THE MALTESE ISLANDS
FOR THE YEAR
1976**

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C O M M E N T A R Y

The present publication updates Demographic data provided in previous issues to the year 1976. The tables are again preceded by a brief commentary which describes briefly the main demographic features for 1976. These were:

- a) a sustained increase in the Maltese population reflecting the phenomenon in evidence since 1975 of a net inflow of migrants.
- b) a downturn in the number of births and in the birth rate following their uptrend between 1973 and 1975.
- c) a relative stability in the number of deaths and the death rate, and
- d) a sustained high rate of marriages prevalent since 1971.

These trends are commented on further in the following paragraphs.

POPULATION

At 304,997 the Maltese population in 1976 increased by 1.4 per cent over the previous year. This was the second time since 1970 that there has been an increase in Maltese population. Once again this increase reflected the phenomenon first noticed in 1975 of a net inflow rather than a net outflow of emigrants.

BIRTHS

Live births decreased marginally by 0.5 per cent to 5,696. There was also a drop in the crude birth rate from 19.0 to 18.7 per 1000 of population. This was the first reduction since 1973 when the foreign part of population was excluded from official vital statistics.

DÉATHS

The number of deaths increased by only 67 to 2,967 so that there was little or no change in the death rate.

Infant mortality continued its downward trend with a rate of 15.0 per thousand live births in 1976 compared with 17.5 per thousand in the previous year. Once again diseases of the circulatory system were the major causes of death claiming 1,481 deaths or 49.9 per cent of total deaths compared with 48.6 per cent and 47.0 per cent in 1973 and 1974 respectively. Deaths through Neoplasms totalled 442 and accounted for 14.2 per cent of all deaths in 1976. This compared with 13.4 per cent in 1975 and 13.7 per cent in 1974.

INFECTIOUS DISEASES

Among reported notifiable diseases with a relatively high incidence, there was a decrease of 36.9 per cent in the number (273) of reported new cases of chicken-pox compared to the previous year and a larger decrease in the number of reported new cases of infectious hepatitis which decreased from 147 in 1975 to 58 in 1976. At the other end of the scale there was an increase in number of reported new cases of whooping cough (from 36 to 141) and influenza (from 20 to 182). The major cause of death among notifiable infectious diseases was once again broncopneumonia with 15 deaths out of 25 cases reported.

MIGRATION

The break in the trend of net emigration established in 1975 was maintained in 1976 when the number of immigrants was greater than the number of emigrants. In fact it was once again the difference between the emigrants and the immigrants that accounted for the increase in the Maltese population registered in 1976.

Of the 1,107 persons who emigrated in 1976, 278 (25.1 per cent) were in the 20 — 24 year age group whilst 188 (17.0 per cent) and 158 (14.3 per cent) were in the 15 — 19 years and 25 — 29 years age group respectively. Of the total number of emigrants 490 (44.3 per cent) were returning to their adopted countries whilst 198 (17.9 per cent) were accompanying their husband and 111 (10.0 per cent) were accompanying their parents. Australia remained the country with the highest intake of Maltese emigrants, accounting for 619 (55.9 per cent of the total) of whom 371 and 205 settled in Victoria and New South Wales respectively.

MARRIAGES

The number of marriages in 1976 went up by 5.2 per cent to 2,938. The largest number of brides, 1,444 (49.1 per cent) were between 20 and 24 years of age whilst the largest number of grooms, 1,202 (40.9 per cent) were between 25 and 29 years of age. However, the highest number of marriages, 677 (23.0 per cent) took place between couples both of whom were in the 20 to 24 years of age group.
