



Act !

A Morning prayer to the God Melkart announces the dawn of another busy day to the Phoenician colony settled in Maleth.

Zolla, an old spinster, is telling Mahbuba, her adopted daughter, how she had found her one day near the Temple, and the latter expresses her ardent desire to discover who her parents were.

Miftakar, Zolla's brother, returns home from a long voyage, laden with beautiful gifts. Mahbuba listens spellbound to Miftakar's story of how the Phoenician vessels had reached the shores of Britain.

Zolla is alarmed at the news that her brother had invited to dinner two wealthy young Phoenicians, Abdosir and Osirxamar, as she is afraid that Mahbuba might fall in love with one of them and thus be separated from her.

In the meantime, Brabani, who secretly has set his heart upon Mahbuba's charms, pays them an unexpected visit and he tries most cunningly to persuade the girl to become a priestess. Mahbuba very reluctantly consents and Brabani goes back to the Temple to make the necessary preparations for her investiture.

Miftakar returns with his guests, and as soon as Mahbuba sets her eyes on Abdosir, she falls in love with him, but unluckily she has to leave immediately with the Priestesses sent by the High Priest to escort her to the Temple.

Act II

Mahbuba's investiture takes place in that part of the Temple normally reserved for Fibiarte, the diviner. Now that Mahbuba has become Meikart's Chief Priestess, Brabani loses no time to make known to her his desire of her becoming his paramour. The girl is shocked and she declares her love for Abdosir, who appears to her imagination as a God.

On finding Mahbuba in her place, Fibiarte the diviner busts into a rage, but after hearing Mahbuba's story she thinks that now the time had come to avenge herself for all the sufferings that embittered her life through the High Priest's wrongdoings.

Zolla, Miftaker, Osirxamar and Abdosir rush breathlessly into the Temple in search of Mahbuba and when they find her they run away with her, aided by Fibiarte.

Att III

The High Priest, Brabani, who has found out Mahbuba's escape, has already given orders for her search and capture.

Osirxamar and Abdosir are the first two suspects brought before the High Priest; Miftakar is the next one, followed by Fibiarte who challenges him to convoke a general council and when all are assembled, Fibiarte accuses him of having murdered the young priestess who was held as the Daughter of the Goddess Astarte (but who was in truth Fibiarte's own daughter) for having resisted him when he tried to seduce her. The diviner, who had found her daughter's body, embalmed it and hid it under the altar slab, now removes the frontal to prove her accusation.

Than Fibiarte fetches Mahbuba, from her hiding place, thus clearing herself of the crime, Brabani had impeached her with.

Mahbuba, on seeing Abdosir runs to him. Brabani very ironically reminds her that once she had become Melkart's Chief Priestess she could never marry her beloved.

Mahbuba instinctively seizes the sacred knife and stabs the High Priest to death. Fibiarte discloses the secret that the High Priest was Mahbuba's father, then she tells Mahbuba that after having committed such a crime she was now free from her yows and could marry Abdosir.

L-ewwel Att.

lt-talba ta' filghodu lil Alla Melkart thabbar iż-żernieg ta' jum iehor fil-hajja biżla tal-Kolonja Fenicja li qed tghammar f-Maleth.

Zolla, xebba imdaħħla fiż-żmien, qiegħda tirrakkonta lil-Mahbuba kif jum wiehed kienet sabitha mitlufa fejn il-Maqdes u rabbietha, u t-tfajla turi xewqitha li ssir taf min kienu ommha u missierha.

Miftakar, hu Zolla, jasal lura minn vjaģģ twil mgħobbi b'ħafna rigali sbieħ, u Mahbuba tghoqod tisimghu, imsahhra, jghidilhom kif il bastimenti Fenici kien irnexxilhom jaslu sax-xtut tal-Ingilterra.

Malli Zolla tisma li huwa kien stieden ghal-ikel żewġ żghażagh ghonja Fenici, Abdosir u Osirxamar, tibda tithasseb li Mahbuba kellha mnejn thobb xi wiehed minnhom u b'hekk titlifha.

Sadattant Brabani il-Qassis il-Kbir, li bil-mohbi kien xehet ghajnejh fuq Mahbuba, ighamlilhom zjara ghal gharrieda biex igiel lit-tfajla issir is-Sacerdotessa ewlenija ta' Melkart. Maħbuba tghid iva kontra qalba u Brabani jerġa lura fil-Maqdes biex iħejji kollox għal-vestizzjoni tagħha.

Jerga lura Miftakar mal-mistidnin tieghu, u kif ghajnejn Mahbuba u Abdosir jiltaqghu, iż-żewg żghażagh isiru ihobbu lil xulxin, iżda fl-istess waqt jaslu s-Sacerdotessi biex jiehdu lil-Mahbuba fil-Maqdes.

Il-vestizzioni ta' Mahbuba issir f'dik il-parti tal-Maqdes fejn soltu Fibiarte kienet dbassar it-twegibiet ta' Melkart. Malli Mahbuba issir is-Sacerdotessa ewlenija ta' Melkart, Brabani minnufieh jurija ix-xewqat hajna tieghu; hi thossa imrexa u tistqarr imnabbitha ghal Abdosir. Imghaddab ghalija, Brabani jheddidha u jwissiha biex ma tmurx kontra r-rieda tieghu.

Malli Fibiarte ssib lil-Mahbuba f'postha, tiżbel, iżda meta din tghidilha x'kien ghadda minnghalija, il-bassara tintebah li kien wasal iż-żmien biex tivvendika ruha mill-Qassis il-Kbir.

Zolla, Miftakar, Abdosir u Osirxamar jidhlu bil-mohbi fil-Maqdes biex ifitxu lil-Mahbuba, u malli jsibuha, iharbuha, mejjuna minn Fibiarte.

It-Tielet Att

Brabani, li kif intebaħ bil-ħarba ta' Mahbuba ordna t-tfiċċija tagħha issa insibuh qieghed jgharbel l-ewwel tnejn li jidru quddiemu mixlija bil-harba tas-Sacerdotessa, li huma Abdosir u Osirxamar. Warajhom jitressaq Miftakar u fl-ahhar Fibiarte, li tisfidah biex jghajjat laqgha tal-Kunsill Generali u quddiem kulhadd tixlieh bil-qtil tas-Sacerdotessa zgħażugħa li kienet miżmuma bħala 'Bint I-Alla Astarte' (iżda li fil-fatt kienet bint Fibiarte stess) talli ma' komplitx max-xewqat ħżiena tieghu; iżda Fibiarte irnexxilha issib il-gisem ta' bintha, ibbalzmatu, ħbietu taht l-altar u issa turieh lil kullhadd.

II-bassara tgħajjat lil Mahbuba biex toħroġ minn fejn kienet ħbietha u b'hekk teħles min l-akkuża ta' Brabani.

Malli Mahbuba tilmah lil Abdəsir dlonk tintefa f'dirghajh; Brabani b'dahqa ironika jfakkarha li issa kienet is-Sacerdotessa ewlenija ta' Melkart u għaldaqstant ma' setghet qatt tizzewweg lil mahbub taghha, u t-tfajla tahtaf is-sikkina minn fuq I-altar u twahhalilu f'qalbu.

Fibiarte tikxef is-sigrit li Mahbuba kienet bint Brabani innifsu. Imbghad iddur fuq it-tjajla u tghidilha li bid-delitt li wettqet kienet inhallet mil-weghda taghha lil-Melkart u setghet tiżżewweg lill-Abdosir.
