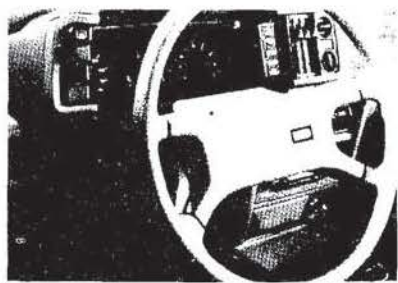
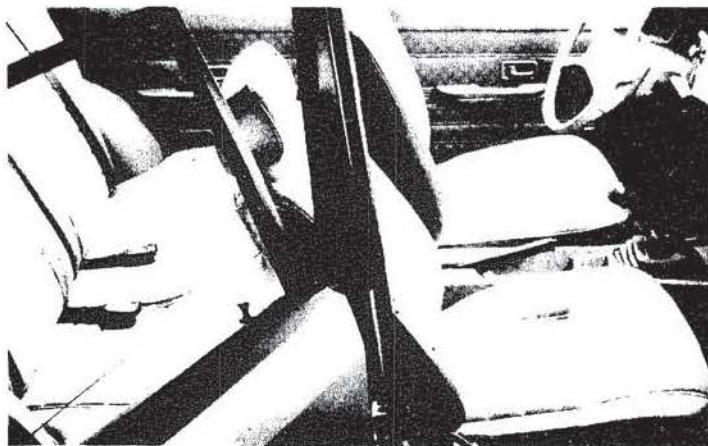
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Wirja ta' Hobbies organizzata mill-Assoċjazzjoni tal-Pulizija u mill-Għaqda tal-Pensjonanti

Tweġiba: Ngħidlek il-verità, jiena kollizzjonista filatelika u ili żmien nipparteċipa f'wirjiet organizzati mill-Posta ta' Malta, d-differenza hija li dawn il-wirjiet filateliċi jkunu kompetittivi u mhux l-ewwel darba li rbaht xi premju.

Minn dawn il-kompetizzjonijiet twieldet f'moħhi l-ideja li għandha ssir wirja ta' hobbies iżda mhux kompetittiva, sempliċiment wiehed jesponi l-materjal tad-delizzju tiegħu lill-pubbliku.

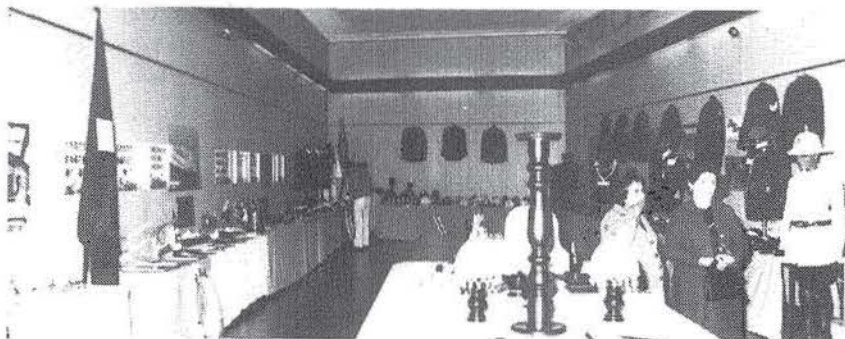

Bejn it-28 ta' Frar, 1986 u d-9 ta' Marzu, 1986 inżammet wirja ta' 'Hobbies' mill-Assoċjazzjoni tal-Pulizija flimkien mal-Għaqda tal-Pulizija Penzjonanti bil-partecipazzjoni ta' membri miz-żewġ għaqdiet. Il-wirja nżammet komodatament fis-sala tal-loghob tal-Police Social Club.

Originarjament, il-wirja kellha tinzamm miftuħa għal tlitt ijiem iżda fuq talba ta' bosta kif ukoll għall-fatt illi kien misthoqq li titwal b'gimgha oħra – grazzi għad-dedikazzjoni tal-esibituri u l-facilitajiet li jingħataw – minnufih ingħatatilna l-awtorità meħtieġa biex tibqa' miftuħa. L-esibituri, li kienu hdax minn fost il-membri tal-korp, fosthom mara u erba' pensjonanti, organizzaw flimkien din il-wirja taħt il-patroċinju tal-Kummissarju tal-Pulizija.

L-Official Side tal-Pulizija apprezzat ix-xogħol kollu li sar u awtorizzat il-facilitajiet kollha li kienu meħtieġa. B'dawn il-kelmejn nixtiequ nringrazzja lill-Kummissarju tal-Pulizija, lid-Deputat Kummissarju u lill-esibituri kollha, kif ukoll lill-isponsors li kellna.

Fost l-ilmenti li l-Assoċjazzjoni tirċievi minghand il-membri tagħha, tirċievi dawk tal-membri 'seconded' fid-dipartiment tal-habs. Dawn l-ilmenti l-Assoċjazzjoni dejjem ressqithom lill-awtoritajiet. Fost oħrajn dawn jirrigwardjaw 'leave', it-time in lieu, il-hinijiet tax-xogħol u tal-break.

Huwa ta' sodisfazzjon għalina li nkunu nafu li l-Gvern innomina lil Imħallef M. Caruana Curran biex jirrakkomanda titjeb fir-regolamenti li jikkoncernaw il-habs u l-impjegati. B'hekk wiehed jistenna li l-affarijiet jitjebu għal kull settur fil-habs.

Ir-reklutaġġ fil-Korp

Matul ix-xahar ta' Marzu 1986 ġew ingaġġati diversi rekluti li ahna bi pjaċir nilqgħu biex naħdmu flimkien. Lir-rekluti l-godda nawgurawhom suċċess fil-karriera tagħhom bhala Pulizija. Huma għandhom iżommu quddiem għajnejhom il-hin kollu li s-suċċess tagħhom jiddependi minnhom infushom billi jfittxu kif jitgħallmu aktar kif jaqdu ahjar id-doveri tagħhom u jkunu leali lejn il-gurament li ngħatalhom. Hawnhekk ta' min isemmi wkoll li r-rekluti qed jingħataw kors bażiku qasir, wara jaħdmu xogħol regolari biex jieħdu l-esperjenza, imbagħad jerggħu jingabru għal kors 'ad hoc' qabel l-eżami aħhari. Din is-sistema tiżgura li kull rekluta jkun ingħata opportunità ta' esperjenza tax-xogħol li żgur isservih ta' gid għall-futur kif ukoll għal matul il-kors. Din is-sistema taqbel magħha l-Assoċjazzjoni mija fil-mija kif esprimiet ruhha f'rapport li kienet hejjiet u għad-diet lill-Awtoritajiet tal-Pulizija dwar ir-reklutaġġ wara li giet mistiedna li tagħmel dan.

Bħalissa jinsabu għaddejnin diversi lezzjonijiet li qed jingħataw lil membri tal-Korp li għadew mill-eżamijiet ta' promozzjoni għal Surgent jew Spettur. Lil dawn kollha nixtiequqhom

kull suċċess aħhari filwaqt li nin-koragġixxu l-oħrajn kollha biex iżommu ruhhom agġornati fil-materji tal-eżamijiet biex ikunu għal-lest f'sejhiet oħra għall-eżami.

Ir-ri introduzzjoni tal-'Extra Duty'

Wiehed mill-punti li dwarhom qed nitolbu laqgħa mal-Prim Ministru huwa proprju l-'Extra Duty'.

Minn nhar it-15 ta' Marzu, 1986 reggħet bdiet tinhadem l-'Extra Duty' minkejja li għadu jseħh il-'ban' mill-Gvern fuq l-'overtime'. Mill-bidunett meta giet sospiza l-'Extra Duty', madwar tlitt snin ilu u qabel, l-Assoċjazzjoni dejjem tennet li l-'overtime' huwa distint mill-'Extra Duty' fid-dipartiment tal-Pulizija. Ix-xebh ma' l-'overtime' huwa l-'Compulsory Extra Duty'. Prinċipalment, ir-raġuni għal dan hija li l-'Extra Duty' iħallas għaliha t-terza persuna u mhux il-Gvern li qed jimpegga.

Din ir-ri introduzzjoni sehhet wara l-intervent tal-Kummissarju fuq talbiet tal-Assoċjazzjoni. Ta' dan, l-Assoċjazzjoni rringrazzjat lill-Kummissarju b'permezz ta' ittra mibghuta fis-17 ta' Marzu 1986 u li fiha giet imtennija t-talba għall-ħlas dovut tal-'Extra Duty' maħduma qabel giet sospiza li tinkludi dik l-hekk imsejjha tal-'Identity Cards'.

Fid-19 ta' Marzu 1986, il-Kummissarju nforma lis-Segretarju tal-Assoċjazzjoni, li kien irċieva l-ittra tas-17 ta' Marzu kif ukoll li l-kwistjoni ta' l-'Extra Duty' li kienet inħadmet qed tkompli tiġi diskussa ma' l-Awtoritajiet konċernati. (Dawn iż-żewġ ittri qed jidhru wkoll f'din il-harga.)

Iċ-ċirkularijiet li jirregolaw l-'Extra Duty' (G.H.Q. Cir. 29/80; 47/80; 55/80; 83/80; 36/81; u 37/81) għadhom jgħoddu. Fost oħrajn, dawn iċ-ċirkularijiet isemmu l-ħlas u s-sieghat li wiehed jista' jaħdem (75 siegha – Cir. 83/80). Dawn iċ-ċirkularijiet ġew miġbura f'ċirkulari waħda li għandha tiġi ppublikata fi żmien qasir.

Mill-Assoċjazzjoni tal-Pulizija



Tajjeb li wiehed ifakkar li għall-finijiet tal-Ordinanza u allura tal-liġi, l-‘Extra Duty’ hija meqjusa xogħol u għal daqstant l-ordnijiet u r-regolamenti kollha dwar ix-xogħol tal-Pulizija jghoddu wkoll għall-‘Extra Duty’.

Mil-laqgħat tal-Assoċjazzjoni

Mill-ahhar hargha tal-Magazin, l-Assoċjazzjoni zammet diversi laqgħat li x-xogħol u l-iskopijiet tagħhom kienu jinkludu kif geġ. Kif semmejna fil-harga ta’ Jan-nar/Frar, għad hemm diversi punti li dwarhom l-Assoċjazzjoni kitbet lill-Awtoritajiet u għadhom pendenti, jigifieri mingħajr risposta. Dawn jinkludu, il-laqgħa mal-Prim Ministru, it-talba biex jerġghu jidhru r-ritratti tal-mejtin fil-magazin, l-allowances dovuti lill-Maltin stazzjonati f’Għawdex, id-drittijiet tad-dipendenti tal-membri tal-Korp li jmutu jew ikorru fuq ix-xogħol u t-talba għal ġurnata żejda ‘off duty’ fl-okkażjoni tal-anniversarju mit-twaqqif tal-Assoċjazzjoni.

Ma’ dawn it-talbiet żdiedet ohra nhar is-7 ta’ Frar, 1986 fejn l-Assoċjazzjoni talbiet biex tkun rappreżentata fil-‘Welfare Committee’. Dan għaliex l-Assoċjazzjoni thoss li peress li hu dover tagħha li tiehu hsieb il-‘Welfare’ tal-Korp, thoss ukoll li għaldaqstant għandu jkollha rappreżentanza fil-kumitat, li skond G.H.Q. Cir. 2/86 dan ma jeżistix.

Dwar il-laqgħa mal-Prim Ministru, reġgħet giet imtennija t-talba b’permezz ta’ ‘reminder’ mibgħut lill-Kummissarju nhar is-7 ta’ Frar, 1986, iżda sakemm qed tiġi ppubblikata din il-harga, ma gejnxi infurmati bi żviluppi.

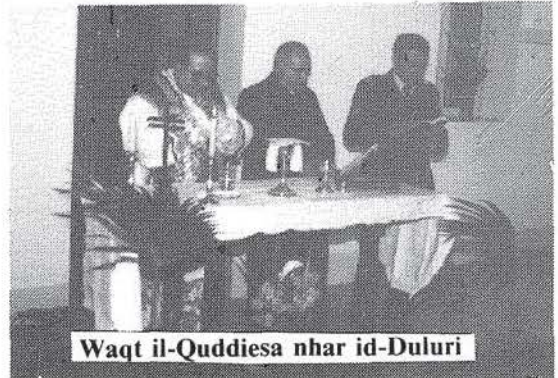

Marzu, 1986, l-Assoċjazzjoni rrispondiet bil-miktub dwar dan fis-sens illi ma thossx li din il-kontribuzzjoni jisthoqqilha xi zieda għalissa u talbet li tinghata raġunijiet bil-miktub għaliex għandha tizzied, meta u jekk din ikollha terġa’ tiġi diskussa.

F’zewg laqgħat li saru għas-Surgenti u Kuntistabbljiet ġie diskussa s-sistema dwar l-użu tat-trasport pubbliku. Dan sehħ wara li s-segretarju tal-Assoċjazzjoni ġie mistieden mill-‘Official Side’ biex jiddiskuti ma’ uffiċjali ohra għolja tal-Korp dwar din is-sistema. Wara laqgħa ma’ dawn l-uffiċjali, is-segretarju laqgħa s-Central Committee tas-Surgenti u Kuntistabbljiet fejn iddikwetew u ssuggerew diversi punti. F’dawn id-diskussjonijiet kien ta’ bilfors meħtieġ li kollox jinkwadra ruhu f’dak li hemm stabbilit fl-‘Estacode’ dwar it-trasport. Sewwa sew kif titla t-taraġ principali ta’ l-għassa tal-Pulizija tar-Rabat Għawdex, insibu kamra zghir uzata bhala kappella. F’din il-kappella insibu statwa sabiha tal-Vara l-Kbira. Il-kurċifiss artistiku ta din l-istatwa nġieb minn Ruma qabel jew fl-1967. Infatti skond tabella li tinsab f’din il-kappella, l-Isqof Camilleri ta xi indulgenzi lil min jghid xi talb quddiem dan il-kurċifiss. Ma dan il-kurċifiss insibu flett statwi sbieh tad-Duluri, San Gwann l-Appostlu u tal-Madalena. Dawn huma xogħol ta l-istatwarju magħruf Għawdexi Wistin Camilleri u saru qabel l-ahhar gwerra dinjija, aktarx fittlettinijiet. Il-flus għal dawn l-istatwi nġabru minn membri tal-Pulizija stazzjonati f’Għawdex

dawk iż-żmienijiet. Barra minn hekk din il-kappella hija armata b’dak kollu li tirrekjedi kappella. Fiha wkoll armar għal festi u armar li jintusa kuljum.

Ta’ kull sena nhar il-festa tad-Duluri din il-kappella tiġi armata għal din l-okkażjoni. Issir ukoll quddiesa mill-Isqof għal membri tal-korp. Anki kull l-ewwel gimgha tax-xahar issir quddiesa.

THE HISTORY OF PHOTOGRAPHY

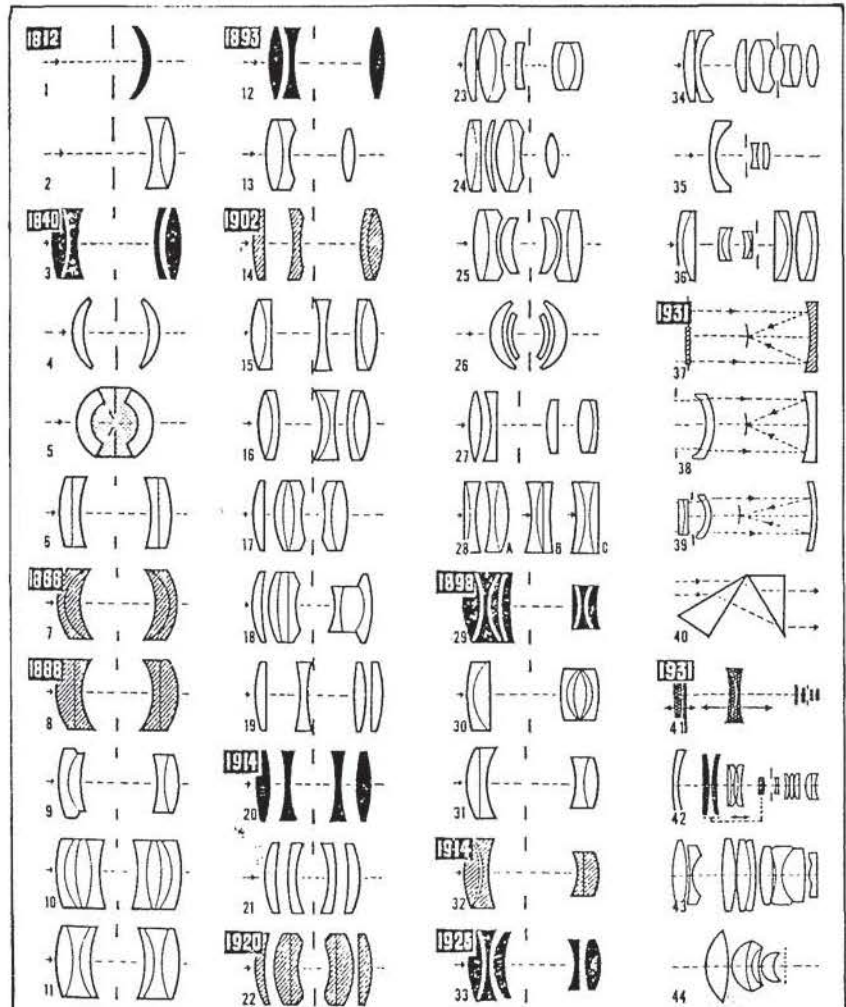
Nevertheless the pioneering spirit led people like Roger Fenton (English) to take his horse-and-cart darkroom to photograph the Crimean war (1855). In America, the Irish Patrick Mathew Brady used a photographic buggy followed the civil war, over 7,000 of his collodion negs. In Paris Nadar, took collodion aerial photographs from a captive balloon.

Stereoscopic photography using daguerreotype had been produced since the late 1840's. Now albumen paper prints and albumen-on-glass transparencies from collodion negs. provided a system of bulk printing low cost stereopairs.

The 1860's brought the introduction of enlargers for collodion negatives. It provided a system of print copying from a glass neg. via light box fitted with a lens. Normally you need a 20 by 16 inch camera to produce a 20 by 16 inch print. The early enlargers like those of the American Woodward (1857) and Scottish Monchroven (1864) used the sun light reflected by a mirror through a hole in the darkroom wall. Due to the slowness of albumen papers, enlargers were normally used to prepare an enlarged collodion negative. Which would then be conventionally printed by contact. It was lately that the enlarger came to use as we know it today.

The limitations of the wet collodion itself gradually became intolerable for location work. Various methods of preserving collodion were tried in order that it might be sensitised and processed at a time separated from photography. All resulted in loss of speed. But by 1871 Dr. Dick Maddox suggested gelatine as a collodion substitute. Two

years later, another Londoner, John Burgess began marketing bromide gelatine emulsion in bottles. The result was not very satisfactory owing to the presence of by products, such as pot. nitrate in the emulsion.

In the 1873, the Englishman Richard Kennett was selling washed pellicles or dried emulsion and ready prepared

coated plates. It was not until 1878 that Charles Bennett published that keeping the emulsion at 90°C for 4 to 7 days, produced a ripening which resulted in increased speed. Emulsion speed allowed exposures as short as 1/25 th. second and shutters became a necessity.

As processing could be done at some other time by somebody else, the trade of photo-finishing became practical amateur photography greatly increased. Amateur photography evolved in such a great way that by 1883 hardly any photographer used collodion material.

NEW IDEAS

•The freedom and speed of dry plates and expanding markets for photography encouraged new ideas in camera design. As cameras could now technically be used manually, manufacturers produced compact light weight equipment. Cameras could be loaded with 12 glass plates and mechanically designed to bring each plate in turn to the focal plane. Many 'detective' cameras appeared - small like objects (toys) disguised as parcels, opera glasses, walking sticks etc...

In 1888, an ex-New York bank clerk (born just outside London, England) George Eastman produced a new camera. He was looking for a name for his new camera. So he invented a strange name which starts with a heavy letter and ends with the same

heavy fonetical letter, and it was arranged in such a way that it could always be remembered. He was after a new, strange but simple name. Eastman put out this camera, he named it Kodak. This new camera the Kodak No. 1, was aimed for people who were not interested in loading plate holders, operating complicated cameras or processing the actual film. For only 25 dollars it was a simple box containing a roll of sensitised paper 20 ft x 2 3/4 ins. enough to make 100 circular negative each 2 1/2 ins. diam.

The f.9 lens was fixed focus and the camera had an instantaneous shutter, pressing a button made the exposure, winding a key transported the sensitive material. It was as simple as that. When the 100th. picture had been taken the camera was sent back to Eastman's factory at Rockester.

The paper roll was cut into stripe, processed and the emulsion stripped off on a transport support. Prints were then made from all usable, negs, pasted onto little mounts and returned with the re-loaded camera, all for 10 dollars.

ROLL FILM

By 1889, the paper roll was replaced by roll film on nitro-cellulose base and 6 years later the film was rolled in a length of backing paper to allow daylight re-loading.

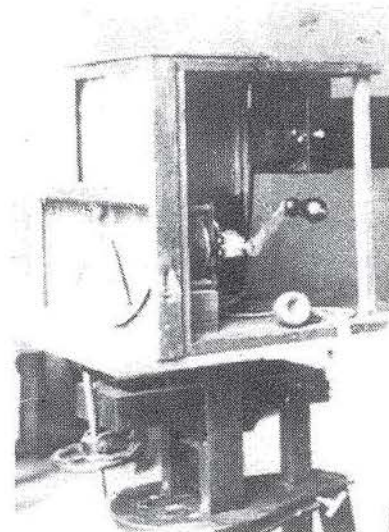
The roll-film was invented by the Father Rev. H. Goodwin, a N. Jersey, Roman Catholic padre

in 1887. Today films are of Polyester (plastic based).

Eastman's slogan 'You press the button, we do the rest' rang round the world. For many years he had a monopoly of roll-film and with it roll-film cameras. The Kodak camera changed the whole character of amateur photography from a process for the initiated few to snapshotting for the millions.

Thomas Edison (American), who was working on an instrument to photograph motion, approached Eastman in 1889 for a suitable new flexible film. The 2 3/4 inch Kodak roll-film was slit down the centre making it 35mm. wide. Edison made the transport perforations at each edge. Later this became an international standard for motion pictures. Then in 1924, Oscar Barnack (German) an employee with E. Leitz, designed a camera for the use with microscopes and using motion picture film. This was later marketed by his company as the first 35mm. camera. The Leica camera.

Other improvements to materials include the extension of colour sensitivity from Blue to Orthochromatic (1885) and Panchromatic (1904) by the German doctor H. Vogel.

Vogel's sensitising dyes were a starting point for practical system of colour photography. Bear in mind also the improvement in lenses such as Rudolf's 1889 Anastigmat lens.

Eastman enjoyed enormous financial success of his camera system in the form of research and development laboratories. These in turn gave way to many new material, like the first practical colour tripack film 'KodaChrome' in 1935.

The 19th. century church in Germany made news when due to a lack of photographic or chemistry knowledge, it condemned all photographic processes and termed it as the work of the devil. It tried to influence the catholic world, including the vatican. Then a catholic priest who took some interest in chemistry, found out that there was nothing satanic about photography.

The scandalised reaction of that German newspaper to the invention of the Daguerreotype seems very curious now, in the light of the benefits that photography has brought to the world. This is how the editorial ended: 'Is it possible that God should have abandoned His eternal principles, and allowed a Frenchman in Paris to give the world an invention of the Devil... If this thing were at all possible, then something similar would have been done a long time ago in antiquity by men like Archimedes or Moses. But if these wise men knew nothing of mirror pictures made permanent, then one can straightaway call the Frenchman Daguerre, who boasts of such unheard of things, the fool of fools.

The 19th. century began with Wedgwood's primitive, unfixed photographs, it ended with Black and White photography in a state of development not far short of today.

The question of who discovered photography is unresolved and in retrospect unimportant.

PHOTOGRAPHY IN MALTA

The British Forces introduced photography in Malta for the first time. But it was reserved only for security Matters and off course reconnaissance. By the 1850's the Naval and Army authorities had their own photographers and the majority if not all of them were servicemen. No local Maltese personnel

were employed as photographers as yet.

But the year 1850/60's, the first photographic studio run by a civilian was that of Giuseppe Lorenzo Formosa, of 66, Old Bakery Street, Valletta. Seven major photographers operating full time, had their studios, most of them at Valletta:

Emanuel Borg, of 21, St. John's Street, Valletta.

Saverio Preziosi Ciantar, of 'London Studio', 133, Strada Teatro, Valletta.

Orazio Agius, 123, Strada Sta. Margerita and 14, Strada Cospicua, Cospicua.

Richard Ellis, of 43, Strada Stretta, Valletta.

Augustine Felice, of 56, Strada Stretta, Valletta.

Alessandro Caurana, of 41, Strada Stretta, Valletta.

H.J. Davison, of 'La Valette Studio', 57, Strada Reale, Valletta.

Most of the local photographic establishments in the island used Daguerre type cameras and Calotype, Collodian and Ambrotype methods for their processes.

More photographic studios were opened all over the major cities, towns and big villages, and by the early 20th. Century, photography in Malta became more popular.

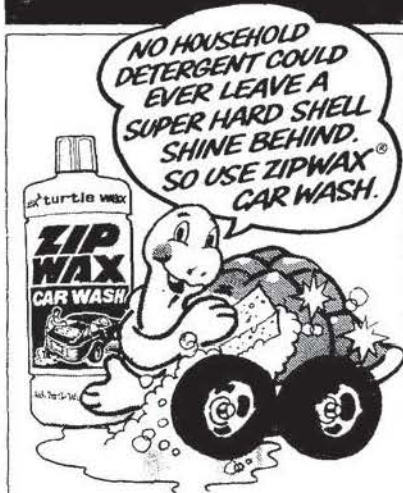

Konsultazzjonijiet dwar materji ta' importanza

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Police questioning — over a glass of Cognac

A very recent sentence⁽¹⁾ delivered by the Court of Magistrates of Judicial Police for the Island of Malta has raised many legal and uniformed eyebrows. Not because the accused was acquitted — that often happens; nor because the Court came to the conclusion that accused's confession was extorted by a promise of favour⁽²⁾ — even Magistrates are entitled to their opinions on questions of fact. What is, to say the least, odd, is that the Court, in its sentence, stated (undoubtedly *obiter*) that it (i.e. the Court) was worried by the prevailing practice of interrogating suspects only in the office of the investigating police officer, even when the suspect is neither a “notorious criminal” nor a person caught **in flagrante delicto**; the Court suggested that such questioning can take place in the suspect's own office or at his place of work or, indeed, at his residence. Moreover the Court seemed to doubt the propriety of the presence of more than two police officers at the questioning and of the suspect waiting for any length of time in the “ante-chamber” before being questioned⁽³⁾.

It is submitted that these *dicta* cannot be taken as being anything even approaching a proper exposition of law.

A suspect is questioned at a police station for the obvious reason that he is, in most cases, under arrest. If he were not under arrest he would not be obliged to follow the arresting officer (usually a constable or sergeant) to the station, he would be at liberty to leave the station at any time, and then the investigating officer would have to go chasing after the said suspect for the privilege of a tête-à-tête over a cup of coffee or a glass of cognac. So, the real issue is not the **place of interrogation** but the **power of arrest**.

Section 359 of the Criminal Code is quite clear. The police may arrest “any person who has

committed, or is suspected⁽⁴⁾ of having committed any crime punishable with imprisonment, with the exception of the crimes punishable under the Press Act, 1974”. The law does not distinguish between notorious and less distinguished criminals; such distinctions are obviously odious, and may lead to the suggestion that criminals or suspects should be afforded different treatment by the police on the basis of their criminal record. Nor does s.359 distinguish between persons caught **in flagrante** and those caught otherwise than **in flagrante**⁽⁵⁾. And, in any case, a person caught **in flagrante** hardly qualifies any longer as a “suspect”!

Arrests in accordance with s.395 are effected by the police in furtherance of their various duties as summarised in s.358. In January of 1981, the Royal Commission on Criminal Procedure, under the chairmanship of Sir Cyril Philips, published its report⁽⁶⁾ which deals with, among other topics, the investigative powers of the police. Paragraphs 3.65 to 3.67 of the said report, although referring to the position in English law, are applicable in large measure also to our law:

3.65 Such rationale as may be perceived in the existing powers of arrest seems to us to be broadly as follows. The ultimate purpose of arrest is to bring before a court for trial a person who commits a criminal offence or is reasonably suspected of so doing. But because arrest deprives the citizen of his liberty its use is to be restricted generally to offences that carry the penalty of imprisonment (there are some exceptions in the case of offences of causing a public nuisance, for example being drunk and incapable) and to persons against whom the summons procedure will not be effective. Arrest may also be used to prevent or terminate the commission of an offence. The general power of arrest without warrant is further restricted to

more serious offences.

3.66 The period of detention upon arrest may be used for certain purposes, and the power of arrest is also related to these. Indeed the purposes for which the existing powers of arrest are used in practice can be put in the following terms. It may be used to prevent the suspect destroying evidence or interfering with witnesses or warning accomplices who have not yet been arrested. Where there is good reason to suspect a repetition of the offence, especially but not exclusively offences of violence, it may be used to stop such an occurrence. Finally, the criterion of having reasonable grounds for suspicion sufficient to justify arrest is not necessarily sufficient to justify a charge; hearsay evidence, for example, may be sufficient grounds for reasonable suspicion, but it is not sufficient for a person to be charged, since it will not be admissible as evidence at trial. Accordingly, the period of detention may be used to dispel or confirm that reasonable suspicion by questioning the suspect or seeking further material evidence with his assistance. This has not always been the law or practice but now seems to be well established as one of the primary purposes of detention upon arrest.

3.67 The point is clearly made by Lord Devlin in the case of *Shaban Bin Hussein v. Chong Fook Kam*⁽⁷⁾. “‘Reasonable cause’ is a lower standard than information sufficient to prove a *prima facie* case. Reasonable cause may take into account matters that could not be put into evidence at all or matters which, although admissible, would not on their own prove the case. The circumstances of the case should be such that a reasonable man acting without passion or prejudice would fairly have suspected the person of having committed the offence. It is important that hasty or ill-advised police action should be avoided. If on the other hand the police hesitate too long to arrest a person when they have

proper and sufficient ground for suspicion against him, they may lose the opportunity of arresting him or may enable him to destroy evidence ... Suspicion arises at or near the starting point of an investigation of which the obtaining of prima facie proof is the end. Suspicion can take into account matters that could not be put in evidence at all."

Since the Royal Commission Report was published the House of Lords has added yet another purpose for which arrest (upon reasonable suspicion) may be resorted to, namely the likelihood that the suspect will respond more truthfully if questioned at a police station than if questioned at his home⁽⁸⁾. In the words of Lord Diplock:

Was it a matter that Detective Constable Offin should have excluded from his consideration, as irrelevant to the exercise of his statutory power of arrest, that there was a greater likelihood (as he believed) that the appellant would respond truthfully to questions about her connection with or knowledge of the burglary, if she were questioned under arrest at the police station, than if, without arresting her, questions were put to her by Det. Con. Offin at her own home from which she could peremptorily order him to depart at any moment...?⁽⁹⁾

All five Law Lords concurred in holding that it was not an irrelevant or extraneous consideration for the purposes of arrest.

It follows therefore that the "stress and pressure" inherent in the fact of arrest and deprivation of liberty cannot *per se* be invoked as a ground for impugning the validity (i.e. admissibility) of a confession by the accused. To hold otherwise would amount to a complete negation of s.359. In this context it is pertinent to recall the English case *R. v. Rennie*⁽¹⁰⁾ which is authority for the proposition that a self-generated or self-induced hope of

an early release from custody, even if it occurs in the course, or as a result, of firm but otherwise proper police questioning, does not render a confession inadmissible. In delivering judgement in *Rennie*, Lord Chief Justice Lane had this to say:

Even if it were the fact that the appellant had decided to admit his guilt because he hoped that if he did so the police would cease their inquiries into the part played by his mother, it did not follow that the confession should have been excluded. Very few confessions were inspired solely by remorse. Often the motives of an accused person were mixed and included a hope that an early admission might lead to an earlier release or a lighter sentence. If it were the law that the mere presence of such a motive, even if prompted by something said or done by a person in authority, led inexorably to the exclusion of a confession, nearly every confession would be rendered inadmissible. That was not the law. In some cases the hope might be self-generated. If so, it was irrelevant even if it provided the dominant motive for making the confession. In such a case the confession would not have been obtained by anything said or done by a person in authority. More commonly the presence of such a hope would, in part at least, owe its origin to something said or done by such a person. There could be few prisoners who were being firmly but fairly questioned in a police station to whom it did not occur that they might be able to bring both their interrogation and their detention to an earlier end by confessing ... It was unnecessary and undesirable to complicate (the) question by considerations of whether conduct was "improper" or constituted an "inducement". The sense and spirit of the principle was more important than the particular wording in which it was expressed. And above all it was to be applied with common sense ... In other words (the judge) should understand the principle

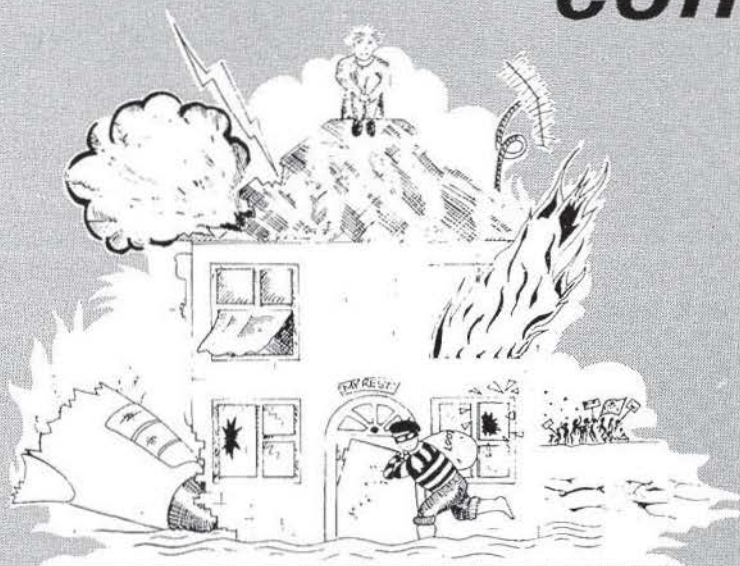
and the spirit behind it and apply his common sense. Their Lordships would add, he should remind himself that "voluntary" in ordinary parlance meant of one's own free will.⁽¹¹⁾

It is unfortunate that sometimes the law is obfuscated by tangential desiderata which in reality are quite naive; as naive, in fact, as the proposition that Magistrates in the course of inquests and inquiries should not summon witnesses to the Courts building in Valletta but should make arrangements to have their evidence taken at their homes.

Madankollu illum l-istess nies kriminali jistghu dejjem, jekk iridu, jkunu ta' ghajnuna ghall-pulizija.

Persuna maghrufa hafna fil-kriminologija Franciża huwa Eugene Vidoc. Vidoc kien suldat f'wahda mill-armati ta' Napuljun fejn serva sakemm kellu l-età ta' hamsa u tletin sena. Fl-1789 Vidoc kellu xi jghid bl-ikrah ma' wiehed raġel li ttantalu t-tfajla tiegħu u dan l-incident wassal lil Vidoc sal-habs għaliex huwa kien ta xeba sew lil dak li kien ittantalu t-tfajla.

Il-hajja fil-habs xejn ma għogħbot lil Vidoc u dan irnexxielu jahrab, izda wara xi żmien reġa' gie maqbud u mitfuħ il-habs bil-konsegwenza li żdiedtilu l-piena. Dan ma għamlux għal darba biss għaliex Vidoc kellu ċerta hila biex jahrab mill-habs u meta l-awtoritajiet tal-habs raw li l-habs ma kien joffri l-ebda sigurtà għal Vidoc, dawn tawh sentenza ta' tmien snin fuq ix-xwieni. Minn din is-sentenza Vidoc irnexxielu jahrab ukoll u fl-1799 huwa mar Parigi, naturalment taħt isem falz, u hemm fetah hanut mnejn kien jinnegozja f'ilbiet użat. Fiz-żmien li qed insemmu f'Parigi kien hemm mewġa kbira ta' kriminalità anzi wiehed jista' jghid li kulhadd kien jagħmel dak li jrid bi ftit ċans li jinqabad mill-Pulizija. Il-Pulizija għalhekk aċċettaw il-proposta ta' Vidoc u dan beda x-xogħol tiegħu bhala 'informer' tal-Pulizija. PROJECTING MALTA'S GOOD IMAGE IN FRANCE

Mr. Alfred Falzon, Educational Officer for French, who also teaches French at the Police Headquarters, came back from France following a short stay in the country at the invitation of the "Association pour l'Accueil des personnalités Étrangères" of Paris through the good offices of the *Ministres des Relations Extérieures*. He was accompanied by H. André Borel, French *Attache Linguistique* seconded to the Department of Education.

During his eight-day stay in the Drome region, Mr. Alfred Falzon delivered a series of lectures in French on the Maltese archipelago to a great number of Secondary school students at Pierrelatte, Montélimar, Dieulefit and Lyons. Each lecture included references to Malta's geography, history, culture, and civilization, education, Maltese language and Literature and industrial and social development. About 250 slides were used to illustrate the lectures which were well received by both the students and the general public who turned up in large numbers in the evening in spite of subzero temperatures prevailing in the region of France at this time of the year.

The highlight of Mr. Falzon's mission in France was the holding of a major Exhibition on Malta

entitled: "Malte Archipel Méditerranéen Carrefour Des Civilisations" (Malta, A Mediterranean Archipelago Crossroad of Civilizations).

The Exhibition, comprising several sections, from Prehistory to present times, was very well received and was prepared in close collaboration with the Photographic Section of the Department of Information, the Malta Police Force and the National Library of Malta where Mr. Falzon carried out much of his research work on Malta's past link with France. Among the large coloured photographs (10" x 8") exhibited in this exhibition, three of them showed the attractive new facade of the Police Headquarters, the emblem of the Malta Police Force and a member of our Force riding one of the Irish horses of our Mounted Police section.

Student exchanges and class to class correspondence (in French and/or in English) between French and Maltese Government and Private schools were also discussed during the meetings held with the French teachers of English at the Lycées de Pierrelatte, Montélimar, Dieulefit and Nyons. These were briefed on the various facilities Malta could

offer them in the field of the teaching of English as a foreign language. A film "Image Malta" (with a voice-over in French), kindly lent for the occasion by the Ministry of Tourism, was shown after each lecture.

Mr. Alfred Falzon's stay in the Drôme was rounded up with a visit on the eve of the departure, to the "Commanderie" of Le Poët Lavel, which used to recruit members of the Order of the Knights of Malta who later joined the "Langue de Provence" with offices at the former "Auberge de Provence" in Valletta, now housing our National Museum of Archeology.

Mr. Falzon's visit and lectures were given extensive coverage by leading French regional papers such as the "Dauphiné Libéré" and "La Tribune de Montélimar". He was the guest of the Mayor of Pierrelatte at the Town Hall, where a reception was held in his honour and during which a reproduction of Maltese artist Edwin Galea's historic watercolour "Napoleon at Malta" was presented to Monsieur Desroziers, Chairman of the Commission of the Municipality of Pierrelatte.

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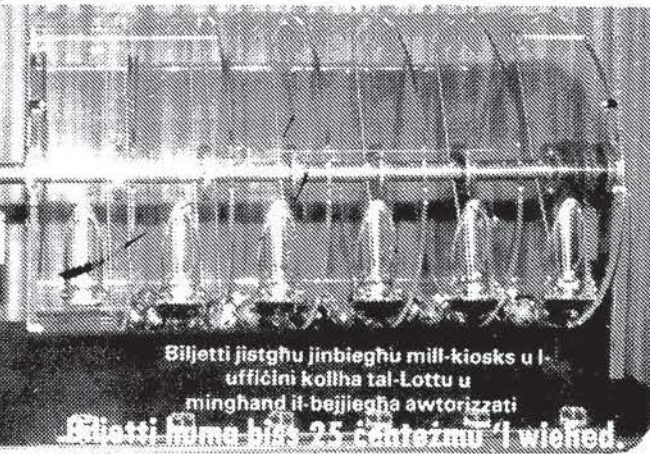

MALTA POLICE DOG SECTION

□ The use of dogs by Police agencies throughout the world is now an accepted fact but it is only since the years following World War II that they were acknowledged as an indispensable to law enforcement. Dogs were used in both world wars to great effect but not in a police context that we know today. This however was not the first recorded use of dogs. History records that guard dogs were used in Egypt in about 1000 BC and later were used by the Arabs in the dual purpose of hunting and also used as guard dogs in the night. The chosen breed most popular is the German Shepherd dog (G.S.D.). Their role was guarding, tracking, carrying messages as a military dog and as a police dog for crowd control and drug detection.

The Malta Police Dog Section originated in 1956. At that time the Section had no vehicles for night patrol and the dog handlers used to perform only foot patrol. The section was very small and there were only three dogs available for police work. These dogs were used by different dog handlers. These dogs were G.S.D.'s. As the time passed the need felt

that the Dog Section had to be expanded and from the Police General Headquarters moved to Sa Maison which is larger enough and has all the necessary facilities. In fact such place can accommodate thirty dogs where each dog has its own kennel. The transfer took place in 1974.

COURSES

Until 1980 the work of the dog handlers was only on criminal work such as crowd control, football grounds, demonstrations etc. These handlers were sent abroad for thirteen weeks courses to specialise in this field of work. Such courses consists of lectures regarding knowledge of the dog and dog handling, agility and mostly Police work. The most important of Police work are Tracking, building searches and

area searches and finally chase and attack.

Tracking: The object of this exercise is to teach the dog to follow by scent a selected trail so that the dog is eventually capable under favourable conditions of following a specific scent to the exclusion of other distractions and, at the same time, of indicating to the handler any items of property left on or adjacent to the track. Training in tracking calls for extreme concentration on the part of both dog and handler. As far as the dog is concerned, it is essential that he must be fresh and alert and not in a tired condition.

Area searches: This exercise is completely separate and distinct from tracking and must not under any circumstances be confused with tracking either by the handler or the dog. The dog relies on finding object by means of Air-borne Scent; he does not rely upon his sight when searching.

Building Searches: This exercise is not introduced into training until tracking and searching for objects to be retrieved are well advanced. It will be noticed that as training in this exercise progresses the dog becomes inclined to lift his head and become interested in air borne scent, rather in the scent on or near the ground. This inclination is likely to interfere with tracking unless the latter subject; with the emphasis on the dog keeping his nose down on com-

mand 'seek', has been mastered. The person for whom the dog is to search plays a very important part in the initial stages of this training. He should go to a pre-selected place, eg. behind a hedge, building, etc. He **must not** have allowed himself at any time to be seen by the dog before hiding.

Chase and Attack: The beginning of the teaching of the chase requires special attention as the utmost care must be taken to prevent undue excitement, hostility or apprehension on the part of the dog. Chasing must be carried out in such natural surroundings as roads, thorough fares and gardens, and performed both by day and night.

MAN'S BEST FRIEND

The part played by the criminal is of the utmost importance and must be carried out in the initial stages by a highly experienced person. The criminal should be dressed in ordinary clothes and any protection worn should be completely covered.

Throughout the years many sophisticated electronic and mechanical devices have been developed to aid men in accomplishing various tasks. Although this modern day technology has accomplished many significant achievement, there is one very important aid that has been available for millions of years to men. Only in recent years has its capability been fully exploited and developed for use in the more complex tasks. This aid is man's best friend and most loyal companion-the dog.

The training and working of dogs is designed to assist officers in learning methods of training and employing dogs in the detection of narcotic substances.

In 1980 the Malta Police began using dogs as a tool to assist in combating narcotic smuggling. Since the inception of the programme the dogs have been credited with narcotic dangerous drug seizures. The street value of these narcotics and dangerous drugs would be in the millions of pounds.

There is, however, no real way money value can be placed on the actual result the dogs have produced since the lives of many

people would have been severely effected, or completely ruined if it had not been for these seizures. The dog's part in aiding law enforcement officers in protecting society for the awesome drug problem is a most significant contribution that must never be overlooked.

With the drug problem, a special branch emerged within our dog section, and with the initiative of the present Commissioner personnel stationed at the Dog Section were sent abroad to train dogs in specialising for narcotic detection.

For this kind of work special dogs must be selected for good temperament. Though the G.S.D. as in the criminal work is the type of breed used in this field. The dog itself must **not** be aggressive as in the criminal work and **must** have the instinct of retrieving. The dogs and handlers selected must be under the guidance of a specialised instructor. At the first few weeks of training the dog should be thought to retrieve an article thrown by his handler. This exercise should take place in an open area preferably grassy surface where the article cannot be seen by the dog.

After such period of training the substance is introduced to the dog. The substance is attached to the article and while the dog is searching and retrieves such article the door or the substance automatically is sniffed by the dog. At this stage the dog will then be sniffing for the odor while eliminating the article.

HEALTH AND CARE

Grooming: Daily grooming of a dog is most necessary to ensure good Health. If a dog is brushed daily it will ensure that the coat is in a healthy condition.

Nose: The nose is a further indication of the dog's health. An excessively dry or moist nose is a symptom of the general condition of the dog.

Teeth: The teeth should be examined daily as they are sometimes damaged by bones and accumulation of tartar should be carefully removed.

Indication of illness: The most common indication of diseases are partial loss of appetite, rise in temperature, heavy breath, increased pulse rate, nasal discharge, diarrhea or constipation. One of the earliest and most important symptom of illness is loss of appetite. These can be best seen while the dog is being fed or groomed.

Exercise: The dog should be exercised daily on smooth or rough surface, on and off the liesh at least for one hour daily. Swimming is the ideal exercise for the mussels of fore and hind quarters.

Dog Handlers: The careful selection of men suitable for training as dog handlers is vital to successful employment of dogs for police purposes. At all stages of training and operational use, the handler and the dog work as a team. The selection of men for traing is therefore no less important than the careful selection of dogs.

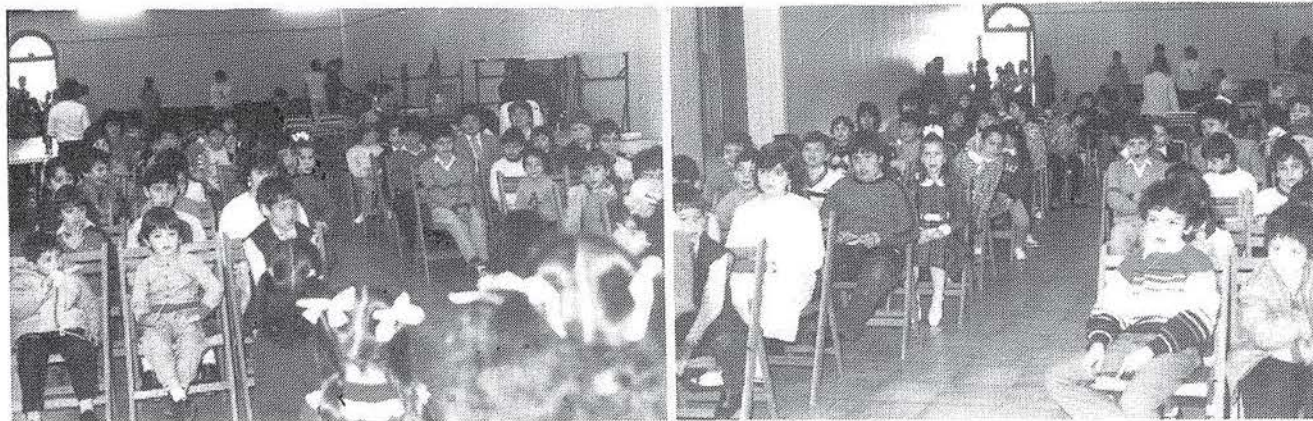

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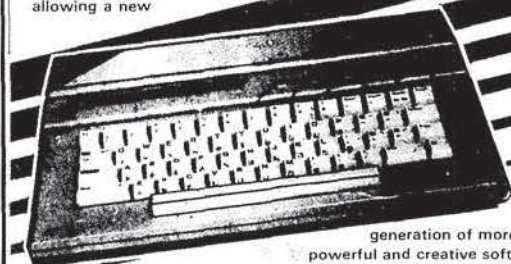

COLLECTION OF POLICE BADGES AND UNIFORMS

□ Ever since my childhood, I always liked uniforms and badges. I first started collecting Military badges, when I was still at school. In those days, I had about 500 badges, from various regiments of the British Army, Australia, Canada, New Zealand and lots of others. Then in 1971, I joined the Malta Police Force, and my hobby came to a halt. One day, a friend of mine, gave me a British Policeman helmet, and from that moment on, I said to myself, "why shouldn't I start collecting Police badges. And that's what I did.

A first, it wasn't very easy to collect Police badges. I used to write dozens of letters to various Police Forces all over the world. I wasn't always lucky, but slowly, I started to obtain a few badges. I always tried to come by. Some of the badges that I managed to obtain were from the former British Palestine Police Force, Tanganyika Police, Uganda Police, Nysaland (now Malawi) and many others. Some times, instead of the badge, on it's own, they also sent me the cap. That gave me an idea, and I said to myself, why not collect the cap, complete with the badge. And so I did.

The first cap that I obtained, way back in 1977 was a German Police cap, from the state of Baden-Baden. I liked it so much, that I was determined to collect more caps. I joined the IPA (Malta) Sec., and that gave me more chance to meet and get in touch with other collectors. Later on, I also joined the Police Insigna Collectors Association of Great Britain, and that gave me a bigger opportunity. I used to get letters from many parts of the world, asking if I'm interested in

'swaping' badges with them. I would like to point out, that badges of the Malta Police Force, have always been in demand with collectors, from all over the world. That gave me a chance to make more contacts. Some of the collectors that I have changed caps/badges with, and that I still correspond with, come from places like Singapore, Portugal, Spain, U.S.A., New Zealand, Switzerland, Canada, Australia, Israel, France, West Germany, England, Eire, N. Ireland, Norway, Italy, Finland, Belgium, South Africa, Iceland, Andorra, and Monaco. These collectors are always pleased to help me with any problems that I might have, about caps or badges, and I do the same from this end.

So far, I have over 160 caps/helmets from the following places: England, Australia, Italy, South Africa, San Marino, Gibraltar, N. Ireland, West Germany, Holland, U.S.A., Canada, Austria, Sweden, Belgium, France, Monaco, Andorra, Russia, Poland, Jugoslavia, Turkey, Norway, Denmark, Spain, Cook Island, Gabon, Leshoto, Togo, Thailand, Japan, New Zealand, Malaysia, Singapore, East Germany, Switzerland, and last but not least, Malta.

I also managed to obtain uniforms from Canada, West Ger-

many, England, Holland, Luxemburg, Belgium and Malta. As these take a lot of space, I try to limit myself, to uniforms that have an interesting aspect, or that are very hard to obtain. Amongst these, I have two Cerimonial uniforms from Luxemburg and Belgium, a complete Malta Police Mounted Gala Uniform, and the famous Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) Red tunic, complete with Sam Brown belt, ect. 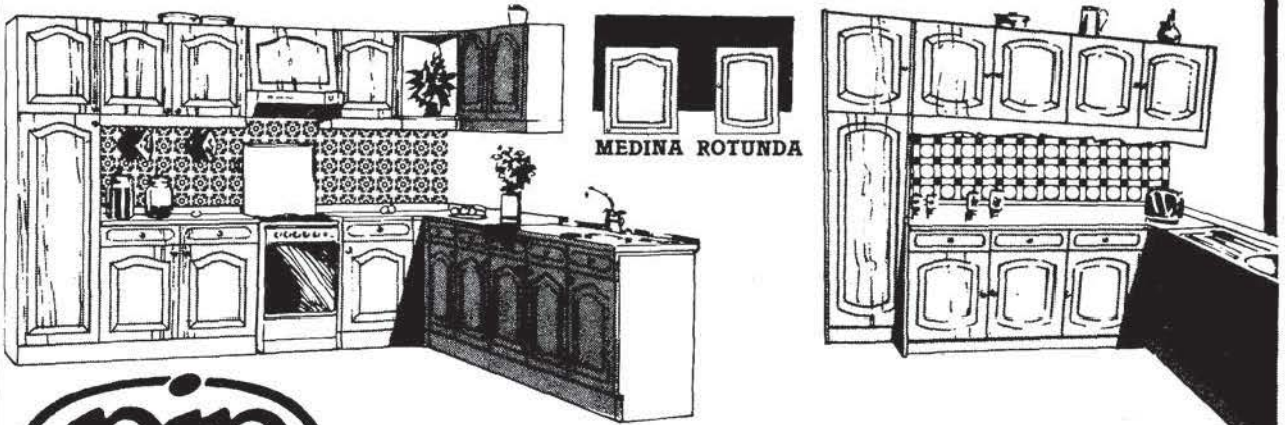

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□ U.S. health officials report progress toward developing drugs to combat Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) a virus possibly more deadly than any other disease known to man.

AIDS is a sexually transmitted disease that experts say cannot be spread by casual contact. It attacks the immune system, leaving the body defenseless against various infections, including pneumonias and certain rare cancers. AIDS is incurable and believed to be always fatal.

The U.S. Public Health Service's Acting Assistant Secretary of Health, Dr. James Mason, emphasized at a recent press briefing that the AIDS virus is extremely difficult to catch and doesn't spread easily — not nearly so easily as, for example, tuberculosis, which can be borne on a cough; or cholera, spread by sewage-contaminated water, or malaria, contracted from the bite of a mosquito. For the average individual who is not homosexual and who doesn't take drugs intravenously, the chance of contracting AIDS is less than one in a million. (The chance of dying in an automobile accident is about one in 5,000.)

Researchers believe AIDS is caused by a virus called Human T-cell Lymphotropic Virus, or HTLV-3. It's a retrovirus, a type of virus that stores its genetic information in a chemical called ribonucleic acid, or RNA. Almost every other organism, from virus to mammals, stores its genetic information in deoxyribonucleic acid, or DNA.

A special protein on the surface of HTLV-3 allows the virus to attach itself and penetrate helper T-cells (T-4 Lymphocytes), a master control cell in the body's immune system. When it enters a T-cell, the RNA-based retrovirus uses an enzyme information into the more standard DNA. The integrated virus eventually commandeers the cell's reproductive machinery to replicate its own genes. AIDS virus particles then emerge from the host cell and go on to infect new cells.

"If you wanted to destroy the immune system with a minimum of work, you would design HTLV-3," said Dr. Samuel Broder, Deputy Clinical Director at

the National Cancer Institute. "If you damage the regulatory capacity of the T-cells, other cells (in the immune system) become lost."

Researchers believe the AIDS virus first infected man about 20 years ago, and is perhaps an evolutionary descendant of a virus that has existed in monkeys for as many as 50,000 years. How the virus got from monkey to man remains unknown, although other viruses have crossed the species line before.

U.S. Researchers report that a better understanding of the virus is helping scientists design drugs to interfere with its survival and, ultimately, a vaccine that would protect those not yet exposed. But they add that it won't be an easy task, since no other infectious disease in history, not even the plague or polio, specifically targeted the body's immune system. They warn that no vaccine or cure is likely for several years.

"What we're trying to do is something that hasn't been done before," said Dr. Mason. "That's to produce a chemical that won't kill people or hurt them, but will totally destroy a virus that is so potent that once it enters the cell it can link itself with a person's genetic material, so that they're indistinguishable."

Dr. Mason said that, through advances in molecular biology, researchers have been able to identify virus-specific component against which chemical agents could be directed without harming the cell. He noted that there are only two drugs on the market today to combat viruses, neither of which eliminates the virus. One antiviral drug, used against influenza, simply holds the virus in check until the immune system can produce antibodies to destroy it.

"The other antiviral agent, Acyclovir for genital herpes

infection, has come about through serendipity, but the potential for targeting antiviral development exists," he said.

In the case of the AIDS virus, Dr. Mason said four antiviral substances have received investigational new drug approval and are being tested in patients in the United States. These include Suramin a popular drug used to treat parasitic diseases like African sleeping sickness; Ribavirin, a flu drug used in more than 70 countries; HPA-23, a mineral compound used in France to treat about 50 patients; and Azidothymidine, a new, unusually potent antiviral drug.

The director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious diseases, Dr. Anthony Fauci, said that one of the most promising drugs, Suramin, has been used to suppress the AIDS virus by preventing it from producing the enzyme reverse transcriptase, which it needs to reproduce and infect other white blood cells.

"But during our studies the patients showed no signs of clinical improvement while taking the drug — in other words, they did not get better," Dr. Fauci said. "That may seem like a negative result, but we have shown now that you can block the virus."

Dr. Fauci said the most effective treatment for AIDS will probably result from the combination of an antiviral drug such as Suramin and another therapy that attempts to restore the body's damaged immune system. He said a number of substances that are known to increase the body's supply of certain critical immune cells are now undergoing clinical tests at hospitals around the country. These include such drugs as Interferon and Interleukin-2 — proteins found in the white blood cells of health people.

Legal Notes by Dr. Vincent A. De Gaetano

LL.D., Dip. CRIM (CANTAB)

Accomplice as witness for the prosecution — stage at which, and purpose for which, his statements made to the police may be produced as evidence.

Zammit was indicted on charges of bribery, extortion, malversation by a public officer and fraud. In the list of witnesses and documents he intended to make use of at the trial, accused indicated all the statements made by prosecution witnesses to the police. The Attorney General pleaded, *in limine*, the in admissibility of these statements. The Criminal Court upheld the plea except in respect of the statements made by Michael Debono; the Criminal Court held that since Michael Debono was to be regarded as an accomplice and was giving evidence following a free pardon conferred by proclamation of the President of the

Republic, he was to be regarded as a "suspect witness" and therefore his statements made to the police were admissible as evidence. The Attorney General appealed. The Court of Criminal Appeal, allowing the appeal, held that —

1. a witness who was also an accomplice was different from other witnesses only in so far as his evidence required sufficient corroboration by other circumstances for the conviction of the accused if such accomplice was the only witness against the accused (s. 635(3) of the Criminal Code);

2. the only evidence which the jury is to consider is that given on oath in Court; however the credit of a witness may be impeached by the party against whom he is called by evidence that he had at other times made statements

inconsistent with his testimony; and a party producing a witness may contradict him by other evidence and may also show that he had at other times made statements inconsistent with his testimony before the jury (s. 641 of the Criminal Code and ss. 583, 584 and 585 of the Code of Organization and Civil Procedure);

3. a court should not pronounce itself *in vacuo* on a purely hypothetical question; it was up to the trial court to decide, during the hearing of evidence or after hearing the evidence, whether to allow the production of any document for the purpose of contradicting a witness or of impeaching his credit.

The Republic v. Afred Zammit
Court of Criminal Appeal, 11 October 1985.

U.S. scientists are also investigating the role of bone marrow transplants in boosting the body's defenses against AIDS. Early studies involving identical twins have shown that bone marrow transplantation can provide the AIDS patient with an instant source of immune cells.

A group of French doctors say they have succeeded in "dramatically slowing" the development of AIDS by using an immuno-depressive drug called Cyclosporine, commonly given to prevent rejection of transplanted organs. They stress that the treatment does not represent a cure, but may allow for long-term maintenance of AIDS-stricken patients.

Researchers report that the discovery of a vaccine against AIDS doesn't appear to be likely for another five years. Dr. Gauci said that researchers are still puzzled about exactly what protects the body against the AIDS virus — knowledge that may be the crucial step in obtaining an effective vaccine. Another obstacle to developing a vaccine lies in the ability of a virus to change its genetic structure, which, in turn,

changes the virus' protein coat that would be targeted by a vaccine.

Some estimates suggest that the mutation rate for AIDS viruses is 100 to 1,000 times higher than for influenza, but scientists are looking for a portion of the protein coat that does not change. If such a stable portion can be found, then it could be used to create a vaccine that would be effective against all strains of the virus.

There is also mounting evidence that the fatal disease can attack a victim's brain as well as his immune defense system. According to doctor's estimates, at least 30 percent of AIDS show symptoms of brain disease or damage to the spinal cord, resulting in Dementia, memory loss and other mental illnesses. Whether the AIDS virus kills cells other than T-4 Lymphocytes in brain disease cases is still not known.

Dr. Fauci said recently that it was conceivable "that the many faceted neuropsychiatric symptoms of many AIDS patients are related to the fact that this virus can infiltrate and infect central

nervous system tissue."

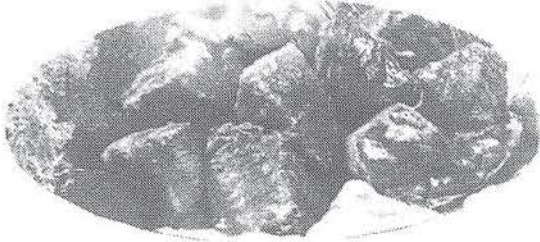
On the positive side, a new antibody test has been developed to protect blood supplies from transmission of the AIDS virus. U.S. doctors report that the blood supply is safer now than ever before and that the problem of blood-transfusion AIDS, for the most part, is over. Nearly 200 people, or about two percent of the total cases of AIDS reported in the United States since 1981, had contracted the deadly disease following transfusions with blood or blood products.

AIDS was first reported in the United States in mid-1981. Since that time, the U.S. Government's centers for disease control has received reports of more than 14,700 cases, about 51 per cent of which have resulted in death. More than 90 per cent of the cases reported have been among homosexual and bisexual men, persons who inject illicit drugs, and persons who have had transfusions with blood and blood products. Only one percent of the total cases appear to have resulted from heterosexual contact, and that percentage has not changed for several years.

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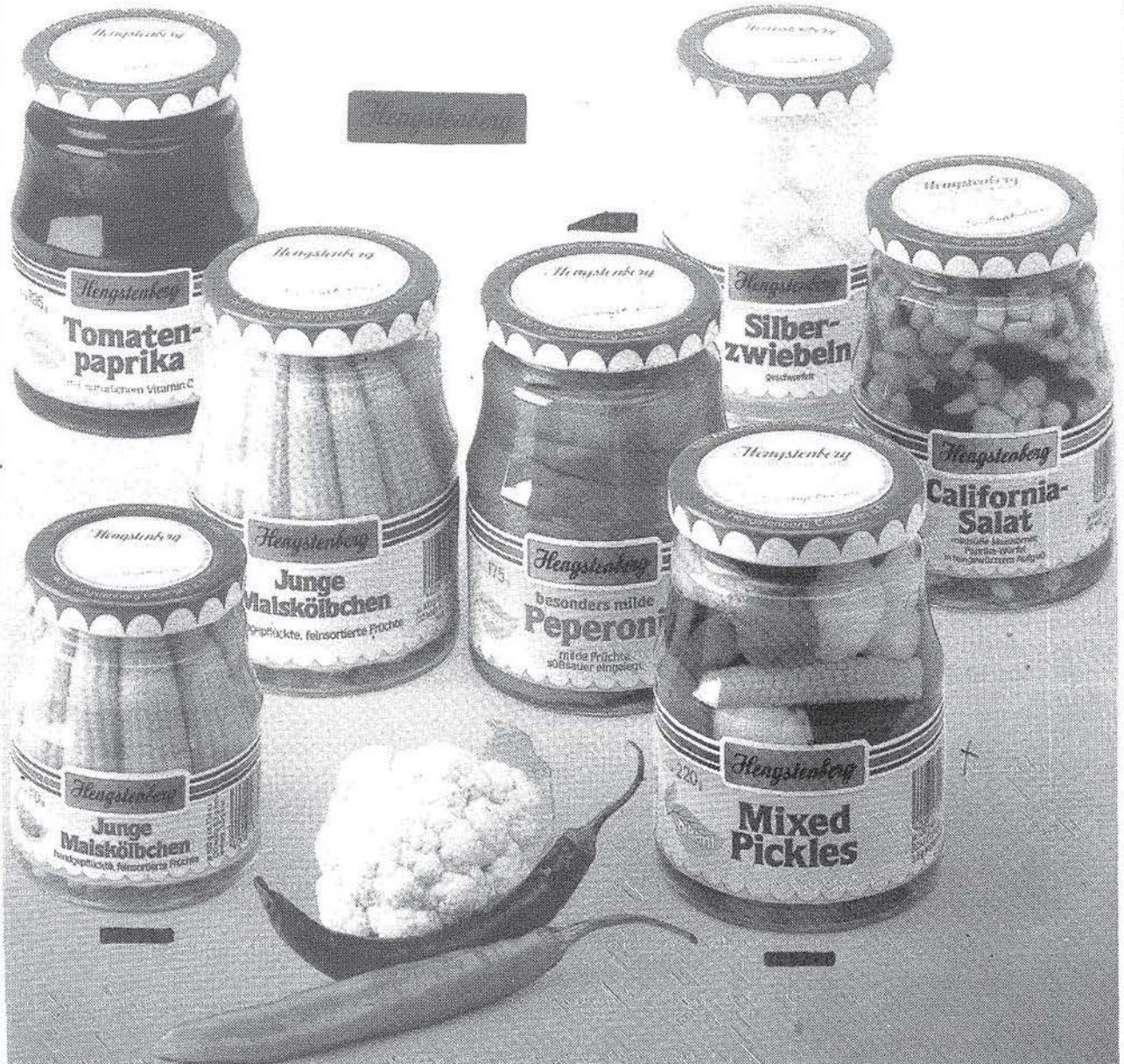

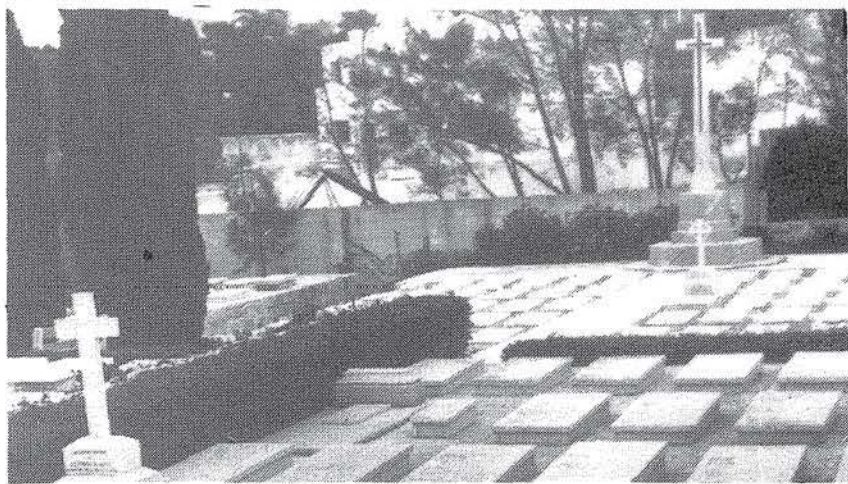

Sittax il-Malti kienu il-hatja, erba qassisin li kienu Dun Gejt Mannarino, Dun Salv Sammut ta' Haż-Zebbuġ, Dun Stiefnu Zarb u Dun Gwann Bonanno. Kien hemm seba' kjerici u hamsa sekulari lajċi. Meta ngħidu kjerici rridu niftakru li f'dawn iż-żmienijiet bosta kienu li jkunu kjerici biex hekk ikunu biss sugġetti għal Veskovat, u fil-pajjiż igawdu ċerti drittijiet, bla ma qatt isiru qassisin.

Waqt li kien għadu sejjer il-proċess, il-Gran Mastru Ximenes laħqu Alla u ħadu fl-4 ta' Novembru 1776. Il-Maltin baġħaduh lil dan u hekk ukoll għamlu shabu stess li mank lapida fuq qabru ma għamlu biex jiftakru fih.

U laħaq Rohan Gran Mastru. Dan kif sar ried jiddikjara l-helsien tal-Maltin, għax ammetta li l-Gran Mastru ta' cablu kien ta kelma fil-ftehim li l-hatjin ikunu meħlusa, u ordna

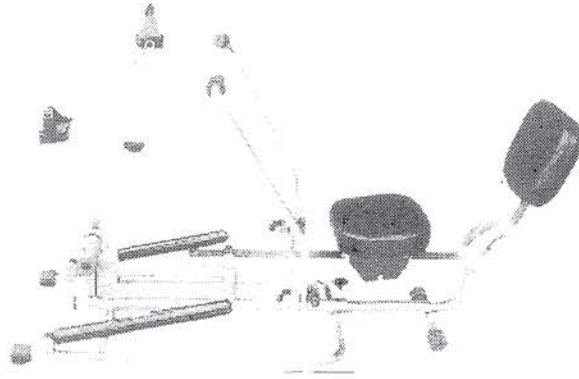

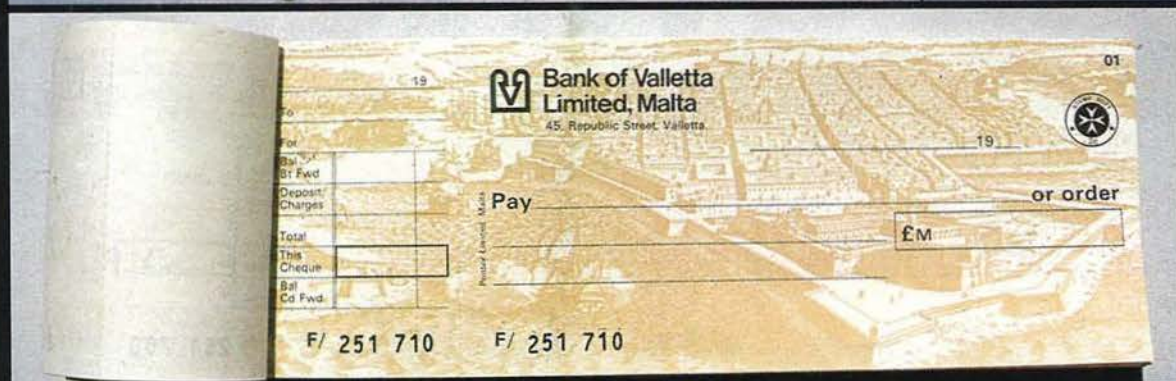
