



BAROSS-MOLNAR-SAJTI: "DANCE WITH TWO CROOKS" A shepherd dance from the region of Kunsag, in the middle of Hungary

ROSSA-GALAMBOS: "DOTTING"

The characteristic and virtuosic man-dance of Transylvania: in it the lads embellish the rhythm of the music with their special way of dancing.

ROSSA-GALAMBOS: "MOODS"

Woman-dancers conjure up the payful moods of childhood, the sad leavetaking from the parental home and finally the hopeful getting ready for wedded life.

VAVRINECZ-GALAMBOS: "LURING"

Teasing and playful dances/pas de deux/from Rabakoz.

ROSSA: "FACE AND MASK"

If you want to assimilate, you have to mask your personality. If you take the mask off, you have to face the toughness of reality, but still life will make you put the mask back and p'ay the role again.

The carnival costumes of Southern Hungary are used in this dance.

VAVRINECZ-MOLNAR: "DANCE WITH LASH"

The rivalry of two horse-herds is expressed in a dance with lashes.

GULYAS: "MUSIC FROM SZEK"

A musical piece based on transylvanian folkmusic traditions.

LAJTHA MANNINGER: "DANCES/FROM UDVARHEY"

An arrangement on transylvanian musical pieces and dances in richly embellished costumes.

VAVRINECZ MOLNAR: "MEMORIES FROM SZAMOSHAT" The coreography is based on Eastern Hungarian dance traditions.

SOPRANO SAROLTA SZALAI "WEDDING SONGS"

ROSSA-GALAMBOS: "WEDDING AND MOURNING" A balladistic interpretation of the tragedy of a great love: The bride dies and the bridegroom can never forget her.

VUJICSICS: "SCENES FROM THE GREAT HUNGARIAN PLAIN" Orchestral piece based on folk tunes from Central Hungary.

ROSSA-SALAMON: "A VERBUNKO MEMORY"

A strong and tough man-dance in honour of the excellent dancers and friends of the Erkel Ferenc ensemble.

ROSSA GALAMBOS: "DANCE WITH BOTTLES"

At the highest pitch of weddings the women picking up the bottles start a joyful fun. This composition recalls the customs and traditions of Northern Hungary.


