




ANTHONY KIMMINS

Anthony Kimmins, the author of 'The Amorous Prawn' and of many other successful plays, has associations with Malta, the Manoel Theatre and the M.A.D.C. going back over 40 years. As Sub. Lieutenant A. Kimmins, R.N. he was a member of the M.A.D.C. in 1918-20, and ected in 'Raffles' at the Royal Opera House. He later produced a snappy revue at the Manoel Theatre called 'Suffering Wildcats'. For his chorus he chose the prettiest girls and, in fact, married one of them!

In 1932 Anthony Kimmins left the Royal Navy to take up play writing and film directing. Amongst his many successes are 'While Parents Sleep', 'Night Club Queen' and 'Chase the Ace', all of which he wrote. In addition he has written and directed a number of films for Fox-British.

In 1960, when he was visiting Malta, he saw the M.A.D.C. do 'Fools Rush in'. After the play he visited the cast back-stage, and told them all about the 'Prawn' which was at that time running in England, since when the M.A.D.C. has anxiously waited for this play to become available for amateur performances. In fact, this is the first amateur performance of this play, as Anthony Kimmins himself was instrumental in getting it released specially for his old club.
