



	b. <i>Golliwog's Cakewalk</i> is the sixth movement from Debussy's suite entitled <i>Children's Corner</i> . Comment on the various features of this piano work with special reference to Debussy's use of ragtime, syncopation rhythms, banjo-like effects and the satiric use of Wagner's Tristan chord, and the large dynamic range.
	c. Give a brief analytical account on Enrique Granados' Spanish Dance 'Minueto' from 'Danzas Espanoles', Op. 5 with special reference to the contrasts in keys and character between the sections.
