





QUARTET OP. 33 NO. 3 IN C MAJ.

HAYDN

Allegro moderato — Scherzo Allegretto — Adagio — Rinale Rondo presto

Opus 33 consits of six quartets of which no. 3 will be played tonight. They were composed in 1781 to celebrate the state visit of the Russian Grand Duke Paul and his Grand Duchess to the Emperor Joseph of Austria. The quartets are dedicated to the Grand Duke and were first performed in the house occupied by him. The Grand Duchess was so pleased that she presented a diamond box to the composer, who also gave music lessons to her. Quartet no. 3 is nicknamed The Bird.

QUARTET OP. 18 NO. 4

BEETHOVEN

Allegro ma non tanto — Scherzo — Minuetto — Allegro

It was until opus 18 was published in 1801 that the public fully appreciated Beethoven's greatness. The six quartets of this opus were composed in 1798-1800, at a time when he was afflicted by an occasional weakness in hearing, a disability he kept secret as long as he could.

QUARTET NO. 1 OP. 44

MENDELSSOHN

Molto Allegro vivace — Minuetto un poco Allegretto — Andante espressivo ma con moto — Presto con brio

No. 1 of these three quartets in opus 44 was not in fact the first to be composed, he wrote it in Leipzig in the summer of 1838, when he was prodigiously busy.



ERMANO MOLINARO was born in Intra Verbania (Novara) on 16th June, 1942. He graduated from the Conservatory of Parma with Distinction in 1961 and won the "Rassegna Nazionale" at Capri in 1963. Since then he has played in Chamber Music Groups in Italy and the United States. He has also played in the Milan Scala Theatre Orchestra. A string trio composed by him has been issued as a gramophone record.

Since 1970 he has been teaching in the Turin Conservatory. He is the 1st viiolinist in the Sinfonic Orchestra of Turin and also 1st violinist in the Italian Chamber Music Orchestra.

BETTARINI CARLO (2nd violin) was born in Livorno on 11th October 1941 and was a student at the Conservatory of Milan. He has been a member

of the Sinphonic Orchestra of Turin since 1905.
He is very active in Chamber Music. He is one of the violinists of the Orchestra da Camera Italiana and the first violinist of the Chamber Music Circle "A. Toscanini" at Turin. He has recorded numerous Chamber Music Pieces for the RAI with this quartet and other chamber combinations.

He has been a member of the "Molinaro Quartet" since 1972.

PIETRO MORETTI (Viola) was born on 16th January 1937 at Turin and graduated from his native city's Conservatory with distinction. He has played in the Orchestra da Camera Italiana and the Sinfonic Orchestra of Turin and various Italian Chamber Music Groups.

He has been a member of the "Molinaro Quartet" since 1972

CARLO RADIC (Violincello) was born in Milan on the 23rd August 1935 and studied at the Conservatory there. He took a scholarship to the Indiana University of Bloomington in the United States.

He has played in the Sinfonic Orchestra of Suisse Romande, the Sinfonic Orchestra of Turin and Salvatore Accardo's Chamber Music Orchestra.


