

Membership is open to all service personnel, UK based civilians and their families. The club meets in the station theatre at RAF Hal Far and is always pleased to welcome new members. It is our aim to present at least two productions per year at Hal Far as well as the annual pantomime at the Manoel Theatre. The next play will be our entry for the 1973 Near East Air Force Drama Festival in March, and preparations for this are already well under way. The club were the winners of the Festival in 1971, the last occasion they entered, and we shall hope and work for an 'encore' this year.

Meanwhile, we'come to our Christmas pantomime. This traditional entertainment evolved from the dances of Arlequins at the Paris fairs in the late 17th century. It then developed through fashionable burlesques or extravaganzas to the strong comedy of the Victorian pantomime and so to the pattern we know today. This year we present 'Ali Baba and the Forty Thieves', one of the best known tales of the Arabian Nights. It is perhaps as well that Scheherazade herself cannot be here to witness the liberties we have taken with her well-loved story, but we trust that our version will at least give as much pleasure as the original obviously did.




