







The Address by Dr. Tonio Borg, Minister for Home Affairs, to the 9th UN Congress on Crime Prevention and the Treatment of Offenders, in Cairo (29th April - 8th May 1995)

Mr President, distinguished delegates, ladies and gentlemen

Let me first take the opportunity to express my appreciation of my delegation for the efforts that are being made by the Government of Egypt in hosting the Ninth UN Congress on the Prevention of Crime and the Treatment of Offenders. We are especially impressed with the warm welcome we received and the efficient organisation of this meeting.

On behalf of the Government of Malta, I also wish to express my thanks and satisfaction to the United Nations Secretariat for their hard work and commitment. I am reminded by my colleagues that with each Congress their workload continues to increase both in content and substance and still they continue to cope to our complete satisfaction.

I have just been appointed Minister for Home Affairs and this is my first international commitments at official level that I am required to address in this position. I take great satisfaction in being able to do so as the choice of themes finds me completely at home having been for the last five years a member of the European Committee on the Prevention of Torture and Inhuman or Degrading Punishment or Treatment, the so called CPT Committee. I have also been for a number of years lecturer on human rights at the University of Malta and a practising lawyer in that same field. These biographical facts as well as the fact that now, as Minister for Home Affairs, I am responsible for both the prevention of crime and the treatment of offenders, gives me great satisfaction in being given the opportunity to address this August meeting.

Mr President, given the short time available to us, I would like to focus on some important topics of this Congress.

This Committee, set up within the framework of a 1987 Council of Europe Convention, is empowered to visit places of detention in any

European Country.

1. International Co-Operation

It is a satisfactory sign of the times that technological progress, especially in the area of information technology, has made it possible for greater and more rapid co-operation between member states in tackling the problems of national and international crime. On the other hand it is a sad sign of the times that international crime has become also both more complicated and at the same time more sophisticated in its methods. Crime has become unlimited both in its scopes and areas of interest, thereby transgressing both national and international barriers in reaching new levels of powers and influence. For these and other reasons, nowadays, the areas where international crime concentrates its main efforts are those where vast quantities of illegal monies circulate and change hands. Drugs is one of the classical examples. These facts give the forces of illegality great powers and the means to fight the forces of legality with the same resources and methods used by them, and possibly using even more sophisticated ones, but with less compunction. In poorer countries they sometimes become a force of greater reckoning than the state itself - the so called state within a state.

Admittedly these are alarming trends. At the same time, they call for greater international co-operation between states. The old maxim, although slightly battered with age and usage, still applies because it stands on the solid ground of truth: *united we stand, divided we fall*. In these circumstances the role of international organisations becomes even more significant.

For these reasons the United Nations, and in particular its Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice Branch, are best placed to act as focal points of these global activities leading to greater co-operation between the states in tackling the problems of international crime.

The five years since the Eighth United Nations Congress took place in Havana have highlighted



to a greater extent than ever before these various international trends. The fall of the Wall in 1989 has been hailed as the most significant event in recent history. In many of the countries affected directly by the events and as a result of the ensuing chaos in their systems of governing and administration, a void was created some of which was quickly filled by forces inimical to legality. This dangerous trend can only be combated by international co-operation. Acting simply as bystanders or indifferent spectators would not only amount to a dereliction of a duty, but would also be inimical to our own interests and that of the entire community.

Even so we can recall significant achievements. International co-operation is, perhaps, at its highest level ever. At this point may I mention concrete examples of co-operation from which Malta, as aspiring member of the European Union has benefited. During these last five years, the fruitful assistance from UNICRI continued. Only last month a Seminar on Crime and Criminal Justice in the Mediterranean area, organised by UNICRI and the University of Malta and funded by the Italian Government, was held and attended by 40 participants from neighbouring Mediterranean countries. A similar conference on Cross-Border Crime in a Euro-Mediterranean perspective with UNICRI's help was held in 1993. May I also mention the on-going assistance in various forms which Malta has received from the Governments of Italy, the United Kingdom, and the USA. Co-operation has been reciprocal, and important cases of drug-trafficking have been successfully solved. Co-operation with neighbouring Mediterranean countries has been highlighted by the time signing of bilateral agreements combating illicit drug trafficking.

The Maltese Government will continue to support all these initiatives. Malta is a small island in the middle of the Mediterranean. Both because of its smallness, but more so because of its important strategic position, it is in a most vulnerable area in the world, halfway between Europe and Africa and by tradition laying in one of the most important sea routes in the world. Thus we, as a government, and as a people, have always sought and will continue to seek international co-operation both for our own security, but more so because it is one of the more important means of attacking

the problem of crime in one's own country.

2. National Programmes

Prevention of crime should remain the highest ideal of all law-enforcing organisations. The old saying remains unchallenged: prevention is better than cure. Malta gives priority to prevention. For this purpose the Government has given all its support for the formation of Neighbourhood Watches. The experiment was so successful that it is now being copied in many other areas throughout Malta. On the part of the Police, they are organising special courses for senior officers to make them aware of the system and how to operate it in the districts under their charge.

This, I think, is one of the most significant development in the area of crime prevention in Malta in these last five years. However, the Government has concurrently with this initiative also backed up the police force with various other programmes and services to make the force a better equipped and more efficient organisation in order to be in a position to better tackle the various ramifications of the world-wide phenomena of an ever expanding and more complicated crime situation.


These new initiatives included a high recruitment drive to bring the Force to the level required in the area of human resources to cope with all its new needs; the computerisation of an information network between districts and headquarters; maintenance of international contacts and signing of a number of bilateral agreements with neighbouring states, especially those relating to the prevention and control of illegal drug trafficking and organised crime; creation of a National Drugs Intelligence Unit to act as a gathering and disseminating focal centre for the three major drug control enforcement agencies in Malta; of the Money Laundering Act Parliament which gives extra powers to the enforcement agencies in their fight against drug traffickers; finalisation of the draft bill on the Information Practices Act, which would give extra powers to the Police in monitoring suspected drug traffickers.

3. Criminal Justice Programme

A Police Academy was set up for the first time in Malta in 1988. More Police officers have received proper instruction, we now need to forward. Only recently the Ministry for Home Affairs has reached

an agreement with the University of Malta, whereby the Institute of Forensic Studies, Centre for Criminology of the University of Malta, would create various courses leading to certificate, diploma, degree and post-graduate degree in the various fields of criminal justice science. The University will also run courses leading to a certificate or diploma course in Criminal Justice to Police and Correctional Services recruits in a newly created Academy of Criminal Justice which is to replace the Police Academy. The first every corp of recruits to under go such courses from the Correctional Services Department concluded their training in February, 1995 while a group of Police recruits is still undergoing their course of training.

4. Probation Service

The overhaul of local probation service started two years ago, over thirty years after the enactment of the Probation of Offenders Act of 1957. The Institute of Forensic Studies at the University developed probation officer training courses two years ago by establishing the Diploma in Probation Services. The curriculum of this postqualification diploma is based on criminology and includes an overview of criminological theories, specialisation of various aspects of probation services, including report writing and the presentation of pre-sentencing report.

In line with these aims of Probation, as from 1994 Probation became part and parcel of the Department of Correctional Services and the first qualified Probation Officers who successfully finished their diploma course at the University were employed with that Department. Apart from Probation the Department of Correctional Services is also earmarked to include under its organisation, besides the Prisons' Service itself, also, a Therapeutic Service, an After-Care Service and a Victim Support Service.

5. Correctional Services

As stated earlier, the reform of the Correctional Services which is now in process in Malta envisages a holistic approach to the problem of criminality. The traditional role of the Prison as a place for the detention of those awaiting trial and for the punishment and segregation of offenders, has to be seen in the light of the fact that prison



is not a solution to the crime problem - it leads to isolation, depersonalisation and loss of occupational skills. The purpose of Prison should be both punitive and reformatory. The ideal to be aimed at being the rehabilitation to the prisoner so as to make him into a useful member of society.

All places of detention in Malta, particularly the Correctional Facilities are open to international inspection by the European Committee for the Prevention of Torture and Inhuman Treatment. This regional mechanism, probably unique in nature and scope, permits members of the Committee to visit places of detention without interference, interview prisoners in private. Following the visit, which usually lasts from 10 to 14 days, a confidential report is sent to the authorities of country visited, with comments, suggestions and recommendations which is the beginning of an ongoing dialogue between the CPT and the authorities concerned.

The Prison in Malta is an old institution, its structure going back to the 1850's. Its mode of management was likewise ancient and based on old custodial principles. The Prison Regulations themselves were outdated. In fact they were first published in 1931 and were still intact in 1994. The first priority of the Government was, therefore, to replace these with modern regulations upon which the new concept of the Prison reform could work. The new regulations are based on the Standard Minimum Rules for Prisoners of the Council of Europe, with some adaptations to make them applicable to the Maltese context and laws.



Hand in hand with this, an extensive area adjacent to the present prison was taken over in 1994 and a Mater Plan drawn up to encompass all the new functions of the Department of Correctional Services as envisaged in the reform and to open enough space to accommodate the anticipated future population of prisoners and provide them with the necessary services and programmes linked with rehabilitation and segregation.

All these activities are at an advanced stage and Government has voted record monies under Capital and Recurrent Expenditures to enable the prison authorities to carry out the envisaged reforms.

6. Conclusion

Mr President, I hope that with my intervention I have been able to give a brief picture of the major thrusts of the reform that is going on in Malta. I have concentrated mainly in my speech in underlining the international obligations of member states, the need for co-operation in the fight against organised crime, and our national experience in the various areas involved.

My government is committed to follow the United Nations statements of standards, norms and guiding principles in the many aspects of criminal justice. On the other hand, my Government is also aware of the difficulties in implementing these growing demands taking into consideration, besides local difficulties, also the many changing facts of criminality, especially at international level. It would not be amiss if in the circumstances we also adjust our commitments to the nature of priorities. Priorities change with circumstances and developments. Therefore, in implementing these policies the status quo would be our worst enemy. I am reminded of President Franklin Delano Roosevelt maxim in that respect, which states that change is policy, and, permit me, sir, to add my own remark to that: otherwise it is stagnation.



International Seminar on Human Rights (Malta, 16th May'95) - Mis-Supt. Dr. A. Farrugia

Between the 16th and the 19th May 1995, an International seminar on Human Rights took place in Malta at the Foundation of International Studies where over 17 representatives of foreign countries took part including Malta together with several Inter-governmental organisations like the UN, the UN Centre for Human Rights based in Geneva, the Commonwealth Secretariat, the UNHCR of Rome and also several other non-governmental organisations like the Amnesty International, and the Red Cross Society also took part.

Amongst the Maltese participants, included also members of the Malta Police Force (the editor Supt. Dr. Angelo Farrugia, Supt. A. Seychell, Supt. Joseph Rizzo, Insp. A. Casha, Insp. H. Anastasi and Insp. M. Spiteri), the Armed Forces of Malta and officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Malta followed by the introductory speech of the Minister for Home Affairs, Dr. Tonio Borg where he highlighted the importance of human rights at all levels of society including the rights of the victim in the investigation of crime. The

landmark Universal Declarations are always evolving into the furtherance of protecting other rights as are certainly the rights of the victim. Malta is a State Party to various International Conventions and Protocols including a number of Human Rights Instruments. The government of Malta continues to give the greatest importance to the involvement of public opinion and awareness to the International Bill of Human Rights.

This four day seminar served as an examination of the international mechanisms available in the promotion and protection of human rights, including the mechanisms set up to eliminate discrimination, prejudice and intolerance. The experiences of various countries and non-governmental organisations certainly contributed in no small way to the realisation of human rights and fundamental freedoms for all without

Peace Keeping Missions

The role of the UN peace keeping missions has increased in its importance enormously especially in the concept of the protection of human rights in the area of conflict. Between 1948 and the end of 1994, there were already 35 peace keeping operations in various countries throughout the world and these always include civilian police where they have to monitor the reorganisation and retraining of the national police to upkeep the high level of the human rights which is one of the main function of all peace keeping missions. Clearly the Human Rights component in a Peace Keeping mission is a very important function. The Peace keeping operation should not be looked as or felt as an army of occupation. Once the human rights are upheld in a country then the peace is not endangered.

OTHER TOPICS

An other important topic where Malta was also involved in the floor discussion (through Supt. Dr. Angelo Farrugia, the editor) was the role fo the Committee against Torture as found in the Convention against Torture of which Malta is a party to the treaty. According to article 20 of this convention, a third party including a non-governmental organisations, can file a report of an alleged torture committed in any country ONLY if the particular country to this convention did not condition the application of this article. Malta ratified this international convention without reservations and hence the procedure under this article is applicable with regards to Malta. More than 80 countries ratified this convention against Torture, and only seven to eight countries did in fact restrict the application of the procedure under article 20 of this convention. Some of the

latter countries include Israel, Morocco, Afghanistan and Ukrانيا.

Other interesting topics discussed included the role of the NGO(s) in the protection of Human Rights, the NGO(s) under non-Treaty based mechanisms, and their role under a purely political mechanism.

Conclusion of Seminar

The seminar was concluded by an important speech by the Minister of Foreign Affairs and Deputy Prim Minister Professor Guido Demarco, who emphasised the importance of enforcing the human rights rather than watching their development only in written international



The Editor Supt. Dr. Angelo Farrugia, who formed part of the official Maltese delegation at the Un congress in Cairo, during one of his interventions in COMMITTEE 2 when the subject of "Urban policy and violent" crime was being discussed. Supt. Dr. Farrugia also addressed the floor at least three times, when on one occasion he took over 25 minutes explaining to the distinguished participants, the Maltese vision on Urban Policy and Crime Prevention, which paper was also supported by the showing of 24 slides via computer disk presentation all related with the NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH concept as applied in Malta. The contribution by Dr. Farrugia was also included in three separate paragraphs of the final report of the Chairman of COMMITTEE 2 of this 9th UN Congress concerning the topic "Urban Policy and Crime Prevention".




L-Intervista

Kitba ta' A.J. Saliba

Joseph Agius twieled fit-28 ta' Diċembru, 1922 f'San Pawl il-Baħar u kien mar joqgħod il-Mosta fejn attenda l-Iskola Primarja sal-1936. Fl-1938 engaġġa mal-1st K.O.M.R. (King's Own Malta Regiment) fejn dam seba' snin u nofs. Spiċċa miil-Army bħala Corporal mal-Military Police. Għall-ħidma tiegħu fi ħdan l-armata matul il- Gwerra Joe ingħata sitt medalju fil-15 t'April, 1992, irċieva il-George Cross Medal. Huwa daħal fil-Korp tal-Pulizija f'Jannar, 1946, bin-numru 883 u wara tlett xhur 'course' fid-Depot ta' Fleur de Lys (fejn kienu mġelgħa jorqu wkoll) sab ruħu stazzjonat xahrejn Haż-Żebbuġ u wara, erba' xhur l-Msida. Wara intervista ma' l-ex-assistent Kummissarju s-Sur Alfred Lanzon ntagħzel biex jingħaqad mat-Traffic Branch.

27 sena fit-Traffic Branch

Beda biex juža muturi tal-ġħamla B.S.A. li kienu ta' l-istess tip tal-Militar. Iż-żda hu ma kellux muturi li seta' jgħid li kien tiegħu għax l-għaxar muturi li kien hemm kienu għad-dispożizzjoni tal-membri kollha ta' fuq il-muturi. Minħabba fil-ġħamla tax-xogħol tiegħu, dak li jissorvelja l-karrozza tal-linjal, u kull ma jiľta q' miegħu fit-triq, Joe ma naqasx li jitla' l-Qorti għas-seduta tat-Traffic darba jew darbejn fil-ġimġha. Dan anke waqt ġranet ta' leave għax il-Qorti ma tistenna 'i ħadd. Huwa jgħid li dejjem

żamm kalm meta kien jiġi pprovokat minn xi ħadd li kien ikun qed jirraporta. Il-facilita' li timla Traffic Office Ticket u twaħħlu mal-vettura u titlaq 'i hemm, kienet għada ma wasletx. Kellu bilfors jiffaċċċa lill-malkreants sabiex ikun jista' jirraportah billi jeħodlu l-partikularitajiet u jiegħid lu x'akkużi ser ikollu kontrih. Bajda u ma ntebbhx biha minħabba nuqqas ta' dawl. Din skopriet ruħa l-ġħada filgħodu minn skwadra tal-pulizija oħra. Is-surġent ġie bi 'crime' u ammonit fil-waqt Joe tħela' jixhed quddiem il-Kummissarju. Din kienet l-eqreb okkażżjoni li Joe miss ma' xi crime, il-bqija qatt ma kellu xejn kontrih.

Parati u Pariri

Joe Agius kien minn ta' quddiem fejn kienu jidħlu skorti ma' nies prominenti. Saħansitra Kien iż-żiġi part of a procession to mark the Queen Elizabeth II's visit to Malta in 1954 and 1964 during her reign. The text also mentions his involvement in the independence ceremony in Edinburgh.

Joe spiċċa mis-servizz fl-1974 u mar jaħdem ma' Mizzi Ltd fl-Msida bħala security officer iżda wara għażel li jmur Deliveryman. Halla l-impieg fl-1979 sabiex igawdi l-pensjoni u l-familja. The Differential Association Theory -

Minn Ps 1379 Raymond Cremona

The criminological theory of differential association is based on the concept that individual criminal actions are the results of positive evaluations of deviance acts after knowledge is procured through social instruction. A person who is subjected to more definitions in favour of crime violation than against crime infringement becomes a delinquent.

Gabriel Tarde who lived between 1843 and 1904 was one of the initial proposers who said "patterns of delinquency and crime are learned in much the same manner as any occupation, primarily through imitation of and association with others". Edwin Sutherland (1883-1950) research between 1924 and 1947 developed further this concept. Don Cressey published later editions of Sutherland's book "Principles of criminology". Cressey was one of the last of Sutherland's students and a leading proponent of Sutherland's research.

The theory was a modern attempt to construct a single explanation for individual criminal causation. The perspectives of differential association were among the first elements that brought the concepts of Sociology to Criminological studies. It was one of the principal direct attempts to explain crime causation. It has been evaluated, criticized, prided and spread throughout the world.


Sutherland argued that persons become delinquent when they define Law violation more favourable to them than conventional behaviour. He also stressed that individuals learn the definitions of crime violations through the usual means that are often used for learning traditional and conventional elements of life.

Sutherland's research was based primarily on studies of "white collar crime". He argued that normal conventional persons who encounter intensive rationalization in favour of committing norms' infringements are vulnerable to commit deviances themselves. If the sources of negative instruction is a person who is usually trustworthy to the person acquiring the definitions there is a better chance that the person acquiring the definitions become a deviant.

The Nine Basic Element of the Theory

The theory has nine basic prepositions.

1. Behaviour conventional or not is learned.
2. One learns criminal behaviour by socialization.
3. An individual's behaviour is particularly effected by close contact with relatives, friends and when among groups of such friends and relatives.
4. Instructions include the particular motive, reason and bearing, and the technical way to achieve a deviant goal.
5. Legal Statutes contribute to the formation of opinion as to the favourable or unfavourable evaluations of criminal acts.
6. People become criminals when the weight of instruction in favour of illegal acts outweighs that against infringement of Law.
7. The affinity and period being regular or otherwise, of an individual's association with the source of negative instruction effect the intensity and extent of criminal behaviour.
8. Learning illegal conduct by association with negative sources is similar to the process of learning orthodox behaviour from positive sources.
9. Although delinquent behaviour is an expression of one's requirements, it is not a compulsory effect of specific requirements, as same needs may be attained through legal practices.

Social economic environments may effect individual associations. An opportunity for a person to be close to readily available sources of negative or illegal inspirations will increase his chances to associate and learn delinquency. Therefore communities with a high rate of criminality increase the chances of any person to have social contacts with negative sources. In addition Criminal environment help an individual to regard criminal behaviour as an acceptable norm in the particular community.

"White Collar Crime" and the Differential Association Theory

This Cultural deviance theory had left a special impact on the empirical research on "White Collar Crime". In "White Collar Crime", yields are usually high. It is the element of profitability that makes this type of crime attractive to many individuals.

Individuals become familiar to methods of achieving criminal accords while in the company of persons already well accustomed to methods and who already have the drives that influence their relationship towards crime. The more intimate and close the relation is with delinquent tutors, the better is the chance for an individual to get impelled towards crime. In Corporate and business environment, stakes are high and crime may leave crucial gains that may exceed the sanctions that are ventured.

In several cases of white collar crime, the society considers such crimes as not effecting anyone individually. Though white collar crime is very much dispersed compared in ratio to other crime, very few cases are prosecuted annually. Radzinovicz (1966) pointed out that:

"For various reasons these offences are regarded by most people as venial, or at least as far less criminal than what Garafolo (1885) called the "natural crimes", the traditional offences against the person and property"

"White Collar Crime" not only creates a perfect setting for a criminal opportunity that leaves high criminal benefits but in most cases of "White Collar Crime" environments, there are readily available and willing instructors.

Evaluation and studies of the Differential Association Theory

Gottredson and Hirschi (1990), agreed that persons commit crime whenever they decide that the pleasures produced by such violation exceed the pain risked on their commission. However they explained that there is a natural desire within individuals for deviant behaviour. Consequently they concluded that individuals, must learn to restrain from committing deviant behaviour. This argument conflicts with Sutherland's nation that crime is the result of learning the non-conventional behaviour, and not the result of deficiency in the learning process of conventional behaviour.

Simons, Miller and Aigner (1980) while analyzing this theory, presented a study that shows that females and males are sensitive to criminal learning in the same manner. However since young age females tend to have less access to criminal and illegal inspirations. This results in lesser delinquent attitudes in females.

Ray Jeffrey (1990) pointed out that the theory has five principal set-backs:

- a) That the differential association theory ignores personal biology and psychology.
- b) The theory fails to overlook the role of opportunities for crime to transpire.
- c) The theory does not explain crimes of passion.
- d) The theory is impossible to explore empirically.
- e) The theory gives very vague recommendations as how to curb crime.

Jeffrey also contends that if the concept that Criminal acts are learned, is presumed to be correct, consequently who inspire the first law-breakers? Can criminologists ignore genetics? Why persons who receive very similar opportunities in National Institutions behave in different manner?

Warr (1993) while explaining a "National Youth Survey", on the effects of age groups on crime distribution and the exposure of youths to delinquent peers, concluded that "age effects an individual ability to learn and consider any inclinations learned through peer groups". According to him infants and addolcents are more vulnerable to learn negative definitions of deviant acts.

Research on the "differential association theory" helped Richard Cloward and Lloyd Ohlin (1960) in their development of the "Differential Opportunity Theory". Ronald Akers and Robert Burgess (1968), also used Sutherland's work in the development of the "Differential Reinforcement theory.
