 8. Is the Police academy/training center organised centrally or decentralised?**
18 Sections have centrally organised police academies. 5 of the Sections have both, depending on the States and in some case special centralised schools for commissioned officers.
- 9. Do male/female applicants have to complete military service?**
In 15 Sections the males must complete military service. This appears to be mainly from within Europe. Israel is the only Section where women must complete military service.
- 10. How much further education is required for promotion to higher ranks?**
- In only one Section there is no requirement for further education for promotion. Half of the Sections require university training. The third require other academic or police training.
- 11. Can you progress through the ranks to commissioned officer?**
In two Sections you cannot progress through the ranks to Commissioned Officer.
- 12. How long does it take to obtain the highest rank within your police structure?**
This varies greatly from Section to Section.







Jiena ġerta li ħafna mill-qarrejja tiegħek semghu b'dan il-każž ta' dan il-qattiel, però nixtieq li dawk li ma semghux biex, isiru jafu dwar dan il-qattiel, li l-każżeġ tiegħu għadu ma nġħala qaxx fl-arkivji tal-pulizija Inglīża. Hemm min jgħid li kien kirurgu Russu għaliex l-għemejjel li kien jagħmel, u fi fit minuti biss, bilfors li kien bniedem imdabħal sew fil-qasam tal-mediciċina. Dan il-qattiel li kien jibgħat ittri ffirmati minn idejh stess lil-pulizija għadu sal-ġurnata tal-lum ma nqabaddx.

Fil-parti l-qadima ta' Londra ta' n-naha tal-Lvant, hames prostituti ġew brutalment imqatta mill-leġġendarju Jack the Ripper, li kienet jirreferu għalib bħala l-qattiel ta' White Chappel u Fardal tal-ġilda. L-erba' delitti sekkew fi żmien ta' erba' xbur bejniethom fis-sena 1888. Dawn id-delitti saru il-bogħod minn xulxin u nvolvuw id-distrett ta' White Chappel, Spital Fields, Aldgate u l-Belt ta' Londra propja.

Certu Donald Rumbleow awtur ta' "The complete Jack the Ripper" kien għadu detective u kuratur fil-Police Crime Museum lura fis-snin sittin. Dak iż-żmien u iltaqa' ma l-evidenza kollha ta' Ripper, li kienet tikkonsisti ittri miktuba mill-pubbliku, rittratti tal-vittmi fil-mortwarju u diversi noti dwar l-inkjesta.

Qtil, sess u mewt dejjem kienet attrazzjoni qawwi ja għal ħafna nies, iżda l-qtıl tar-Ripper u l-fatt li għadu ma nstabhx min kien, iżid l-interess ta' ħafna nies.

L-ewwel qılı ta' jack Sebb fis-sighħaq bikrin ta' Awissu 31, 1888 meta hu probabilment stad u qatel lil-Polly Nichols, prostituta ta' tnejn u erbgħin sena ta' Lvant ta' Londra. Grizzejha ġew imċarri ta' sas-sinsla ta' dabra u żaqqha miftuha berah tabt il-kustiżi. Sa Novembru 9 ta' l-istess sena erbgħa

iġsma oħra ġew misjuba, l-istess ittrattati bi brutaliità makabra, u b'hekk il-qattiel ha dan il-laqam ta' "Ripper", wieħed li joftoq. Kien jaċċa l-vitma tiegħu, u waqt li bi kienet tipprepara ruħha, kien jaqbadha minn grizzejha, jifgaħħha sakemm tintilef minn sensiba jew mejta. Imbagħad kien ibaxxha lejn l-art, rasha lejn ix-xellug tiegħu, u jiftihha grizzejha berah.

Lil vittmi tiegħu kollha kien jagħmillhom hekk, u normalment kien jiebu biċċiet mill-imsaren tal-vittmi tiegħu. Dawn il-fatti ġew meħudin mill-autopsji li saru fuq l-iġsma tal-vittmi u l-pożizzjonijiet li kienet meta kienet jinstabu. Ma kien hemm l-ebda evidenza li l-qattiel kelli x'jaqsam mal-vittmi tiegħu. Hemm min jgħid li r-Ripper kelli mibegħda kbira lejn dawn il-prostituti.

Ma naħux kemm inqatlu prostituti propja, però jgħidu li x'aktarx inqatlu ħamsa. Hemm min jgħid erba' obrajna seba' u iżjed. Hafna pulizija jemmnu li qatel disa'. Il-hames vittmi li jafu bibhom huma: 1 Maryanne (Polly) Nichols, ingatlet il-Gimħa, Awissu 31 1888, 2 Annie Chapman, maqtula s-Sibt 8 ta' Settembru 1888, 3 Elizabeth Stride, maqtula s-Sibt 30 ta' Settembru 1888, 4 Catherine Eddowes, maqtula fl-istess jum, u 5 Mary Jane (Marie Janette) Kelly, maqtula l-Gimħa 9 ta' Novembru 1888.

Rumbleow jirrimarka li kien hemm ħafna suspecti li setgħu kienet r-Ripper. Fost dawn kien hemm it-teorija lura fis-sena 1970, illi t-tifel ta' iben jew bint ir-Regina Vittorja, il-Princep Albert Victor Duka ta' Clarence u Avondale kien ir-Ripper però ma għandna evidenza konkreta u r-Ripper għad irid jinqab.

Min jirnexxilu jżur in-naba ta' l-Lvant ta' Londra, malajr jinduna li l-post ma tantx inbidel min ta' dak iż-żmien, u malajr jifhem kif dan il-qattiel imsemmi seta

jattakka bhal leħha ta' berqa u jisparixxi f'sekonda mingħajr tracċċa ta' xejn. Il-“fog” u d-dawl batut tat-toroq iservi ta' vantagg ġħall-qattiel u x-xena ta' llum ġħada l-istess ħafna bhala meta kienet fl-1888.

Ftit il-bogħod hemm Spitalfields, suq ġħall-apert fejn Mary Jane Kelly kienet thuf gewwa t-toroq ma prostituti oħra jen biex ifixxu l-klienti tagħhom. Xi kultant kienet jieħdu drink got-tavena "Ten Bells" got-triq Goulston. Mary Jane, jew kif kienet jgħajtula Mary Janette għiet maqtula mir-Ripper il-Gimħa 9 ta' Jannar. Jgħidu li bawn hekk, il-Hadd 30 ta' Settembru, kiteb messaġġ bil-ġibs fuq bieb "Il-Lhud huma n-nies li m'humiex ħatja ta' xejn," fit wara li qatel it-tieni vittma tiegħu tal-ġurnata, Catherine Eddowes waqt li ha miegħtu bhala tiskira wahda mil-kliewi tagħħibba! Elizabeth Stride għiet maqtula l-istess ġurnata. Sal-ġurnata tal-llum hadd ma jaf x'ried jgħid il-qattiel b'dan il-kliem.

Fi pjazza Mitre, Rumbleow jirrakkonta l-qtıl t'Eddowes probabilment waħda mill-vittmi l-aktar imbiċċra tal-qattiel Ripper. Il-kadavru tal-vittma kien għadu shun x'bin il-pulizija sabitu u dan ifisser li mmissjaw lir-ripper bi fit sekondi. Attwalment il-pulizija kienet stazzjonaw raġel wara ġajt ta' dħabla ta' sqaq, biex jonsob il-qattiel x'bin ifegg. Dan ir-raġel għasssa ta' bil-lejji kien pulizija fi żmien. Probabilment, il-pulizija ta' wara l-hajt iddejjaq u mar jgħid kelmtejn ma l-ex kollega tiegħu Ripper qatal lill-ahħar vittma tiegħu mijja w-tnejn il-sena ilu, u qatt m'hux se joqtol iżjed. Però sal-ġurnata tal-llum dan il-misteru għadu ma solviex ruħu. Tgħid min kien dan l-individu? X'kien il-motiv tiegħu li joqtol dawn in-nisa? Dawn il-mistoqsijet insaqsibom lili nnifsi, però risposta għalhom ma nisbx. Min fejn għiet din il-mibegħda li nibtet go qalbu?


