1. The weather conditions associated with a particular wind are determined by its area of origin and by the characteristics of the surface over which it blows. Explain this statement using examples from local winds that influence the Mediterranean region. (20 marks)




Figure 1: Local winds in the Mediterranean region (Source: http://lyachtua.com)

2. Explain the formation of rias with reference to examples in the Maltese Islands or other Mediterranean countries. Include diagrams and sketch maps to help you answer this question. (20 marks)

- 3. (a) Describe the effect of the following factors on surface run-off:
 - (i) geology,
 - (ii) vegetation cover,
 - (iii) drainage density. (12 marks)
 - (b) Sketch a storm hydrograph for a drainage basin during a flash flood. On the sketch label the following features:
 - (i) rising limb,
 - (ii) falling limb,
 - (iii) peak discharge,
 - (iv) base flow. (8 marks)

Section 2: Human Geographical Processes




Figure 2: Lee's Model of Migration (Source: Lee, E.S., 1966)

- 4. Figure 2 illustrates a model of migration of people.
 - (a) With reference to examples, discuss **four** reasons why people migrate. (10 marks)
 - (b) Describe **five** problems, generally called 'intervening obstacles' that are faced by migrants moving from one country or region to another. (10 marks)

- 5. (a) List **four** characteristics of a hamlet. (4 marks)
 - (b) Discuss **three** factors that have led some hamlets to become depopulated and abandoned. (6 marks)
 - (c) Discuss **five** factors that have resulted in some hamlets growing into villages and towns. (10 marks)

- 6. Tourism is a very important source of revenue for Mediterranean countries.
 - (a) Give **five** reasons why northern Mediterranean countries are a more popular tourist destination than southern Mediterranean countries. (10 marks)
 - (b) Describe **five** geographical factors that make Malta and other Mediterranean Islands attractive to millions of tourists every year. (10 marks)

Section 3: The Man-Environment Relationship

- 7. Volcanoes are a natural hazard to populations that live around them but they can also be used for the benefit of the same populations.
 - (a) By referring to specific examples, describe the main hazards associated with the eruption of a volcano. (10 marks)
 - (b) Explain how volcanoes are used for the benefit of the people living in their vicinity. Refer to specific examples. (10 marks)
- 8. (a) Give **three** reasons why deforestation is still happening in many parts of the world. Support your answer with examples. (12 marks)
 - (b) Describe **four** measures that can be used to control deforestation. (8 marks)
- 9. (a) Explain the environmental threats posed by the disposal of uncontrolled and unseparated waste in dumps or landfills. (10 marks)
 - (b) Explain how engineered landfills can reduce the environmental impact of waste disposal. (10 marks)




Figure 3: A topographic map (Source: http://www.mapcruzin.com)

 - (b) Describe the topography of the area shown in Figure 3. (6 marks)
