

ADDITIONS TO THE ANT FAUNA (HYMENOPTERA: FORMICIDAE)

OF THE MALTESE ISLANDS

Background

The Maltese Islands are situated in the Central Mediterranean basin having a total land area of c. 316 km². A diverse ant fauna is present in this archipelago which is increasingly threatened by habitat degradation and invasion of alien species. The myrmecofauna of the archipelago has received considerable attention by researchers since 1893, bringing the total number to 59 species, 11 of them non-native. Confirmation of some already reported species, e.g. *Messor structor* (Latreille), *Tapinoma nigerrimum* (Nylander), *Tetramorium caespitum* (Linnaeus), is required in the light of recent taxonomic changes.



Research Objective

- critical study of literature and published records
- revision of unpublished collection data (1995-1997)





Fig. 1. Map with recent collecting localities (2015-2019)

- collection of new ant material (2015-2019) (fig. 1)

Methods

- direct sampling
sifting
MSS-traps, Malaise traps

Results

We provide an updated list of 70 ant species from the Maltese Islands. Two species are recorded for the first time in Malta – *Anergates atratulus*, an extremely rare socially parasitic ant, and *Hypoponera abeillei*, a hypogaeic ant. Additionally, we report first verified records of *Hypoponera ragusai*, *Leptanilla revelierii*, *Solenopsis fairchildi*, *Strumigenys tenuipilis* and *Tetramorium davidi*. Seven morphospecies with unspecified taxonomic status were also collected – 4 of *Aphaenogaster* (subterranea-group), 1 of *Lepisiota* (frauenefeldi-group), 1 of *Leptanilla*, and 1 of *Temnothorax* (near *aveli*) and require further studies.
