- e) Why has Homer been called the father of Western Civilization? What is so unique and significant about the Homeric epics?
- f) What has made history look upon Scipio Africanus Maior as the greatest general of the classical world? Discuss.

- b) How does the study of mythology enrich the experience of every modern reader and writer?
