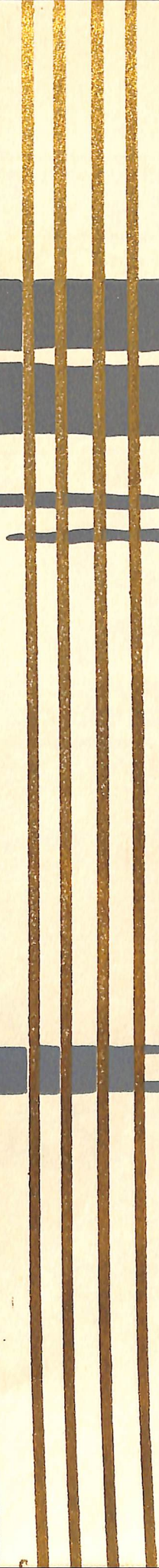

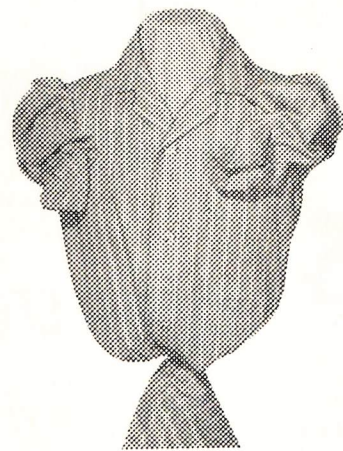

CYNTHIA TURNER

CYNTHIA TURNER, born in 1932, started her musical studies in Malta under the tuition of Miss Giovanna Bascetta. In 1949 she qualified for the Licenciate of the Royal Schools of Music, London, and was awarded a three year scholarship at the Royal Academy of Music, London, by the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music (London). In her second year at the Academy she graduated for the Licenciate of the Royal Academy of Music, and after completing her third year at the Academy, she entered for the music contest in Bayreuth, Germany, and was selected to take part in the final Concert.

In 1953 she took part in the International Music Competition in Munchen, Germany, as a result of which she was awarded a course of six months under the well-known Russian Professor Harbowski in Stuttgart, and later with Professor Rouoff in Munchen, and also with the Hungarian Chopin player, Julian Von Karolyi.

Cynthia Turner, who needs no introduction to the local audience, was chosen to represent Malta in a music programme broadcast by the B.B.C. in honour of H.M. the Queen's Commonwealth Tour. She has performed Tchaikowsky's B flat minor piano concerto with the Orchestra of the Commander-in-Chief under the baton of Maestro J. Sammut for the Malta Cultural Institute, and for the British Institute.

She has given several recitals for both these Institutes as well as at the Manoel Theatre, Overseas Club Malta and London, Admiralty House, F.B.S. Middle East, B.B.C. London, Radio Munchen and Radio Luxemburg.

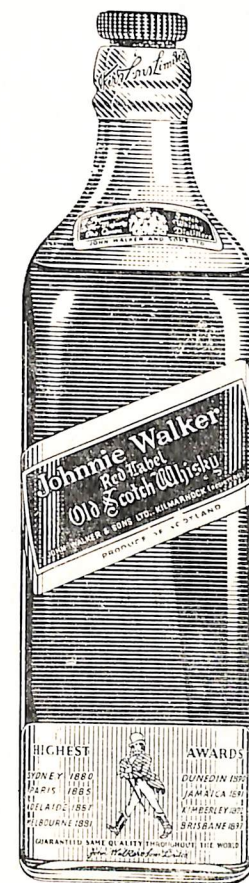
