3. Read the following passage and answer all the questions:

- b) Discuss the myth surrounding two of the following figures, particularly their connection with Crete and Athens or with the foundation of Rome: **Europa Ariadne Pasiphae Aeneas Achilles Agamemnon.**
- c) What did the revolution of the Gracchi in Republican Rome represent? Can you compare this to any modern political situation?
- d) What has been the lasting influence of the Golden Age of Greece on the Western world? Discuss any two major figures.
- e) Which mythological Greek tragedy do you feel is the most compelling? Why?
- f) What can you say about the figure of Julius Caesar, and why has it attracted so much attention?

5. Write an essay of not less than 300 words on TWO of the following topics:

- a) Some contemporary best-selling authors and film-makers are inspired by the stories and heroes of Classical Mythology. What are your comments on this?
- b) Do you consider that there are any advantages to be gained from being educated in the Classics? Discuss.
- c) In an imaginary conversation between a disciple of Homer and a disciple of Socrates, who do you think would present the best arguments for claiming the title of "the Father of Western Civilization"? Why?
