

NOVELLO

Although the Opera "Tancredi" is not so well known as the "Barbiere di Siviglia", "Cenerenotla" and others, the overture to this opera is, as all other overture, played often. The opera was first produced in Venice in 1813, on a libretto by R. Rossi.

DANZA SPAGNOLA

C. DIACONO

This famous Maltese Composer was born in Zejtun in 1876. He was one of the best and well received composers in Malta. He started his studies with another famous Maltese Composer Paolino Vassallo. Afterwards he began an active career which earned for him a name among the famous musicians in Malta. He worked incessantly till he passed away at the age of sixty-six. He composed two operas, three oratorios, an operetta, twenty one Cantatas, seven symphonies, overtures as also a great number of hymns and religious compositions. Licino Refice considered Diacono as a "luxury" for Malta while Lorenzo Perosi in his turbulent life found peace and consolation in Diacono's music.

PIANO CONCERTO NO. 2 IN G MINOR OP. 22

**SAINT-SAENS** 

Andante sostenuto — Allegro scherzando — Presto.

This concerto has won a universal popularity for its tunefulness, gaiety and charm. Saint-Saens was a master of form, melody, and orchestration, besides he was himself a fine pianist. The work is written in three movements: a) Andante Sostenuto, b) Allegro Scherzando, c) Presto. In the 1st movement there is an imposing melody which the composer amplifies as he proceeds, and this is followed by a syncopated tune that form a second subject. This leads to a working out section, a cadenza, and back to the opening theme. The 2nd movement is entertaining and brisk; it is a movement which charms everyone. The 3rd movement's quick tempo seems to denote a tarantella. After some complicated rhythm and trills, double octaves and scales in double thirds, the orchestra now contents itself with an unobtrusive share until the final chords are reached.

INTERVAL

Novello family: a gifted musical family of which the most important member was Vincent born in London 1781, died Nice 1861. Roman Catholic organist: composer church music and revived more published Purcell's in five Vols: Masses of Mozart; Haydn, Beethoven Vols of English Anthems by Croft; Greene, Boys and also organ music. Out of one of his publications (1811) grew the firm of "Novello and Company".

#### SYMPHONIC SUITE FROM OPERA, SNEGOUROTCHKA KORSAKOV

Rimsky-Korsakov's operas represent to H.C. Colles the turning away from the naturalism of the historic drama (Mussorgsky's Boris) to the symbolism of the pictorial stage, of which the ballet is the ideal representation. Vocal melody was not Rimsky-Korsakov's strong point as it was Tchaikowsky's. Rather the keen-edged instrumental phrase in appropriate coloring of violin, trumpet or oboe, the counterpart of gesture, the incisive rhythm, and the languorous arabesque were the groundwork of his inspiration. In the main, if we say that it was Rimsky-Korsakov who gave form and consistency to the Russian opera, we must also say that it was the Russian preoccupation with the ballet which imbued Rimsky-Korsakov a distinctive sense of those qualities.

#### THE BARTERED BRIDE

**SMETANA** 

Smetana, Bedrich (Czech form of Frederick; 1824 - 84); Czech composer, also conductor and pianist; encouraged by Liszt. Took part in the unsuccessful Czech revolt against Austria, 1848, and afterwards worked for some years in Sweden; but from 1861 settled again in Prague. Became totally deaf in 1874 but continued to compose. Previous works include operas "The Bartered Bride" and "Delibor", choral work, many piano pieces. Cultivated, and is regarded as founding a Czech national style influenced by folk-music.




