DUTIES OF JUDGES

IN exercise of the powers conferred by Section 11 of the Code of Organization and Civil Procedure (Chapter 15), the President of Malta has directed that the following arrangements regarding the duties of Judges in the Superior Courts be effected as from 1st May, 1985.

Previous arrangements, in so far as they are incompatible with the present arrangements, will be revoked with effect from the same date. However, these arrangements do not preclude any Judge from sitting in any Court to which he had been assigned to dispose of cases postponed for judgment.

Civil Court, First Hall

The Hon. Mr Justice Wallace Gulia, B.A., LL.D., will sit in the Civil Court, First Hall.

Criminal Court

The Hon. Mr Justice Carmelo Scicluna, LL.D., will sit in the Criminal Court.
