## MALTA MEMORIAL DISTRICT NURSING ASSOCIATION

This Association was founded in 1946, by Captain Ingham with the help of many prominent people in Malta, as a living memorial to the Maltese and British Servicemen who lost their lives defending Malta and Gozo in the last war.

This is a voluntary Home Nursing service of fully trained Nursing Sisters, all of whom have done four years training in General and Midwifery nursing and six months specialised District training.

This nursing service is available to every family in Malta and Gozo whatever the social environment, but must be supported financially by the people of these Islands.

To enable every family to avail themselves of the service, the head of each family should join the contributory scheme by paying the very small amount of 10/- yearly and by supporting all social functions in aid of the M.M.D.N.A.
