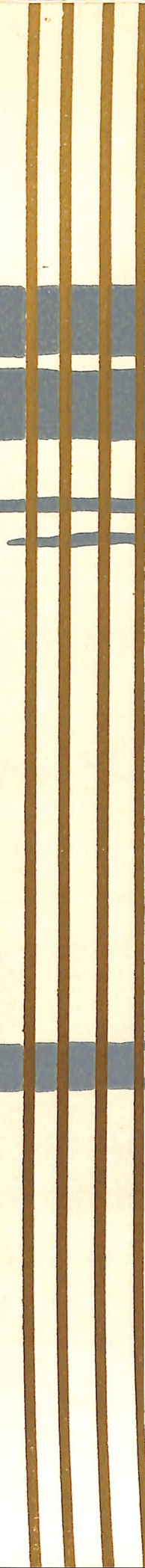

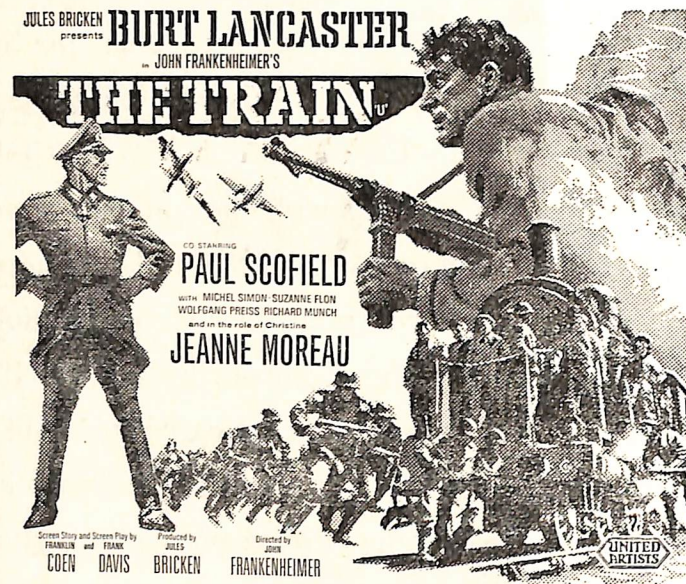
BRUCE WANSBURY will be leaving Malta in the New Year for an appointment in Singapore, and it is quite possible that this will be his last production for the Malta Amateur Dramatic Club. His association with the Club goes back to 1950 when he appeared in and assisted with the production of Noel Coward's "This Happy Breed". Since then he has acted in and produced a number of plays for the Club. Older members will remember his production of "An Inspector Calls", and his performance as the Compere in "1066 AND ALL THAT". During his recent spell of duty in Malta he appeared in "WITNESS FOR THE PROSECUTION", played SOTMORE the amiable drunk in "LOCK UP YOUR DAUGHTERS", and besides the current production gave us "THE LIGHT OF HEART", and "CHARLEY'S AUNT".

He has always been active in Service Drama, running the Service Players, a company formed to fill the gap left by the M.A.D.C. during the war, from 1948 until 1950. In 1964 he was in H.M.S. FALCON'S winning R.N. Drama Festival Team, ("PENNY FOR A SONG"), and this year produced the winning play in the first Inter-Service Drama Festival, H.M.S. FALCON'S "BREATH OF SPRING".
