Automatically import Zoom lecture recordings to Panopto

Zoom recordings of sessions scheduled via the VLE Zoom meetings manager will be automatically available to students under the **Cloud Recordings** tab. The Zoom recordings will be retained for 1 year from the date of recording, in line with the retention policy.

You may wish to back up your Zoom lecture recordings scheduled via the VLE in the corresponding Panopto study-unit folder, since Panopto recordings stored in study-unit folders are retained for 2 academic years. You can opt-in as follows:

- 1. Access the UM Panopto platform.
- 2. Click on your **User profile** (initials) in the top-right corner.
- 3. Click the **User Settings** button.
- 4. Within the *Info* tab, scroll down to the **Meeting Import Settings** section.
- 5. Tick the **Zoom** option.
- 6. Click Update.

Meeting Import Settings

Automatic Import

Enable or disable automatic import of Meeting Recordings. If it's locked by the administrator, the setting cannot be changed.



7. Close the *User Settings* dialog box.

Note:

- The steps above must be carried out **once**. Subsequently, Zoom recordings of sessions scheduled via the VLE *Zoom meetings manager* on any VLE study-unit area are automatically backed up on the corresponding Panopto study-unit folder.
- As per the retention policy of Panopto and Zoom recordings, the copy of the Zoom recording stored in Panopto will be retained for 2 academic years.
