COMMENTARY

The present issue of the Demographic Review presents data on Population and Vital events in 1980. Apart from providing detailed statistical tables on vital events which occurred during the year, it also gives comparative data for previous years. The Tables are as usual preceded by a brief Commentary reviewing the main demographic features for 1980. During the year under review the Maltese population continued to grow at an acceptable rate, health standards were maintained at a high level resulting in a low infant mortality rate and a high expectation of life in respect of both sexes while the predominant diseases causing death remained those associated with countries characterised by advanced social and economic conditions.

Population

The upward trend in the population in evidence since 1975 was retained in 1980. As at 31st December the estimated Maltese population was 318,028; 2,766 or 0.9 per cent more than at the end of the previous year. This rise was, as in the previous four years, due both to a net inflow in migration and to natural increase.

Fertility

There was a small decline in the number of births which totalled 5,602 compared with 5,823 registered last year. This resulted in a marginal drop in the crude birth rate from 18.5 to 17.6 per 1000 persons. Total period fertility rate has been worked out at 1.98 as at end of 1980 while the Net Reproductive Rate has been estimated at .96.

Nuptiality

The number of marriages in 1980 was 2,775 yielding a rate of 8.7 per 1,000 of the population. The number of marriages as well as the marriage rate remained high compared with the 1960 decade when the population was declining rather than increasing. The number of civil marriages during the year was 108.

Mortality

A total of 3,215 deaths was recorded during the year under review. This was 247 more than in the previous year. The mortality rate stood at 10.7 for males and 9.5 for females. There were 85 deaths among infants under one year of age resulting in an infant mortality rate of 15.2 per 1,000 live births. The expectation of life at birth was 68.5 years for males and 72.7 years for females.

Emigration

The reversal in the trend of a heavy outflow of migrants rather than a net inflow evident since 1975 was sustained in 1980. The net addition to the population by returning migrants in the year stood at 379. The number of persons who left Malta in 1980 was 1,374 whilst 1,753 returned to live in Malta permanently.
