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1976

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COMMENTARY

This issue of the Demographic Review provides details of Demographic and Vital developments during 1975 together with comparative data for previous years. These are preceded by a short commentary which describes the main features of 1975 which are summarised hereunder:-

- a) a reversal of the population downtrend in evidence since 1970
- b) an accelerated rise in births, and an upturn in deaths.
- c) a deep trough in the number of emigrants and a sharp rise in that of returned emigrants.
- d) a reduction in the number of marriages following the sharp increases registered in 1973 and 1974.

POPULATION

In 1975 the Maltese population increased by 2,281 or by 1.1 per cent to 300,903. An increase of 5.2% in births and a reversal of the usual emigration pattern from a net outflow to a net inflow were more than enough to offset the 5.6% increase in deaths.

BIRTHS

Live births which totalled 5,727 have reached the highest level since 1964. The crude birth rate also retained its upward trend, having increased from 17.7 in 1973 to 18.3 in 1974 and 19.0 in 1975. The highest crude birth rate by locality, 53.9, was registered at San Gwann, an area in which an intensive programme of subsidised house building was carried out by Government. As a result there was an influx of married couples, many of them still young, thus pushing up the local birth rate from 50.1 to 53.9. The lowest local crude birth rates were registered at Mdina (4.3) and Fontana (1.3).

No triplets were born in Malta in 1975 but there were 55 twin births, five of which occurred to mothers over 35 years of age.

DEATHS

Deaths increased by 5.6% to 2,900. Infant mortality continued its downward trend with a rate of 17.5 in 1975 compared with 19.9 in the previous year. The same applies to the neo-natal death rate which decreased to 11.8 from 14.2 in 1974. Once again diseases of the circulatory system were the major cause of death claiming 1,408 deaths or 48.6% of the total compared with 47.0% in 1974. Deaths caused by accidents, poisoning and violence continued

to decrease. During the year under review, 58 deaths were attributable to these causes compared with 65 in 1974. In this context, October 1975 was the worst month with 8 deaths (13.8%) due to accidents, poisoning and violence. In 1974, February was the worst month with 11 deaths (16.9%) attributed to these causes.

NOTIFIABLE DISEASES

The most common notifiable infectious disease in 1975 was chickenpox with 433 reported new cases - an increase of 65.3% over 1974. On the other hand the number of reported new cases of measles decreased from 784 in 1974 to a mere 23 in 1975. The main cause of death among notifiable infectious diseases was once again bronco-pneumonia with 10 deaths out of a total of 15 compared with 17 out of 21 in 1974.

MIGRATION

The usual pattern of net emigration which prevailed since World War II was reversed in 1975 with 2,957 returning emigrants and 1,624 emigrants. The number of emigrants returning to their country of adoption was 348, or 21.4% of the total, whereas those accompanying parents or their husband numbered 285 (17.5%) and 258 (15.9%) respectively. The age groups of Maltese emigrants in 1975 spread from the 0 - 4 year group to the over 60 year group but the highest percentage of emigrants 25.6% were in the 20 - 24 age-group followed by 18.4% in the 15 - 19 age-group and by 15.9% in the 25 - 29 age-group. Australia remains the country with the highest intake of Maltese emigrants, numbering 691 or 42.5% in 1975.

MARRIAGES

The number of marriages in 1975 decreased to 2,794 from the peak of 3,510 it had reached in 1974. The 20 - 24 age-group prevailed with 1,397 brides (50.0% of the total) and 1,169 grooms (41.8%). Marriages in which both the bride and the groom were in this age-group numbered 722 or 25.8% of the total. There was one bride and no grooms under 15 years of age and 4 brides and 13 grooms aged 65 years and over. The most frequent month for marriages in 1975 was December when 335 marriages were celebrated whilst in the previous year October was the most popular month with 369 marriages.
