Dissertation Progress Report
PHR5637

You are required to prepare a progress report related to your dissertation.

Rationale: The progress report is intended to put forward the research question, describe the methodology being applied, present preliminary results and discuss further work to be undertaken to achieve the outcomes of the research.

Key components:

- Presentation (not more than 5 minutes) including the following headings: Background, Aim and Objectives, Methodology and Discussion (including any preliminary results). References should be in Vancouver style, numbered and incorporated within each slide.

- Report (1000-1500 words excluding abstract and references) including the following headings: Introduction, Aim and Objectives, Methodology, Preliminary Results, Discussion. A total of two tables or figures can be included. An abstract (maximum 200 words) is required including the following headings: Aims and Objectives, Methodology, Preliminary Results and Discussion

References should be in Vancouver style using author-date citation system and listed alphabetically in the references section after the discussion. Only references cited in the text should be included in the list. References should be listed according to the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals. Please refer to: https://www.nlm.nih.gov/bsd/uniform_requirements.html Use of footnotes is recommended for sources such as reports, non-peer reviewed articles, websites and newspaper contributions.
