THE MAN WHO CAME TO DINNER

This p'ay, a high comedy, was produced originally in 1939, firstly in New York and then afterwards in London.

I have decided to let the play remain in its original period so a lot of the characters who are mentioned in various conversations have long since died but as so many of them are American, the audience will not be bewildered by this and I am sure that no difficulty whatsoever will be found by anyone in following what is going on.

It is without question a 'situation comedy' and is riotously funny. It has in fact become a classic of its time. With a cast of some thirty people the production has not been easy particularly as there are so many amusing situations and I have felt it necessary to concentrate on speed and, right from the moment the curtain goes up, speed is indeed the essence of the whole play.

The authors, Moss Hart and George S. Kaufman, need no introduction as they have written many famous plays and musicals. Alexander Woolcott, on whose life the play is based, and who died in 1943, was a very famous journalist and broadcaster and was a legend in his time.




