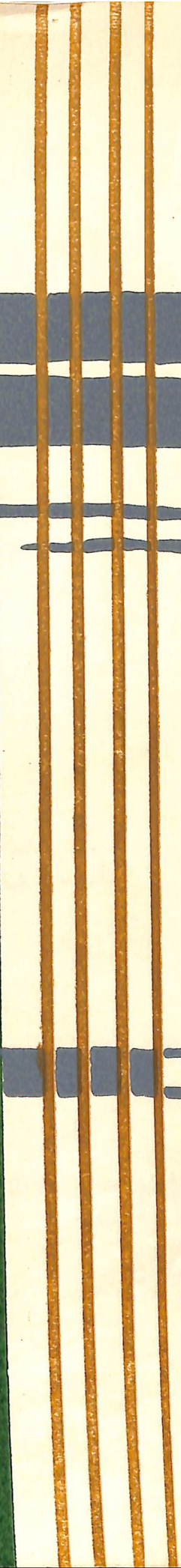

THE SEMINARY IN MALTA

The priest, today, must be adequately prepared to cope with the challenge which is being thrown down by our changing world.

Happily many are the people in our Island who are well interested in the life and in the needs of the group of young men — about ninety at the moment — who are looking forward to become priests in the Seminary of Malta. We do not have, and perhaps cannot have, a direct say in their training, but the great religious event of our times, Vatican Council II reminds us that new members to the priesthood are a collective responsibility of the Christian community.

In February 1962 a group of ladies was called at the Seminary in Floriana and they willingly agreed to start taking more particular and personal interest in the requirements of that all-important institution. They go by the name of "Dame del Seminario" and they are all ladies outstanding for their public spirit and for their zeal in Catholic activities in this Island. They are formed into five groups. The Bursary Group is the one that has organised to-days concert at the Manoel Theatre under the distinguished patronage of their Excellencies the Governor General and Lady Dorman. The purpose of the Concert is the raising up of funds for a Seminary Bursary for the benefit of needy seminarians.

It is to the merit of the Bursary Group of the Dame del Seminario that a perpetual bursary has already been founded and funds have been raised for a more updated education of our future priests.

Through your generous support and the hard work of a number of lay people the Seminary can step out into another year, continuing to move and keep up with modern trends.
