



BROADCASTING ENSEMBLE OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

The Broadcasting Ensemble of the People's Republic of China has been invited to give concerts in Malta and Gozo by the Minister of Labour, Welfare and Culture, the Hon. Miss Agatha Barbara.

In 1953 the Broadcasting Department of the People's Republic of China formed an 'Ensemble' composed of thirty musicians. Today, besides singers, this 'Ensemble' consists of seventy elements. The 'Ensemble' gives regular programmes on radio and television and performs also in towns, villages and factories, where it not only entertains the people but finds inspiration for new compositions.

The Repertoire of the Ensemble is rich in both modern and classical works. The most notable, however, are the traditional instrumental compositions and traditional instruments. Some of these, such as Erhu, Ghunghu, Tihu, Yangchin, Tutze, Sheng u Kuan, date hundreds of years. Throughout the years, some changes have taken place but they are still very popular with the Chinese.

The Ensemble gave its first performance abroad in 1957 and since then it has become more popular not only in China but also in foreign countries. This is the second tour of Europe by the Ensemble. Besides Malta, the Ensemble is also touring Italy and West Germany.

The Maltese people are proud and happy to welcome the Ensemble and wish to thank all those who made it possible for them to listen to the music of the People of China.



MANOEL THEATRE BOOKING PLAN


