

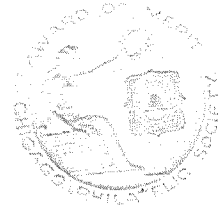

14 - Oct - 2 Nov 1933, 50th Ocean crossing Flight to the Chicago World Exhibition, via: Brazil (Recife-Pern) 17/10, Recife - Rio de Janeiro 18/19, Rio - Recife 19/20, Recife - Miami 21/22, Miami - Akron 1st Landing-Chicago 23/25, Chicago - Akron 2nd Landing 26, Akron - Seville 28/31, Seville-Friedrichshafen 1/2 November 1933.



During 1933, only mail for the 2nd and 7th South America Flights L.Z 127 “Graf Zeppelin” to have been endorsed also, with the Berlin Frankfurt connecting Flight cachet, has been recorded up till now.

Recorded Mail out of Malta recorded endorsed with the confirmation L.Z.127 cachets.

All Flights in 1934 had the same confirmation cachet except the 3rd-Argentina Flight, and 12th South America, Christmas Flight.

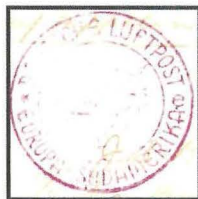

1936 L.Z. 129, “Hindenburg” 6-9 Sept 1936 to USA (Lakehurst)

1936 (6-9 Sept) There is no L.Z.129 “Hindenburg” confirmation cachet on this letter.

Mail to Malta

On the 18th of September 1928, the new dirigible, flying for the first time, was named “**GRAF ZEPPELIN**”, in honor of the Count.

On the 12th Oct 1928, at 07.30 am local time the **L.Z. 127 “Graf Zeppelin”** inaugurated its first long-range voyage crossing the Atlantic, to Lakehurst, New Jersey, U.S.A., completing the journey of 8050 km, without any problems, in 81 hours and two minutes.



The return flight **Lakehurst New Jersey to Germany** took place on the **28th October 1928**, arriving in **Friedrichshafen** on the **1st Nov 1928**.

Return Flight 28 Oct 1929, of LZ 127 “**Graf Zeppelin**” from **Lakehurst New Jersey. NY.USA.**, to **Friedrichshafen - Germany**, showing the **FIRST FLIGHT AIR MAIL confirmation cachet in VIOLET**, arriving on the **1st Nov 1928**, in **Friedrichshafen** - on to **Malta**, arriving in **Sliema - Malta**, on the **5th Nov 1928**, as per arrival hand stamps on back, together with the postman’s personal number 32.

1929 (22 AP) Germany (Magdeburg) - Seville (Med Flight)—Malta

Post card from Magdeburg Germany, with *on board post mark* 22nd April 1929 of the **L.Z. 127 Graf Zeppelin**, & *Zeppelin confirmation cachet in RED*, of its 1929 *Med Flight*, dropped at Seville Spain, and machine cancellation **SEVILLE 24.4.29** on back, addressed Mr. F. Bentley, arriving in Malta on the 1/5/29. Mr. T. Camilleri has recorded a similar card.

1930 Pan American Flight, Friedrichshafen – Seville, First Landing -18/19 MY 1930

1930 (28 AP), Card posted in Wien on 28 AP 1930, machine cancellation.

1930 (18 MY), left Friedrichshafen, showing *confirmation Zeppelin cachet in RED*, of - 1930 *Pan American Flight*, (**SUDAMERIKA FAHRT**) on to Seville, where it landed, on the 19th May at 17.17 hrs, delivering this card there for onward transmission to Malta, arriving in **B'Kara - Malta** on the 26 May 1930. A similar card has been recorded.

1931 (9-13 April) EGYPT Flight

1931 (10 AP), L.Z. 127 "Graf Zeppelin" return Flight from Egypt.

1931 (10AP), Cover endorsed in manuscript "By Graf Zeppelin" sent from Cairo-Egypt bearing 27mils Egyptian stamp overprinted in violet "GRAF ZEPPELIN" AVRIL 1931 /100 cancelled by the special 10 AP 31 10-P/CAIRE/GRAF ZEPPELIN. Back stamped FRIEDRICHSHAFEN/ 13 4 31/7 - 8/ *BODENSEE*, arriving in Cospicua – Malta on 16th AP 31. It bears on the back also the post man's personal hand stamp No 15.

The following L Z 127 *Graf Zeppelin* cover is one of a set of four, addressed to Egypt's King Fouad, flown on the Palestine round trip, bearing the RED confirmation PYRAMID German Zeppelin Flight Cachet, franked with the 27 mils Egyptian Air Mail stamp overprinted in violet "GRAF ZEPPELIN"/ AVRIL 1931/100", and cancelled by the special 10 AP 31 19-P/GRAF ZEPPELIN / Cairo, or Port Said, or Alexandria, or Suez, both on the stamps and on the cover.

MAIL OUT OF MALTA

1933 (6-17 May), 1st South America Flight

L.Z. 127 "Graf Zeppelin" MALTA - BRAZIL (PERNAMBUCO)

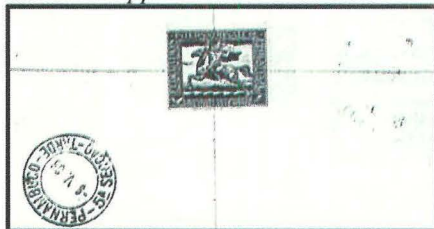

1933 (6 May), This cover was sent to Malta by Mr F Buchal of Bad Salzalmen, Bad Magdeburg, who franked it with the Maltese and German stamps, handed it to the Welkenraedt Post Office, in Germany, to be sent *under cover to the Post Master General in Malta*, who on receiving it cancelled the Malta stamps with the double ring/killer block spacers - VALLETTA / MALTA / AP 19 / 33, and endorsed it in RED

"Posted at Welkenraedt / under cover to the Post Master General",

who posted it back to Germany, boarding the L.Z. 127 "Graf Zeppelin", 1st S.A.Flight on the 6th May 1933. The German stamps were cancelled by the black double ring FRIEDRICHSHAFEN /*BODENSEE*/ 6.5.33 20-21, and the confirmation Baron Zeppelin portrait cachet in BLUE applied.



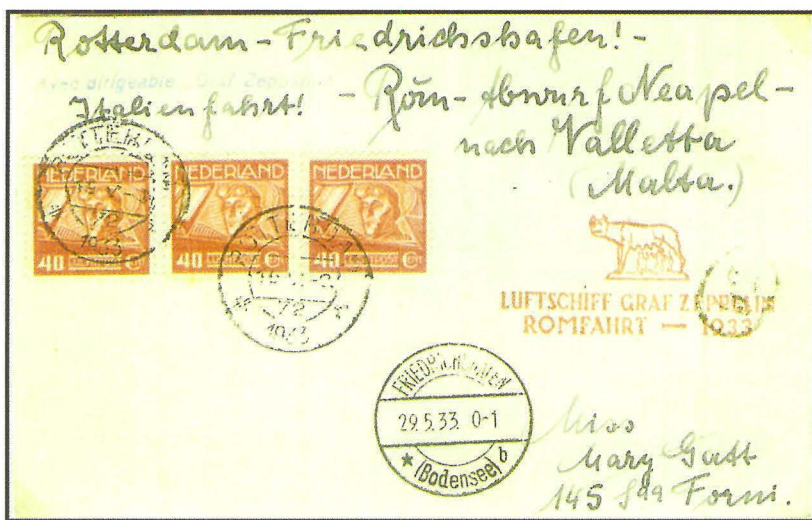
Mr T. Camilleri has recorded a similar cover of the 1933 1st Flight, provenance unknown.

1933 (29-30 May) Italian ROMFAHRT FLIGHT MAIL TO MALTA

1933 (29 MY), the L.Z.127 “*Graf Zeppelin*” began its voyage bound for ROME – the “ROMFAHRT”.

It flew from *Friedrichshafen* over *Basle, Bescanon, the Rhone Valley and Marseille*. From there it traveled the coast crossing *Nice, Genoa, and Leghorn*, where it dropped mail, and landed at *Ciampino Airport* outside Rome at 4.30pm.

The “*on board post office*” delivered its mail to the Italian authorities and took on mail as well.

Card posted in the Netherlands, ROTTERDAM / 15.V.1933, and put on the L.Z. 127 “*Graf Zeppelin*” flight to Rome on the 29TH May 33, as per the FRIEDRICHSCHAFEN / Bodensee hand stamp, together with the confirmation Orange Romulus & Remus Graf Zeppelin ROMFAHRT- 1933 cachet.

It arrived in Malta 1st June 1933.

The Malta postman’s personal hand stamp “No 36”, is on the front.

At 7.30 pm the airship departed for Naples, but dropped mail over *Nettuno* instead, because of approaching nightfall. This mail was taken to Naples by other means.

For the Italy –ROMFAHRT return Flight, Italy issued six stamps with values 3, 5, 10, 12, 15, and 20 Lire. The Italian colonies of Cyrenaica, Tripolitania, and the Aegean Islands, each issued six stamps, with the same values as the Italian Issue. San Marino issued the same six values, and Greece issued 30,100, and 120 drachma stamps.

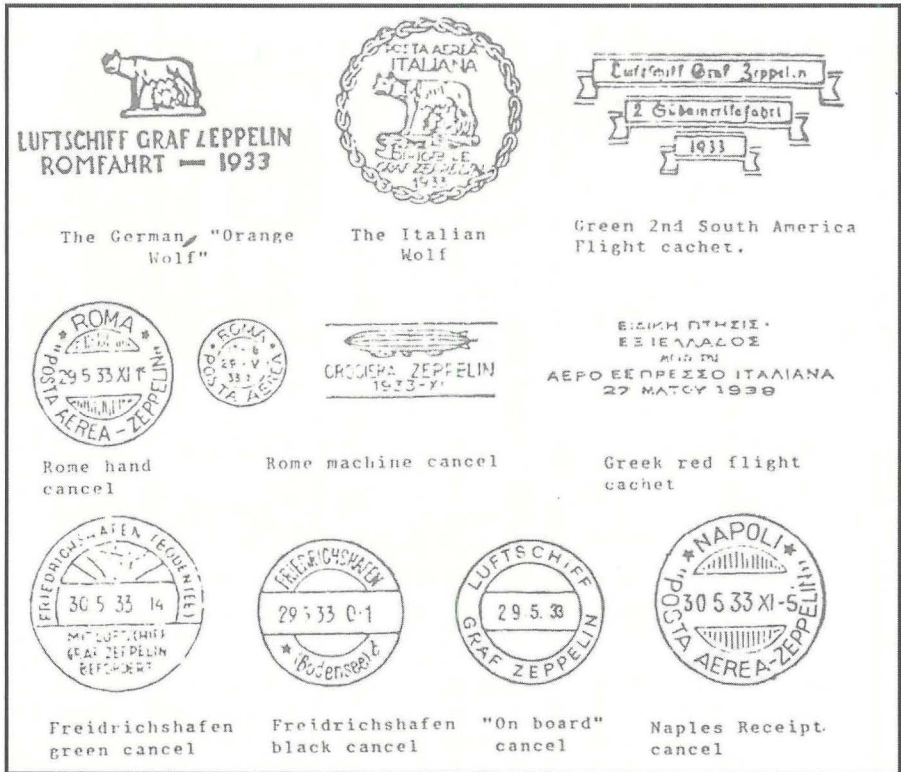
MAIL FROM MALTA TO EUROPE

Mail from Malta, for Europe, and for the second L.Z. 127 South America Flight, was loaded on the return Italian - Romfahrt Flight.

It had the following franking.

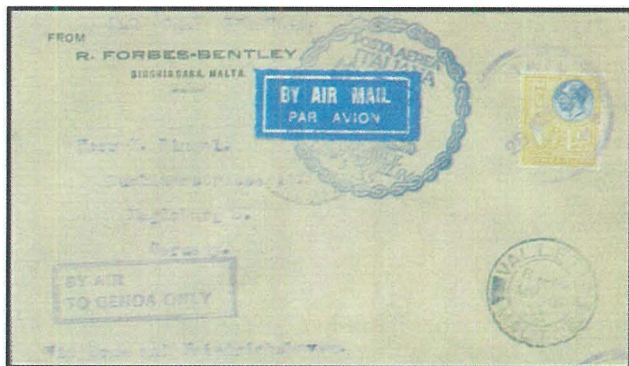
- Malta franking only for Europe.
- Mixed franking for Europe.
- Mixed franking for 2nd South America Flight via Rome & via Berlin.

These are the hand stamps found on the L.Z. 127 "Graf Zeppelin" ROMFAHRT – 1933 Flight to Rome and back to Friedrichshafen, for the connecting 2nd South American Flight.



MALTA – ROME – GERMANY (Friedrichshafen)

Malta franking only for Europe

1933(26 May), Malta–Germany by Air to Genoa only, on to Rome, to board the Italian - ROMFAHR return Flight to Friedrichshafen, (29.5.33) and then on to Magdeburg.

It is franked only with one 4½d K.G.V, MALTA stamp.

No additional Italian stamps were added, either in Malta or in Rome.

Endorsed by the confirmation - **VIOLET Romulus & Remus Italian Cachet**

Transit cancellations and Magdeburg arrival hand stamp on back.

Mixed franking for Europe

1933 (23 May), card sent from Malta to Rome, with mixed franking. The Malta KGV 2½d, cancelled by the **VIOLET AIR MAIL / MALTA/ 23 MAY 1933**, endorsed with the **VALLETTA dater in black hand stamps**, to board the return flight (29.5.33), L.Z. 127 "Graf Zeppelin" ROMFAHRT-1933, endorsed by the confirmation **Romulus & Remus cachet in Green**, and **Friedrichshafen Green**, arrival hand stamp, the additional Italian 3 Lire Zeppelin & Vittorio Emanuele 75 cents stamps cancelled with the double black Italian ring **ROMA / POSTA AEREA – ZEPPELIN**.

1933 (23 May), Letter sent from Malta – Genoa – Rome - Germany, franked with K.G.V., ½d, & 6d Air Mail stamps cancelled by Violet AIR MAIL / MALTA / 23 MAY 1933 hand stamp, and black VALLETTA dater, by Air to Genoa only, which accidentally catches slightly the additional Italian 50c stamp, which proves that the Italian stamps were applied in Malta before departure. The Italian stamps were then cancelled by * AMB GENOVA MILANO* 5EZ B, to board the L Z 127 “Graf Zeppelin” ROMFAHRT-1933 return flight to Germany, confirmation Romulus & Remus GREEN cachet applied.

1933 (23 May), Registered letter No 608, Malta - Rome, franked by K.G.V., ½d, 3d, 6d Air Mail, cancelled by Violet AIR MAIL / MALTA / 23 MAY 1933, plus additional Italian stamps, to board the return ROMEFHART -1933 Flight, with confirmation GREEN Romulus & Remus cachet, & Friedrichshafen Zeppelin (30.9.33) arrival hand stamp in green.

1933 (26 May), letter from Malta to Magdeburg / Germany, franked by KGV 4½d, stamp, cancelled by Violet AIR MAIL / MALTA, bearing VALLETTA dater, and Violet BY AIR to Genoa only, together with additional 5 Lire Italian Zeppelin stamp, cancelled by ROMA / POSTA AEREA - ZEPPELIN on 29th, to board the L.Z. 127 *Graf Zeppelin* return ROMFAHRT flight to Friedrichshafen, endorsed with the confirmation BLUE Romulus & Remus cachet, and on the back by the special Italian machine cancellation, and the GREEN arrival 30th Friedrichshafen post mark, arriving at its destination Magdeburg on the 31st.

1933 (3-13 June) 2nd South America Flight

Mixed Franking Malta–Rome–Friedrichshafen–Brazil(Pernambuco) via return of the ROMFAHRT - 1933 Flight (29.5.33), *but without the 2nd South America Flight Cachet in GREEN (German script)*

1933 (26 May), Reg letter No 880, sent from Malta to Pernambuco / Brazil via Rome, to board on the 29.5.33, the ROMFAHRT L.Z. 127 Zeppelin return Flight to Friedrichshafen (29.5.33), and connect with the 1933 Second South American Flight.

No hand stamp of this South America Flight was applied on this cover.

It left Malta with a mixed franking of KGV 6d stamp cancelled with the Violet AIR MAIL / MALTA / 26 MAY 1933 hand stamp, and a block of four of the Italian 3 Lire Zeppelin stamps cancelled at Rome, with the ROMA / POSTA AEREA – ZEPPELIN / 29 MAY 1933 hand stamp, where the BLUE Romulus & Remus Cachet was applied.

1933 (26 May) Malta - Brazil (Pernambuco)

Franked with K.G.V Malta 6d and 12 L Italian stamp, for the return ROMFAHRT L.Z. 127, with the confirmation Violet Romulus & Remus cachet to connect with the 1933 2nd S.A. Flight, Brazil (Perm.) at Friedrichshafen.

Mr. G.Orlandini has recorded an identical letter with Reg VALLETTA (MALTA) No873

He states that letters exist with L3, L5, L10, L15, L20, probably with Reg Nos 874 to 878. No 2nd South America cachet in Green (German Script) was endorsed on these letters.

Malta – ROME – LIMA / PERU

1933 (26 May), letter from Malta to LIMA / Peru, franked K.G.V., 6d, and cancelled by the VIOLET AIR MAIL / MALTA / 26 MAY 1933, to board the ROMFAHRT – 1933, L.Z. 127 “Graf Zeppelin” return flight, bearing additional Italian 20 Lire Zeppelin stamp, cancelled by the ROMA / POSTA AEREA - ZEPPELIN, together with the VIOLET Romulus & Remus to Friedrichshafen to connect with the 1933, 2nd South America Flight. This 2nd South America cachet in GREEN was not applied.

1933 (3-13June) Mixed Franking 2nd South America Flight, via Berlin, confirmed by, 2nd Anschluss Berlin / Friedrichshafen connecting Flight cachet in RED and the Three Line German Script South America cachet in Green.

1933 (26 May) Malta to Pernambuco / Brazil, via BERLIN franked by KGV, 4½d cancelled by AIR MAIL / MALTA / 26 MAY 1933, and dated. This letter went via BERLIN, receiving 1933, 2nd Berlin / Friedrichshafen Flight connection cachet in RED. The 12 Lire Italian Zeppelin stamp is cancelled by the three line German script confirmation cachet of the 2nd South America Flight in GREEN. Pernambuco arrival date stamp–5.VI.33 Tarde(evening). As it was not collected it was sent back to Malta by the Poste Restante 26/6, “NON RECLAME”.

1933 (26 May), Letter from Malta to Pernambuco/Brazil, via Berlin bearing KGV 2½ Melita (Postage), pair K.G.V 1d, together with 10 & 3 Lire Italian Zeppelin stamps. The Melita stamp is cancelled faintly by the Violet Air Mail Malta hand stamp which also touched the 10 Lire Italian stamp. This proves that the Italian stamps were already on the envelope when posted in Malta, contrary to what was believed so far that they were franked in Rome, plus Malta datar. Same postal characteristics as the previous one.

1933 (26 May) Malta to Brazil (Pernambuco), via Berlin, bearing Malta KCV 4½d, cancelled by the Violet Malta Air Mail, one 3 Lire & pair 5 Lire Italian Zeppelin stamps cancelled by the German three line script, 2nd South America Flight cachet in GREEN, and endorsed by the 1933 2nd Berlin / Friedrichshafen connection Flight cachet in RED. The Malta datar 26/MY/33 overlaps clearly the side of the Italian stamp. This proves that the Italian stamps were already on the envelope posted in Malta. Mr. G. Orlandini has recorded four other similar letters via Berlin having the same postal characteristics as the previous ones, but having different Italian franking, (block of 4 of the 5L, 5 & 10L, 12L, 15L).

The previous seven, and the following five letters, all have the mixed franking of **Malta and Italian stamps**. The Malta stamps cancelled by the **Violet Malta Air Mail** and the letters endorsed with the **Valletta** dater going first to **Berlin** where they were endorsed with the confirmation **1933, 2nd South America - Berlin / Friedrichshafen connection Flight cachet in RED**, and the **Italian - Zeppelin stamps** cancelled by means of the **2nd South America** confirmation **three line in German script cachet in Green**. They were addressed by **Mr Forbes Bentley to himself, c/o Poste Restante in Pernambuco – Brazil**, and as they were not collected, the Brazil P.O, on the 26th June, returned them to him. Air Mail back to Malta was not paid so they crossed the Air Mail Label to save on postage back to Malta, endorsing them (**NON RECLAME**) etc.

1933 (1-17 July), 3rd South America Flight

The Malta Government Gazette No 196, of 2nd JUNE 1933, announced the following new Air Mail rates:

[No. 196.]

It is hereby notified that His Excellency the Governor in Council, availing himself of the powers vested in him by Article 12 of the Post Office Act 1924, has been pleased to direct that the air mail fee, in addition to postage, payable on mail matter posted in these islands for transmission via Rome by the "Graf Zeppelin" air service to the undermentioned places be fixed as follows:—

This meant that as from the 2nd June 1933, Mail was going to be accepted at the Malta GPO, for the F.Z. 127 "Graf Zeppelin" - 3rd South America Flight, postage to be paid as per published rates for the whole trip for the first time.

Mr. F Buchal, of Bad Salzelmen / Magdeburg the sender of this **Third Flight cover** was unaware of notice No 196, so he continued doing as he did in the past, (1933 1st Flight) by going to the **Post Office at Welkenraedt**, hand the cover with the mixed Maltese and German stamps on, to be sent "**under cover to the Post Master General in Malta**".

This envelope was received by the Post Master, Malta, who registered it **R. VALLETTA (MALTA) No 163**, giving the *sender* a Reference Number which was written in manuscript black ink, and recorded in a special register, - **G.P.O. Malta. Ref.1522/33. Letters posted in one batch belonging to the same individual all had the same reference number.**

Endorsed it with the red hand stamp

Under cover to the Postmaster General

cancelled the Maltese stamps by the single black 24mm ring **G.P.O / MALTA/ JU 16 /33**, sending it back to Germany first by Air to Italy, then by train, the German stamps being cancelled by the oval train post mark (**FRANKFURT- BASEL / BAHNPOST /2.85 - 19.6.33**), boarding the *Zeppelin* on the 1st July as per confirmation cachet in **BLUE** of the 3rd South America Flight.
