

	The Sonata in <i>E Major Kirkpatrick 380 – Lango 23 (17547)</i> is considered one of the most popular sonatas by Domenico Scarlatti. Comment on the form making special reference to sections, thematic material and tonality. Debussy's <i>Golliwog's Cakewalk</i> is the 6 th and last movement from a suite for piano

- b. Debussy's *Golliwog's Cakewalk* is the 6th and last movement from a suite for piano dedicated to his daughter "Children's Corner" (1908). This movement has attracted much critical acclaim mainly for its juxtaposition of a ragtime-inflected cakewalk with parodied quotations of Wagner's famous prelude to his opera *Tristan und Isolde*. Discuss.
- c. Show how Enrique Granados succeeds to portray the Spanish *tinta* in his Danza No. 1 "Minueto" from *12 Danzas Espanolas*, Op. 5.
