


A NOTE ON THE PLAY

A Boston Story is based on a Henry James novel "Watch and Ward" written as a serial in 1870. The novel's title derives from a famous group in Boston known as "The Watch and Ward Society", whose purpose it was to keep an eve on public behaviour and private morals.

It is interesting, in our modern more liberal society, to find that the novel very narrowly escaped censorship by these people. Even modern American editors have compared it with "Lolita" or spoken of it as 'strewn with images so palpably erotic that the gentle Henry must have been reading too many French novels.'

Ronald Gow in his brilliant adaption of the novel into a play hoped that "playgoers would not consider themselves so morally endangered"!

The present audience will, I hope, find in it all the eloquence, wit and charm which made it such a success in London in 1968.
