When many of the present Fsobians were still pupils at Floriana School, they had succeeded in winning for two consecutive years — 1947 and 1948 — the First Prize of the Children's Drama Festival then organized by the Malta Drama League. Hence it is no wonder that when the idea of organising a National Children's Drama Festival was broached to them, they received it with great enthusiasm.

In giving shape and form to the idea the Fsobians enlisted the support of a number of public-spirited ladies and gentlemen — all drama lovers — foremost amongst whom Mr. Joe Zammit Cordina, an ardent Thespian himself, who assumed the duties of a clever and hard-working Hon. Secretary.

Cooperation came from all quarters. The Hon. Dr. A. Paris, M. D., Minister of Education, readily agreed' to our request to extend his Patronage to the Drama Festival. Chev. J. P. Vassallo, O.B.E., the Director of Education, received the idea enthusiastically and went to the extent of nominating his representative on the Organising Committee in the person of Miss M.
