Kypros was born in 1953 in Paphos, Cyprus. He studied Medicine at King's College School of Medicine and Dentistry in London and soon after graduation joined the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology in 1980 and working mainly on fetoscopic techniques and procedures. After the departure of Professor Charles Rodeck, Nicolaides became director of the Harris Birthright Research Centre for Fetal Medicine, the first fetal medicine unit in the United Kingdom

His research in Prenatal Diagnosis covers a wide span of topics extending into the many realms of prenatal ultrasonography, cytogenetic studies and doppler velocimetry.

“We basically examine women with problems during pregnancy, from England as well as other European countries. We watch for the normal growth of embryos with ultrasound techniques. We are able to isolate the problem with ultrasound and can then proceed to surgery in the womb to rectify it”.
