This production is dedicated to the fond memory of ADRIAN RENDLE the first principal of MTADA, without whose initial work it would not have happened.

A TERSE SIX LINER in the November 15th issue of *The Guardian* brought down the curtain on the life of ADRIAN RENDLE — that remarkable Thespian who in January 1977 breathed the very first wisp of energy into MTADA.

A professional theatre director of long standing Adrian worked with the Tavistock Repertory Company, the Tower Theatre, Canonbury, the Fortune Theatre in London, and the Theatre Royal, Straford, Atte-Bow, where in 1964, he succeeded Joan Littlewood as director of Stage Sixty. In 1974 he formed his own fringe company, the Actors Studio Theatre; and directed drama and documentaries for the B.B.C. On behalf of the British Council, who sponsored his three year stay in Malta, he worked in Zambia and Uganda. Back in the U.K. he taught at R.A.D.A., Webber Douglas and L.A.M.D.A. He also published two books dealing with the various aspects of theatre training.

Under Rendle's wings MTADA strove to develop professional awareness towards the basic attitudes to acting and production and so heighten the standards of the work. His clear and strong opinions, uttered forcibly, but always with good humour, have left an indelible mark on our theatre. Today, after twelve years and over of solid training, when approximately ninety percent of the theatrical fraternity have walked the MTADA boards there is ample reason to believe that the curtain shall never come down unkindly on the Maltese theatre.

THE COMPANY -

The evening production is the students' penultimate performance with MTADA, as on May 26th they will present their "Masters" Class at the Foyer of the Manoel Theatre. These students joined MTADA in October 1986 and had tutorials in Voice, Movement, Interpretation, Fencing, Improvisation, History of the Theatre and Criticism/ Appreciation; besides practical work on Make Up and Stagemanagement. At the end of each term they took part in a presentation which included a Theatre-in-Education project.

The group spent the month of 13th July to the 15th August 1987 at the University of Perugia undergoing an intensive drama course with Roberto Ruggieri, Giampiero Frondini and Sabine van der Stern amongst other tutors. In August 1988 they worked for a month with Young Vic actress Jane Maud on a voice and elocution project.
