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CAUSES OF DEATH UNKNOWN

Sooner or later, Death comes at the end and the Law, either in its civil or criminal aspects, follows suit. This is hardly surprising for as one noted poet held "law would clip an angel's wing"! In this short article, our concern is to throw some more light on the steps to be followed in cases which involve a sudden, or violent or suspicious death, or of a death the cause of which is not known – from the point of view of our Criminal Law.

Whenever any one of the above-mentioned incidents of death takes place, and as soon as the matter is made known to the Executive Police, a report thereof is drawn up, usually by the District Police Officer and forwarded without delay to the Court of Magistrates of Judicial Police. Although the Maltese Criminal Code mentions the word "Court", in point of fact this report is received by the Inquiring Magistrate who happens to be the 'duty' magistrate on that particular day. Such a report should contain all the relevant details as to the identity of the person found dead. For this reason, particulars of day, time, location and environment must be included. Wherever possible, the investigating police officer should moreover indicate whether any so-called 'foul-play' is in any way in evidence. It is now proposed to briefly explain what is normally expected as a minimum from the various officers that take part in the inquest involving a dead person where the cause of death is not certified by a medical doctor as being known.

At the outset, it is very important for the investigating police officer to arrive on the scene of death as early as possible and without undue delay in order to ascertain that no evidence be removed, cancelled or tampered with – and not to leave until all such evidence be properly recorded in terms of law. When this is not possible, a police constable is to be detailed to the scene of the incident where death

occurred until the investigating officer arrives. The primary duty of the investigating police officer is to establish the following two important data, namely, (i) the identity of the deceased; and possibly (ii) how, when and where the deceased came by his/her death.

Upon receiving the police report, the duty magistrate will then hold an inquest on the dead body for the purpose of ascertaining the cause of death. In order to accomplish this, the magistrate takes down all such evidence as may be possible for him to procure, usually with the help of experts appointed by him with a specific task. The Criminal Code envisages some other cases involving deaths where an inquest must also be held. Again, one of the underlying reasons for the holding of such an inquest is to make sure that the death in such instances resulted from a known cause. These special instances mentioned by the law are the following:

- (a) whenever a person dies while he/she is imprisoned; or
- (b) detained in any place of confinement contemplated in the Prison Act, 1976; or
- (c) while a person dies when under police custody; or
- (d) whenever a person dies in the Mount Carmel Hospital while he/she is being kept there under a Court order in terms of law, or for the purpose of his/her being examined by experts appointed by the Court.

In the majority of cases, the duty magistrate orders a post-mortem examination on the body (more commonly referred to as the "autopsy"), and medical experts are appointed in order to medically establish the cause of death and whether such a death was a natural one. Our Code also specifically empowers the inquiring magistrate to order, wherever necessary, the dissection and the internal examination of the body. If the body has been buried already, the magistrate is also empowered to order its disinterment or exhumation for a necroscopic examination.

All post-mortems are held at the Mortuary or as otherwise indicated by the magistrate. Before it starts, the dead body must be indentified upon oath by two other persons who know the person in question. Prior to the removal of the body to the mortuary, however, certain other procedures have to be adhered to. When a medical doctor is called to examine a person believed to be dead, he has three principal duties to keep in mind, that is,

1. to make sure that death has, in fact, taken place;
2. to make a superficial examination on the body in order to exclude medical grounds for suspicion; and
3. to issue a death certificate, if he is in a position to do so. Should this be not possible he is to state that the cause of death is unknown and inform the police.

When the cause of death is not known, another kind of a medical examination is required before removing the body, the so-called *levée du corps* (literally meaning the 'raising of the body'.) The *levée du corps* differs from the first medical examination already described. It involves instead a detailed medical description of all the relevant data regarding the cadaver. It is neither unusual nor uncommon for some time to elapse between the finding of the body and the performance of the autopsy. This fact alone makes it imperative upon the medical expert conducting the *levée du corps* to be as competent and efficient as possible. On his part, the investigating police officer and efficient as possible. On his part, the investigating police officer should assist the expert by giving him all the circumstantial details gathered by him regarding the dead body as well as the immediate environment. If the body be seen where first discovered, note should be taken of the exact position and attitude, of any signs suggesting a struggle or an assault, of foot-prints or other marks to or from the body; of any bottles, medicines, spirits,

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THE CITIZEN, TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS AND THE LAW

This is the fourth and concluding part of a series in which we reproduced a lecture given by Dr. Joseph Galea at the University of Malta.

Reference is also made to the Bill at present before Parliament which sets out to unify the Criminal and Civil Process for redress in cases of death, bodily harm or damages arising from traffic accidents.

A very important principle to be kept in mind in assessing damages arising from negligence, is that they are to be regarded as a compensation for an injury sustained and not as a punishment for a wrong inflicted upon the victim. It is consequently the duty of the victim to do everything that is reasonably possible to minimise and mitigate the damages sustained by him. He is to refrain from any act through which the damages might be increased. For example, a person deciding to change an entire part of a car, when it can be repaired easily and at a lesser cost, might find that he will not be entitled to recover the extra cost unjustifiably incurred by him. Similarly a person, who capriciously refuses to undergo normal therapeutic treatment for his injuries, thereby making his disability worse, is likely to have his claim for larger damages strongly contested.

Of course, the injured party is not bound to make any undue or unreasonable sacrifices or to assume any burden in minimising the damages. Thus, for instance, a person of scanty financial means is not expected to raise a loan for the repair of a damaged vehicle in order to cut down on losses resulting from his inability to use his vehicle, say, for his trade or profession.

In concluding this brief and necessarily superficial review of a very vast and dynamic subject, I feel this is the place to make a few

comments on some desirable measures that might be introduced, firstly to contain this ever growing negative phenomenon of the motor car age by preventing and forestalling accidents and secondly, to make remedies better and more tangible.

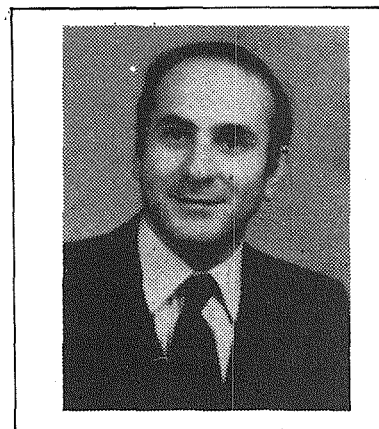
1. Emphasis must be laid by the Police authorities on educating drivers about the Highway Code, the basic rules of the road and their rights and obligations. Whereas more recently newly licensed drivers are being tested on their knowledge of the Highway Code, thousands and thousands of Maltese drivers literally have never heard of this little green book. Perhaps it is high time to introduce such oral tests for all licensed drivers as a condition for renewal of driving licences.

2. So much more could be done to make our roads safer by adequate sign posting (particularly Stop Signs) and, if we can afford it, adequate lighting. The most gruesome accidents I have had the occasion to deal with were those happening at night time, in unlit roads, with foreigners at the wheel.

3. Thirdly, all vehicles should be regularly tested for road worthiness and subjected to periodical inspections. These and many other measures could go very far in preventing travel accidents.

From the remedial aspect, I feel there is a very strong case for introducing Full Third Party Risk Insurance Coverage, extending beyond damage caused through death or bodily injury, to all kinds of damage, notably damage caused to property of third parties. This will ensure that at least when the injured party has been successful in obtaining a favourable judgement against a reckless driver, he will be able to enforce it successfully against solvent insurers.

Furthermore, it might now be the time for our legislators to



consider the amendment of our Civil Code, introducing the principle of compensation for **pain** and **suffering** resulting from tortious acts, bringing our law in line with foreign liberal laws.

For some time now, a Bill has been before Parliament, which could go a long way in streamlining procedures for redress in collision or traffic accident cases, if carefully implemented with certain amendments. This Bill, amending the Criminal Code, sets out to give the Court of Magistrates of Judicial Police and, in turn, the Court of Criminal Appeal, jurisdiction and power to order the person convicted in the Police trial, after being involved in a traffic accident, to pay damages to the injured party, in cases of involuntary homicide, involuntary bodily harm or involuntary damage to property.

When and if this Bill becomes Law, it will have the effect of unifying the criminal and civil process for redress, thus, hopefully, expediting matters somehow and avoiding duplication of work. Where the damages in question exceed Lm250, the order of the Criminal Court will be enforced by the Civil Court First Hall or the Gozo Magistrates Court in its

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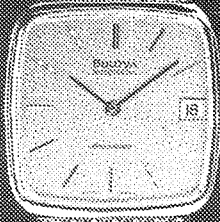


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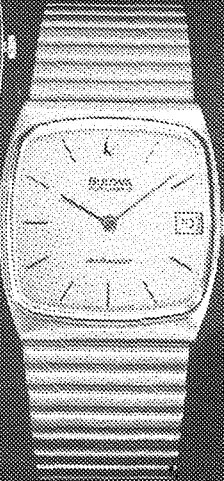
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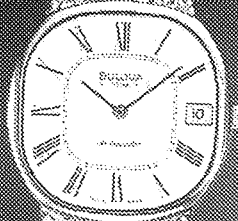
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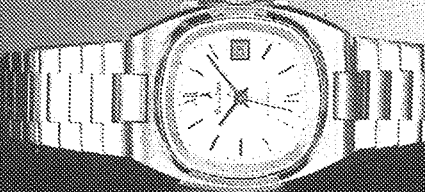
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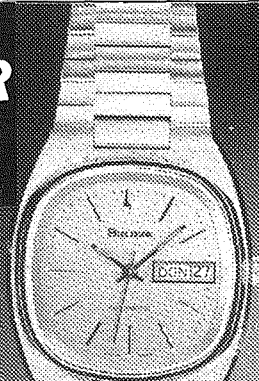
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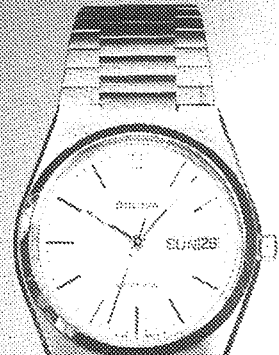
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TAGHLIM EDUKATTIV

superior jurisdiction. When the amount is less, it will be enforceable by the Civil Court of Magistrate. The only appeal that will be available from such orders to pay the damages caused will lie to the Court of Criminal Appeal.

The injured party will still be able to take action before the Civil Court for liquidation of damages and their payment, however the Civil Courts will only be able to award a sum higher than that awarded by the Criminal Court, provided that account is taken of the sum already awarded by that other Court. In these cases, the Civil Courts will however have to accept the Criminal Court's decision on liability and responsibility for the accident giving rise to the damages, though they may enquire also whether other parties are to blame as well.

A further amendment which the Bill proposes to introduce makes it possible for the Civil Court to stay proceedings before it until criminal proceedings, pending before the Criminal

Courts for the same accident, are concluded. Furthermore, the injured party, who has filed a precautionary warrant or garnishee order to safeguard his claim for damages arising from a traffic accident, need not file the civil writ of summons for damages within 10 days, if a criminal action for the same accident is already before the Criminal Courts.

Irrespective of whether this Bill becomes Law or not, every effort must be made by legislators, judges, Court referees and lawyers to ensure as smooth and as speedy a procedure as possible in the establishing of liability for traffic accidents and in the assessment of damages resulting therefrom.

All involved in the complex machinery of redress would do well to remember at all times that, particularly in cases of bodily injury and death, the compensation eventually obtainable in financial terms can, at best, only remotely alleviate the irreversible hardship inflicted on the victim or his heirs and dependants.

L-Għaqdiet tas-Snajja fl-Imghoddi

L-għaqdiet tas-snajja f'art twelidna ma humiex xi haġa tal-lum biss. Daqqa ta' għajn fuq iż-żmenijiet bikrija ta' Malta, turina li l-Maltin dejjem kienu sabu li l-aħjar saħħa, l-aħjar qawwa, qegħda fil-għaqda.

Il-fdalijiet qodma, fl-irkejjen kollha ta' Malta u Għawdex, tal-ewwel żmenijiet, jew tar-Rumani, kollha jixhdu għaqda Maltija, daqs dik li werew il-Maltin fl-aħħar żmenijiet tal-kavallieri, u taħt l-ewwel jiem tal-ħakma Franciża, meta taħt mexxejja Maltin, għall-ewwel darba, ingħaqdu u bdiet ir-rewwixta l-kbira, biex irnexxilhom ixejnu l-għadu.

U kemm deherna haġa wahda meta f'dak il-jum ta' tempesta, grew bi għarhom lejn ix-xtaita biex jaraw x'kien dak il-bastiment li tfarrak mal-blat, u x'kien ġara mill-ekwipagg ta' fuqu, li donnu kien inbelgħa mill-mewg. U kif rifes Pawlu u shabu fuq artna, missirijietna laqgħuhom u daru bihom.

Fl-eqdem belt ta' Malta, fejn illum ngħidulu Rabat u Mdina, fiċ-ċimiterju tal-aħħar żmien tar-Rumani, jew kif jgħidulhom uħud, fil-katakombi ta' San Pawl u ta' Santa Agta, kien instab gebel kbir minqux fuqu b'għodod ta' landiera, jew haddieda, imqassijiet, imritli, tnalji u għodda oħra. L-arkeoloġi, dawk li jistudjaw il-qedem, sejhulhom collegia artificum, jigifieri għaqdiet tas-snajja. Għalhekk qabel haġ'oħra dawn il-fdalijiet juru l-għaqda bejn il-haddiema u l-imghallmin, għaqda qisa dik ta' bejn il-knisja u l-istat.

Semmejti il-knisja, għaliex il-knisja kienet dejjem it-tokk fejn taħt id-dell ta' hitanha kienu jiltaqgħu n-nies ta' l-inħawi kollha. U kull ma sar mhux biss f'Malta u Għawdex, imma fid-dinja, mal-milja ta' eluf ta' snin, kien madwar il-hitana tal-knejjes.

Għad għandna bosta nħawi fil-gzejjer tagħna li jfakkru fejn kienu jgħixu, jew jaħdmu, il-haddiema: Hal-Bajjada, it-triq tal-hadedin, it-triq tas-sigġijiet, it-triq tal-masri, is-sur tal-kurdari fil-Birgu, u bosta oħrajn, li jixirqilhom studju għalihom.

L-ewwel tagħrif li wasalna dokumentat, dwar l-għaqdiet tas-

snejja, huma ftit karti, manus-kritti, li jinsabu fl-arkivju magħrufa bl-isem ta' kapituli, jeddijiet, li kienu tressqu mill-Università, il-gvern ta' dari, u kienu mqegħda u mwassla għand il-vicire ta' Sqallija, fil-belt ta' Katanja, sabiex il-kurvisieri, cutturieri, a fari mestieri, fussero esclusi nelle elezioni ad officii dell'Università.

Fis-sena 1341 niltaqgħu li l-mastrudaxxi kienu ngħaqdu fir-Rabat, u kienu jmorru jakkumpanjaw il-vjatku tal-morda, u jiehdu sehem ukoll fil-funerali tal-mejtin.

L-imsieħba tal-għaqdiet kienu nies tas-sengħa, u kienu suldati fl-istess hin. Kemm-il darba l-haddiema u l-imghallmin, kellhom jitilqu xogħolhom biex imorru jehduha ma' l-għadu ta' arthom u djarhom, jekk mhux dinhom ukoll, u wara, flok l-imqass, flok iz-zappun, flok is-serrieq, kienu jaqbd u l-moqdief għax kienu jinqabdu bhala lsiera.

Fi żmien il-kavallieri, imbagħad, il-Maltin ta' bejn is-sittax u l-hamsa u sittin sena, kienu kollha taħt l-armi.

L-għan ta' l-għaqda kien li jagħtu dejjem unur lis-sengħa tagħhom u qabel kolloxx li jharsu sew il-qawl mhux kull min zeba' wiċċ sar haddied; li jgħinu lil xulxin kemm fl-ispiritwal, u sew fit-temporal, bil-kliem, bil-għemil, bl-għajjnuna lill-morda u x-xjuħ, u jhennu għall-iżventurati.

Kull għaqda kellha l-qaddis tagħha.

Id-drawwa kienet li kull għaqda tpoġġi taħt id-dell, il-patroċinju, ta' xi qaddis. Din id-drawwa ma kienitx Maltija biss, u anqas moderna. Naqraw li l-istatut ta' Pisa, belt fl-Italja, tas-sena 1161, iġhid li l-konslijiet tal-baħħara u tal-kummedjanti, kienu jiltaqgħu fil-knisja ta' San Mikiel. Il-Venezjani meta kienu taħt il-ħakma ta' Kostantinopli kienu ltaqgħu f'Santa Sofija, u hemm kienu jwettqu u jfasslu l-ligijiet tagħhom.

U l-professjoni li kien ikollu l-qaddis f'hajtu kienet tiswa għar-rabta ta' l-imsieħba fl-għaqda.

Meta wara r-rebħa kienet

inbniet il-Belt il-gdida, Valletta, għaxxa ta' kull barrani, dawk il-haddiema li kienu fl-inħawi ta' Bormla, tal-Birgu u fil-qrib, ġew hawn mal-kavallieri. U għalhekk l-għaqdiet tas-snejja sabu ruħhom fuq din ix-xaqliba wkoll: il-haddedin, il-fundaturi, u l-maeskalki, ta' dawk l-ibliet, magħqudin hawn fil-belt, talbu lill-Gran Mastru biex jagħrafhom bhala Korporazzjoni. Kienu għamlu sitta u tletin statut, u tawhom ix-xejra ta' dawk l-għaqdiet li kien hemm fil-belt ta' Palermo, fi Sqallija.

Il-Gran Mastru Verdala, fil-25 ta' Lulju 1599, hareġ id-degriet u għarafhom kif kienu talbu.

Il-haddiema, kif rajna, kienu suldati wkoll. Ara kemm, li dawk il-haddiema tal-Belt, kienu jgħibu x-xabla magħhom fuq ix-xogħol, u kull bejjieh, jew imghallem, kellu jzomm la darba fil-hanuz tiegħu, biex f'każ ta' emerġenza, jitlaq jgri ma' shabu u jissielet għall-ġieħ art twelidu.

L-imseħbin tal-għaqda ma kienux jistgħu jehdu sehem f'aktar minn wahda mill-għaqdiet. Darba kien inqala' xi għelt, għax ċertu Manwel Sciberras kien miktub fil-kunfraternità tar-Rużarju u f'dik tal-Karità. Biex tinqala' l-kwistjoni, haġa li ma titwemminx, kellu jindaħal l-Inkwizitur Pallavicini.

Nhar il-festa tal-qaddis, wara l-funzjoni, kien isir pranzu, gwapp għal dak iż-żmien, għall-imseħbin. Tiftakru f'dawk l-ewwel insara fil-katakombijiet ta' Ruma, meta madwar il-mejda, magħrufa bl-isem ta' agape, kienu joqogħdu flimkien, kemm il-fqar, u sew l-għonja, f'għaqda wahda f'għabra tal-aħwa.

Meta l-knisja ta' San Pawl tagħna, tal-Belt, kienet qegħda fejn illum hemm il-knisja tal-Gizwiti, kien hemm l-altar dedikat lil Sant'Eligju, il-patrun tal-haddieda. U meta aktar tard saret bidla tal-art mall-Gizwiti, il-kumpanija giet fil-knisja ta' San Pawl, bl-altar flok dak fejn hemm il-kappella tas-santissimu Sagrament tal-lum. Meta mbagħad kienet inhasset il-htieġa

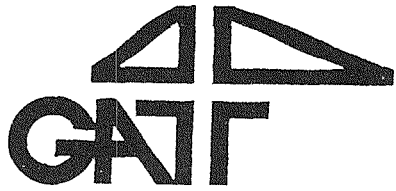
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li jkabbru l-knisja l-għaqda għaddiet għall-knisja tal-Vitorja, u wara 25 sena (1769) bi ftehim mal-patrijiet ta' Ġiesu, skond l-att tan-nutar V. Giammalva, tal-21 ta' Mejju 1769, l-għaqda stabbilit ruhha fil-Knisja ta' Ġiesu, fejn qabel kien hemm il-kappella ta' Santu Rokku.

Il-mastrudaxxi, donnu l-aktar li kienu jissemmew. Il-knisja tal-Karmnu kienet diġà bdiel tinbena, meta l-kappella ta' San Pawl kienet ghadha fejn għedna aktar 'il quddiem, u billi l-għaqda aktarx kienet l-aktar 'in demand' dak iż-żmien, htegiha twaqqaf altar f'dik il-knisja tal-Karmnu, u l-altar kien dedikat lil San Guzepp, mastrudaxxa bħalhom, u hekk għada sal-lum.

Fis-sena 1611 twaqqfet l-għaqda tal-hajjata u tal-merkanti. Dawn iddedikaw altar lil Santo Omobonu bi protettur tagħhom fil-knisja ta' San Pawl ukoll. Fost il-hafna dokumenti li rajt għazilt insemmi episodju wieħed: ċertu mgħallem, Mikelang Mallia konslu, nhar l-4 ta' Awissu 1710, gie kundannat mill-konsodali biex iħallas lil wieħed hajjat id-differenza fil-prezz ta' par qalziet u qmis, għax kienu jiswew anqas milli kien hadlu tagħhom. B'dan irrid nuri kemm kienu jimxu bir-reqqa dawk kollha li kellhom għal qalbhom l-għaqda ta' senghathom.

Mhux talli din l-għaqda tal-hajjata kienet qawwija, iżda nistgħu ngħidu li kienet maghrufa sew mill-barranin. Kienet nebħa għall-għaqda tal-hajjata ta' Londra, fil-belt tal-imperu Inġliż, saret għaqda u hadet l-isem ta' The Merchant Taylors Company, u ngabret taht id-dell u l-bandiera ta' San Gwann Battista. Il-kavallieri ta' Malta li kienu jafu sew l-għaqda li kellha f'San Pawl, kienu għenu mhux ftit fit-tiswir tagħha, u għalhekk nistgħu ngħidu li l-għaqda tal-belt harġet fergħa minnha, mijiet ta' mili 'l bogħod minn artna.

Sa mill-ewwel żmenijiet l-imsieħba tagħha bdew jilbsu l-kunfratija bajda bil-muzzetta

blù bil-kunsens tal-Isqof, u l-konsulti kienu jsiru fis-sagristija tal-knisja. Meta jmut ir-rettur kien jehtieg li jsir rikors għand il-Gran Mastru biex il-konsodali jkunu jistgħu jagħmlu l-elezzjoni u jagħzlu rettur ġdid.

Erba' u għoxrin skrapar mill-Belt u minn Bormla, ingħaqdu u ngabru taht il-patrocinju ta' San Krispin u Krispinajnu fil-knisja ta' San Pawl, fis-sena 1607. L-għaqda tal-iskrapar kienet ġa saret fil-parroċċa ta' San Lawrenz tal-Birgu, u oħra fil-parroċċa ta' San Pawl tar-Rabat. Fis-sena 1756 kien sar konslu tal-iskrapar ċertu bejjiegħ tal-ġlud, u l-kumpanija kienet hadet daqs-xejn għaliha għaliex riduh li jkun skrapar bħalhom.

Għalkemm l-għaqda tan-nissieġa kienet tezisti sa minn żmien l-ewwel insara f'Malta, kif turi dik il-gebla misjuba fir-Rabat, din kienet hadet xejra ta' għaqda kif jixraq meta ngabru għad-dell ta' Sant'Agta fil-parroċċa tagħna wkoll, fis-sena 1804. Din l-għaqda qabel kienet fil-parroċċa ta' Bormla. In-nissieġa fil-belt kienu jahdmu fit-triq tal-Masri, fejn twelidt jien, fit-telgħa ta' bejn it-triq San Gwann u Triq Melita tal-lum, ahna ta' San Pawl ngħidulha t-triq tal-ark.

Kien hawn ukoll l-akkademja tal-pitturi, skulturi u nduraturi. Dawn kellhom altar dedikat lil San Luqa fil-knisja ta' San Frangisk ta' Putirjal, u l-istatut tagħhom kienu approvati mill-

gran mastru Carafa fis-sena 1671.

Iż-żmenijiet li qeghdin nirrakontaw dwarhom kienu bil-bosta differenti mil-lum. Dak iż-żmien il-hanut tal-parrukkiera kien ukoll spizerija, u kont tagħraf li dak il-hanut billi kien ikollu arblu mal-bieb, miżbugħ abjad u aħmar irrigati, qishom id infaxxata. Dawn fis-sena 1720, kienu nġaqdu, u talbu lill-gran mastru Pereloos biex iġharraf-hom, u aktar tard kisbu altar fil-knisja ta' San Frangisk ta' Putirjal u ddedikaw lill-qaddisin Kosma u Damjan, imbagħad meta t-tobba intagħzlu mill-parrukkiera, dawn bdew jingħaqdu fil-knisja ta' Liesse, ix-xatt, u wara żmien marru fl-ora-torju tal-Gizwiti.

Id-dvernari, u l-koki, għal habta tas-sena 1620, kienu ngabru taht l-istandard ta' San Martin. Wieħed mill-istatuti tagħhom kien li nhar il-festa tan-nawfragju, l-imsieħba tal-kumpanija ta' San Martin kellhom idoqqu l-qniepen tal-parroċċa, u wara żmien dabbru l-kappella ta' San Martin.

Kien hemm ukoll l-għaqda tal-gjollieri, u dawn kellhom l-altar ta' Santa Liena fil-parroċċa ta' San Pawl ukoll. Hemm hafna għaqdiet oħra x'insemmu, iżda ż-żmien ma għandniex. Dawn kienu l-għaqdiet li żammew kburi isimhom u isem Malta, għax fil-għaqda hemm is-sahħa. J'alla l-għaqdiet li għandna fi żmienna jissoktaw ikabbru isem dawk ta' qabilhom, f'gieħ art twelidna.

L-ARMI TAL-PULIZIJA

minn Edward Attard

B'effett mill-1 ta' Jannar 1984 kien hemm tibdil fl-arma tal-Korp tal-Pulizija u dan wassalni nippubblika dan l-artiklu fejn jidhru wkoll ritratti u infurmazzjonijiet ohra dwar l-armi li kellu l-Korp f'dawn l-aħħar mija u sebghin sena.

Kif kien intqal f'artiklu dwar l-uniformijiet tal-Pulizija, fl-ewwel żminijiet tal-Korp, il-Pulizija ma kienux jilbsu uniformi u naturalment lanqas brieret jew elmijiet. L-ewwel uniformi u naturalment L-ewwel uniformijiet x'aktarx dehru fl-1839 meta kienet tintlibes gakketta twila u tomna li fuqha ma kienet titwahhal l-ebda arma. L-istess gara fl-Ingilterra u għalkemm il-Korp tal-Pulizija Ingliz twaqqaf fl-1829, l-ewwel arma dehret fl-1856 fuq l-elm u iswed li speci tiegħu għadu jintlibes sal-lum.

L-EWWEL ARMA

F'Malta għandna indikazzjonijiet li l-ewwel arma tal-Pulizija dahlet xi żmien wara l-1856 u kellha forma tonda, tal-metall, għalkemm mizbugħa sewda, bil-kliem MALTA POLICE FORCE madwarha u fin-nofs tagħha kienu jehlu n-numri ta' identifikazzjoni tal-membri tal-Korp. Din l-arma kellha l-kuruna li kif jidher fir-ritratt hija kuruna tar-Regina. Tajjeb wiehed iġid li matul iż-żmien li Malta kienet kolonja l-armi kollha kellhom il-kuruna, iżda din tvarja minn dik tar-re għal dik tar-regina kif jidher aktar 'il quddiem. Għalkemm jeżistu xi ftit minn din ix-xorta ta' armi għand il-kollezzjonisti, iżda għadni qatt ma rajt xi ritratt, pitura, jew incizjoni fejn jidher xi membru tal-Korp liebes beritta b'din l-arma.

IT-TIENI ARMA

Din dahlet x'aktarx fl-1878 u kienet tal-bronz u hija l-ewwel minn hafna armi li għandha s-salib ta' San Gwann (Eight pointed Cross) li se nibqgħu nsibuh kwazi fost l-armi kollha li gejjin.

Din l-arma kienet tintlibes fuq elmu abjad ta' għamla differenti

milbus illum f'xi ċerimonji. L-arma hija tal-bronż ta' daqs ta' 8 cm b'6 cm u tigbor fiha l-ewwel arma saħansitra l-istess kliem (Malta Police Force) u madwarha hemm, kif diġà ntqal, is-salib ta' San Gwann. Fuq is-salib hemm il-kuruna li hija wkoll 'Queen's crown'. Infakkru li f'dawn iż-żmienijiet ir-Reġina Vittoria kienet ir-reġina ta' l-Ingilterra.

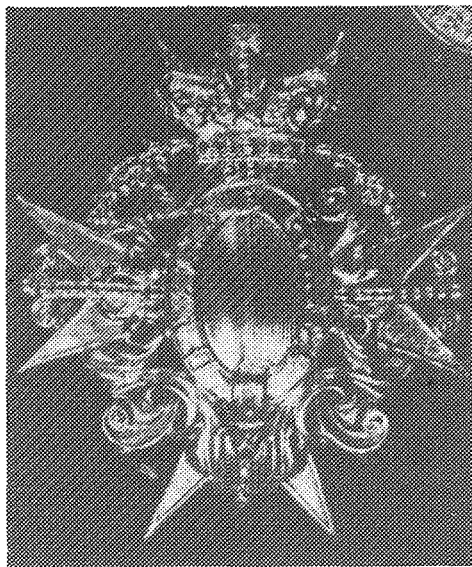
IT-TIELET ARMA

DELEGATION

by John de Gray

Definition

Delegation may be defined as the channelling of work, coupled with corresponding amounts of responsibility and authority, from superiors to subordinates for effective execution.

'Delegate' comes from the Latin 'delegare' and means to trust or commit to some one else. The word is only used where the trust or commission is placed with the right to withdraw it. It therefore implies a level of control. Total abdication of responsibility and authority is not delegation.

Responsibility is the corollary of delegation; once authority is delegated the subordinate becomes responsible to the delegator for the proper exercise of that authority. Although responsibility has been created by delegation, the delegator has not divested himself of his own responsibility to his superiors. Responsibility, therefore, cannot be delegated.

How to delegate

When delegating authority, it is necessary for the limits of that authority to be clearly defined, preferably in writing, what is to be done and by whom. It is not always possible to define the field accurately.

The definition of the field of authority may be a full written specification, expressed verbally or established by custom. One must bear in mind that to delegate to the lowest competent level means economical delegation. Delegation is a continuous process and the delegator must keep himself informed about the work he has delegated. He must correct and explain errors as soon as possible, but without discouraging his staff.

The degree to which a man can successfully delegate to a subordinate depends upon the capability of the subordinate, the complexity of the work, and the importance of the decisions. Ideally, the degree of delegation should be expanded according to the subordinate's ability. Conversely, until the running-in process has been completed and the subordinate's capacity established, delegation should be restricted. During this period his object should be to get to know his

boss's mind through informal contact.

It is not wise to allow a member of an organisation to derive authority from **two** superiors, as the exercise of those authorities may conflict. For this reason a simple chain of command in which one member has only one immediate superior is preferable. Delegation is influenced by span of control. The greater the span, the smaller the portion of authority which can be delegated to each subordinate, and the more complete this delegation has to be since there is less time available for the control of these subordinates.

Why delegate?

The reasons for delegation are numerous and varied and there I mention only some of the more important ones:

If a man and his subordinate are separated by distance it is necessary to delegate more completely, so that quick decisions may be taken on the spot;

When the superior is likely to be absent or working at different times of the day, delegation is essential;

It is essential that the same question receives the same answer at different times and places;

The work load is greater than one man can cope with;

It enables decisions, in the main to be taken by those who are best suited to take them and closest to relevant facts;

Delegation develops staff and encourages initiative; (Delegation should therefore slightly over-extend the present capabilities of the staff)

To build morale by increasing job satisfaction and expressing the trust the superior has in his subordinate;

Finally, delegation provides a valuable method of training personnel to fill positions with considerable authority;

Thus a man can practise the exercise of increasing amounts of authority and responsibility as he is promoted. IF this is done adequately, there should be no difficulty in filling the top positions when the time arrives.

Difficulties of delegating

Many men who are competent in every other respect are unable

to delegate. This failing is a barrier to their own progress, a frustration to their subordinates and a hindrance to their organisation.

The causes may be varied: —

lack of trust in their subordinates: the belief that they can do things better;

fear of rivalry; when one is afraid of someone else taking credit, or of admitting that others know more than them, or can do things better, or of a subordinate getting ahead too fast;

fear of loss of control over their subordinates, vanity and perfectionism.

Difficulties can also be caused by the subordinate. Intellectual arrogance may appear when a subordinate has academic qualifications and expects to by-pass his superior who has no such qualifications. Difficulties may also arise when the subordinate is older and more experienced though less able than his superior. In such cases he tends to resent and resist changes. Here the removal by transfer of the subordinate may be necessary.

What to delegate

A good manager should delegate anything that somebody else in his organisation can do better than him, by taking advantage of men with more knowledge and experience than him in certain aspects of work, or at less expense and with better timing. The less than ideal solution at the right time is better than the otherwise ideal solution at the wrong time.

On the other hand there are things which a manager must **never** delegate. These are things which only he can do; including overall policy, overall planning, selection, appointment and discipline of immediate subordinates.

Conclusion

Leadership is not either authoritarian or democratic. There are various possibilities: tells, sells, tests, consults, joins. The one selected will depend not only on the capabilities of the manager, but also on the type of subordinates he has and on the situation in which the decision is taken.

PARK, WALK AND TALK *by Philip H. Schnabel,*

Chief of Police, Rocky Hill Police Dept.

"I never see a police officer."

"The police are never there when you need them."

"The police zip by in their cruisers without even a passing glance."

How often have police administrators been subjected to such comments! Unfortunately, even though statistics and computer printouts illustrate that police are properly deployed and that calls are answered expeditiously, citizens remain uniformly unimpressed.

Balance a public disgruntled at what they perceive to be a lack of police presence with a cost-conscious city administration and what does the police chief face — grief, an impossible situation, being caught between a rock and a hard place. Police chiefs of departments in widely varying areas of the country are aware of the astounding similarity of citizen and city council dissatisfaction with the lack of police visibility. Yet, how do you increase police presence in the community without a massive depletion of the police budget? One such programme which bridges the gap between cruiser and foot patrol is "park, walk, and talk."

In most instances, a park, walk, and talk programme can be established and refined with dramatic results. However, failure and lack of effectiveness can also result.

The park, walk, and talk concept was introduced in the New York City Police Department because the commissioner had strong feelings about getting police officers out of their cruisers and into direct contact with citizens, especially in minority neighbourhoods. A "directed patrol" plan was formulated to take advantage of an estimated 70 percent of the average officer's uncommitted patrol time. The concept was launched with considerable publicity, and to ensure the programme's success, supervisors on patrol were deployed to guarantee officers compiled with the operation. Yet, several pitfalls developed. The directed times for foot patrol were often in conflict

with calls for services. Officers in high-activity minority districts never had time to participate because they were continually dispatched on minor assignments. Within a short period of time the plan ceased to function through inattentiveness and lack of followup. In addition, since operational supervisors had no input in establishing the plan and had not been given a philosophical back ground on the plan prior to its implementation, many displayed a distinct lack of interest or indifference.

Police officers also believed they had been left out of the process. Yet, these officers were expected to create a new image for law enforcement through their personal interaction with citizens, many of whom were apathetic to any type of contact with the police.

There is no doubt that the commissioner's idea was an outstanding method for providing high police objectives. However, the key was to get the officers who were going to carry out the programme involved and interested in its success as well as in its development. The officers had to be convinced that the programme would benefit them personally, as well as gain support for larger objectives.

In a large department, development, coordination, and deployment in a park, walk, and talk programme is naturally difficult, but not insurmountable if given sustained attention and followup. To develop an effective programme in a smaller agency is considerably easier; however, the pitfalls faced are still present to a certain degree.

Line officers should be given an opportunity to voice their ideas and criticisms in the initial planning stage. They should be asked to suggest likely patrol areas for the park, walk, and talk concept, as well as times that such patrol activities could achieve the greatest possibility of effectiveness. Dispatchers should be familiar with the objectives of the programme and should interrupt assignments only for major

calls.

Officers can participate in the evaluation of the concept, conveying what they perceive the reaction to their presence will be. Naturally, the caliber and professional orientation of the patrol officers in the department will affect the programme's effectiveness. If the agency has a significant number of militant officers, encouraging such individuals to interact with citizens on a personal basis may, in fact, result in a lowered level of community support. In such a case, there must be an intensive orientation programme for all officers. Unfortunately, many agencies will recognise such a problem as being applicable to their operation, but with better preparation, positive peer pressure will develop. Certain officer will still try to undermine the programme and use their expanded on-duty personal contacts with citizens to downgrade the department. However, informed, interested, and involved officers meeting.

A determination must be made as whether to structure patrol patterns rigidly or allow flexibility. Where the concept is initially resisted, the natural reaction of an administrator determined to see the plan succeed is to define time and area deployment precisely and to direct rigid supervision so that reluctant subordinates realise that the programme will succeed. Such a technique is actually counterproductive. Even though lapses may initially occur, it is far better to provide broad operational guidelines for the officers to follow. Some marginal officers may side by in the formative period, but as the programme becomes accepted and citizens expect to see officers in various locations, the officers themselves will begin looking forward to the increased attention the "line cop" receives from the public.

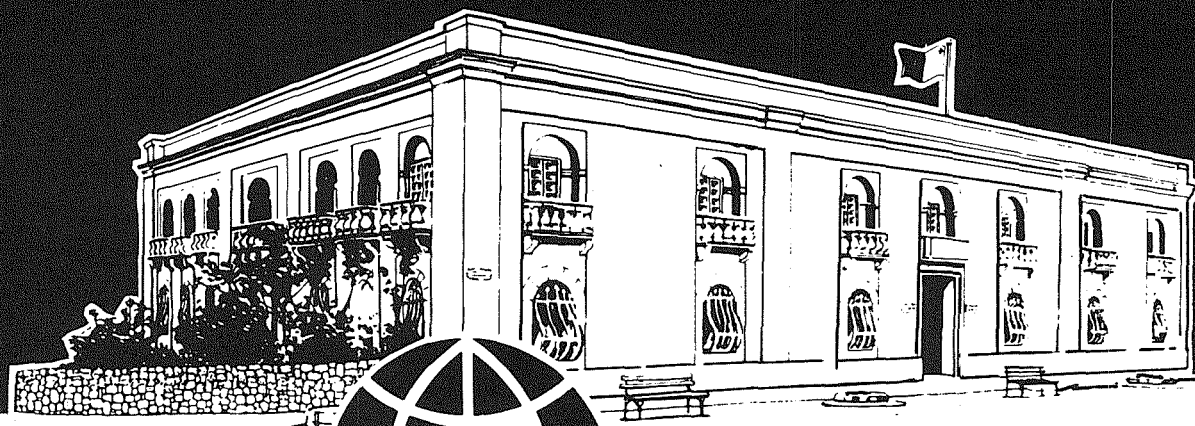
As the programme develops, citizens begin to look upon the police as fellow human beings, but as dehumanised, insensitive individuals they may perceive them to be. Also, police officers

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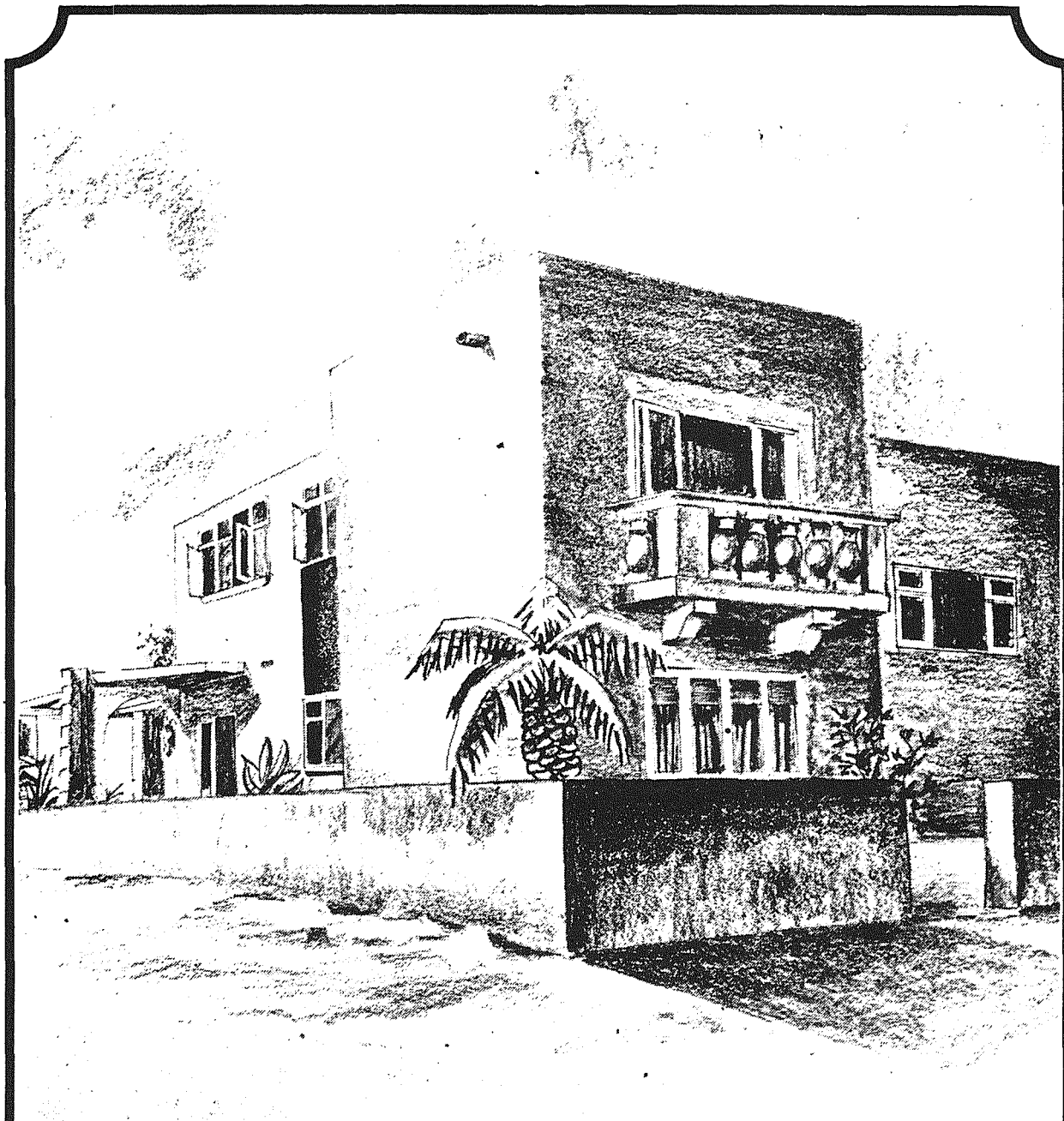
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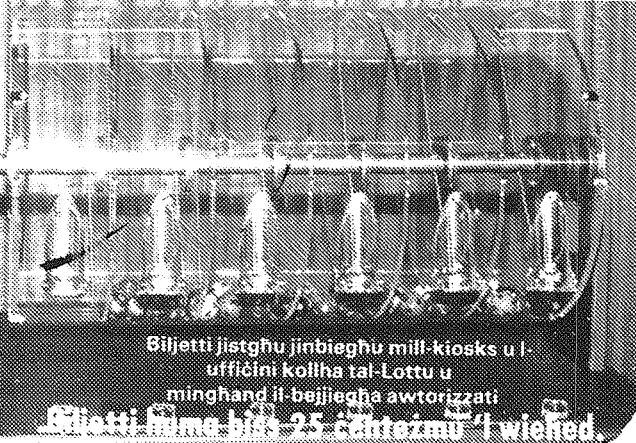

regain the knowledge that the public is composed of persons who are sympathetic and supportive of the goals of professional law enforcement and increased benefits for "their" officers.

By increasing police visibility, the park, walk, and talk programme provides a measure for crime deterrence. More important, however, it increases a feeling of security in the average citizen where personal contact with the police may have never occurred or which may have taken place in a negative setting.

Freedback should be encouraged. Comments should be sought from officers, supervisors, politicians, and the public. Merchants in the downtown area are particularly impressed and expressed support and appreciation for the programme. They credit the recent decline in shoplifting, harassment, and loitering to increased police presence in the business district. One proprietor stated, "There is more of a feeling of law and order downtown." Another commented that the walk and talk patrols make people feel safer. "The public's attitude has changed - they feel more secure." To date, the reaction has been uniformly enthusiastic, until some areas begin to note that their neighbourhood is not receiving the same coverage as others. It is important to keep the plan flexible and to consider such comments as constructive criticism. This dramatically illustrates that the objectives of the programme are being realised and that more people want to get involved. Increased coverage can be gained by paring time devoted to each location from 30 minutes to 15 minutes.

Another byproduct of the programme is reduced gas consumption. With the park, walk, and talk programme targeted at a minimum for 2 hours of foot patrol per 8-hour shift, there is a considerable reduction in fuel usage.

The strict admonishment with which every foot patrol officer is painfully aware - "Stay out on the street" - is not a desirable facet of the programme, but some restriction must be exercised. A recommended format is

to divide the jurisdiction into business and residential beats, each of which should be covered by the patrol officer during his shift. On business beats, officers should be encouraged to visit with proprietors and customers in their establishments. However, on residential patrols, obvious complications could result from officers visiting citizens in their homes during various periods of the day. Therefore, as a general guideline, officers on residential assignments should not enter a citizen's residence without prior knowledge and approval of a supervisor.

To ensure success, supervisory personnel should be brought into the programme during the planning stage, as are patrol officers, and should be afforded considerable input prior to implementation. Supervisors must be assured that a flexible supervisory style is a critical element of the concept.

Such flexibility might include allowing assignment time and are to be at the discretion of the officer, as long as the assignment is covered during designed portions of the shift. It may also be necessary to curtail part, walk, and talk assignments during inclement weather.

Of course, periodic evaluation of all aspects of the operation is critical to maintain enthusiasm and to take into account fluctuating community needs. A park, walk, and talk programme uses the knowledge and experience of officers involved, employs a flexible supervisory style, and encourages input from the officers and citizens. While subject to review and modification, it can "bridge the gap" not only between cruiser and foot patrol but also between police officers and the citizens they are sworn to protect.

MARINE FRAUDSTERS WAIVE THE RULES

Time charter, hired for a period, or bareboat charter, for a given period with responsibility for crew provisions, and bunkering. Most charter parties are straight forward business arrangements, made along well tried lines. Much of trade has developed a standard charter party document suitable for its own purpose. Not all charterers are people with goods to transport, because in this, as in any other form of commerce, there are opportunities for profit available to the entrepreneur. Until 1970, one might have thought fraud with a bareboat charter most unlikely. The cost of chartering a vessel is very high, but in these days, it is becoming clear that the scale of maritime crime is much higher than believed, and funds are found to finance fraud on a massive scale. In 1979/80 one country reported losses of £30 million in charter party frauds.

Cargo theft in the marine fraud category is not the kind of pilferage one associates with losses taking place during the loading and unloading of vessels in ports. Cargo theft in marine fraud means misappropriation of the whole or part of the ship's cargo. The dishonest owner loads a valuable cargo, issues Bills of Lading to a nominated port, the ship is diverted to another port, the name changed with a paint brush, and the cargo discharged and sold at the quay side. The vessel will then sail, having put the name back, and the missing goods are placed in dispute. The losers in most cases being the insurers. It is difficult to believe that this type of crime could happen in the 1980's but it does and frequently.

Linked with cargo theft is piracy, not by false documents but by armed raids on ships. Between 1980 and 1982, there were 30 cases of armed pirates in fast motor boats raiding vessels, holding up the crews and stealing vast amounts of cargo. These inci-

dents were mainly in Africa and the Middle and Far East. Pressure has been put on the authorities in these areas to combat this crime with armed police patrols and fast motor launches, and this is having good effect.

Scuttling is generally regarded as the oldest form of marine fraud "Willful casting away of a vessel". Early scuttlings were essentially Hull Frauds. Vessels in ballast or low value cargo – unsophisticated, a far cry from the present clever, cunning schemes culminating in the infamous but ingenious case of the supertanker "Salem". This \$35 million fraud took place in December 1979 and was the largest fraud in history, hitting the headlines world wide. The story is well known, the group of fraudsmen purchased the Salem, oil which had not been paid for was loaded at Kuwait, and then illegally sold to the South Africans in Durban. It was then alleged that the vessel and the cargo sank in the deep waters of the Atlantic.

Statements were taken from crew members to support the scuttling, stating that certain plates and covers had been removed from the Salem before she sank. The captain denies taking the ship into Durban, but the South African authorities admit buying the oil which was enough to keep the Republic going for 12 days. The perpetrators, who got away with \$35 million are known to the authorities, but because of extradition problems are most unlikely to be arrested or prosecuted. Where this case made headlines with the press and TV, other suspected scuttlings mainly in the Far East, hardly receive mention. Vessels suspected of deliberate scuttling are usually 15 or more years old, the property of small operators, and sailing under a Flag of Convenience.

Flags of Convenience, when under discussion, often develop with overtones of a sinister kind.

It has been suggested that if such 'Flags' were abolished, so would crime associated with carriage of goods by sea. Some support for this view may be gained from an analysis prepared by a leading cargo underwriter, of 52 known deliveries or mis-deliveries of cargo:

"An analysis of the 52 cases involved shows an interesting situation:

A. BY FLAG: Cyprus – 11 cases; Greece – 24 cases; Liberia – 2 cases; Panama – 15 cases.

B. BY AGE: 0-15 years – 9 cases; 15-20 years – 14 cases; 21-25 years – 17 cases; 26-30 years – 10 cases; 31-35 years – 2 cases.

C. BY GROSS: 501-2,500 – 5 cases; REGISTERED: 2,501-5,000 – 10 cases; TONNAGE: 5,001-7,500 – 15 cases; 7,501-10,000 – 16 cases; 10,001 and over – 6 cases.

Nearly all the cases where Panama flag vessels were concerned are in respect of ownership registered in the Far East. None of the reported cases can be attributed to vessels complying with the new 'regular pattern of trading' wording in the rems of the new Classification Clause or the so-called 'Liner' trading definition of the previous clause."

Over the past 20 years, terrorism involving ships and ports has been on the increase. Although not connected with maritime fraud, it is a very serious and disturbing problem. One associates terrorism with Embassies and airports. It is interesting to note that during the past two years, terrorist groups seized 14 ships, many attacks were by explosive devices, as a result, nine people died, over 60 were wounded and in most cases persons were kidnapped. A ship is the ideal base for terrorists. When the gangway is up, the ship becomes a fort, self-contained for weeks with food, water and

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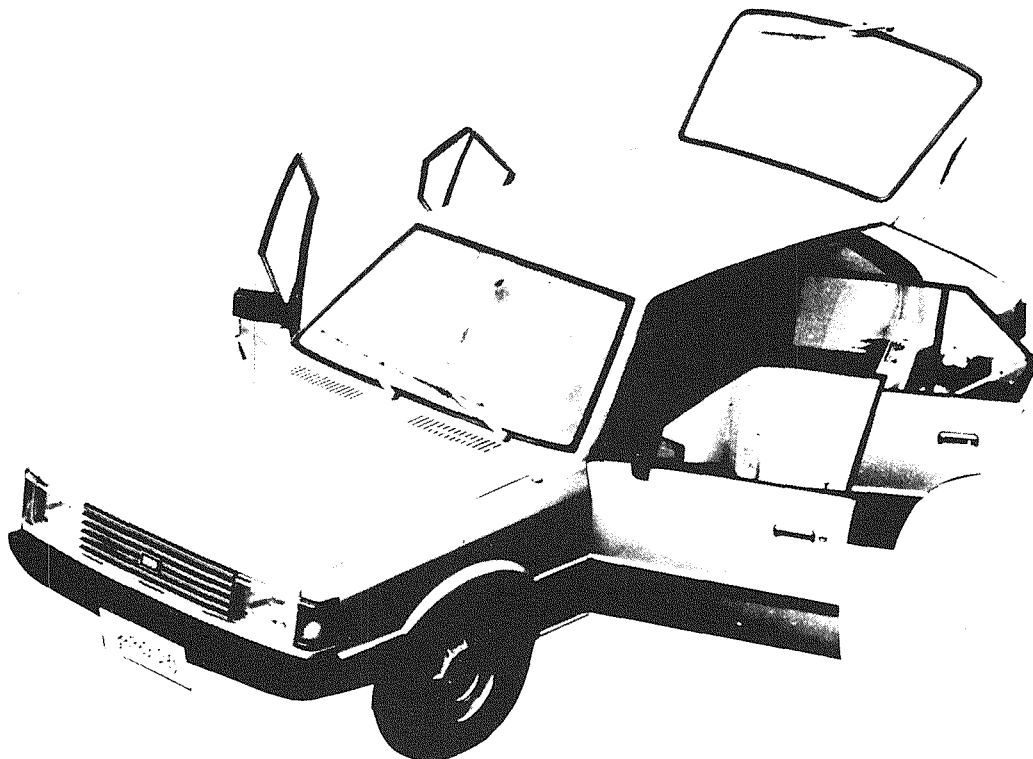
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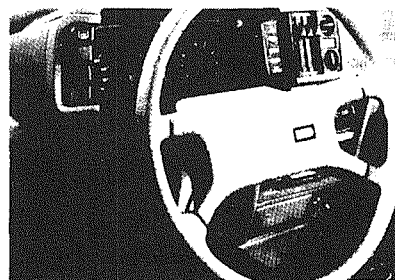

vomit, blood-stains or other suspicious articles. As far as the dead body is concerned, the expression and colour of the face, the position of the hands, the condition of the body-clothing as to tears and stains, the degree of rigidity or putrefaction and the presence of wounds should also be thoroughly observed. In view of this, it is therefore highly improper, to say the least, to remove the body or tamper with it before the magistrate conducts his on-the-spot inquiry or the **levée du corps** is carried out. In some instances it may well happen that unless certain tests are carried out during this examination, some very important data will be irretrievably lost. All investigating officers, be they police officers or medical experts or otherwise, are to be at all times fully aware of what is expected of them. Only in this way are the chances of any evidence being lost or destroyed considerably whittled down.

All the relevant material evidence gathered by the inquiring magistrate will form an integral part of a written comprehensive report drawn up by the said magistrate. This report is called the **procés-verbal**. This record of the inquest would also contain the various reports and documents submitted by the various judicial and technical experts appointed during the inquest as well as the findings of the inquiring magistrate. It is transmitted to the Attorney-General within three working days of its being drawn up in written form. It should finally be noted that the **procés-verbal**, if regularly drawn up, is deemed as evidence in a trial in that it is regarded as having a probative force.

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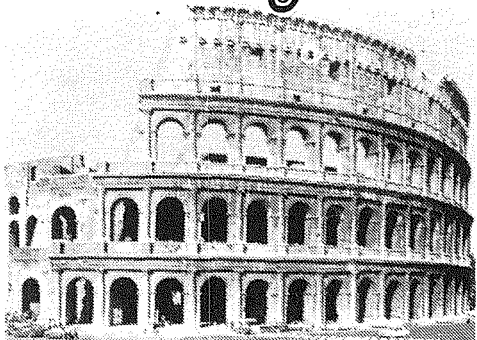
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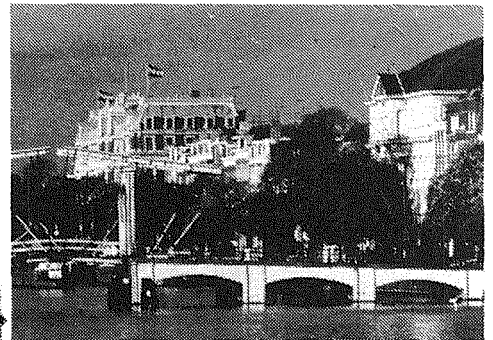

communications. During my service as the Chief Constable in the Port of London Police, we carried out exercises with specialist troops in the U.K. and abroad in an attempt to take a ship that had been seized and well-planned by mock terrorists. From the protection of armour, views from port holes, obstacles from masts, aerials, wires, and deck obstructions, it was found to be most difficult, nearly impossible to take the ship from air, quay or water side. Contingency plans by police, port authorities and shipping are now well laid in this directions.

Fraud prevention is the key as one can gather, detention and prosecution are most difficult.

Therefore, all parties should protect themselves by taking extreme care when dealing with unknown persons. A cargo owner should deal with respectable ship owners and charterers. Check with Lloyds' Register and Lloyds' Lists to establish class and capacity. The correct port at the time, and above all if the freight rate is too attractive. The single owner, age of the ship, the type of cargo and destination should also be closely studied. All sections of the marine industry should tighten procedures. Banks should encourage use of the Lloyds' Register, Shipping Index, check ownership, size and position of vessel at the time the Bill of Lading is dated. Documentary credit operations should be computerised and brought into line with modern business methods. We have seen headlines in our national newspapers such as:

"If banks were using their own money, they would have a different system." and also,

"Bankers' blindness." In the right against maritime fraud, these are being explored by governments, banks, shipping, insurance, commerce and police, during which time, maritime fraud will continue to flourish.

Some unsuspecting shipping or insurance or representative will be working away in his city office, while others are on their way to their homes, and a telex machine will chatter out this type of message:

"M/V SPACE ARRIVED DESTINATION — CONSIGNED AS LOCKER CARGO — 4 CASES OF SOLID GOLD BRACELETS — ON CUSTOMS' EXAMINATION IN PORT, FOUND TO CONTAIN BRACELETS OF YELLOW METAL. PLEASE ADVISE."

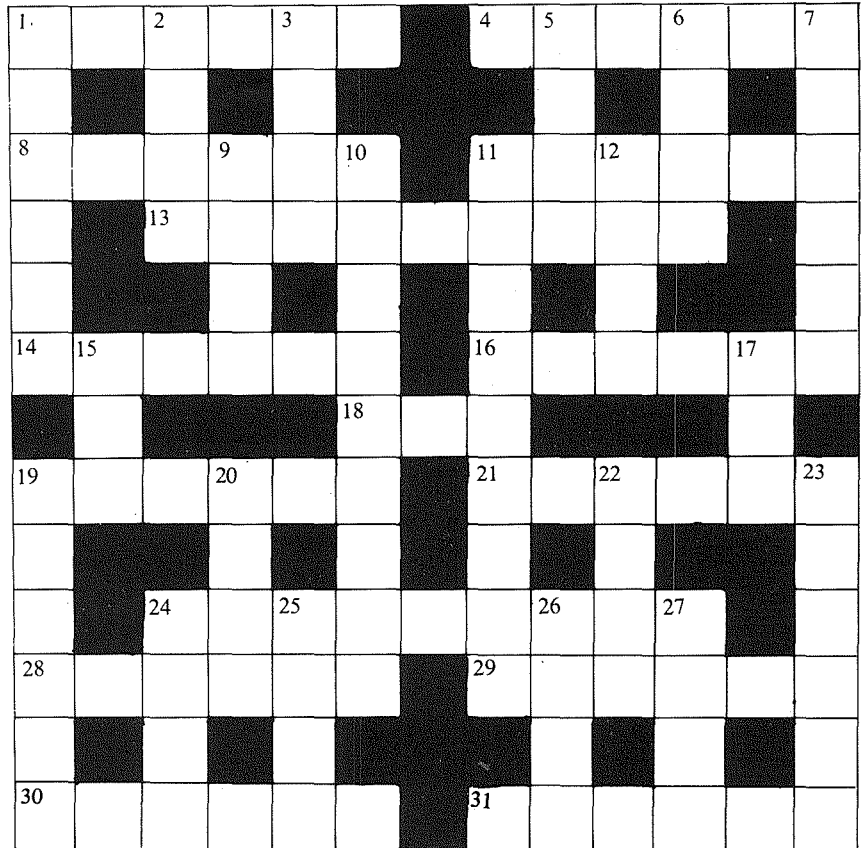

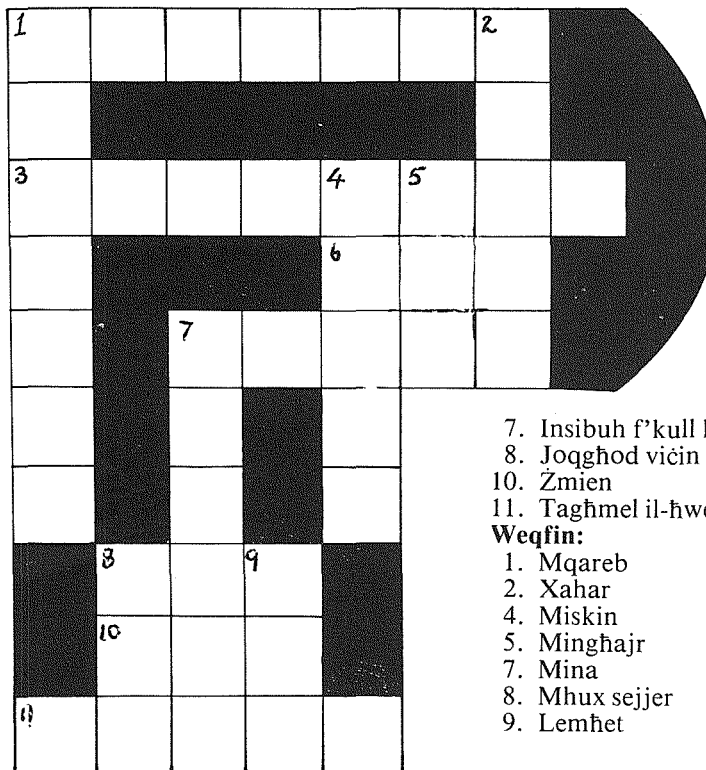

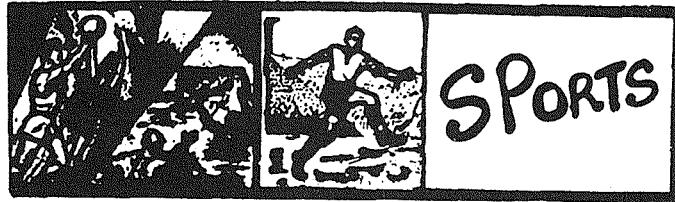
