<b>MID5002</b>	<b>Research methods applied to Midwifery (Semester 1)</b>	<b>10 ECTS Credits</b>
<p><b>Available for:</b> Qualified midwives who hold a professional registration with a regulatory body recognised by the UM. The study-unit listed above is delivered face to face mostly asynchronous manner. Proficiency in basic IT skills is a prerequisite. Limited to 20 students.</p> <p>CPD study-unit fee: €650</p>		
<b>POD5002</b>	<b>Vascular Assessment of the Lower Extremities (Year)</b>	<b>5 ECTS Credits</b>
<p><b>Available for:</b> Health care professionals holding a B.Sc. (Hons.) Degree and Podiatrists in possession of a Diploma with 5 years clinical experience. Limited to 15 students.</p> <p>CPD study-unit fee: €325</p>		
<b>RAD5022</b>	<b>Magnetic Resonance Safety (Semester 1)</b>	<b>10 ECTS Credits</b>
<p><b>Available for:</b> Qualified radiographers who hold a professional registration with a regulatory body recognised by the UM and who have an interest in developing basic knowledge and skills in MRI safety. The study-unit listed above is delivered in an online mostly asynchronous manner. Proficiency in basic IT skills is a prerequisite. Limited to 10 students.</p>		
<b>RAD5023</b>	<b>Advanced Training for Magnetic Resonance Safety Officers (MRSO) (Year)</b>	<b>20 ECTS Credits</b>
<p><b>This study-unit is primarily intended for qualified radiographers who practice in MRI.</b></p> <p><b>Available for:</b> Qualified radiographers with work experience in MRI who hold a professional registration with a regulatory body recognised by the UM and who have an interest in developing advanced knowledge and skills of a Magnetic Resonance Safety Officer. The study-unit listed above is delivered in an online mostly asynchronous manner. Proficiency in basic IT skills is a prerequisite. Limited to 10 students.</p>
