He is the founder and past Head of the Department of Counselling at the University of Malta (UM) (2012 to 2021), past Head of the Department of Psychology at the same university, a past Head of the University of Malta Counselling Unit, and past President of the Malta Association for the Counselling Profession (MACP). Designed and coordinated the first Masters in Counselling programme offered by UM and co-designed and coordinated an international Masters programme in Transcultural Counselling with the University of Maryland at College Park (USA) and as a collaborative degree with the University of New Orleans and later with the University of the Cumberlands (USA). Designed a Post graduate Certificate in Counselling Supervision and co-designed a Post Graduate Certificate in Adlerian Counselling. Dione has served as the Harassment and Bullying advisor of the University of Malta since 2014. In 2022 he was appointed as Adjunct Professor at the University of Verona.
