Hans Thürwächter was born on February 26, 1930.

He received his education as Pianist at the Academy of Music at Freiburg in Breisgau and Mannheim, at Mozarteum in Salzburg, at the Conservatoire National Paris and at the Ecole Normale de Musique in Paris.

His teachers have been, besides others, Reine Gianoli, Yvonne Léfébure, Alfred Cortot, Richard Laugs, Kurt Leimer and Friedrich Wührer.

Hans Thürwächter performed in Algiers, Brazil, Germany, England, Finland, France, Ireland, Italy, Marocco, Austria, Switzerland, Sweden and Spain.

He also played at the following Radio Stations:

Westdeutscher Rundfunk, Hessischer Rundfunk, Südwestfunk, Süddeutscher Rundfunk, Radio Jornal do Brasil in Rio de Janeiro, Maroccan Radio, Radio Moscow, Radio Svizzera Italiana in Lugano, Studio Zürich and Radio Vatican.

Hans Thürwächter is Lecturer at the Academy of Music and Theatre in Mannheim since 1956.

He works during the International Summer Academy at the Mozarteum in Salzburg as Assistant of Professor Kurt Leimer.

RONDO IN D MAJOR K. V. 485

MOZART

The Rondo in D major K. V. 485 was composed in January 1786 somewhat in the manner of Emanuel Bach. It is what came to be called sonatarondo having as it does, a development section, a clean recapitulation and a coda. The single theme appears in many keys. The theme is used — in the same key — in the finale of the G Minor piano quartet, but there it soon disappears.

EROICA VARIATIONS IN E FLAT MAJOR OPUS 35

BEETHOVEN

Turning from the sonatas to survey Beethoven's miscellaneous pieces, one becomes aware of another chain of specialised works, running parallel with the sonatas — the twenty-one sets of variations for solo and the two sets for piano duet. Variation form interested Beethoven only less than sonata form. Though he usually reached his highest powers when the variations made part of a sonata or symphony, a few of the twenty-one separate sets are of significance in relation to his general development.

The fifteen variations with Fugue in E flat major Opus 35 deserve the attention they have not received. Their theme is the very one from Beethoven's own ballet "Prometheus" which he employed later for the finale of the Eroica and the canonic and fugal devices, the treatment of the piano and the powerful intellectual progress of the music are a presage of his third period style.

FANTASY IN F MINOR OP. 49

CHOPIN

Chopin has almost exclusively composed for the piano. Under his hands as virtuoso and composer alike, rose the most flowering and magic passages, glittering and mysterious arabesques.

Melancholic melodies leave deep and unforgettable impressions on the listener.

Rythmic and passionate harmonies and the finest ornaments of tunes fascinate all senses.

What Paganini achieved only by his demonic play, Chopin mastered as composer.

THREE PIECES FOR PIANO

BORIS BLACHER

Allegro — Moderato — Allegro Moderato

German composer Boris Blacher was born in China in 1903 of Russian parents and since 1953 until his death in 1975 he was director of the (West) Berlin High School of Music. His works include "Romeo and Juliet", "Prussian Fairy Tale" and other operas, and an oratorio "The Grand Inquisitor" (after Dostoyevsky's Crime and Punishment'. He also composed two piano concertos, as well as an orchestral "Variations on a Theme" of Paganini.

Blacher was particularly interested in rhythmical organization (following Stravinsky) and has evolved a system of 'variable metres' by which variable bar-lengths are planned according to mathematical relationships.

INTERVAL

SYNPHONIC STUDIES OP. 13

ROBERT SCHUMANN

This great son of Germany's romantic period has at the beginning of his career exclusively worked for and with the piano.

Originally resolved to become a piano virtuoso, fate decided otherwise for him, when his fourth finger was paralysed.

His first compositions, op. 1-23 are exclusively written for the piano.

The symphonic studies op. 13 — composed in 1834-1837 — were dedicated to William Sterndale-Bennett and reflect a symbiosis of the principally classical conception with a new line of polyphony.

This composition is designed to convey to the listener orchestral impressions through the piano.


