

Suise Joseella?

SAVERINO GAZZELLONI is a world renowned flutist who had given many concerts. He is a professor at the Conservatory of Music of St. Cecilia in Rome and at the Chigiana Academy of Siena, he also teaches post-graduate classes in various countries of the world A great number of modern composers have written for him about 135 pieces, both chamber and with orchestra. He has been awarded eleven "Gran Prix du Disque" for his many recordings. He has also obtained important acknowlegements both national and international for his interpretations which vary from baroque to modern music.

Bruno Canino who for some years appears with Gazzelloni as his pianoforte accompanist was born in Naples and finished his musical studies at the Milan Conservatory, where he received a degree in piano in 1955 and in composition in 1960. As a pianist he won prizes in Bolzano, Florence and Darmstadt, where he excelled in the performance of contemporary music. His compositions have been played at the International Festival of Venice, at the "Ferienkurse" of Darmstadt and elsewhere.

SONATA IN C MAJ. No. 2 OP. 13 — PASTOR FIDO

VIVALDI

Preludio — Allegro vivace — sarabande — allegro

Antonio Vivaldi was born about 1676 or 1679 and died in Vienna in 1741. He is closely identified with Venice by reasons of birth, upbringing and place of residence. His father Giovanni Battista Vivaldi was a violinist at St. Mark's and so Antonio's instruction in the same instrument fellowed as a matter of course. He was a pupil of Legrenzi, Maestro di cappella at St. Mark. He became a noted violinist and a popular composer. Bach's contemporary and in some respects his model as to his composition for strings is most noted for his concertos for string, oboe and flute. He also composed a number of operas.

SONATA IN G MAJ. No. 2 FOR FLUTE AND PIANO

HAYDN

Allegro molto — andante — allegro vivace

Joseph Haydn was born in 1732 at Rohran. He was born of poor parents, the second of a family of twelve. Although the great composer suffered many hardships in his early years, his life on the whole, was one of genuine happiness, and his bright cheerful spirit can be traced n his music. Haydn is known as the father of the modern orchestra and founder of the modern symphony and sonata form. As a musician he played violin, harpsichord, pianoforte and organ. He was also a fine tenor singer.

SONATA IN C FOR FLUTE AND PIANO

DONIZETTI

Largo — Allegro

Gaetano Donizetti was born in 1797 at Bergamo. He was educated at Naples and known as a notable composer of Operas. He composed instrument music and about sixty operas, which

were performed all over the world. His melodies were attractive and they demanded capable singers in a period when opera was above all an exhibition of vocal tone and technique. He died in Bergamo at the age of fifty.

MADERNA

Bruno Maderna, an Italian composer, was born in 1920. He was a pupil of Scherchen. He is a composer of modern music including electronic music. He is also a conductor.

SERENADE IN D MAJOR OP. 41 FOR FLUTE AND PIANO BEETHOVEN

Allegro — tempo di minuetto — molto allegro — andante con variazioni — allegro scherzante e vivace — adagio — allegro vivace disinvolto

Ludwig Van Beethoven was born at Bonn in 1770. He was the son of a tenor singer. When he was twelve years old he got the post of accompanist in the electoral theatre. In 1795 he appeared at a public concert in Vienna playing on his first real appearance as a composer and performer in early concerto. His music has been divided into three different styles. He perfected the sonata in a different method from that of any previous composer. Almost painfully show in the composition of his works the whole of any piece forms such a closely woven network of music.




