DAPHNE LUNGARO

This is the fifth appearance of Daphne Lungaro and Her Pupils at this Theatre since April, 1966.

After having studied dancing for seven years at Grandison College in England and after having qualified for Membership (Advanced Certificate) of The Royal Academy of Dancing and the Associateship (Advanced Certificate) of The Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing, Daphne Lungaro returned to Malta in July, 1965 to teach Classical Ballet, Stage Dancing, National Dancing, Social Ballroom and Mime.

Whilst in England Daphne Lungaro had the honour to be chosen as the leading dancer in Pantomine in 1963 with Norman Wisdom and to dance in the "Sunshine Matinee" at The Theatre Royal, Drury Lane, London in 1965 together with Beryl Grey, Bryan Ashbridge, Yelena Riabinkina, Alexander Bagok, Solveig Ostergaard, Niels Kehlet, Ludmila Vlasova and Stanislav Vlasov.

Daphne Lungaro's aim, in Malta, is to discover talented children and give them the benefit of her extensive training and professional stage experience acquired in the United Kingdom.

Examiners from The Royal Academy of Dancing in London visit Malta each year to examine her pupils.


