- Last year we celebrated 25 years since the Junior College opened its doors in 1995.

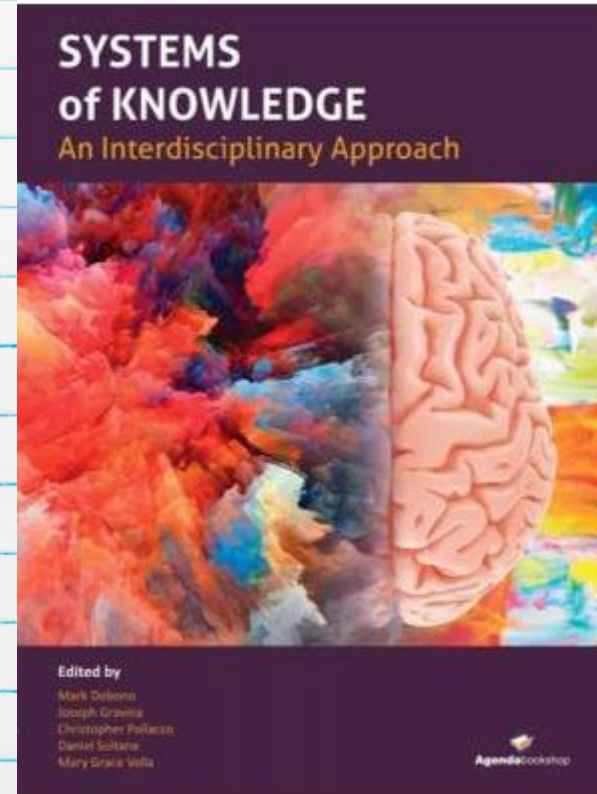
