SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACT

An abstract of **not more** than **2000 characters** including spaces (excluding title and student's name) has to be submitted via the electronic website by the indicated deadline. *Note one submission per student*. A hard copy of the abstract signed by project supervisor.

The abstract must convey in a clear concise manner information which would be contained in the final project report. The abstract should emphasise important aspects of the project. It must be understandable when read.

Guidelines:

- 1. Type Double spaced and use Times New Roman size 12.
- 2. Use standard abbreviations.
- 3. Do not include any graphs, tables and illustrations.
- 4. Proof read abstracts carefully.
- 5. Do not include more than **2000 characters** including spaces including references.

Abstract Guidelines:

Title and Name of student	
Background	Description of the situation
Objective	The question or problem addressed by the study must be clearly presented.
Design	The basic design of the study, selection of study subjects, observational and analytical methods, statistical methods used.
Setting	Details where study was carried out.
Main outcome measures	The endpoint/s of the study should be clearly outlined.
Results	Description of results should be brief and precise. Give specific data and statistical significance where applicable. Present only representative data. Avoid phrases such as 'Results will be shown'.
Conclusions	The conclusion(s) should follow logically from the objective, main outcome measures, and results of the abstract.
References	Maximum of four references, numbered consecutively in the text. Refer to: https://www.nlm.nih.gov/bsd/uniform_requirements.html
