L-Importanza tal-Prosekuzzjoni









The Malta Police -

Throughout the war years I covered all the five Police Districts in Malta, one or two at a time, for specified periods.

I was in charge of the Water Police when I saw the Ohio and the Illustrious limp into harbor - I duly contacted the valiant Captain of the Ohio on board, as instructed. With regard to the Illustrious, German planes were not long in coming over to disintegrate her completely. The merchant ship on the other side of Dockyard Creek (I think it was the Essex) was badly hit but still floating - in point of fact, a bomb had gone through the funnel, exploding inside the ship thus causing wanton slaughter amongst the crew and stevedores. I had never seen such kind of devastation but my greatest consternation was the moment I skidded, clearly enough, on a primary part of a human skin.

On another occasion, there were four of us in a Police motor-boat on our way from Marsa to the Custom House when we savoured an unexpected attack on the harbor, with bombs no that far away. However, we were soon left alone by the Italian pilot when, Circa miseria", he heard the sharp crack of my (unprintable) blast in Italian; or else, by the German what- not who, in that case, must have known Italian quite fluently.

It was a late hour at night when, during one of the attacks by German planes, I saw from near the Custom House what I reckoned to be a German pilot parachuting down over Senglea. I caused the relative message to be sent to Headquarters but then, soon after, all hell was let loose over Senglea: that was no German pilot but a mine presumably meant for the Grand Harbour. It's strong blast reached us loud and clear right across the harbour.

On another night, the Electricity Power Station not far from the Custom House was hit, and a vital bakery at the Marsa was set on fire I jumped into my car and drove straight to Marsa. The fire engine was soon on the spot, and water was poured all over the roof and the ventilators, as well as, unwittingly, at a concealed 15,000 volt transformer at the back of the bakery. Afterwards I wondered why none of us did not receive the tiniest of shocks: the sparks that kept on shooting out made us aware of the danger. But then, the surprising sequence that followed made me wonder all the more. Later, on my way back, I found out that earlier, on my way to the Marsa, I had driven my car under a very high voltage line wire across the road next to the Power Station, and that I had somehow missed it by two inches.

At one time I went to Sliema to see my family whom

I had not seen for about a month and on hearing a drove of German planes on their way inland, I rushed out into the street without even bothering to cover my bald head. I then heard a bomb or shell coming down and could not bring

myself to run for cover. I got stuck in the centre of the road. For all that, it was no bomb at all: it was merely an ack-ack cap. The funny, strange and coincidental part of it all was the astonishing way it chose to give me such a light kiss on the very tip of my nose' No' my crooked Roman nose is by way of inheritance'


Another incident concerned a heavy explosion at the mouth of the Grand Harbour and so, as the Officer in charge, I got into my police motor boat and, soon after, was on my way to investigate the matter when suddenly, the motor boat engine came to a halt and we started to drift towards the shore. Indeed, quite a blessing in disguise' The Italian MT boats were trying to enter the harbour, and my brother in the RMA who was in charge of the guns at that spot had just received orders to shoot at anything moving in those waters.

Seeing the merchant vessel S.S. Talabot in 1942, fully laden (and with a dangerous cargo) ablaze in the Grand Harbour was really heartbreaking. Steps were taken to prevent it from exploding and from causing sweeping destruction all round.

Before I move on to experiences in other Districts I wish to add a "P.S." Which, of all things, concerns Fate, that entity which could well have been more affable than to have me posted to the Water Police. She must have known only too well that although I always loved the sea, the sea never loved me. For all that, the cruel el sea displayed on a screen, in a cinema or T.V., always succeeded in reminding me that I should know better than to feel sea sick.

When the Opera House in Valletta was bombed and blown up by German planes, it so happened that I had just entered Kingsway: I just managed to survive that hair-loosing experience.

Despite all, it was a pitiful instant when I saw an Italian pilot at some height over Valletta drifting in the air towards Grand Harbour, with a parachute that evidently refused to open. His prayer to the Virgin Mary to help

him was loud and clear. He finally crashed in a private garden in Cospicua.

When in charge of the central part of the island, I observed a huge "bomb" some six feet high hurling down and, strangely enough, somersaulting on it's way - it landed in a field and there was no explosion I found out that it was made or tin and that it had been packed with incendiary bombs which, in effect, caused no damage at all.

Over at Hamrun, a bomb released from an enemy plane was seen horizontal at some height on it's way across Marsamxett Harbour towards Valletta. It actual exploded not far from the Opera House site, at the entrance to an air-raid shelter killing a number of people.

On one particular night quite a number of huge delayed action bombs were dropped all over the island: one of my Inspectors accompanied me to try and locate as many as we could in my area: in one of the houses in High Street, Hamnun, one of the bombs had gone through the roof and ceiling and ended up close to an old woman in bed. The fallen masonry had killed her. She was carried out and soon after, the bomb exploded and demolished the whole building. Further down the same street another bomb had gone through the roof of another house, into the front room and, luckily enough, down into an old well. We were in line with the house when the bomb exploded and it so happened I ran towards that particular house for cover. Luckily because of the position of the bomb, the house was not completely wrecked; yet, large building stones toppled down from the side of the roof, the front door shot out by my side and two young women who were inside crashed straight into me. We did not suffer any serious damage, however tiny pieces of metal or shrapnel did manage to penetrate our uniforms.

On another occasion the central part of the island, particularly the old capital Mdina, was inundated with Butterfly Bombs which, small simple and so dangerous to the touch (unless geared to explode overhead) caused quite a number of casual ties.

The Bomb Disposal Officer and I visited a garden dotted with a good number of them. Somehow, I did happen to touch and move one of them in a passage way and... not thanks to Mr. Hitler... it failed to explode' I may add that the B.D.O. had something to say about that, yet that was the very Butterfly Bomb' that was dismantled and had its details despatched to London.

I cannot very well recollect when I happened to meet two South African deep-sea divers who were recovering mines from a stricken ship in Marsaxlokk Harbour. They said they had come across two colossal octopuses near the ship and so refused to go under water at that spot again. In 1943 and 44 I was appointed five times as Acting Director of Prisons. Then my greatest worry centered on the bomb damage caused to the Prisons themselves, especially to the main deeps. Because of the abnormal times and the consequent very stringent laws, the number of inmates had increased threefold and one can well imagine the effect air raid alarms had on some 300 persons locked up in cells. Amongst them I had two brothers awaiting the rope penalty" but they were resigned to their fate and not even air raid sirens affected them in handed in Malta take permanent charge of the said Civil Prisons.

One of my disturbing apprehensions whilst in charge of the Prisons concerned the fact that, as matters stood, I could not avail myself of the Director's quarters. Thus, every day, at a late hour, I had to walk all the way (of course in complete darkness) from the Prisons in Pawla to Vittoriosa Police Station for the night; but the knotty point centred on the number of rats that moved inland from the shore to the lower part of Cospicua which I had to cross. My solution was to make a run for it and to disperse the rodents that happened to be in my way.

Whilst at the Prisons, I had an official visit by the Governor, Lord Gort, who as a perfect Officer and Gentleman, fully appreciated my observation with regard to awaiting trial prisoners (of whatever nationality) who could well incriminate themselves in making any kind of statements by way of a reply.

When I relinquished the post of Acting Director of Prisons and returned to the Police, Mr. D.C. Campbell, the Lieutenant Governor, very kindly expressed his pleasure in transmitting to me his tribute to my work and the Government's appreciation of the services rendered during a particularly difficult period".


The stage was reached when food shortage in the island was the greatest problem of all. And here the Santa Maria Convoy must be mentioned. We were only ten days off the complete breaking point, apart from the possible or expected Italian invasion in the south-east of the island. The codeword Kangaroo would have conveyed the final order to destroy all relevant documents and even, for all that, to shoot, where necessary members of the public.

One cannot but admire and bestow the greatest praise upon the wonderful personnel of the three services who, together with those dear souls who lost their lives, showed such laudable courage and noble devotion to duty.

I salute you and convey to you all a hearty Maltese word of farewell: SAHHA.



Forsi I-aktar risposta valida I-għala aħna il-pulizija għandna nagħtu I-aħjar servizz lill-pubbliku, hi peress li huma I-istess cittadini li jħallsu permezz tat-taxxi għall-pagi, il-manteniment u titjieb fil-kundizzjonijiet għall-membri tal-korp tal-pulizija.

II-pubbliku huwa I-konsumatur ewlieni tasservizz li jagħtu I-pulizija. X'inhu r-rwol prinċipali tal-pulizija? Id-doveri tal-pulizija jinkludu li jżommu I-paċi u I-bon ordni pubblika. Caring for your computer - Ps 1180 P. Caruana

Your personal computer (PC) like any other machine requires some form of preventative maintenance. We hear lots of arguments stating that PC's can work in any environment, which is true, however by controlling the environment in which our PC and relative equipment is placed we can reduce the occurrence of common faults.

Apart from the expected wear and tear the most common six factors which you must be on the lookout for are: 1) The user 2) Heat 3) dust and Ash 4) Power 5) Corrosion and 6) Magnetism.


- 1) The most common cause of computer problems is the user. Problems such as disconnected cables, Incorrect software configurations and other trivial problems are related to the lack of knowledge on the users part. Unfortunately most users fail to read any type of user manual. It is not enough to simply plug in your PC and start wording, each user most learn as much as possible about his machine. With the necessary knowledge trivial problems which are user related will be reduced drastically
- 2) Excessive heating and cooling are both damage to your PC'. A general node is that if the environment is correct for the user then it is correct for your PC. The manufacturers of PC 's have recognised the fact the each machine generates a level of heat and to combat this problem ail vents and tans have been included ill the machine's architecture. however er with the introduction of additional cards the heat level has increased. Such heat may be the cause of errors to internal devices such as your hard disk. To prevent this problem always ensure that the air vents are never obstructed. Should it be necessary, install an additional fan to cater for the extra heat generated.
- 3) The exposure to household and office dust is inevitable. Once dust settles it insulates the circuit devices of your PC and prevents heat being dissipated. The best defence against dust is to cover your PC with a dust cover, especially when any works are in progress m the vicinity. Floppy disks should also never be brought into contact with dust. Dust can actually corrupt your data. another step should be to vacuum the interior of your PC occasionally. Cigarette smoke is a menace to your computer. Not only do the ash particles settle on your circuitry but may also cause data corruption on making contact with the surface of a floppy disk. Damage to sensitive parts of the disk head may also occur.
- 4) It is very important to maintain a constant Clean' power supply to the computer. The smallest fluctuation in the power line to a computer can cause the system to fail, possible disastrous results. The are three major power problems a) brownouts less voltage is available to drive the computer than required. b) blackouts a complete loss of voltage in the power-line and c) transients spikes of excessive voltage sent down power lines without any notice. There are two methods to safeguard against power-problems a) spike

catchers or guards and b) Uninterruptable power supply units. The spike catcher is the simplest of the two devices and only servers to prevent transients and spikes from reaching the equipment. The cost of the spike catcher is trivial when compared to the equipment to be guarded. An uninterruptable power supply alit (UPS) is effectively a large battery which is automatically switched into the power circuit if the main supply fails. The battery is charged whilst the main supply is operating correctly. A UPS normally also includes some form of spike catcher and filtering circuitry to minimise noise. A UPS costs considerably more than a simple spike-catcher. However it does offer a greater degree of protection where it is essential that no information is lost. When choosing a device one must keep in mind the importance of the information being protected.

- 5) The metal connector pins on interface cards, microchip pins and cables can become corroded. This is a chemical change in which the metal of the pins and sockets is gradually eaten away. Corrosion can be very damaging. Liquids its any form spilt onto a PC tan have a drastic effect on a computer system under certain circumstance. But may have little or no damage if treated correctly if a drink is spilt into a PC or any related device, the most important thing is to immediately shutdown the system or switch off the power supply. Do not attempt to fix the situation personally, refer the equipment to a qualified technician for analysis and repair. If something is spilt into a disconnected computer system it is more than likely that no damage has occurred. The importance is to remove the liquid from the equipment followed by a thorough clean-up using a cleaning solvent. Ensure the PC is completely dry before switching on - leave the PC switched off for at least two days.
- 6) Information is stored on various types of magnetic media e.g. floppy disks, tapes etc. The information stored within these devices is prone to be corrupted and destroyed on being exposed to a magnetic field. Such magnetic fields are created by high voltages or currents, such as those found in monitors and audio speakers. Thus do not keep your storage device near equipment such as your printer, photocopier and monitors. Data passing through cables has also known to be effected when passing through magnetic fields.



Language as a Weapon -

In an episode of the ABC network presentation, 'The Commish' (a series about a police commissioner in a major American city), the protagonist had returned to patrol duty and was "working the street" in an effort to prove a point. He responded to a domestic disturbance call and was confronted by a large white male who was highly excited and threatening to become combative. The female, who was apparently the victim, had retreated to a bathroom and was crying.

The protagonist approached the situation by talking to the male, attempting to calm him and gain his cooperation. Through his words and the tone of his voice, he was succeeding in de-escalating the situation, when suddenly another officer - his backup - arrived and immediately began verbally assaulting the male, ordering him to physically surrender to being handcuffed.

The male suspect became furious, and a fight ensued. Ultimately, five police officers were required to subdue the suspect, and some of the officers were injured in the altercation.

The scrip presented an excellent example of how language can quickly escalate or de-escalate a situation.

Though this was "only a telvision program," similar situations occur too frequently in real life - with unfortunate consequences. Situations frequently arise in which a few words can trigger unnecessary escalation, which in turn can destroy the progress of a simple arrest situation.

There are indeed instances in which the suspect has nothing to lose and simply chooses to fight, believing that he can either get in a good punch, break free and flee, or cause the officer to do something that can later cause the case to be thrown out of court.

Most of the time, however, an officer can defuse what might become an explosive situation through the use of language. Unfortunately, though street officers are trained in the use of force with firearms, PR-24, chemicals, tasers and other weapons, training in the use of language is often overlooked.

Officers should recieve basic - as well as in-service - training concerning every tool at their disposal. Instruction in escalation/de-escaltation through the use of language and communication skills should be a part of that training.

Language thus becomes another tool, another weapon, just as effective as any of the others. But it is a

weapon each officer should feel comfortable using prior to resorting to the weapons on his belt. Escalation traditionally moves from the use of chemicals, through the PR-24 or taser and, finally, to the ultimate weapon - deadly force. The proper use of language provides another step in the sequence - on the nonviolent end.

Just as the use of traditional weapons require extensive academy training, as well as constant inservice training to maintain an edge, so should the use of verbal skills. In his book, Verbal Judo, George Thompson uses the phrase "consciously competent" to describe the state of combined training, skill and perceptiveness that allows an officer will be able to recount the steps taken - and why they were taken - if this becomes necessary in the courtroom. This consciously competent mode requires a determined thought process, not just a reliance on rote training and instinct.

All officers must understand that effective communications can be judged from different perspectives. They must constantly be aware of how language is perceived, what verbal personality is expressed and what the goal of the verbal interaction is. Is it to defuse the situation? Provoke the situation to elicit an arrest? Accomplish something else entirely?

Additionally, officers must know the environment in which they are working. Today, when officers are rotated frequently, that environment can change between calls. Knowing the environment - and the audience that lives in that environment - can allow the officer who is confident of his communications abilities the opprotunity to make an appeal to the beliefs, deal with the prejudices and assess the insecurities of that audience.

Training should include role-playing exercises of realistic encounters such as domestic disturbances, conflict resolution and street disturbances. This training should be carried into the field by the field training officer (FTO), who can then facilitate the transition from the training environment into the day-to-day world of the police officer.

Evaluation criteria should include such items as statistical information regarding any reduction of incidents of use of lethal and less-than-lethal force, complaints against officers and anecdotal information (as long as it is represented as such).

Typically, officers arrive after an incident has escalated to an explosive point. Obviously, then, they will be much safer when they use their minds and speech in harmony. Such a presence enhances professionalism and commands respect.



International Co-operation on Drugs The United Nations Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs

This is designed to limit the cultivation, production, trade, import, export, distribution and use of opium and derivatives, synthetic drugs whose effect is the same as opiates, cocaine and cannabis.

The United Nations Convention on Psychotropic Substances

This covers control over certain synthetic drugs which act on the central nervous system.

The Vienna Convention

This convention calls for states to implement legislation for international co-operation between signatories in drug-trafficking matters to: eliminate conflicts of jurisdiction, freeze or seize proceeds of drug trafficking, ease extradition, allow mutual legal assistance, allow controlled deliveries, control traffic on the high seas, monitor procursor chemicals.

Signatories to these conventions are obliged to control very closely the manufacture, distribution and availability of these drugs. This applies both for the home market and for export.

The Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC)

This body is responsible for shaping UN policy in drug misuse matters.

The United Nations Commission on Narcotic Drugs (CND)

This body advises the Council on drugs matters. It is consulted by other UN bodies on drugs matters, including strategies and policies.

The United Nations Drug Control Programme (UNDCP)

This body advises governments on application of international drug control treaties. It also produces detailed information on drug patterns.

The United Nations Interregional Crime and Justice Research Institute (UNICR)

UNICR researches the connection between crime and drug misuse and how individual countries deal with it.

The International Criminal Police Organisation (INTERPOL)

INTERPOL is involved in a wide range of matters of police interest incriminal activity. On the drugs side it provides information about illegal movements of drugs and money internationally. It also co-ordinates extradition warrants.

Customs Co-operations Council (CCC)

There are currently (1992) 112 countries in the CCC and it includes all the major Customs authorities. The CCC operates to standardise customs procedures and legislation through international agreements, working in co-operation with the UN. It also has a significant part to play in Customs enforcement through its own enforcement committee by an exchange of information, particularly in the anti-drug field.

The Pompidou Group

Established by the Council of Europe, the Pompidou Group has a membership of 25 states. The group looks at addiction in Europe and aims to work at reducing demand and maintaining contact points for drug trafficking control at

Europe's international airports. It seeks to widen Customs co-operation throughout Europe. With the opening up of Eastern Europe the Group has been at the forefront in co-ordinating control efforts in the wider trading area, with the easier travel and transport facilities now available.

The Dublin Group

This is a group of aid doner/drug consumer countries. It comprises 18 members; namely the Individual EC countries, the EC as a body, the USA, Canada, Australia, Japan and Sweden.

European Committee to Combat Drugs (CELAD)

This organisation exists to co-ordinate all EC anti-drugs work. It meets six times a year. It established the European Plan which is the basis for anti-drugs work throughout the EC; a European Drugs Intelligence Unit for exchanging information between the 12 EC states; and a European Drugs Monitoring Centre for researching drugs statistics.

The Trevi Group

This group exists to promote greater harmony between the members of the EC on a range of issues. Particularly of interest here is that element dealing with issues of drug trafficking and major crime.

Bilateral Groups

There exist numerous organisations and agreements between pairs or small groups of countries, both for exchange of information and for active enforcement measures. A list of these would be long and too specific an interest. Furthermore, since such arrangements vary and increase with time the list would never be up to date. Therefore, no attempt has been made at a listing.

Warning

Drugs of misuse are, by their nature, poisons and as such as hazardous substances. When examining suspect substances do not touch, taste or smell them.

The chemicals used in drugs test kits are also hazardous. Amongst the contents can be acids or carcinogenic substances. Use gloves whenever possible when carrying out tests and follow the drug kit manufaturer's advice.

Controlled drugs are frequently packed or concealed in such a way as to render their retrieval difficult and dangerous both in terms of immediate injury or long term health risk to the officer. Protect your skin and clothing.


Drugs paraphernalia can also be dangerous in the same way as the packaging of drugs, eg. blades and hypodermic needles. When handling these things place a barrier between your skin and the suspect item, eg. use tweezers or a sheet of plastic.

Drugs couriers are not always the nicest, cleanest of people and can have any one of a coctail of various anti-social habits and diseases. They represent a health hazard in themselves. Bear in mind the fact that a person does not have to look ill to be riddled with the most unpleasant diseases and in fact appearances can be enhanced to look normal. Do not take chances with drugs couriers and dealers.

It is essential when dealing with any of these things that you take all necessary precautions and use any protective equipment or clothing available.

For your own sake.





Money Laundering - by PS 1229 J. Petroni

Money Laundering is a multimillion industry (in any currency). Clearly the enormous amounts of profits to be made from drug dealing have to be concealed from the authorities. If they are not conceiled then they can easily be seized or, if the national legislation does not allow seizure, they can still be an indicator to drugs activity.

The money laudering process is described in three separate phases:

Placement. This is the insertion of money from an illicit source into an apparently legitimate location.

Layering. This is the means by which a series of movements or transactions are used to mask the origins of the money.

Integration. This term covers the movement back into commercial activity of the funds previously laundered and is therefore the last element of the process.

Placement

Recognising that large volumes of cash can draw the immediate attention of law enforcement officers, criminals often physically remove the bulk cash from the place it was acquired. Criminal organisations are most likely to gather the proceeds in areas where the cash can be more easily disguised or misrepresented, and less easily recognised for what it is, or where it comes from.

The initial step in money laundering is therefore twofold: to move the cash from where it was obtaine, and then to place it into circulation through banks, shops, businesses, or abroad.

The physical smuggling of currency and monetary instruments out of the country. The various methods of transport (i.e. international air express companies, commercial air passengers, private aircraft, cargo shipments and vehicles bound for neighbouring countries) do not leave a discernible audit trail.

Dealings in precious metals, stones and artwork are generally considered to be cash oriented,

where cash is exchanged for precious metals, stones and artwork ect. These latter can of course act as a medium of exchange in themselves, and can often be more easily transported.

Where is the best place to hide a tree? In a forest, of course! Where is the best place to hide cash? With lots more cash, of course!

The purchase of hard assets (cars, boats, planes, stocks, luxury items or real estate) with cash is a significant money laundering method. The purpose of large scale puchases is three-fold:

- a) to support a luxurious lifestyle;
- b) to change the form of the proceeds from conspicuous bulk cash to some equally valubable but less conspicuous form, and
- c) to obtain major assets which will be used to further the criminal enterprise.

Layering

If the bulk cash has not been detected during placement, the lauderers' activities become increasingly more difficult to uncover. The confusing and complicated ways in which layer after layer activities of transactions are piled on top of one another are intended to make the traceability of the illegal (and seizable) proceeds extremely difficult for law enforcement.

Integration

Once the layering process has been accomplished, the launderer needs to provide a legitimate-seeming explanation for the wealth. Integration schemes place the laundered proceeds back into the economy in such a way that it reenters the banking system appearing as normal business earnings.

TAKING CARE OF YOUR HANDS AND FEET Part I - WPS 21 J. Scerri

" of all beauty routines, the care of hands and feet pays the greatest dividends in terms of comfort and appearance".

The skin on the back of the hands is fine and soft with both sebaceous and sweat-gland openings, while the skin on the palm is coarser and tougher and one of the driest parts of the body because, unlike other areas, it has no sebaceous glands. It does however have numerous sweat-glands which are often triggered off by nervous or emotional reaction hence this results in clammy or sweaty palms and the same is true for the soles of the feet.

Hand and wrist have great mobility from twentyeight (28) beautifully balanced bones. There are twenty-six (26) bones in each foot; their strength

combined with a mass of ligaments and muscles that in turn resist the body's weight and make the human vertical position possible. The big toe is vital to this strength and balance as is the ball of the foot and the arch which absorbs most of the weight.

NAIL BIOLOGY

Nails grow up from the epidermis and are made up of the state of the s

epidermis and are made up of Karatin (a protein also found in hair). Finger nails grow from the nail bed at a rate of 1 millimetre per week, appronmitly 1 and a half inches a year. It takes about 6 months for a nail to grow. Toe nails grow only half this amount, and thumbernails grow faster than the nails on the fingers. The shape and quality of our nails is an inherited tendency.

However it is also associated with the kind of food we eat and the kind of care applied, if at


all! Since the nail plate is only made of protein substance and has no nerves nor blood vessels, we can cut or shape our nails as desired.

The Nail Bed rests under the nail plate and this is the part containing the living material. At the base of the nail bed lies the Nail Matrix containing nerves, blood lunula, vessels and glands. It is very important to have a healthy matrix for proper nail cuticle growth. A weak matrix produces problem nails. The Lunula is found at the base of matrix the nail. This is the white area in the shape of the half-moon. Around the nail is a thin overlapping skin-epidermis which is called

the Cuticle fry edge nail plate nail bed bone.


A hand can show age more quickly than any other area? So beautiful hands are an asset since they are on show most of the time-so maintenance through care is essential. This does not apply for only women but also for men! A work calloused hand, ingrained with dirt, flaking nails and wrinkled, clearly advertises

its own Qr's carelessness. Hands that are frequently immersed in water and exposed to detergents and shampoos will dry out first. It is IMPORTANT to wear rubber gloves whenever possible (even better to have them a size larger than your usual glove size and that have a cotton lining) If hands are dirty or stained, they should be never brushed, but rubbed with a piece of



soft rag and soap and for a more thorough treatment, rubbed with brown sugar and warm

olive oil. Always dry
wet hands
thoroughly and use
a hand cream
afterwards. For
avoiding chilblains
and chapped skin
wear gloves (wool
or leather)
extending well over
the wrists in cold



seasons. Exercise hands by straightening them forcibly; aft to flow the stagnant blood in the vessels especially when cold. Be gentle when acme you have to use your hands to do something, nails are easily broken or damaged in the nail bed when knocked. Remember NEVER use your nails as tools! Healthy, strong nails need plenty of vitamins A and D plus

calcium and zinc to protect them from everyday wear and tear. If you suffer from weak nails you

may be lacking in essential fatty acids and should try a course of cod liver oil or almond oil capsules. With a little effort your hands can became one of your best assets. So do spend some time on your nails (however never sit on themes)

Professional treatments are always best, however you can learn to be very professional yourself by at least maintaining your finger and toenails between visits to the manicurist or beautician. A weekly manicure at home is required to keep your hands and nails in top shape and once a fortnight is enough for a pedicure.

STEP-BY-STEP MANICURE

- 1. File sides of the nails very gently. The ideal shape is a rounded one with straight sides. (Keeping sides straight helps nails resist splitting and cracking)
- 2. Massage cuticle cream into nail bed and fingers and soak nails in warm soapy water for a few minutes.
- 3. Carefully push back cuticles with a rubber-end hoof stick, cuticle pusher or manicure stick with the tip wrapped in cotton wool.
- 4. Apply base coat. This makes a smooth base and has the added advantage of protecting nails.
- 5. Now apply on nail polish is desired. Brush on polish in three strokes down the centre of the nail, then down each side. Apply two coats. (Allow five minutes drying time between coats)
- 6. Apply a top coat to each nail, up to and under the tip. Use cotton buds soaked in remover to wipe smears of polish from fingers.




