

Information about the Philatelic Society Malta Members of F.I.P.

History

The Philatelic Society was founded on 6th March 1966 by a group of Maltese philatelists.

Purpose

To bring together on a regular basis those interested in stamp collecting and postal history for discussions, lectures, shows, exchanges and other activities related to stamp collecting.

Objectives

The aim of the Society is to encourage the study and collecting of stamps and other collectables from absolute beginners, (including children), through to experienced specialist collectors, and to promote these hobbies in every conceivable way.

Activities

Meetings are held at St. Publius Hall, St. Publius Street, Floriana, usually on the first Wednesday of each month excluding July, August and September. The meetings commence at 18.00 hrs and include ample time for members to exchange stamps, postal history items and more recently postcards, telecards and cigarette cards as well, of course, information on their favourite hobby. Non members are welcomed.

Illustrated talks, sometimes by eminent foreign speakers, usually take place during the monthly meetings. The meetings are chaired by the President, Chev. Dr. Alfred Bonnici, one of the longest serving members of the Society and an F.I.P Gold Medalist. Chev. Dr. Bonnici is also the Editor of the Journal of the Society which has achieved international recognition, being published three times a year. It has been awarded Silver Medals in Chicagopex 2002/4/5.

An annual (or more frequently) auction is held to enable members to dispose of their surplus material, and to enable other members to acquire stamps, etc., that they have been searching for.

The association is a member of the F.I.P. and members are encouraged to exhibit

their collections there. They have been awarded several, Gold and Large Vermeil medals.

Every month the Secretary, Mr. Walter Rizzo, mails a newsletter to local members giving details of meetings and other activities, this includes a buy/swap/sell section.

For the past six years the Society has organised on a non competitive basis for its members a Philatelic Exhibition *Maltex*.

The journal is distributed free of charge to members.

Smilers

It is generally known that Australia Post introduced the idea of personal photographs alongside postage stamps, offered as Personalized Stamps or P-Stamps. The product was later to be adopted and adapted by several countries, including Great Britain (Smilers), Canada (Picture Postage), Indonesia (Personalized Stamps and Prisma), New Zealand (Personalized Stamps), Singapore (My Stamp) Slovakia (Personal Stamp), and lately Malta (Personalised Stamps).

Smilers are the perfect way to personalize one's mail by having one's favourite photograph featured next to an actual stamp. It is a charming way to make one's mail that little bit more special. That is what it is reported that a good number of people are saying and if that is correct then Smilers sheets are here to stay. At least for another few years.

Most countries have a perforated tab in a portrait format to the left or the right of the stamp area, thus ensuring that there is a clear separation between the stamp which is meant for the public and the photograph which is ordered privately.

The Royal Mail had a compromising acceptable version of introducing *Generic Smilers*. Generic Smilers are sheets which contain pre-printed non-personalised imagery or text on the label area. This format enables collectors to obtain the sheets without the added cost of using the personalised method.

One can be sure that other countries will jump on the band wagon over the coming years in order to offer an element of fun for their customers and an extra source of revenue for themselves.

Following are the Generic Smilers sheets issued by the Royal Mail to date.

- 1. "Smilers" 10 x 1st Class stamps featuring different smiling faces. The stamps were issued on 22 May 2000 at Earls Court, London for the Stamp Show 2000 which was held between 22 28 May. The labels attached to the stamps had 'The Stamp Show 2000' printed thereon.
- 2. "Christmas" 20 x 19p stamps released on 3 October 2000. The stamps featured a robin perched in a letter box. The labels contained Seasons Greetings. Alongside the bottom right hand margin is the trade mark which reads '© The Post Office 2000'.
- 3. "Christmas" 10 x 1st Class stamps released on 3 October 2000. The stamps feature the face of Santa Claus holding a cracker in one hand. The labels contained Seasons Greetings. The trade mark is similar to item (2) above.

- 4. "Smilers for you Occasions" 20 x 1st Class stamps released on 5 June 2001. The Occasion sheets contain four columns of stamps, and a half stamp size related label positioned to the left of each stamp.
- 5. "Smilers" Smilers stamps similar to item (1) above re-issued 3 July 2001 with the labels attached to the stamps containing felicitous greetings.
- 6. "Smilers for Christmas" stamps similar to item (2) above re-issued 9 October 2001. The trade mark alongside the bottom right hand margin reads 'Smilers is a trade mark of Consignia plc © Consignia plc 2001'.
- 7. "Smilers for Christmas" stamps similar to item (3) above re-issued 9 October 2001. Alongside the bottom right hand margin is the trade mark which is similar to (6) above.
- 8. "Cartoons" 10 x 1st Class stamps issued on 18 December 2001. The sheet is based on the humorous 1st class stamps first released in 1996, next to a label complimenting the humour of the cartoon.

Year 2002

- 9. "Smilers for you Occasions" 20 x 1st Class cartoons stamps and labels issued on 5 March 2002. The stamps feature four of each design from the Occasions 2002 range i.e. New Baby, Moving Home, Best Wishes, Hello and Love next to a label with a suitable image. The stamps have standard (non-elliptical) perforations.
- 10. "World Cup" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 21 May 2002, celebrating England's great performance in the World Cup 2002, using the bottom right hand stamp from the World Cup miniature sheet next to images of football fans and great football moments depicted on the labels.
- 11. "Christmas" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 1 October 2002. The sheet has a new design featuring the popular Father Christmas next to labels with the words of 'Jingle Bells'.
- 12. "Christmas" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 1 October 2002. The sheet consists of ten Teddy Bear stamps and ten Dennis the Menace stamps next to labels featuring 'knock, knock' jokes.

Year 2003

13. "Flowers" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 21 January 2003. The sheet contains two of each of the ten colourful 'Flowers' greetings stamps first issued in books in January 1997. On the generic sheet the labels adjoining the stamps feature further illustrations of the flowers shown on the stamps. The stamps and labels are surrounded by a lush, verdant background design. The stamps and labels are ideal for use on Valentine's Day and Mother's Day cards, as well as for

- birthdays and other social occasions. The 'Flower' stamps do not have elliptical perforations which makes it easier to distinguish single stamps from the original printing of 1997.
- 14. "Occasions Multiple Choice" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued 4 February 2003. Occasions 2003 is the third set of 'Occasions' stamps to be issued. This was the first time that the Royal Mail had produced a set of stamps that gave customers the chance to interact on a stamp by making their own mark, and then sending their own personalized message on an envelope. There are six 1st Class stamps in the set and each stamp has three tick boxes for the sender to choose the most appropriate message, allowing them to congratulate, commiserate, express their love or give someone the all-important thumbs up or thumbs down all before the letter is even opened.
- 15. "Cartoons" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 29 July 2003. The sheets include a crossword puzzle on the bottom margin.
- 16. "Winter Robins" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 30 September 2003. The labels alongside the stamps depict a story of a snowman, robins and Father Christmas. This is the first of three sets of Winter Smilers stamps for Christmas 2003.
- 17. "2nd Ice Sculptures" 20 x 2nd Class stamps issued on 4 November 2003. The labels alongside the stamps feature winter animals sculptured from ice and snow (see note below). This is the second of three sets of Winter Smilers stamps for Christmas 2003.
- 18. "Ist Ice Sculptures" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 4 November 2003. The ice and snow sculptures were created by artist Andy Goldsworthy who works in the open air using materials found in the natural landscape. This is the third and last set of three sets of Winter Smilers stamps for Christmas 2003.

- 19. "Hong Kong Stamp Expo" 20 x 1st Class 'Hello' stamps issued on 30 January 2004. The labels attached to the stamps bear the Hong Kong exhibition logo in the margin and an image of a monkey holding a sign which states "Year of the Monkey" in Chinese (Cantonese) characters.
- 20. "Occasions" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 3 February 2004. The stamps feature humorous drawings of an envelope with a postman, being kissed, as a duck, as a baby and an aeroplane.
- 21. "Bicentenary of the Royal Horticultural Society" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 25 May 2004. The colourful labels illustrate and give details of different groups of dahlias and guidance on successful dahlia growing. The R.H.S. logo appears in the sheet margin. For the record the R.H.S. organizes the Chelsea

- Flower Show and also runs gardens at Wisley in Surrey, Rosemoor in Devon, Hyde Hall in Essex and Harlow Carr in North Yorkshire.
- 22. "Rule Britannia" (England World Rugby Champion) 20 x 1st Class stamps issued 27 July 2004. The labels attached to the stamps contain images of the nation's icons which include the postbox and the red London bus. The sheet was issued to celebrate the feast of sporting events that had taken place over the summer period such as the international cricket test, Euro 2004, Wimbledon, the British Open and the Olympic Games amongst others.
- 23. "Christmas Delivery" a composite sheet containing 10 x 1st Class and 10 x 2nd Class stamps issued on 2 November 2004. Illustrated labels alongside the stamps feature two repeated series of five images of Father Christmas getting up in the morning and preparing for bed. The background design features an image of Father Christmas flying over Buckingham Palace about to make his last delivery.

- 24. "Farm Animals" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 11 January 2005. Featured is a mixture of traditional and rare British breeds.
- 25. "Magic" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 15 March 2005. The labels attached to the stamps show four magic tricks namely, Coin from the air, Nothing up your sleeve, Magic handkerchief and Coin in a bread roll. The stamps were issued to celebrate the centenary when 23 magicians came together at Pinoli's Restaurant in London in 1905 to form the Magic Circle.
- 26. "Hello Occasions" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 21 April 2005 to coincide with the Pacific Explorer Stamp Exhibition in Sydney.
- 27. "The White Ensign" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 21 June 2005. The labels alongside the stamps feature signal flags and their meanings. The sheet is a reminder that the White Ensign is flown by all Her Majesty's ships in commission and furthermore that traditional ceremony is still an important part of the Royal Navy.
- 28. "Classic ITV 1955 2005" 20 x 1st Class stamps issued on 15 September 2005 to mark the 50th anniversary of Independent Television. Affixed to the Emmerdale (serial favourite soap drama) stamps are labels showing six front covers of TV Times plus listings of some of the programmes broadcast in 1965, 1972, 1992 and 2004 most of which may now be out of date.
- 29. "Christmas" composite sheet containing 10 x 1st Class and 10 x 2nd Class issued on 1 November 2005. The labels feature birds and a cat playing with a snowman whereas the sheet margin depicts robins and Christmas crackers.




Fig. 1 Smilers




Fig. 2 Christmas




Fig. 3 Christmas




Fig. 4 Smilers for you - Occasions




Fig. 5 Smilers




Fig. 6 Smilers for Christmas



Smilers for Christmas




Fig. 8 Cartoons




Fig. 9 Smilers for You – Occasions




Fig. 10 World Cup




Fig. 12 Christmas




Fig. 14 Occasions Multiple Choice




Fig. 15 Cartoons




Fig. 16 Winter Robins



2nd Ice Sculptures






Fig. 20 Occasions



Bicentenary of the Royal Horticulatural Society




Fig. 22 Rule Britannia




Fig. 23 Christmas Delivery



Farm Animals




Fig. 25 Magic




Fig. 26 Hello Occasions



Fig. 28 Classic ITV 1955-2005




Fig. 29 Christmas







POSTAL DIARY 1st January 2005 – 31st December 2005

3 January

Maltapost plc notifies that mail will not be distributed today and that all its Branches will not open for business.

18 January

A special Occasion Card has been issued by Maltapost today to raise funds for the victims of the Asian Tsunami Disaster. The Card No 12 in the series shows a printed set of stamps originally issued in May 1988, one of which depicts the Red Cross and the Red Crescent. The stamp has been re-valued at 51c.



In aid of the Tsunami Victims

19 January

Maltapost has today issued its first Commemorative set of stamps for this year — Old Maps of Malta. The set consists of 4 values 1c, 12c, 37c, and Lm1.02 and it has been designed by Alfred Caruana Ruggier. The stamps are offset printed (Perf. 14 x 13.9 comb) on Maltese Crosses watermarked paper in sheets of ten stamps by Printex Ltd. Malta. A special



handstamp inscribed "Old Maps of Malta/—— Malta/ Jum il-Hrug/19.01.05" has been used on mail franked with the "Old Maps of Malta" stamps released today. The stamps in this set have been previewed on "The Malta Stamp" Bulletin No 227 issued by the Maltapost Philatelic Bureau.

26 January

The Maltapost Philatelic Bureau has today issued the 2004 Year Pack, the 17th edition in a series. The Year Pack includes all the issues of the previous year in mint format.

The front cover carries the flags of the ten new EU Member States , surrounded by the European Union stars. The cover is in fact the image of the 16c stamp issued jointly with the other E.U. acceding countries in May of last year.

A complimentary Postcard is offered in a Mint format with the Year Pack.

26 January

The Year Pack Postcard No 8, showing the 1c stamp in the "Letterboxes 2004" stamp set is also being sold separately on the Branches counters. Cancelled Postcards bear the first day of issue date JA 26/05.

29 January

A special hand postmark commemorating the 100 years from the Consecration of the Fontana Parish Church will be used today at the Victoria B.P.O., Gozo. The oval shaped handstamp is inscribed "Consecration of Fontana Parish Church/1905-2005/29-01-2005 Victoria – Gozo – Malta".



19 February

Forged Maltapost 16c stamps used for European destinations have been discovered sold illegally in booklets of six stamps.

22 February

Maltapost has launched a New Courier Service aptly titled "Maltapost Express International". This new service offers delivery to key worldwide destinations in the shortest possible time.

23 February

A special hand postmark "Spring Stampex 2005" will be in use at the Counter Hall, Valletta, between Wednesday 23 and Saturday 26 February during office hours. The handstamp will be inscribed "Stampex/ 23-26.02.05/ Valletta – Malta".

An identical hand postmark will be used at the Maltapost plc Stand at Stampex 2005 Show at the Business Design Hall, Islington, North London on these days and also on Sunday 27 February.



23 February

The "Rotarians" commemorative set of 2 stamps issued today. The value of the stamps (Perf. 14 x 13.9 comb) are 27c and 76c. The stamps, offset printed on Maltese Cross watermarked paper in sheets of ten by Printex Ltd, are designed by Martin Bonavia.



A special handstamp inscribed "Rotarians/ Jum il-Hrug – 23-

02-05/ ——— Malta" has been provided to cancel mail franked with the "Rotarians" stamps on the First Day of Issue. The stamps and the commemorative postmark have been previewed in "The Malta Stamp" Bulletin No 228 (February 2005) issued by the Maltapost Philatelic Bureau.

3 March

A special handstamp inscribed "Int.Briefmarken Borse/ 2005/ Munchen/ M.O.C./3-5 March" will be used at the Counter Hall, Valletta between 3 and 5 March during office hours.

An identical hand postmark will be used on these days as well, at the Maltapost plc Stand at the Munich Stamp Fair.



3 March

Maltapost has today released Hans Christian Andersen Joint Issue with Denmark. The stamps are identical to those designed by the Danish stamp artists Mette & Eric Mourier del, and issued in Denmark today. Printex Ltd offset printed the stamps (perf. 13.6 x 14 comb) in Sheets of 10; the values being 7c, 22c, 60c and 75c.

A commemorative handstamp inscribed "H.C.Andersen/1805-2005/ Jum il-Hrug—3-3-2005/——— Malta" has been prepared to cancel mail franked with these stamps on First Day of Issue. The stamps and postmark have been previewed in "The Malta Stamp" Bulletin No 229 (March 2005) issued by the Maltapost Philatelic Bureau.



21 March

A commemorative handstamp has been used at Dar Annona Counter Hall, Valletta, in connection with the Helicopter First Flight from Xewkija Helipad to Luqa and back, on the 21 March 2005. The handstamp is inscribed: "Helicopteros del Sureste/ 1st Flight-03-05/ Gozo – Malta – Gozo/ Valletta – Malta".



21 March

The Maltese-Spanish Philatelic and Numismatic Club has issued two elusive covers to mark the Bell 412 EP Helicopter First Flights Gozo-Malta and return by the Helicopteros Del Sureste S.A. on the 21 March 2005 GOZO – MALTA Flight endorsed on the back on arrival in Malta: "INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT/ MR 21 05/ LUQA – MALTA"

MALTA —GOZO Flight endorsed on the back on arrival in Gozo: "VICTORIA/MR 21 05/GOZO".

24 March

All Maltapost Branches in Malta and Gozo will be closed on Holy Saturday, when there will be no mail deliveries. The last day for postal deliveries and services before the Easter week-end will be today, Thursday. Normal service will be resumed on Monday.

11 April

The Sub-Post Office in Borg Olivier Street, Mellieha is closed as from today; it will reopen for business on April 18.

15 April

A single stamp designed by the Maltapost Graphic Design Section , with a face value of 51c, is being issued today by the Philatelic Bureau in commemoration of the Death of Pope John Paul II. The stamp offset printed by Printex Limited on Maltese Cross watermarked paper is issued in sheets of ten stamps.

A special handstamp inscribed "In Memoriam—Gwanni Pawlu II/ Jum il-Hrug/

15.04.2005/ ——— Malta" has been prepared to cancel mail franked with this stamp and First Day Covers. The Pope's stamp and the commemorative handstamp are previewed in "The Malta Stamp" Bulletin No 229a (April 2005) issued by the Maltapost Philatelic Bureau.

Note: Two Branch Post Offices handstamps, those to be used at Naxxar B.P.O. and at Paola B.P.O.had an error in the

Issue Date reading "00.04.2005". The handstamps were withdrawn and replaced by others, as soon as the date error had been detected.

20 April

Philatelic Bureau.

A Sheetlet of sixteen stamps featuring "Insects" is being issued today. The stamps all valued at 16c show different species found on the Maltese Islands. The stamp Sheetlet is designed by Andrew Micallef and offset printed by Printex Ltd.

A special handstamp inscribed "Insects/ Jum il-Hrug — 20.04.2005/ ———— Malta" has been provided to cancel the "Insects" stamps franking the mail posted on the First Day of Issue. The stamps and handstamp have been previewed in "The Malta Stamp" official Bulletin No 230 (April 2005) issued by the Maltapost

21 April

A special handstamp commemorating the International Stamp Show "Pacific Explorer" in Sydney Australia is being used at Dar Annona Counter Hall, Valletta from Thursday 21 to Saturday 24 April, during office hours.

The handstamp is inscribed "Pacific Explorer 2005/ 21-

24.04.05/ Valletta – Malta".

A similar handstamp is being used on the International Exhibition Stand run by the Crown Agents, Maltapost's representatives at The Pacific Explorer Show in Sydney.



2 May

To commemorate the first anniversary of Malta's May 1st Accession to the European Union in 2004 and also to commemorate the Malta Collection's First Anniversary, the Philatelic Bureau of Maltapost has released a beautiful packaged top-up pack which contains all the stamps issued between May 2004 and May 2005.

5 May

Maltapost Philatelic Bureau has issued today its 05-05-05 Card, the fifth in the series. This year's Card carries a 16c stamp from the United Europe Issue, stamped with the 05.05.05 datestamp.

The card can be sent through the Post to any destination

The card can be sent through the Post to any destination without additional postage provided it is posted by not later than May 7.

9 May


Malta Europa 2005 Postage stamp set of 2 stamps valued 16c and 51c has been issued today. The set is designed by Joe P. Smith and offset printed in sheets of ten stamps on Maltese Cross watermarked paper by Printex Ltd. A special handstamp inscribed "Europa 2005/ Jum il-Hrug – 09.05.2005/ ———— Malta" has been provided to cancel mail bearing the Europa stamps posted on the First Day of Issue.

The stamps have been previewed in "The Malta Stamp" Bulletin No 231 (May 2005) issued by the Maltapost Philatelic Bureau.

24 May

Maltapost has issued a First Day Cover, today, to launch the new personalized stamps service. It carries two stamps, the 7c stamp for local postage and the 16c stamp for postage to European mainland.

The 7c stamp has a se-tenant personalized stamp with a photograph of a birthday boy and the 16c stamp carry the Maltapost logo adjoined to it.





27 May




